QUICK HITS ON THE #16 WOLVES

- The No. 16 Wolves enter the non-conference match-up with an 8-1 record overall and 2-0 mark in the NSIC, currently on a seven game win streak.
- NSU is shooting 47.8 percent from the floor, 38.4 percent from the arc, and 68.1 percent from the foul line.
- Northern is averaging 74.0 points, 38.1 rebounds, 15.3 assists, 12.8 turnovers, 5.8 steals, and 4.9 blocks per game this season.
- The Wolves are coming off two double figure victories to open NSIC play against Minot State and U-Mary, as Ian Smith and Gabe King each nabbed career highs.
- Smith scored a career high 26 points against the Beavers, while King added a career high 18 against the Marauders.
- Smith is leading three Wolves averaging double figures, notching 13.1 points per game. He also holds a team leading 36 assists this season.
- Carter Evans is shooting a team leading 67.7 percent from the floor, while notching a team second best 5.4 rebounds per game.
- Logan Doyle is leading the team in the rebound department, averaging 7.9 per game in addition to 8.7 points per game.

BEMIDJI STATE UNIVERSITY // DEC. 8 @ 8 PM

About the Beavers

- Bemidji State enters the weekend 4-4 overall and 1-2 in the NSIC notching a win over Duluth.
- BSU is shooting 45.7 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent from the arc, and 74.3 percent from the foul line, while averaging 75.9 points, 36.4 rebounds, 15.1 assists, 13.8 turnovers, 6.1 steals, and 2.5 blocks per game.
- Jai'Vionne Green is leading four Beavers in double figures averaging 14.6 points per game.
- Sharif Black is averaging a team third best 12.6 points, and team leading 5.5 rebounds per game.
- Lucas Wendt is leading the team shooting 57.9 percent from the floor, while averaging 14.0 points per game.
- The Beavers are led by head coach Mike Boschee in his sixth season at the helm.

Last Match-Up

- The Wolves split with the Beavers in 2016-17, winning the road contest 88-61 and falling 63-59 at home.
- Bo Fries led the team on the road with 18 points, shooting 6-of-9 from the floor.
- Ian Smith led the team in the loss with 23 points and a team second best nine rebounds.
- Logan Doyle grabbed a career high 17 rebounds in the home game as well.
- Northern is 62-26 all-time against Bemidji State.

About the Golden Eagles

- Crookston enters the weekend with a 4-4 record overall and 2-1 mark in NSIC play.
- The Golden Eagles are shooting 48.6 percent from the floor, 41.5 percent from the 3-point line, and 75.8 percent from the arc, while averaging 84.4 points, 35.3 rebounds, 12.4 assists, 11.1 turnovers, 4.8 steals, and 4.6 blocks per game this season.
- Harrison Cleary leads the team averaging 23.9 points per game and 191 thus far.
- Gable Smith is shooting a team leading 67.4% from the floor, while pulling down 6.4 rebounds per game.
- Alan Hodge is second on the team averaging 18.1 points per game, while Chase Knickerbocker is notching 13.8.
- UMC is led by head coach Dan Weisse in his fourth season at the helm.

Last Match-Up

- The Wolves defeated the Golden Eagles 101-68 and 85-80 a season ago.
- Logan Doyle led six scorers in double figures with 17 points in the game one victory, as the Wolves shot 57.6 percent from the floor and hit ten 3-point baskets.
- Doyle tallied a team leading 23 points and 20 rebounds in the game two victory, while Ian Smith notched 12 points and 15 rebounds.
- Northern is 34-2 all-time against Crookston and currently on a ten game win streak.

PAUL SATHER // HEAD COACH

Paul Sather enters in eighth year at the helm for the Wolves in 2017-18. Sather, who is the 22nd head men's basketball coach at Northern State, is a 1996 graduate of NSU. Sather has compiled an 126-78 record while at Northern.

In 2016-17 the Wolves finished tied for second in the overall league standings with Southwest Minnesota State, finishing 22-8 overall and 17-5 in the NSIC. Three Wolves garnered All-NSIC honors as Logan Doyle was named the NSIC Newcomer of the year and to the NSIC first team, and Ian Smith and Mack Arvidson were named to the NSIC second team. Northern State junior DJ Pollard was named the NSIC Elite 18 recipient holding the top GPA from the NSIC Championships with a 3.96 mark.

In his sixth season at the helm Sather landed two on the All-NSIC second team in senior Skye Warwick and junior Darin Peterka. The Wolves also tallied an upset victory over then No. 1 Augustana 90-81.

In 2014-15 he led the Wolves to their first NCAA Regional appearance since the 2008-09 season. Sather and the Wolves went 23-9 on the year with a fourth place finish in the NSIC, and second place finish in the NSIC North. Seniors Seth Bachand and Tydan Storrusten were named to the NSIC First and Second Team's in 2014-15.

In 2012-13, Sather led Northern to its first 20-win season since 2007-08. The Wolves went 20-11 overall and their 14 conference wins in '12-'13, was the first time since 2008-09 that the Wolves had double-digit NSIC victories.

In his short tenure with the Wolves, Sather has also coached six 1,000-point scorers at NSU in Collin Pryor, Dustin Tetzlaff, Seth Bachand, Skye Warwick, DJ Pollard, and Mack Arvidson.

Prior to arriving back in Aberdeen, Sather spent five years as the head coach at Black Hills State, guiding the Yellow Jackets to a 94-62 record during his time there before returning to NSU.

Sather was instrumental in turning the BHSU program around from a 10-19 season in 2006-07 to an NAIA Final Four contender in 2008-09. The Yellow Jackets also qualified for the national tournament in 2009-10 and compiled an overall conference record of 46-25 in the five years under Sather, including winning two Dakota Athletic Conference championships.

As an assistant for the Wolves in the early years of his career, Sather was a part of three Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) regular season championships and NSU's first ever NSIC Tournament Championship.

After earning his bachelor's degree in secondary education in 1996 from Northern State University, he served as physical education teacher and assistant boys' basketball coach at Sidney High School in Nebraska from 1996-1997. The following year he was a graduate assistant at Wayne State College while he earned his master's degree in sports administration.

Originally from Princeton, Minn., Sather had a stellar career collegiate career as a Wolf from 1990-1994. He was team captain for the NSU when they earned back-to-back national runner-up finishes in 1993 and 1994.

Sather resides in Aberdeen with his wife Kelsie and their two children, Sam and Becca.
