## VIKINGS OPEN NSIC TOURNAMENT AT HOME AGAINST BEMIDJI STATE

SIOUX FALLS, S.D. – The final weekend didn't exactly go as planned for the Augustana men, but a win on Friday at Winona State gave the Vikings just enough to secure a home game in the first round of the Northern Sun Tournament, which begins on Wednesday against Bemidji State at 8 p.m., following the Augustana women's game, also against the Beavers, which starts at 6 p.m.

The Vikings earned the No. 5 seed on the NSIC South with a 10-12 record, but get to host Bemidji State in the first round for a second straight year because of a better conference record than the Beavers, who finished with a 9-13 mark in the conference.

This marks the second meeting of the season between the two teams, which met on Feb. 3, in Bemidji, where the Vikings came away with a comfortable 92-66 win behind a career night from John Warren, who set career-highs with 32 points, eight 3-pointers and with 14 rebounds. The Vikings also got a double-double from Adam Dykman, who finished with 17 points and 10 rebounds.

Should the Vikings prevail again on Wednesday, they would advance to play the winner of the U-Mary at Southwest Minnesota State game on Saturday at 5:30 p.m. in the NSIC Quarterfinals at the Sanford Pentagon. Augustana cruised to a 114-81 win over U-Mary in the lone meeting of the season at the Sioux Falls Arena on Dec. 9, and split with the Mustangs; winning 89-78 on Dec. 30, in Marshall, Minnesota, before falling, 81-77 on Feb. 10, at the Arena.

## VIKINGS QUICK HITS

- Wednesday's game mark the 2,198th game in program history
- Augustana finished the season with a 151-65 all-time record in NSIC play
- The Vikings won their only other game this season played on a Wednesday (Nov. 22, vs. Doane – 111-72)
- Augustana beat Bemidji State twice in NSIC Tournament, both times in the first round (2015, 2017)
- The Vikings used the same five starters in all 28 games this season, and all five average at least 10 points per game
- Augustana led at some point in 27 of the 28 games this season, and led in the second half or overtime of 23 of the 28
- The Vikings advanced to at least the quarterfinals of the NSIC Tournament in each of the last five seasons
- The win at Winona State on Friday marked the second win for the Vikings when trailing at the half
- Four Vikings combined for 17 double-doubles this season; Asmus (7), Spencer (4), Dykman and Warren (3)
- Jordan Spencer leads the nation with 213 assists this season
- A start on Wednesday would give Spencer 129 in his career, tied with Daniel Jansen for the most in school history
- Marcus Asmus ranks second in the NSIC with 238 rebounds, and an 8.5 rebounds per game average
- Bodey Behrends scored a career-high 12 points in the first meeting of the season with Bemidji State

**NOTEWORTHY**

**ARENA SWEET ARENA:** The Vikings returned to the Sioux Falls Arena for the 2014-15 season, and rattled off 29 straight wins on the new/old home floor. The Vikings now own a 40-10 record in the Arena since returning in 2014.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Senior Jordan Spencer entered the season ranked 20th in all-time scoring at Augustana with 1,221 career points. His 433 points this season boost his total to 1,654, which ranks 10th all-time, 28 points shy of passing Scott Beckstrand (1,681 points from 1990-94) for ninth all-time.

**DISH IT OUT:** Along with being a prolific scorer for the Vikings, Jordan Spencer entered his senior season with a school-record 688 assists, and a 6.8 assists per game average. The dynamic distributor added 213 assists so far this season, pushing his record total to 901, and his assists per game average to 7.0.

**STOP, THEIF!** He scores, he assists and he steals. Jordan Spencer came into the season tied for 17th all-time at Augustana with 122 steals, but his 34 steals this season give him 156, good for seventh all-time.

**3-POINTER STREAK:** Augustana made at least one 3-point field goal in each of the last 424 games. The last time the Vikings did not make a 3-pointer came on Jan. 24, 2004, a 79-69 loss against North Dakota in the Elmen Center.

**FINISH WHAT YOU START:** Already a starter in 100 games in his career coming into the season, Spencer needs to start 30 games this season to set the school-record for career starts, a record held by Daniel Jansen (129 starts from 2012-16). He enters the week 28 starts this season, for a total of 128 in his career.

**VIKINGS IN DOUBLE FIGURES:** At least one Viking score in double figures in each of the last 248 games. The last time at least one Augie player did not score at least 10 points in a game came on March 3, 2010, in a 75-52 loss to Wayne State at the Elmen Center in the first round of the NSIC Tournament, when Lee Stephens led the Vikings with eight points.

**WHERE DID THE POINTS GO?** Over the last two seasons, Augustana graduated a total of 9,150 career points from a total of eight student-athletes, which includes five 1,000-point scorers, two of which scored at least 2,000 career points.

The most prolific coach in Augustana history, Tom Billeter returns in 2017-18 for his 15th season leading the Vikings, his 20th season as a head coach and his 33rd season as a college coach.

A Byron, Illinois native and University of Illinois graduate, Billeter took over a struggling program in 2003, and began transforming the Vikings into a model program on and off the court.

The Billeter-led Vikings won just six games in his first season at Augie, but wasted little time starting to climb in the conference standings. His second season at the helm saw the team win eight games, followed by 12 wins in year three and 16 wins in year four.

In his fifth season, Billeter's Vikings posted a 22-9 record, finished second in the conference and earned the first of three straight trips to the NCAA Tournament, all 20-win seasons, including a school-record 24 wins in 2009-10.

After a year away, the Vikings returned to the NCAA Tournament in both 2011-12 and 2012-13, and even though they missed out in 2013-14, the team returned better than ever in 2014-15, setting the stage for a historic run.

Led by a core group of upperclassmen, the 2014-15 Vikings posted the school's first-ever 30-win season, the first regular season conference title since 1988-89 and a No. 1 seed at the Regional Tournament, but the historic run came up just short in a 66-65 loss to Northwest Missouri State in the regional semifinal.

Undaunted, and with the entire team returning in 2015-16, the Vikings completed what they started the year before, winning a program-record 34 games and securing the first men's basketball National Championship in school history. Augustana posted the highest winning percentage in NCAA Division II in 2015-16 and the second-most wins of all NCAA teams across all three divisions.

Despite losing the majority of the national championship squad to graduation, Billeter still led the Vikings to a 24-9 record and a berth in the NCAA Tournament in 2016-17 before falling to the eventual national champion Northwest Missouri State Bearcats on their home floor in Maryville, Missouri, in the regional semifinals.
