QUICK HITS ON THE #12 WOLVES

- The Northern State University men's basketball team enters the weekend with a 23-3 record overall, as well as a hold on the NSIC North and overall standings.
- NSU opened the week moving up four spots to No. 12 in the NABC Top-25 Coaches Poll.
- DJ Pollard leads four in double figures, averaging 13.1 points per game, closely followed by Ian Smith averaging 13.0 points per game.
- Logan Doyle and Darin Peterka are notching 11.8 and 11.3 points per game respectively.
- Doyle leads the team shooting 65.0 percent from the floor and averaging 7.1 rebounds per game. The senior is also leading the NSIC in field goal percentage this season.
- Smith has dished out a team leading 114 assists and grabbed 33 steals.
- Cole Dahl is shooting a team leading 47.7 percent from the arc, while Peterka has drained a team high 37 long range buckets.
- The Wolves sit atop the league in scoring defense (68.4), scoring margin (+12.4), and rebounding margin (+7.3) in games against NSIC opponents.
- They are shooting 50.3 percent from the floor, 40.8 percent from the arc, and 74.6 percent from the foul line this season, while averaging 79.7 points, 36.2 rebounds, 15.8 assists, 11.5 turnovers, 5.4 steals, and 4.1 blocks per game.
- NSU ranks nationally in the top-15 in scoring margin (+13.3), field goal percentage (50.3), and 3-point field goal percentage (40.8).

MINNESOTA CROOKSTON // FEB. 9 @ 8 PM

About the Golden Eagles

- Minnesota Crookston enters the weekend with a 9-15 record overall and 6-12 mark in the league.
- Harrison Cleary leads the team and the NSIC averaging 24.8 points per game, with a team leading 67 made 3-pointers this season. He also has a team leading 93 total assists, averaging 3.9 per game.
- Gable Smith is averaging a team leading 7.0 rebounds and 3.9 blocks per game, while shooting 61.7 percent from the floor. Smith also has a team leading 41 steals in 2017-18.
- Alan Hodge Jr. is averaging 14.7 points per game, while Chase Knickerbocker and Ben Juhl are notching 11.0 and 10.8 per game respectively.
- The Golden Eagles are shooting 46.1 percent from the floor, 39.5 percent from the 3-point line, and 79.1 percent from the foul line, while averaging 76.2 points, 33.0 rebounds, 10.8 assists, 10.8 turnovers, 5.3 steals, and 5.6 blocks per game this season.
- UMC is led by head coach Dan Weisse in his fourth season at the helm.

Last Match-Up

- The Wolves defeated the Golden Eagles 76-64 from Wachs Arena earlier this season.
- Smith and Evans each notched 18 points, while Pollard and Peterka tallied 13 each.
- NSU tallied 40 points in the paint and 24 points off turnovers.
- Northern is 35-2 all-time against Minnesota Crookston, winning the last 11 contests.

BEMIDJI STATE UNIVERSITY // FEB. 10 @ 6 PM

About the Beavers

- Bemidji State enters the weekend with a 10-13 record overall and 7-11 mark in the NSIC.
- Sharif Black leads five averaging double figures with 15.4 points per game. He is also grabbing a team second best 5.0 rebounds per game, behind Logan Bader notching 5.8.
- Bader has hit a team leading 46 made 3-pointers, and averages 11.4 points per game.
- Lucas Wendt is second on the team averaging 14.0 points per game, while shooting a team high 57.9 percent from the floor.
- Jai'Vionne Green and Christian Pekarak are the final players in double figures averaging 13.2 and 10.4 points per game.
- Pekarek has a team leading 95 assists and is shooting a team high 39.4 percent from the arc.
- The Beavers are averaging 72.8 points, 35.3 rebounds, 13.2 assists, 11.8 turnovers, 5.1 steals, and 2.1 blocks per game this season, while shooting 45.5 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent from the 3-point line, and 71.3 percent from the foul line.
- BSU is led by head coach Mike Boschee in his sixth season at the helm.

Last Match-Up

- Northern defeated Bemidji State 75-54 at home earlier this season.
- Pollard led the team with 17 points, while Carter Evans notched a second best 15 off the bench.
- The Wolves are 63-26 all-time against Bemidji State.

PAUL SATHER // HEAD COACH

Paul Sather enters in eighth year at the helm for the Wolves in 2017-18. Sather, who is the 22nd head men's basketball coach at Northern State, is a 1996 graduate of NSU. Sather has compiled an 126-78 record while at Northern.

In 2016-17 the Wolves finished tied for second in the overall league standings with Southwest Minnesota State, finishing 22-8 overall and 17-5 in the NSIC. Three Wolves garnered All-NSIC honors as Logan Doyle was named the NSIC Newcomer of the year and to the NSIC first team, and Ian Smith and Mack Arvidson were named to the NSIC second team. Northern State junior DJ Pollard was named the NSIC Elite 18 recipient holding the top GPA from the NSIC Championships with a 3.96 mark.

In his sixth season at the helm Sather landed two on the All-NSIC second team in senior Skye Warwick and junior Darin Peterka. The Wolves also tallied an upset victory over then No. 1 Augustana 90-81.

In 2014-15 he led the Wolves to their first NCAA Regional appearance since the 2008-09 season. Sather and the Wolves went 23-9 on the year with a fourth place finish in the NSIC, and second place finish in the NSIC North. Seniors Seth Bachand and Tydan Storrusten were named to the NSIC First and Second Team's in 2014-15.

In 2012-13, Sather led Northern to its first 20-win season since 2007-08. The Wolves went 20-11 overall and their 14 conference wins in '12-'13, was the first time since 2008-09 that the Wolves had double-digit NSIC victories.

In his short tenure with the Wolves, Sather has also coached six 1,000-point scorers at NSU in Collin Pryor, Dustin Tetzlaff, Seth Bachand, Skye Warwick, DJ Pollard, and Mack Arvidson.

Prior to arriving back in Aberdeen, Sather spent five years as the head coach at Black Hills State, guiding the Yellow Jackets to a 94-62 record during his time there before returning to NSU.

Sather was instrumental in turning the BHSU program around from a 10-19 season in 2006-07 to an NAIA Final Four contender in 2008-09. The Yellow Jackets also qualified for the national tournament in 2009-10 and compiled an overall conference record of 46-25 in the five years under Sather, including winning two Dakota Athletic Conference championships.

As an assistant for the Wolves in the early years of his career, Sather was a part of three Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) regular season championships and NSU's first ever NSIC Tournament Championship.

After earning his bachelor's degree in secondary education in 1996 from Northern State University, he served as physical education teacher and assistant boys' basketball coach at Sidney High School in Nebraska from 1996-1997. The following year he was a graduate assistant at Wayne State College while he earned his master's degree in sports administration.

Originally from Princeton, Minn., Sather had a stellar career collegiate career as a Wolf from 1990-1994. He was team captain for the NSU when they earned back-to-back national runner-up finishes in 1993 and 1994.

Sather resides in Aberdeen with his wife Kelsie and their two children, Sam and Becca.

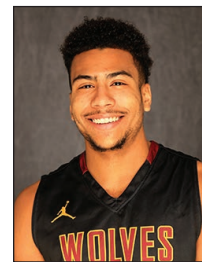
