WOFFORD (1-2, 0-1) AT #13 ETSU (4-0, 1-0)

THE ETSU GAME

Wofford continues Southern Conference play on Saturday on the road at East Tennessee State ... The Terriers are 1-2 on the season after a 24-22 road win at Elon, a 31-10 loss at home to #24 Kennesaw State and a 31-23 road loss to #22 VMI ... East Tennessee State is 4-0 on the season and 1-0 in league play ... They have wins over Vanderbilt, UVA-Wise, Delaware State and a 55-48 overtime win at Samford last Saturday ... The Bucs are off to their best start since 1999 ... Wofford and ETSU have met 28 times, with the Terriers holding a 15-13 lead in the series, including winning the last nine meetings ... The two teams did not play in the 2021 spring season, but in 2019 Wofford earned a 35-17 win in Johnson City ... The Bucs are ranked 13rd in the Stats Perform FCS Poll and are 14th in the FCS Coaches Poll ... This will mark the third-straight week the Terriers have faced a ranked team, which happened last during the 2017 season.

TERRIER TOP NOTES

Here are the top notes of interest heading into the ETSU game:

- The Terriers return 18 starters from the 2021 spring season, including six on offense, nine on defense and three specialists. Eleven other players who started games also return.
- Wofford is ranked 68th in the nation in total offense and 71st in total defense through the first three games.
- The rushing offense was ranked fifth overall at 232.8 yards per game in the spring. Wofford has been ranked in the top ten in rushing offense for 22 straight seasons.
- Wofford scored first in all five games during the spring season, but the opponent has scored first in all three games this fall.
- The 2020-21 season marked the end of a streak of three straight Southern Conference Championships and four straight FCS Playoff appearances.
- In the SoCon Preseason poll, the Terriers were selected to finish eighth, the lowest since 1999.
- Four players were recognized by the coaches on Preseason All-SoCon team. First team honors went to DL Micheal Mason and OL Zak Kurz. OL AI Hogan and RB Nathan Walker picked up second team honors.

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT ...

ETSU'S LAST GAME

In a game that featured four lead changes in the fourth quarter and a game-tying Tyler Keltner field goal at the end of regulation, the ETSU football team kept its perfect record intact as Quay Holmes provided the game-winning touchdown in overtime, lifting the 15th-ranked Buccaneers to a thrilling 55-48 win at Samford on Saturday afternoon from Seibert Stadium.

With both teams combining for 1,259 yards of total offense, the Bucs finished with a season-high 531 yards, while red-shirt freshman quarterback Tyler Riddell threw for a career-high 291 yards and accounted for four touchdowns (three passing/one rushing). ETSU rushed for 240 yards – 168 coming from Holmes – marking a season-high for the red-shirt junior. Holmes, who also rushed for two touchdowns, registered the 14th 100-yard rushing of his career. The kickoff return game was also critical as Jacob Saylor posted a career-best 71-yard return and followed that up with a 50-yarder both of which set up fourth-quarter touchdown drives. Defensively, Donovan Manuel was one of four Bucs to register double-digit tackles as his career-high 13th hit on the final play stopped running back Jay Stanton five yards short of the first down marker, sending the ETSU sideline into a frenzy.

LAST MEETING

WOFFORD 35, ETSU 17
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 5, 2019

JOHNSON CITY, Tenn. – Wofford defeated East Tennessee State 35-17 at Greene Stadium. Joe Newman scored four rushing touchdowns on four straight possessions in the first half to take a 28-3 lead at the break. The Bucs scored the first two touchdowns of the second half to make it a 28-17 game. Wofford then put together a 15-play drive that covered 92 yards in over seven minutes to seal the win at 35-17.

Wofford is 3-2 overall and 2-1 in the Southern Conference. ETSU is 2-4 on the season and 0-3 in the league. The Terriers were led by Joe Newman with 185 rushing yards and four touchdowns, along with 49 passing yards. The Bucs were led by Trey Mitchell with 12-of-23 passing for 163 yards and a touchdown.

The Terriers had the ball to open the game and after a first down faced a fourth-and-one near midfield. Joe Newman snuck for the first down, but Wofford had to punt to end the drive. The Bucs went three-and-out and punted. Wofford had three first downs before a one-yard touchdown run by Joe Newman made it 7-0 with 2:03 left in the first quarter.

On the next drive by the Bucs, Jireh Wilson had a tackle for loss that forced a three-and-out. Joe Newman found a seam and went 59-yards for a touchdown to give Wofford a 14-0 lead with 12:53 on the clock in the second quarter. The Bucs used a 59-yard kick-off return to begin their next drive on the 35-yard line. After a first down, the Bucs hit a 27-yard field goal to make it a 14-3 game at the 10:07 mark in the quarter. Joe Newman ended the next Wofford drive with an eight-yard touchdown run for a 21-3 lead with 7:40 left in the half.

The Bucs completed a pass but George Gbese forced a fumble that was recovered by Ryan Titus at the 45-yard line. With the ball back, Joe Newman scored his fourth touchdown of the half on a 15-yard run for a 28-3 advantage with 5:07 on the clock. On the next drive by the Bucs a sack by Tanner Barnes and Jireh Wilson on third down forced a punt. After Blake Morgan had a first down at midfield, a deep pass on the final play of the half by Joe Newman was intercepted in the endzone.

To begin the second half, the Bucs had four first downs and scored on a two-yard run by Quay Holmes to cut the lead to 28-10 at the 10:23 mark. Wofford gained one first down before punting on the next possession. A sack by Austin Lufkin and Corey Prince on third down resulted in a three-and-out for the Bucs. The Terriers took over at midfield but went three-and-out and punted. The Bucs had a first down and then a 42-yard pass completion for a first down. On fourth-and-one, they gained a yard on the first play of the fourth quarter. A 26-yard touchdown pass to Quay Holmes on the next play made it a 28-17 game with 14:23 remaining. Wofford went three-and-out and punted with the Bucs taking over at midfield.

The Terrier defense forced a three-and-out and began their next drive on the eight-yard line with 11:00 left in the game. After a first down, Joe Newman ran for a 33-yard first down to move across the 50. Blake Morgan added two first downs and a first down catch by KeiAndre Sanders set-up a four-yard touchdown run by Miller Mosley. The Terriers had a 35-17 lead with 3:13 left in the contest. The Bucs had a pass on fourth-and-ten that was short and Wofford took over on downs with 2:02 remaining. Miller Mosley ran for a first down and then the team took a knee to run out the clock.

ABOUT WOFFORD

At quarterback, Jimmy Weirick started all five spring games, with Peyton Derrick seeing time in four games ... Weirick was 40-of-70 passing for 553 yards and three touchdowns, while Derrick was 12-of-21 with a passing touchdown and two rushing touchdowns ... Irvin Mulligan was the leading rusher with 342 yards on 51 carries, while Ryan Lovelace had 277 yards on 56 carries and Nathan Walker had 45 carries for 219 yards - all three top rushers had at least two touchdowns ... The top receiver was KeiAndre Sanders with nine catches for 108 yards ... Tight end Landon Parker had 155 yards on eight catches and two touchdowns ... The offensive line replaced all five starters from the 2019 and only allowed seven sacks (1.4 per game) to rank 20th in the nation ... Linebackers Joe Beckett (35), Brandon Brown (33) and John Beckley (30) were the top tacklers ... Beckley recorded two sacks and 3.5 tackles for loss, while Micheal Mason had 2.5 tackles for loss and a sack ... Darron Paschal and Miles Richardson had the two interceptions for the team ... Dawson Henis and Walker Gliarmis handled the placekicking duties, with Atkins Roberts kicking off 21 times and Landon Parker leading the SoCon with a 45.0 yards per punt average.

INJURY REPORT

Players that will miss the 2021 season due to injury include OL Paxton Cotrell, LB Logan Barnes, DB Santana Curtis, DL Tanner Barnes, LB Howie Thomas, OL Ozzy Clayton and LB Joey Kimberling.

REBUILDING THE ROSTER

After playing the spring season with only 79 players on the roster, and dressing less than 60 for the final game against The Citadel, the Terriers have rebuilt the roster. There are 43 newcomers to go with the 68 returners for 111 total players - the most since there were 112 on the roster in 2015.

COACHING CHANGES

The Terriers saw one big coaching staff change for the fall season. Offensive coordinator Wade Lang announced his retirement on June 30, 2021 after 33 seasons on the coaching staff and 31 seasons as the offensive coordinator. Wofford hired Tyler Carlton in July and he will share the offensive coordinator duties with Dane Romero.

ROSTER NOTES

Now that the spring season is complete, let's look at how the roster was impacted. During the spring and summer of 2020, 13 players - including four projected starters - left the team for a variety of reasons. Ten additional players opted out in the fall, which included three projected starters. As the spring season began, an additional four players opted out. At the end of the spring season, there were a total of 79 players on the roster.

END OF SPRING SEASON

Wofford announced on Monday, April 5, that the football team was opting out of the remainder of the spring season. The decision was based upon a combination of player COVID opt-outs and injuries that left the team below the Southern Conference guidelines for specific position groups.

WOFFORD'S LAST GAME

Wofford was defeated 31-23 by VMI on September 25 at Foster Stadium. With the game tied 14-14 at the half, the Keydets outscored the Terriers 17-9 in the second half to secure the victory. Wofford opens the season at 1-2, while VMI is 3-1. It was the Southern Conference opener for both teams. The Terriers were led by Irvin Mulligan with 20 carries for 136 yards, while Jimmy Weirick was 11-of-19 passing for 119 yards along with 52 rushing yards. Korey Bridy led the Keydets with 22 carries for 171 yards and a pair of touchdowns.

Wofford had 375 total yards, with 256 rushing yards. VMI had 319 total yards, 183 of which were passing. Wofford had a 20 to 18 advantage in first downs. Wofford was 8-of-16 on third down, along with 2-of-4 on fourth down. VMI was 4-of-8 on third down. Wofford was called for two penalties to three for VMI. The Terriers had a 35:36 to 24:24 time of possession advantage.

WOFFORD-VMI GAME NOTES

VMI has won back-to-back games in the series for the first time since 1988 and 1992. Wofford leads the all-time series that began in 1924 by a 13-12 margin ... The 20 carries and 134 rushing yards were both career-highs by Irvin Mulligan ... Joe Beckett led the team with ten tackles, followed by John Beckley with seven. Chuck Smith had his first career sack and forced fumble, while Cameron Woolery had his first career sack ... The five total sacks in the game are tied for the second most in school history and the most in a game since 2005 ... LB Camden Gray, S John Michael DiRoberto, DL Brandon Maina, DB Isaiah Wadsworth and DL Anthonie Lattany made their first career starts ... Game captains were Peyton Derrick, Micheal Mason and Nathan Walker ... Attendance at Foster Stadium was 5,077.

SPRING ALL-SOUTHERN CONFERENCE

On the 2020-21 All-Southern Conference teams, Wofford players honored include defensive lineman Micheal Mason (first team coaches and media), defensive back Tahir Annoor (second team coaches) and running back Irvin Mulligan (All-Freshman team).

SPRING ALL-AMERICANS

Wofford fullback Nathan Walker was named a Stats Perform FCS Second Team All-American and a Phil Steele Second Team All-American. Walker, a junior from Cross, South Carolina, played in all five games this spring with three starts. He was third on the team with 45 carries for 219 yards and led the team with three rushing touchdowns. Micheal Mason earned a spot on the HERO Sports Sophomore All-America Team. The native of Florence, S.C., had 2.5 tackles for loss and a sack during his five starts on the defensive line.

PRESEASON SOUTHERN CONFERENCE POLL

In the 2021 Southern Conference Preseason Poll, the conference's nine head coaches picked Wofford to finish eighth with 21 points. This marked the lowest preseason selection for the Terriers since 1999. The Southern Conference Sports Media Association selected Wofford seventh with 108 points. Both polls picked Chattanooga to finish first.

PRESEASON ALL-SOCON

The Terriers had four players recognized by the coaches on the 2021 Preseason All-SoCon team, with two on the first team and two on the second team. Leading the Terriers on the first team was defensive lineman Micheal Mason. Three players were named on offense. Senior offensive lineman Zak Kurz earned first team honors. Second team honors went to offensive lineman Al Hogan and running back Nathan Walker.

NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Wofford's Michael Mason was named the Stats Perform FCS National Defensive Player of the Week for games on Feb. 13 and between Feb. 19-21. Mason, a sophomore from Effingham, S.C., collected eight tackles (seven solos) with three tackles for loss, including a pair of sacks that caused fumbles recovered by the Terriers. He also came up with a one-yard tackle for loss on a Mercer fourth down attempt in the third quarter as the Terriers earned a 31-14 win over the Bears. Mason was also named the College Sports Madness National Defensive Player of the Week.

A ZERO ON THE ROSTER

While the NCAA began allowing the number "0" to be worn in the fall of 2020, no Terrier wore that number last season. This season, both linebacker TJ Neal and wide receiver Devin Mathews become the first Terriers to wear "0."

PLAYOFF STREAKS

Wofford had been to the playoffs in four years, but that streak ended in 2020-21. North Dakota State has the longest active playoff appearance streak at 12 games, followed by South Dakota State (10) and James Madison (8). Weber State reached five games while Wofford and San Diego saw their streaks end at four games.

THE 2019 SEASON

Wofford was 8-4 overall and was 7-1 in the Southern Conference ... Wofford won the outright SoCon Championship and earned the automatic bid, marking the seventh league title in school history ... It was the first time the Terriers have won back-to-back-to-back league championships ... Wofford reached the NCAA FCS Playoffs for the fourth-straight season ... In the opening round, the Terriers were defeated 28-21 by Kennesaw State to end the season ... Players received a total of nine All-Southern Conference honors, with Joe Newman the Offensive Player of the Year ... OL Blake Jeresaty was named to multiple All-America teams, including AP, AFCA and STATS ... In the finals polls, Wofford was ranked 16th by STATS FCS and 17th by the FCS Coaches.

THE 2021 RETURNERS

Wofford looks to return 18 starters for the 2021 season. On offense, quarterback Jimmy Weirick, running back Nathan Walker, offensive linemen Zak Kurz, Al Hogan, Chad Gardner and Quashon Greenlee return. On defense, the nine returners are defensive linemen James Garnett and Michael Mason, linebackers John Beckley, Joe Beckett, Brandon Brown and Rett Russell, and defensive backs Donovan Anderson, Miles Richardson and Tahir Annoor. On special teams, kicker Walker Gliarmis, punter Landon Parker and long snapper Colin Springer will return. An additional eleven players who started at least one game also return.

2021 INCOMING CLASS

The Terriers welcomes a huge incoming class of 43 players in the fall of 2021, which includes seven transfers. There are 21 players on defense, 20 players on offense and two specialists.

NEW NUMBERS

Several players have switched numbers for the 2021 season, including CB Tahir Annoor (2), CB Jahem Hazel (3), LB John Boyles (4), S Isaiah Walker (9), LB Logan Barnes (15), DL Tanner Barnes (18), S

Santana Curtis (21), RB David Legette (22), DL Cameron Woolery (55) and DL Chuck Smith (97).

DOUBLE NUMBERS

The Terriers have sixteen sets of double numbers to note this season with the large roster. WR Devin Mathews and LB T.J. COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT

Garrison Moore was named to the 2020-21 Academic All-District Football Team, selected by CoSIDA, which recognizes the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances on the field and in the classroom. Moore, from Columbia, South Carolina, started two of the five games played this spring. He had five catches, including a 26-yard touchdown reception against The Citadel. For his career, Moore played in 41 games with three starts. He had 11 catches for 186 yards and two touchdowns. A chemistry major with a 3.87 grade point average, Moore was inducted into Phi Beta Kappa this spring. He received his Bachelor of Science in May summa cum laude and will begin medical school in the fall of 2021. This marks the 21st straight season that at least one Wofford football player has earned CoSIDA All-District honors.

2020-21 FIRST CAREER STARTS

Against The Citadel, WR RJ Khayo, DB Isaiah Walker and OL Jeremy Michaux made their first starts, giving Wofford 17 players with first starts in the season.

2021 FIRST CAREER STARTS

In the season opener at Elon, seven players made their first career starts. OL Anthony Garcia, OL Cecil Fisher, QB Peyton Derrick, RB Irvin Mulligan, RB Jamari Broussard, DT C.J. Tillman and LB T.J. Neal. Against Kennesaw State, TE Dillon Droze, DB Okachi Emmanwori and DL Romello Gray started their first career games. VETERAN CAREER GAMES PLAYED/STARTS

The most veteran player on the team this year is linebacker Joe Beckett with 45 career games played. Brandon Brown (43) and John Beckley (41) have also played in more than 40 career games. John Beckley leads the team with 28 career starts, followed by Joe Beckett (20), Brandon Brown (16) and Nathan Walker (14).

took over five minutes off the clock ... Irvin Mulligan has had nine of his 43 carries go for a first down or touchdown... Wofford has 36 receptions, with 22 of those first downs or touchdowns ... The Terriers had an average start of the 33.8 yard line, while opponents had a 26.7 yard line average start ... On opening drives in a game, Wofford has one touchdown and two punts. On second half drives, the Terriers have a punt, field goal and interception.

PARKER CAN CATCH... AND PUNT

Landon Parker was one of only two players in the FCS last season that was a position player and a specialist, joining UT Marting quarterback and punter Dresser Winn. Parker was ranked fifth in the country in punting at 44.9 yards per punt, which was first in the SoCon. He was also the team's leading receiver with eight catches for 155 yards and two touchdowns. Against VMI (3/27) his 75-yard touchdown reception in the fourth quarter was the seventh-longest in school history and his 68-yard punt was the sixth longest in school history and the longest since 2001.

DL Elijah Ball's brother played at Alabama from 2012-16 ... WR Landon Parker's brother punted at Duke and his father punted for the Denver Broncos ... QB Peyton Derrick's dad played at Wofford from 1978-82 and his brother, Dakota, played at Furman from 2007-12 ... DL Jacob Drag's father played on the defensive line at Clemson (1984-89) ... LS Forrest Alvarez parents both graduated from Wofford and his brother, Carew, also played football for the Terriers ... CB Tahir Annoor's brother, Aaquil, played at Furman and his younger brother Amir is a freshman at Wofford in 2021 ... LB Jack Scroggs' younger brother, Griffin, has committed to play on the offensive line at Georgia ... WR Will Daniel's father played football at N.C. State and works as an assistant coach at several high schools and colleges, including Bishop England and Charleston Southern ... OL Griffin Reid's brother played football at The Citadel ... LS Cameron Hicks brother played football at Samford.

WOFFORD 100-YARD RUSHERS

Wofford had a 100-yard rusher in four of 13 games in 2017 with Blake Morgan, Andre Stoddard (2) and Joe Newman reaching the mark. In 2018, Wofford had six 100+ rushing performances. Joe Newman had the first 100+ game of 2019 against Gardner-Webb, with Newman (104), Jacquéz Allen (105) and Irvin Mulligan (106) reaching the mark against Western Carolina. Blake Morgan added 147 yards against Furman. After no 100+ rushing games in the 2021 spring season, Irvin Mulligan (114) reached the mark in the season opener at Elon and added 134 yards at VMI.

OPPONENT 100-YARD RUSHERS

A big part of the defense is not allowing an opponent to have a 100+ yard rusher. In the past 83 games, there have been just eleven rushers with 100 or more yards. The Terriers went 17 games without allowing a 100+ rusher (last 2 games in 2013, 11 games in 2014, first four games in 2015). They then went an additional 19 games without a 100+ rusher. Wofford didn't allow a 100+ rusher in 2017. Twice in 2018 there were 100+ yard rushers against the Terriers and there were five in 2019, along with one in 2020-21 and two in the fall of 2021.

UNDER 100 YARDS RUSHING

In nine of the 14 games in 2016, the Terriers held opponents to under 100 rushing yards. Wofford started 2016 by holding Tennessee Tech to 41 rushing yards and then Ole Miss ran for 174 yards. Youngstown State had 240 in the playoffs, the most by an opponent that season. Wofford held 2017 opponents to under 100 yards rushing six times (Gardner-Webb 99, Samford 10, ETSU 15, Chattanooga 99, VMI 80, and Furman 52). In 2018, VMI, Wyoming, Gardner-Webb, Chattanooga, ETSU, Samford and Elon were held to under 100 rushing yards. The 2019 season began with Wofford allowing just 75 yards to SC State and then just nine yards by Gardner-Webb. ETSU was held to 95 rushing yards, Western Carolina had only 64 and Mercer had only 89.

REACHING 1,000 CAREER YARDS

Nathan Walker reached the mark 1,000 career rushing yard mark with 13 yards against Kennesaw State in 2019 for 1,007 yards and now has 1,234 in his career.

A LITTLE MORE PASSING

In 2012, Wofford ran the ball almost 90% of the time. Since then, the Terriers have relied a little less on the run in the option offense. Of the 854 plays in 2018, 663 were rushes with 191 passes for an 77.6% run offense. In the short 2021 spring season the Terriers rushing numbers were down to 71.6%

Since the start of the 2010 season, the Terriers have been most successful when they throw the ball ten times or less in a game. With ten or fewer attempts, Wofford is 48-21 overall. With eleven or more passes per game, Wofford is 33-28 overall.

THE 2020-21 TERRIERS GROUND ATTACK

The Wofford rushing game returned to the top ten after the first four games of the season. The team was fifth in yards per game (232.8) when the season ended.

RUSHING LEGACY

Wofford has finished among the top ten schools in the nation in rushing in each of the past 22 years. The Terriers' wingbone offense puts a premium on ball control and keeping the opponent's offense on the boundary. Eight times the Terriers have been second in the nation in rushing yards per game, while in 2010 and 2011 they finished first.

GOING OVERTIME

Wofford picked up a 35-34 win in overtime against Chattanooga in 2019. The Terriers lost the first two overtime games played, then won the next two. In 2012, a 24-17 double overtime loss at Samford was followed by a win over Chattanooga. There was a win over Mercer in 2015 and losses to The Citadel and Youngstown State (double overtime) in 2016. The Terriers had overtime wins against Western Carolina and Chattanooga in 2017. Wofford is now 7-5 all-time in overtime games.

in 2006 snapped a streak of 10 straight regular season non-conference wins against FCS opponents ... The Terriers had not lost a non-conference regular season game to a FCS opponent since dropping the 2000 season opener to Lehigh 34-14 ... The loss to Gardner-Webb in 2013 ended a nine-game streak and Wofford lost again to Gardner-Webb in 2014, along with a loss to SC State in 2019 and a loss to Kennesaw State in 2021.

TERRIERS AGAINST FBS TEAMS

The 2019 season marked the 22nd time in the last 23 seasons the Terriers have played against a member of the FBS (NCAA Division I-A). Overall, Wofford is 1-22 in those games. In 2011, Wofford had a lead at Clemson in the third quarter. At South Carolina in 2012, the game was tied at 7-7 at the start of the fourth quarter. Wofford was down five points to Georgia Tech in 2014 with ten minutes to go in the game. In 2017, Wofford trailed South Carolina 14-10 in the third quarter. Wyoming scored with 17 seconds left in the game in 2018. Wofford was scheduled to play South Carolina in 2020 but the game was canceled. North Carolina is on the slate in 2021 and South Carolina in 2022 before a game at Pitt in 2023. South Carolina returns to the schedule in 2024 and 2026, while Clemson is scheduled again in 2027.

SEEING RED

The Wofford red zone offense was 43-of-46 overall with 32 touchdowns and 9 field goals for a 93.5% success rate which was third in the nation in 2019. This was a big improvement over 2018 when the Terriers were 39-of-48 (81.0%). During the abbreviated 2020-21 season, Wofford was fourth in the nation and first in the SoCon in red zone offense with a 94.4% success rate.

DEFENSE BY COMMITTEE

The Terrier defense is a true team effort with contributions from numerous players last season. Overall, six players recorded 20 or more tackles. Seven players had at least a share of a tackle for loss, while three recorded sacks. In the five games, there were four different players with a share of being the leading tackler.

TERRIERS AT HOME

Wofford has won 79 of its last 103 games played in Gibbs Stadium, including going 5-0 in 2014 and 2018 ... Since Gibbs Stadium opened on Oct. 5, 1996, Wofford has posted a record of 100-38 (.750) ... The Terriers have won 60 of 89 home SoCon games at Gibbs Stadium.

TERRIERS IN THE NFL

One Terrier was on an NFL roster at the beginning of training camp in 2021. Defensive lineman **Miles Brown '19** signed as a rookie free agent with the Arizona Cardinals and was on the 53-man roster on opening weekend and played before moving to the practice squad. He returned to the active roster in November. Overall he played in four games with four tackles. He spent the majority of the 2020 season with the Tennessee Titans on the practice squad and signed with Detroit in the summer of 2021. He was signed to the practice squad with the Lions, but waived on September 2.

MR. RICHARDSON

Jerry Richardson came to Wofford in the mid-1950s as an unheralded pass receiver from Fayetteville, N.C. By the time he left to begin his pro career with the Baltimore Colts, the passing combination of Charlie Bradshaw to Jerry Richardson had received nationwide fame. Richardson was an Associated Press Little All-America selection in 1957 and '58. He still holds Wofford's single-game record with 241 receiving yards vs. Newberry in 1956 and is the record holder for touchdown receptions in a season (9 in 1958) and in a career (21). As a senior at Wofford, he scored 72 points on nine touchdowns, 12 extra points and two field goals. Drafted by the defending world champion Colts, Richardson played two seasons in the NFL, earning Colt Rookie of the Year honors in 1959 and finishing third in the balloting for top NFL rookie. He was the founder of the Carolina Panthers. In 2015, Wofford announced the construction of two new facilities on campus donated by Richardson. The Rosalind S. Richardson Center for the Arts opened in the spring of 2017 and is the home to academic programs in theatre arts, visual arts and art history. The Jerry Richardson Indoor Stadium is a 123,000-square-foot facility opened in September of 2017 and includes a 3,400-seat basketball arena and a 400-seat volleyball competition venue. Jerome Johnson Richardson Hall, a residence hall for approximately 150 students with athletic facilities for baseball, softball and golf, will open in the fall of 2020. On February 24, 2021, Wofford announced a \$150 million gift to the endowment from

CAROLINA PANTHER TRAINING CAMP

The Carolina Panthers have held summer training camp at Wofford since their inaugural season in 1995. The camp provides Wofford tremendous national exposure and visibility. In 2019 the camp drew almost 70,000 visitors to campus. After missing camp in 2020, the Panthers were back for the 2021 season and are expected to return in 2022 until moving into their new facility in Rock Hill in 2023.



SOCON SUCCESS

Wofford has finished among the top four teams in the Southern Conference race in 15 of the last 17 years, winning seven SoCon Championships. In the last 17 years, the Terriers have won 83 of 127 SoCon games played. Over that time, Wofford is the winningest program in the Southern Conference with a .653 win percentage.

ABOUT WOFFORD

Wofford is currently the third-smallest school in NCAA Division I-FCS with an enrollment of 1,750 students. The smallest school is Presbyterian College at 1,048 and VMI is second with 1,700. Wofford College, established in 1854, is an independent liberal arts college in Spartanburg, S.C. (average SAT for incoming class, 1247). Wofford ranks in the top five nationally in the percentage of undergraduates receiving credit for study abroad. Home to one of the nation's 276 Phi Beta Kappa chapters, Wofford's historic 175-acre campus is recognized as a national arboretum. Affiliated with the United Methodist Church, the college is committed to provide superior liberal arts education that prepares its students for extraordinary and positive contributions to society. The focus of Wofford's mission is upon fostering commitment to excellence in character, performance, leadership, service to others and life-long learning.

ACADEMIC SUCCESS

Wofford's football program has ranked among the top 10 percent of FCS teams in the Academic Performance Review (APR) in eight of the last eleven seasons to earn public recognition. In 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019, Wofford had the highest APR in the SoCon. The Terriers lead the SoCon with 162 Academic All-Southern Conference selections since the program started in 2003.

Among all NCAA Division I (FBS and FCS) football teams, Wofford's APR score of 983 is 41st in the nation. The Terriers are ahead of schools such as Harvard (981), Georgia Tech (980), Samford (980), Baylor (879), Rice (977), and Wake Forest (979).

Wofford has had at least one player named CoSIDA/Capital One First Team All-District in each of the last 21 seasons. In 2020-21 Garrison Moore was named Academic All-District. In addition, safety James Zotto was named an Academic All-American in 2014.

Josh Conklin is entering his fourth season as head coach of the Wofford College football team. In his first two seasons at the helm, the Terriers won back-to-back Southern Conference Championship and reached the NCAA FCS Playoffs.

Wofford announced on January 2, 2018, the hiring of Josh Conklin as head football coach. Conklin, who spent the previous three seasons as the defensive coordinator at the University of Pittsburgh, was an assistant coach at Wofford from 2007-09 working with the secondary. Conklin has additional experience at Florida International, Tennessee, The Citadel and South Dakota State University, serving as the defensive coordinator at Pitt, Florida International and The Citadel.

Last season presented numerous challenges for the Terriers as they navigated the COVID-19 pandemic. The team took the field in February for an abbreviated spring slate of conference-only games. Wofford won the opener and were 1-1 when the next game was canceled. Returning to the field with a revamped defensive front, the Terriers dropped the final three games with each decided by a touchdown or less. Following the season, Michael Mason and Tahir Annoor earned All-Southern Conference honors.

In 2019, the Terriers lost the first two games of the season before the next five straight. Following a loss to Clemson, Wofford had wins over Mercer, Furman and The Citadel to finish the conference slate with a 6-1 record to claim the outright Southern Conference title. With the automatic bid to the NCAA FCS Playoffs, the Terriers were defeated 28-21 by Kennesaw State in the first round.

A total of nine players earned All-Southern Conference honors. Quarterback Joe Newman was the Offensive Player of the Year and offensive lineman Blake Jeresaty received the Jacobs Blocking Trophy, along with multiple All-America honors. Conklin was named Coach of the Year by the media. The Terriers were ranked #17 by the FCS Coaches and #16 in the STATS FCS poll to end the season.

The 2018 season began with SoCon wins over The Citadel and VMI and the team was 6-2 heading into November. A win over Western Carolina on November 10 secured a 6-2 mark in league play, which was good for a share of the Southern Conference Championship. In the first round of the playoffs, Wofford defeated Elon 19-7 at Gibbs Stadium. In the second round, the season came to an end with a 13-10 loss to #4 seed Kennesaw State. The Terriers had eleven players earn All-Southern Conference honors following the season. In addition, Miles Brown, Justus Basinger and Andre Stoddard were recognized as All-Americans. Wofford ended the season ranked #12 by the FCS Coaches and #13 in the STATS FCS poll.

Conklin served as Pitt's defensive coordinator for three seasons. Under Conklin's watch, Pitt featured one of the most productive pass rushes in the country. The Panthers ranked sixth nationally in sacks in 2016, averaging 3.31 per contest. Pitt compiled 111 sacks during his three seasons.

In 2017, the Panthers ended the season with a 24-14 upset of undefeated and #2 ranked Miami. Pitt had four sacks in the game and held the Hurricanes to 45 rushing yards. Conklin's 2016 unit also boasted lofty national rankings in rush defense (16th, 119.6 yards per game) and

defensive touchdowns (eighth, four TDs). The Panthers had a 43-42 win over eventual national champion Clemson in Death Valley to highlight an 8-5 season that culminated in the trip to the Pinstripe Bowl. In his first season as defensive coordinator, Pitt posted an 8-5 record and earned a berth in the Military Bowl.

Conklin joined Pitt after building an impressive resume as FIU's defensive coordinator for two years (2013-14). In his final season, he was nominated for the prestigious Broyles Award after overseeing a unit that ranked first nationally in fumble recoveries (19), second in defensive touchdowns (six), fourth in turnovers gained (33), eighth in turnover margin (plus-11 overall; 0.92 margin per game) and 35th in total defense (363.8 yards per game).

Prior to FIU, Conklin was the safeties coach at the University of Tennessee (2012) and defensive coordinator and safeties coach at The Citadel (2010-11). While at The Citadel, Conklin coached cornerback Cortez Allen, a member of the Pittsburgh Steelers from 2011-15.

From 2007-09, Conklin coached the defensive backs at Wofford. He added special teams to his responsibilities in his final season working with the Terriers. In Conklin's initial two years, Wofford had 33 interceptions. The Terriers led the Southern Conference in 2007 with 20 interceptions and ranked second in 2008 with 13. Wofford advanced to the FCS Playoffs in each of those seasons. In 2007, the Terriers won the Southern Conference and led the league in scoring defense.

Conklin's coaching career was launched at South Dakota State, where he served as a graduate assistant in 2003 and 2004. He then was promoted to a full-time post with the Jackrabbits, coaching the secondary and special teams in 2005 and 2006.

Conklin is a 2003 graduate of Dakota State University. He was a starting linebacker and Academic All-American for the Trojans. A native of Gillette, Wyoming, Conklin was born June 19, 1979.

In addition to his bachelor's in physical education from DSU, Conklin also earned a master's in sport administration from South Dakota State. He and his wife, Molly, have He and his wife, Molly, have three children - sons Clark and Davis and daughter Millie.
