WSC FACES FINAL GAMES VS. NSIC NORTH OPPONENTS THIS WEEKEND WITH ROAD TRIP TO BEMIDJI STATE AND MINNESOTA CROOKSTON

THE MATCHUPS: Wayne State College hits the road this weekend for NSIC North games at Bemidji State Friday night at 8 p.m. and Minnesota Crookston Saturday at 6 p.m.

The Wildcars are 12-12 overall and sixth place in the NSIC South at 7-9 in league play. BSU 9-12 and four place in the NSIC North at 6-10 while UMC starts the weekend at 8-14 and 5-11 (6th place) in league play. Last season, BSU won in Wayne 78-76 while WSC outlasted UMC 79-72.

Wayne State men's basketball can be heard on local radio and the Wildcat Sports Network and flagship radio station KTCH FM 104.9/KCTY 1590 AM-98.9 FM in Wayne. Fans outside the KTCH listening areas can listen to the broadcast by logging onto the internet broadcast link at http://www.waynedailynews.com. Aaron Scheffler will call the play-by-play action this weekend with both games on KTCH FM 104.9 'Big Red Country'.

WILDCATS SPLIT NSIC HOME TWINBILL VS. SCSU AND UMD: Wayne State met the hottest team in the NSIC last Friday evening in Rice Auditorium as the St. Cloud State Huskies cruised past the Wildcats 82-58, but WSC bounced back the following night with a thrilling 88-86 overtime win over Minnesota Duluth.

St. Cloud State used 55 percent shooting (31-56) to take down the Wildcats. Tony Bonner and Brian Goodwin each scored 10 points to lead the Wildcats. WSC was limited to just 41 percent shooting in the game (24-58) and just 4 of 18 from the 3-point line.

WSC came back the following night with 57.9 percent shooting (33-57) and made 9 of 10 free throws in the overtime period to outlast the Bulldogs 88-86 in overtime. It was the fourth time in the last nine meetings that WSC and UMD played an overtime contest. Junior guard Vance Janssen poured in a career-high 22 points on 9 of 15 shooting followed by Kendall Jacks with 21. Senior forward Jordan Cornelius added 16 points and nine rebounds while making 4 of 5 from 3-point range.

ABOUT WAYNE STATE: The Wildcats are 12-12 overall and sixth place in the NSIC South Division at 7-9 entering this weekend's road trip to Bemidji and Crookston. WSC is 9-5 at home, 2-6 in road games and 1-1 on a neutral court this year.

WSC is 11th in the NSIC in scoring offense (75.4) and fifth in scoring defense (72.1). The Wildcats rank seventh in the league in field goal percentage (.475), 10th in 3-point field goal percentage (.368) and 13th in free throw percentage (.720). Wayne State is 14th in the league at 6.9 3-pointers per game and ranks 15th in rebounding margin at -3.0 per contest.

Wayne State leads the NSIC in turnover margin (+3.25) and steals per game (7.0).

Junior guard Kendall Jacks leads Wayne State in scoring at 14.0 points per game (20th-NSIC). He shoots 51.4 percent from the field and 80.6 percent at the free throw line (15th-NSIC) while leading the team in assists with 54.

Junior reserve guard Trevin Joseph adds 11.8 points a contest, leading the team in 3-pointers with 33. He ranks sixth in the NSIC with 1.4 steals per game. Junior point guard Vance Janssen accounts for 10.0 points a game and is third in the league in steals (1.6) while shooting 87 percent (47-54) at the stripe.

Senior forward Jordan Cornelius produces 8.2 points and a team-high 4.7 boards per game, shooting 48.2 percent from the field and 78.3 percent at the free throw line. Senior guard Brian Goodwin averages 7.8 points and 4.3 rebounds a game.

Sophomore reserve center Tony Bonner scores 7.4 points a game to go with 3.1 rebounds a game while shooting 56.1 percent from the field (74-132), to rank 12th in the NSIC.

DID YOU KNOW???:

- ***Home teams in NSIC play last weekend were just 7-9 and are now 72-55 (.567) overall this season.
- ***WSC is 3-6 this season in games decided by five points or less, including four losses with less than three seconds to play.
 - ***WSC is 8-1 in games when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
 - ***Wayne State is already 9-5 at home this year after going just 4-8 in Rice Auditorium last year.
 - ***On the flip side, after going 6-9 in road games last year, WSC is just 2-6 away from home this year.
- ***Wildcat senior forward Jordan Cornelius is the next Wildcat in pursuit of 1,000 career points at WSC. He enters this weekend's play with 976 points and looks to become the 33rd player in school history to hit 1,000 career points.

WAYNE STATE HEAD COACH JEFF KAMINSKY: Jeff Kaminsky is in his second season as head men's basketball coach at Wayne State College. He was named the 27th head coach in the program's 102-year history on June 15, 2016.



Under Kaminsky, the Wildcats posted a 10-19 overall record and 8-14 mark in the NSIC South Division in his first season as head coach. WSC doubled its win total from the previous season, starting the year with a road win at Missouri Western 70-57 that snapped a 17-game road losing streak dating back to January 31, 2015. The Wildcats ended the year with six road wins, one more than the previous three years combined.

WSC also made substantial improvements defensively under Kaminsky as the Wildcats allowed nearly 10 fewer points than the previous season. The 'Cats ranked sixth in the league allowing 75.8 points per game after inheriting a team that was 16th the previous year while allowing 85.1 points a contest. Wayne State also ranked first in the league in turnover margin (+3.07) averaging only 10.8 turnovers a game while creating a league-high 13.9 a contest.

When hired at WSC, Kaminsky brought 29 years of collegiate head coaching experience and over 450 career wins to the Wildcat program. Kaminsky served 11 seasons as the head coach at Valley City State University in North Dakota before coming to Wayne, compiling a 183-144 record that included five 20-win seasons in his last nine years at the school. His 2015-16 team recorded a 22-11 record and advanced to the second round of the NAIA Division II National Tournament while finishing the season ranked #21 in the final NAIA Division II Top 25 Coaches Poll

Kaminsky's 2012-13 team posted a 23-7 record at Valley City State while advancing to the NAIA National Tournament for the first time since 1987.

Kaminsky also served 11 years (1994-2005) as head coach at Wisconsin-Superior where he also served as the interim athletic director overseeing 16 sports from 2000-2004. His first collegiate head coaching job was at Mid State Technical College in Wisconsin where Kaminsky spent seven years as head coach, accumulating a 153-70 record with three consecutive Wisconsin Junior College State Championships.

Kaminsky began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Division I Kent State in the 1985-86 season, helping the Golden Flashes to a 19-10 record and second place finish in the Mid American Conference.

Kaminsky graduated from Grand Valley State University in Michigan where he was voted GLIAC Scholar Athlete of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year as a senior helping GVSU to a 21-7 record and Sweet 16 appearance in the NCAA Division II Tournament. He began his collegiate career at College of DuPage in Illinois where he was a Junior College Honorable Mention All-American in the 1982-83 season helping his team to a 28-4 record.

Kaminsky obtained his bachelor degree from Grand Valley State in psychology and earned his master's degree from Kent State University in sport psychology.

ABOUT BEMIDJI STATE: The Beavers are 9-12 overall and fourth place in the NSIC North with a 6-10 league mark entering Friday night's game vs. Wayne State. BSU is 6-5 at home, 3-6 in road games and 0-1 on a neutral court this year.

Bemidji State averages 72.2 points a game (13th-NSIC) and allows 73.8 (7th-NSIC). The Beavers rank 14th in the league in field goal percentage (.454), 12th in 3-point field goal percentage (.355) and 14th in free throw percentage (.717).

BSU ranks second in the league in field goal percentage defense, allowing opponents to shoot just 43.4 percent this season. The Beavers are 11th in the NSIC in rebounding margin (-1.9) and are tied for third in 3-pointers per game (8.7).

The Beavers are balanced offensively with four starters averaging double figures, led by senior guard Sharif Black (Chadron State transfer) at 14.8 points and 4.9 rebounds per game. He ranks ninth in the league in minutes played per game (33.1) averages just under three assists per contest.

Sophomore guard Jai'Vionne Green adds 12.9 points and 4.3 rebounds a contest with sophomore forward Logan Bader accounting for 11.5 points and 5.8 rebounds per contest. Bader leads BSU in 3-pointers with 40 and ranks sixth in the league with a 3-point field goal percentage of .494.

Senior guard Christian Pekarek also averages double digits with 10.0 points per game to go with 3.7 rebounds. He leads the Beavers with 86 assists, ranking seventh in the league at 4.1 per contest.

WAYNE STATE VS. BEMIDJI STATE SERIES HISTORY: The Wildcats hold a 27-22 lead in the all-time series vs. Bemidji State, but the Beavers have won five of the last six meetings.

Last season, BSU won in Wayne 78-76 and also won in Bemidji two years ago 79-69. BSU also beat WSC in Wayne three years ago 87-80.

In the 2013-14 season, BSU rolled WSC in the regular season 69-46 but WSC avenged the loss with a 88-76 win over the Beavers in the first round of the NSIC Tournament in Bemidii.

The last WSC regular season win over BSU came in the 2012-13 season, a 64-62 win at Bemidji on January 12, 2013.

SCOUTING MINNESOTA CROOKSTON: The Golden Eagles are 8-14 on the season and 5-11 in the NSIC North heading into this weekend's games against Augustana Friday night and Wayne State Saturday. UMC is 7-3 at home, 1-10 on the road and 0-1 in neutral court games this year.

UMC scores 76.6 points a contest (10th-NSIC) and allows 74.3 per contest (8th-NSIC). Minnesota Crookston ranks 11th in the league with a 46.3 field goal percentage, is seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.395) and leads the NSIC in free throw percentage (.789). The Golden Eagles are tied for 12th in the league averaging 8.0 3-point field goals per contest.

Minnesota Crookston leads the NSIC in blocked shots per contest (5.3) and is 13th in the league in rebounding margin at -2.5 per game.

Sophomore guard Harrison Cleary leads UMC and the NSIC in scoring at 25.1 points per game (tied for fifth in NCAA Division II). He is tied for second in the league in 3-point field goals per game (2.8) and tops the league in free throw percentage at 96.4 percent (107-111).

Junior guard Alan Hodge follows at 15.2 points per game, tied for sixth in the league with 2.3 3-pointers per contest. Freshman guard Ben Juhl also averages double figures at 10.3 points a game.

Junior forward Gable Smith accounts for 8.1 points and 7.1 rebounds per game and leads the NSIC in blocked shots per game at 3.6.

WAYNE STATE VS. MINNESOTA CROOKSTON SERIES HISTORY: WSC and UMC have met every season since the Golden Eagles joined the NSIC in the 1999-2000 season. Wayne State has a 23-7 lead in the series, but the Golden Eagles have won two of the last three meetings.

Last season, WSC won 79-72 in Wayne. Two years ago, UMC edged the Wildcats in Crookston 70-68 and also won in Wayne in 2014-15 by a score of 61-57. WSC's last win in Crookston was during the 2012-13 season - 66-41.
