Beavers travel to Wayne State for NSIC double dip

This Week: The Bemidji State University baseball team continues Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference play April 3 with a doubleheader at Wayne State College beginning at 1:30 p.m.

Conference Games: All conference doubleheaders will play a seven-inning game first, followed by a nine-inning contest. The nine-inning game has a 10-run rule after seven complete innings. If game one goes into extra innings, game two becomes a seven-inning contest.

About Bemidji State: Bemidji State (11-9, 2-2 NSIC) split its NSIC opener 2-2 with Concordia University, St. Paul March 29-30. BSU posted a 2-0 victory in 10 innings in game one of the series, but fell 5-4 in game two. In the March 30 doubleheader, the Beavers lost 6-1 before it defeated the Golden Bears 7-6 in game two. Senior **Lewis Baumann** got both game-winning hits for Bemidji State, the first was a two-run home run in the 10th inning of game one of the series, and the second capped a four-run inning for the Beavers that gave it a 7-2 lead. Senior lefty **Phil Bray** started game one and went eight innings. He didn't allow a run, gave-up just three hits and fanned a 2013 NSIC-best 13 batters. BSU is 3-1 in extra inning games this season and 3-5 in contests decided by one run.

About Wayne State: Wayne State went 4-0 March 29-30 at home against University of Minnesota Crookston with 9-0, 3-1, 8-0 and 9-0 victories. WSC is 8-1 in its last nine game and owns 12-6 overall and 4-0 NSIC records. The Wildcats rank ninth in batting average this season with a .272 mark. On the mound, WSC has posted the second-best ERA in the league at 2.80. Blake Brisson is hitting .390 and owns a team-high 23 hits. On the bump, Tadd Johansen is 5-0 with a 0.76 ERA (third in the NSIC). In 35.1 innings pitched he has allowed three earned runs and fanned 36 batters.

Last Action vs WSC: The Beavers and Wildcats have already met once this season at the H.H.H. Metrodome Feb. 21. WSC came away with identical 3-2 victories in the doubleheader, as game two went nine innings. Head Coach **Tim Bellew** is 3-27 against Wayne State as the Beaver skipper. He is 2-14 versus the Wildcats in Wayne, Neb.

Team Notes

- The Beavers have produced 54 runs in the sixth inning and beyond, while allowing just 18.
- BSU is 9-3 when scoring first and 5-2 when posting a run in the first inning. Bemidji State leads its opponent 19-5 in the first inning this season.
- The Beavers have gone into extra innings four times this season (3-1) after only going past the scheduled number of innings once in 2012.
- BSU posted 22 hits in the 12-5 March 16 victory against Minot State. The single game hit total is the best by any NSIC team in 2013.

Player/Pitcher Notes

- Senior **Logan Kalis** posted a 14-game hitting streak Feb. 16-March 29. He has six multi-hit games and four multi-RBI games this season.

seventh in the 2013 Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Preseason Baseball Coaches' Poll. BSU earned 112 points and the seventh spot in the poll – its highest since 2008.

Preseason All-Americans

The Collegiate Baseball Newspaper listed its 2013 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) NCAA Division II Preseason All-Americans in late January. Included as an ABCA Preseason All-American from the Central Region were Bemidji State University's **Zach Braun** (Jr., C/1B, Lakeville, Minn.) and **Logan Kalis** (Sr., 1B/RHP/1B, Little Falls, Minn.).

Senior **Jaryd Marks** (RHP/1B, Cottage Grove, Minn.) was named a Central Region Player to Watch, while freshman **Joey Hanowski** (INF/OF, Little Falls, Minn.) was named a Newcomer to Watch.

The **Preseason All-American** awards are the first of their kind under head coach Tim Bellew, who is entering his eighth season at BSU.

NSIC and NCBWA Central Region Player of the Week

Senior shortstop **Lewis Baumann** (Colorado Springs, Colo.) was named *Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Player of the Week* March 18, then *National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) Central Region Player of the Week* March 20.

Baumann is the first regional player of the week during head coach **Tim Bellew's** eight seasons at BSU.

He posted a .583 batting average on a team-high 14 hits in 24 at bats, while batting in the nine-hole position. He recorded seven extra base hits, which included four doubles, two home runs and a triple, totaled 26 bases and posted a 1.083 slugging percentage. The shortstop added eight runs and eight RBIs with one walk and one hit by pitch. He posted a .593 on-base percentage and recorded a stolen base.

In the field he recorded a .957 fielding percentage with 16 assists, six putouts and was apart of three double plays.

NSIC Pitcher of the Week

Senior lefty **Phil Bray** (Chatfield, Minn.) was named *Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Pitcher of the Week* April 1, in an announcement from the league office.

Bray didn't allow a run in eight innings of a start in the Beavers' NSIC opener March 29. He was credited with a no decision in the 2-0, 10-inning (scheduled seven-innings) victory against Concordia University, St. Paul. The senior lefty allowed just three hits (all singles) and totaled 13 strikeouts to tie a career-high and record the most Ks by an NSIC pitcher this season. In 25 at-bats, CU mustered just a .120 batting average.

He is the ninth student-athlete under head coach **Tim Bellew** to earn a player of the week honor from the league. (Five player, four pitcher of the week honors).

The third winningest coach in Bemidji State baseball history, **Tim Bellew** has amassed a 120-239-1 overall record and 68-140 mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC), as the skipper of the Beavers. Now in his eighth season as head coach, Bellew took over the BSU baseball program in the fall of 2005.

Under Bellew, 10 student-athletes have been named to the *NSIC All-Conference Team*, including three first team honorees. Two student-athletes have gone on to earn an all-region team nod, while catcher Zach Braun was Bellew's first All-American in 2012.

BSU has also found success in the classroom under the direction of Bellew, as 44 student-athletes have been named *Academic All-NSIC*. Highlighting that group is Josh Silvernagel, who earned the *NSIC Myles Bran All-Academic with Distinction Award* and went on to become *ESPN The Magazine College Division Academic Third-Team All-District V* in 2010.

In 2012, Bellew's climbing success guided the Beavers to a 23-27 overall and a 16-20 NSIC record to finish eighth in the league standings. The 23 victories tied for third in program history for wins in a season. At the conclusion of the campaign, three players were named All-NSIC, including two *First Team All-NSIC* members, – the first time under Bellew two players were named first team – in Braun and Logan Kalis. Both players went on to become the first players under Bellew to earn all-region laurels, while Braun was selected as an All-American from the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (second team) and Daktronics (second team). The 20-win season was just the sixth in 61 years of baseball at Bemidji State.

BSU went 17-36 overall and 8-22 in NSIC in 2009, then followed that season with a 16-37 overall and 7-25 NSIC record in 2010. The BSU skipper then tallied 18 wins in 2011 to record its fourth consecutive season with 16 or more wins in a season. The Beavers went 18-29 overall and 12-21 in NSIC play.

In 2008 Bellew led the Beavers to the best season in six years. BSU finished the season with a 16-25-1 record overall and a 13-13 mark in the NSIC. BSU's 16 wins and 13 conference victories were the most since the 2002 season when the Beavers were 19-11 overall and 13-3 in conference play. The skipper of the Beavers also propelled them into the NSIC Tournament for the first time since the 2002 when they picked up just their fourth tournament win. The inaugural NSIC Tournament was at the conclusion of the 1996 season.

During his time at Bemidji State Bellew has also become an active member of the Bemidji Youth Baseball organization. He has also put on baseball camps and clinics for the youth. The director of facility maintenance at the field, Bellew played a large role in the renovation process of the BSU Baseball Field in the fall of 2007.

Bellew joined the Bemidji State coaching staff after orchestrating the most-successful baseball era in the history of Kansas Wesleyan University. He took the reigns in 1995 after two years as an assistant coach and his hire began to pay dividends almost immediately. He earned Kansas Collegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year honors in 1996 and in 1997 he led KWU to a National Small-College Athletics Association National Championship and was named NSCAA National Coach of the Year.

KWU repeated as NSCAA National Champions in 1999 and Bellew was again named NSCAA National Coach of the Year. He qualified KWU for a berth in the NAIA Region IV tournament and in 2001 he directed KWU to its first KCAC championship in 27 years. In 10 seasons at KWU, Bellew coached 38 First-Team All-KCAC honorees, seven NAIA All-Americans and 11 NSCAA All-Americans. He also had one player drafted and two signed as free agent acquisitions. KWU recorded 20 or more wins seven times during Bellew's stint.

Bellew, an Arizona native, began his collegiate playing career at Central Arizona Junior College in 1980. He played second base and shortstop for the Vaqueros until 1982. He transferred to Kansas Wesleyan in 1985, where he earned the President's Leadership Award in 1986. In 1987, Bellew was named Second-Team All KCAC as middle infielder and helped lead KWU to an NAIA playoff berth.

Bellew graduated from Kansas Wesleyan with a bachelor of arts degree in health in 1987, and received a master of business administration degree from KWU in June of 2002.

Along with his duties as head baseball coach, Bellew is head of games management at BSU.

Bellew currently resides in Bemidji with his wife Pam, his son Mason, who is a freshman on the BSU baseball team, and his daughter Claudia.

During his last year as an undergrad, he assisted with games management and started 30 out of the 32 games played, serving as the team's catcher. He has spent the last six summers in Bemidji, where he was on the grounds crew at the BSU baseball field.

Bennett, a native of Hayfield, Minn., is a 2010 graduate of BSU and obtained a degree in technology education with a coaching specialty. He earned a masters degree in sports studies from Bemidji State in 2013.
