#MarchMadness The madness that is March hits the GNAC now as the conference's top six teams take to Bellingham for the GNAC Championships. Plenty is on the line this week as the winner of the tournament will carry the conference's automatic bid into the NCAA Division II Championships.

#TheChampsAreHere Alaska Anchorage won its fifth consecutive regular-season title last week, defeating second-place Northwest Nazarene on Thursday before clinching the outright championship with a win over Central Washington two nights later. The Seawolves now enter the GNAC Championships as the No. 1 seed and will face either Concordia or Central Washington in Friday's first semifinal.

#HeatingUp Alaska Anchorage and Concordia enter the postseason with the longest winning streaks in the conference. The red-hot Seawolves have won 20 consecutive games while the Cavaliers are winners of their last five.

#ASaintlyWeek Saint Martin's forward **Bria Thames** received GNAC Player of the Week honors after averaging 19 points and 13.5 rebounds per game in her team's split at Concordia and Western Oregon.

GNAC Championships Preview

Bellingham, Wash. - Clinching its ninth conference tournament appearance in the event's nine-year history, Alaska Anchorage enters as the No. 1 seed in the 2019 GNAC Women's Basketball Championships, beginning Thursday at Western Washington University's Carver Gymnasium.

The top-seeded Seawolves enter the postseason as the hottest team in the conference after winning their fifth consecutive regular-season championship. The team has won 20 straight games, finishing with a 19-1 record in GNAC play. Its only defeat came against a nationally-ranked Northwest Nazarene back on the first day of December, a loss that UAA would avenge in the regular season's final week to help clinch the league title.

Looking to build on last season's co-regular season championship, Alaska Anchorage came out of the gates with plenty of momentum to start the 2018-19 campaign. Winners of its first seven games, the team was rarely tested and posted a pair of victories away from home by 40 and 32 points in its first two contests of the year. It entered the final week of the regular season tied at the top of the GNAC standings with Northwest Nazarene but was able to seize control of the league with a 64-55 victory over the Nighthawks last Thursday.

A balanced offensive attack helped lead the No. 1 seed to one of its most successful seasons in school history. Senior **Hannah Wandersee** tops the Seawolves in scoring, averaging 14.3 points per game at the conclusion of the regular season. The forward/center ranks inside the top-five in the GNAC in both scoring and field goal percentage. Bolstering the backcourt is senior **Sydni Stallworth**, who ranks second on the team at 10.2 points and 3.1 assists per game.

Northwest Nazarene, the other co-regular season champion a year ago, is the No. 2 seed after finishing the 2018-19 campaign with a record of 26-2 (18-2 GNAC). It's been a streaky year for the regular-season runners-up after tallying separate winning streaks of 17 games and eight games over the course of the year. Included in that longest run to start the season was an 84-68 victory over eventual No. 1 seed Alaska Anchorage.

A pair of upperclassmen in the backcourt have paced the Nighthawks offense. Junior **Avery Albrecht** ranks second in the league in free throw percentage (.914) and tops the team in scoring at a clip of 13.8 points per game. Senior **Ellie Logan** is following closely behind at 11.3 points per game. Guard **Marina Valles** has assisted her team on both ends of the floor. She is currently fourth in the GNAC in both assists (4.4 per game) and steals (2.3 per game).

Simon Fraser has been a member of the GNAC for nine years and is back in the GNAC Championships for a ninth straight season. The Clan will be the tournament's No. 3 seed after finishing 17-10 (13-7 GNAC). They were one of just two teams to knock off Northwest Nazarene this season, topping the Nighthawks for a 76-73 win back on January 26. The victory came in the middle of a stretch of 10 wins in 11 games. Simon Fraser opens the tournament against No. 6 seed and host Western Washington.

The Clan has been led offensively by senior **Sophie Swant**, who is averaging 14.4 points per game. That figure has the forward ranked fourth in the conference. The backcourt has been carried by point guard **Taylor Drynan**, whose 4.7 assists per game was only topped by one other GNAC player during the regular season.

Central Washington (17-10, 12-8 GNAC), the No. 4 seed, is back in the tournament for the fifth time in school history. It is led by a high-powered and balanced offense that boasts five players averaging in double figures while ranking third in the GNAC in points per game. Guard **Alexis Pana** carries the team into Bellingham, leading it in points (14.2 per game), assists (5.0 per game) and steals (2.1 per game). The assists figure currently leads the conference.

The Wildcats began the season with five straight victories and improved on both their overall and league records from a year ago. Their interior defense shined throughout the 2018-19 campaign, tallying 4.5 blocks per game to lead the GNAC and rank inside the top-30 nationally. Offensively, a red-hot field goal percentage carried CWU on the other end of the floor. Its 46.2 percent clip from the field ranks second in the conference.

Winners of its last five games, No. 5 seed Concordia (16-12, 11-9 GNAC) enters the postseason as one of the hottest teams in the conference. It will meet Central Washington in what figures to be a competitive quarterfinal matchup after the two teams split the season series with a pair of road wins. The Cavaliers are paced by a strong group of seniors in addition to sensational sophomore **Olivia Vezaldenos**, who won the conference's regular-season scoring title with an average of 15.9 points per game. This will be the program's first-ever appearance in the GNAC Championships.

Finishing the regular season strong with back-to-back victories, Western Washington (16-12, 11-9 GNAC) ended in a tie for fifth-place and enters the tournament as the No. 6 seed. One of those victories, an 18-point win against Simon Fraser last Tuesday, punched their ticket to the postseason while setting up a border battle showdown in Thursday's second quarterfinal. The program is back in the GNAC Championships for the eighth time in nine years after a brief absence in 2018. Leading the team back to the postseason is sophomore **Kelsey Rogers**, who is averaging 12 points and five rebounds per game the Vikings.

Around The GNAC

ALASKA ANCHORAGE



Alaska Anchorage picked up two more wins last week to clinch the GNAC regular-season title. The team knocked off then conference co-leader Northwest Nazarene on Thursday before blowing out Central Washington for a 69-51 victory two nights later.

Thursday's 64-55 win avenged the team's only loss of the season. Senior **Sydni Stallworth** led the way in the victory, scoring a game-high 13 points while pulling down four rebounds.

Stallworth was one of three Seawolves to finish at least one game scoring in double figures on the week.

Senior **Hannah Wandersee** is the team's leader in scoring, averaging 14.3 points per game. She is followed by fellow senior Stallworth, who is scoring at a clip of 10.2 points per game.

Alaska Anchorage is ranked No. 5 in the latest WBCA Division II Coaches Poll and No. 8 in the D2SIDA Poll.

The team heads to Bellingham this week as the top seed in the GNAC Championships, where they will await either Central Washington or Concordia for its postseason opener.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



The team's final road trip of the season resulted in a split up north. Central Washington blew out Alaska for a 77-50 to start the week before falling to GNAC regular-season champion Alaska Anchorage on Saturday.

The team was led in its big win by guard **Alexis Pana**, who tallied a game-high 15 points and four rebounds. Sophomore

Kassidy Malcolm was right behind Pana, dropping 13 points while dishing out four assists.

Pana leads the team in both scoring (14.2 points per game) and assists (5.0) as the postseason tips off.

The team is defending at one of the highest rates in the country, including a figure of 4.5 blocks per game. That has CWU ranked first in the GNAC.

The Wildcats will tip off their postseason run in Bellingham on Thursday afternoon, meeting No. 5 seed Concordia at 12 p.m.

CONCORDIA



Concordia was in action for a pair of games last week, sweeping their final two contests of the regular season with victories over Saint Martin's (85-81) and Seattle Pacific (67-62).

The Cavaliers have now won five straight and clinched the program's first-ever trip to the GNAC Championships in the final week of the season. The late-season win streak earned

the team the No. 5 seed for the conference tournament.

The team was led on the week by sophomore **Olivia Vezaldenos**. Vezaldenos averaged 22.5 points and 4.5 assists across the two wins, including a 24-point explosion in the regular-season finale to win the league's scoring title.

Vezaldenos is averaging 15.9 points per game through 17 weeks of play. On the glass, senior **Keesha Sarman** tops CU with 7.8 rebounds per game.

The Cavaliers will return to the floor on Thursday afternoon against No. 4 seed Central Washington in the GNAC Championships quarterfinals. A victory in that game will earn the team a date with top-seeded Alaska Anchorage on Friday at 12 p.m.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



The Nighthawks went on the road last week and earned a split up in Alaska. The club blew out Alaska for a 98-58 victory after falling in a tight defeat to regular-season champion Alaska Anchorage.

Guard **Avery Albrecht** shined for NNU in the win, leading her team with 19 points in the 40-point victory. She was one of six players to finish at least one game scoring

in double figures.

Albrecht leads the team with 13.8 points per game entering the postseason. Senior **Ellie Logan** is following closely behind at a clip of 11.3 points per game.

The Nighthawks are ranked No. 9 in the latest WBCA Division II Coaches Poll and No. 11 in the D2SIDA Poll.

Northwest Nazarene will tip-off its GNAC Championships run in Saturday's second semifinal, facing either Simon Fraser or Western Washington at 2:15 p.m. (PST).

SIMON FRASER



- The Clan were unable to pick up a victory in their final road trip of the season. The team fell at rival Western Washington to start the week on Tuesday before dropping a tight 79-71 decision at Montana State Billings to cap the week.

- Sophomore **Claudia Hart** led her team on the week, averaging 12 points per game for the trip. Her 16-point performance off the bench in Bellingham led Simon Fraser.

- Senior **Sophie Swant** is at the top of the SFU scoring list after 27 games, averaging 14.4 points per game. Sophomore Jessica Jones is closely behind at 12.1 points per game.

- The team will be back in action for another border battle in Bellingham on Thursday afternoon, facing No. 6 seed Western Washington in the GNAC Championships quarterfinals.

WESTERN WASHINGTON



- The Vikings ended the regular season in style last week, blowing out rival Simon Fraser for a 67-49 victory on Tuesday before capping the week with a win at Montana State Billings two nights later.

- Western Washington was led on the week by center **Anna Schwecke**, who recorded a monster double-double of 26 points and 19 rebounds against the Clan.

- Sophomore **Kelsey Rogers** leads the team in scoring, averaging 12 points per game after 17 weeks of action. Schwecke is following closely behind at a clip of 11.9 per game as the fifth month of the season begins.

- The Vikings will tip-off the postseason at home on Thursday afternoon, hosting Simon Fraser for the second time in two weeks in the GNAC Championships quarterfinals. Tip-off is set for 2:15 p.m. inside Carver Gymnasium.
