VIKINGS MEN RETURN TO THE ROAD

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. – The season-long four game homestand in the books, Augustana returns to the road this weekend for games at Minnesota Crookston and Bemidji State. The Vikings and Golden Eagles get things started on Friday at 8 p.m., while Saturday's tilt in Bemidji begins at 6 p.m.

The Vikings returned to the Elmen Center for the first game of last weekend, and made the most of it in a convincing 85-65 win over Minnesota Duluth. Four Vikings scored in double figures, led by Jordan Spencer and his game-high 30 points. Augie also got 15 points and 13 rebounds from Marcus Asmus, his fourth double-double of the season. The Vikings also got 17 points from Adam Dykman and 10 from Steven Schaefer in the win.

Friday's momentum did not follow the Vikings back to the Sioux Falls Arena on Saturday against St. Cloud State, as a slow start gave the Huskies an early lead that they would never relinquish in an 80-63 win. John Warren led the Vikings with 16 points, as the only Augustana player in double figures.

Following this weekend's action, the Vikings return home for one more regular season weekend at the Arena, when they host Sioux Falls on Friday, Feb. 9, before closing the regular season home schedule against Southwest Minnesota State on Saturday, Feb. 10, when both the men's and women's basketball teams invite all basketball alumni to come to the Arena for basketball alumni night.

VIKINGS QUICK HITS

- This week's games mark the 2,192nd and 2,193rd games in program history
- Augustana enters the week with a 149-61 all-time record in NSIC play
- Head coach Tom Billeter notched his 380th career on Jan. 19, vs. Upper Iowa
- After leading at some point in the first 21 games of the season, the Vikings did not lead on Saturday vs. St. Cloud State
- The Vikings used the same five starters in all 22 games this season
- All five Vikings starters average at least 10 points per game
- Augustana held its opponent to under 50 percent shooting in all 13 wins
- The Vikings committed a season-low five turnovers vs. Minnesota Duluth, the fewest since March 1, 2016, vs. MSUM
- Jordan Spencer leads the nation with 170 assists, four more than second place (Conor McGuinness of Adelphi, 166)
- Spencer made his last 26 free throw attempts, with his last miss coming against Minnesota State on Jan 5
- Steven Schaefer currently holds the Augustana record for career 3-point field goal percentage at 50.8 percent
- Four Vikings combined for 12 double-doubles this season (Spencer 4, Asmus 4, Dykman and Warren 2)
- Minnesota Crookston's lone win over Augustana came on Nov. 24, 2004 in Crookston, by the score of 90-88
- Augustana won the last five meetings with Bemidji State, with the last loss coming on Jan. 10, 2014, 69-67, in Bemidji

NOTEWORTHY

ARENA SWEET ARENA: The Vikings returned to the Sioux Falls Arena for the 2014-15 season, and rattled off 29 straight wins on the new/old home floor. The Vikings now own a 40-8 record in the Arena since returning in 2014.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Senior Jordan Spencer entered the season ranked 20th in all-time scoring at Augustana with 1,221 career points. His 370 points this season boost his total to 1,591, which ranks 12th all-time, 38 points shy of passing Bill Gross (1,628 points from 1969-73) for 11th all-time. He needs to score 51 points over the rest of the season to crack the top-10.

DISH IT OUT: Along with being a prolific scorer for the Vikings, Jordan Spencer entered his senior season with a school-record 688 assists, and a 6.8 assists per game average. The dynamic distributor added an NCAA Division II-leading 170 assists so far this season, pushing his record total to 858, and his assists per game average to 7.0.

STOP, THEIF! He scores, he assists and he steals. Jordan Spencer came into the season tied for 17th all-time at Augustana with 122 steals, but his 25 steals this season give him 147, good for eighth all-time, and eight shy of passing Shaun Hickman (154 steals from 1984-88) for seventh all-time.

3-POINTER STREAK: Augustana made at least one 3-point field goal in each of the last 418 games. The last time the Vikings did not make a 3-pointer came on Jan. 24, 2004, a 79-69 loss against North Dakota in the Elmen Center.

FINISH WHAT YOU START: Already a starter in 100 games in his career coming into the season, Spencer needs to start 30 games this season to set the school-record for career starts, a record held by Daniel Jansen (129 starts from 2012-16). He enters the week 22 starts this season, for a total of 122 in his career.

VIKINGS IN DOUBLE FIGURES: At least one Viking score in double figures in each of the last 244 games. The last time at least one Augie player did not score at least 10 points in a game came on March 3, 2010, in a 75-52 loss to Wayne State at the Elmen Center in the NSIC Quarterfinals, when Lee Stephens led the Vikings with 8 points.

WHERE DID THE POINTS GO? Over the last two seasons, Augustana graduated a total of 9,150 career points from a total of eight student-athletes, which includes five 1,000-point scorers, two of which scored at least 2,000 career points.

The most prolific coach in Augustana history, Tom Billeter returns in 2017-18 for his 15th season leading the Vikings, his 20th season as a head coach and his 33rd season as a college coach.

A Byron, Illinois native and University of Illinois graduate, Billeter took over a struggling program in 2003, and began transforming the Vikings into a model program on and off the court.

The Billeter-led Vikings won just six games in his first season at Augie, but wasted little time starting to climb in the conference standings. His second season at the helm saw the team win eight games, followed by 12 wins in year three and 16 wins in year four.

In his fifth season, Billeter's Vikings posted a 22-9 record, finished second in the conference and earned the first of three straight trips to the NCAA Tournament, all 20-win seasons, including a school-record 24 wins in 2009-10.

After a year away, the Vikings returned to the NCAA Tournament in both 2011-12 and 2012-13, and even though they missed out in 2013-14, the team returned better than ever in 2014-15, setting the stage for a historic run.

Led by a core group of upperclassmen, the 2014-15 Vikings posted the school's first-ever 30-win season, the first regular season conference title since 1988-89 and a No. 1 seed at the Regional Tournament, but the historic run came up just short in a 66-65 loss to Northwest Missouri State in the regional semifinal.

Undaunted, and with the entire team returning in 2015-16, the Vikings completed what they started the year before, winning a program-record 34 games and securing the first men's basketball National Championship in school history. Augustana posted the highest winning percentage in NCAA Division II in 2015-16 and the second-most wins of all NCAA teams across all three divisions.

Despite losing the majority of the national championship squad to graduation, Billeter still led the Vikings to a 24-9 record and a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 2016-17 before falling to the eventual national champion Northwest Missouri State Bearcats on their home floor in Maryville, Missouri, in the regional semifinals.
