### 2002-03 Season Recap

Bemidji State finished 9-18 overall and 5-13 in the NSIC. The nine victories was the most in three seasons - the 1999-2000 club totaled nine as well. Also, the five league wins was the most since BSU went for seven three years ago. The Beavers did not make the NSIC Tournament for the first time since the conference went to its post-season format in the 1999-2000 season.

BSU attempted at least 20 threes in 12 games after launching 22 and 24 in the last weekend. Bemidji State went 10 straight games to end the season forcing more than 20 turnovers and had fewer turnovers than its opponent in each of its last 16 games. Overall, BSU had more turnovers than its opponent in just four of 27 games. The green and white finished with 357 steals on the year, which was a school record - the old mark for steals was 356 during the 1985-86 season. The Beavers went 11 games on the season shooting under 40 percent. Down at the half in the final two contests, BSU dropped to 1-14

on the year when trailing after the first 20 minutes. In being out-rebounded in 11 of the final 12 games, BSU was 5-16 overall when having fewer boards.

**Amber Graf** recorded her fifth 20-point effort of the season against Concordia-St. Paul (2/28/03) and was in double-figures in 25 of 27 games. Graf also set a BSU season record as she finished 104 of 133 from the charity stripe which broke the 102 made free throws (Jenny Loeck) and 132 attempts (Karen Morrissey) during the 1994-95 campaign. Graf represented BSU on the 2002-03 all-conference honorable mention squad. With 19 points against Winona State (3/1/03), **Christi Goodhart** reached double-figures in nine of her final 11 games - she averaged 13.5 points per game in that span, nearly four points above her season average.

# 2003-04 BEMIDJI STATE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

## NORTHERN SUN INTERCOLLEGIATE CONFERENCE

Founded in 1932, the Northern Intercollegiate Conference (NIC) has enjoyed a varied existence in the upper Midwest region that it claims as home. In the spring of 1992 the **Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC)** was formed from the merger of the NIC - the men's conference, and the Northern Sun Conference (NSC), which was the women's conference. The NSC had existed since 1979. The NSIC is currently made up of institutions from Minnesota, Nebraska and South Dakota. In the 1999-2000 academic year, the NSIC became an expanded 10-team league from a previous seven-member conference. The conference will boast nine members in 2003-2004.

Since 1932, various institutions have competed in the NSIC. Bemidji State University, Minnesota State University Moorhead and Winona State University are all charter members and have remained in the conference for its 71 years of existence. The University of Minnesota-Duluth is also an original member, but left the conference for nearly 30 years, then rejoining in 1976. Other current members have joined in later years: Southwest Minnesota State University in 1969, Northern State University in 1978, Wayne State College (NE) in 1998, while Concordia University-Saint Paul and the University of Minnesota-Crookston became members in 1999. The University of Minnesota-Morris became a league member in 1966, however, the Cougars have opted for the NCAA Division III ranks, beginning in 2003-2004.

Before the NSIC became eligible for National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) championship competition in 1995, its member institutions had an extremely rich tradition in the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA). The NIC's and NSC's tenure in the NAIA included several national championship teams and individuals as well as many national qualifiers.

This past year on the field of play, the University of Minnesota-Duluth displayed its athletic dominance en route to winning the 2002-2003 NSIC All-Sports Competition. The Bulldogs used top finishes (co or outright) in 12-of-14 NSIC sports to take first place in the final league standings. In women's sports, UMD was a perfect 8-for-8, taking home NSIC regular season or tournament championships in basketball, cross country, soccer, softball, tennis, indoor and outdoor track & field and volleyball. UMD men's athletic teams also fared extremely well, winning NSIC titles in cross country, football and men's indoor and outdoor track & field.

The 2003-2004 academic year will be another exciting one, as the NSIC and its member institutions will host several premier events. For example, each NSIC school will again compete at the NCC/NSIC Volleyball Challenge in early September. This event will be in Omaha, Neb. for the second year in a row. March Madness will be in full force for the fifth consecutive year as the NSIC men's and women's basketball tournament, which determines the league's automatic qualifiers for the NCAA tournament, will be at the beautiful Gangelhoff Center on the campus of Concordia University-Saint Paul. For the fifth year in a row, the conference will continue to market its member schools through radio and television productions.

The Northern Sun Showcase television program (32 shows in last four years) and the 2004 NSIC men's and women's basketball tournament championship games will all hit the airwaves again on Fox Sports Net. Also, the Northern Sun Spotlight radio show (over 80 shows the past four academic seasons) will air on several stations throughout the Midwest for another 20-week flight during 2003-2004 sports season.

Over the years, the NSIC has provided extremely competitive intercollegiate athletic programs for its members and features schools of modest size with fairly restricted athletic budgets. Although the programs are not designed to be equal to Division I athletics, many former NSIC athletes have distinguished themselves in national and international competition. Each member school emphasizes the educational, entertainment and unifying value of sports while pointing with pride to the many advantages to be gained by attending these colleges and universities. As some affiliated with the conference have coined, the NSIC quite possibly is, "the most competitive conference in NCAA Division II."
