



The Division II Administrative Committee met this afternoon to continue to take action on Division II regulations and policies impacted by COVID-19. The committee discussed recruiting activity with multiple uncommitted prospective student-athletes and camps and clinics.

The committee **adopted noncontroversial legislation to permit any number of uncommitted prospective student-athletes and their family members to participate on a telephone/video call with coaching staff members and current student-athletes until the start of the institution's fall 2020 term.** All other publicity restrictions per Division II Bylaw 13.10 apply.

The committee **confirmed that institutional camps and clinics can take place at any location subject to applicable public health guidance, and institutional and conference decisions.** The committee also **confirmed that coaching staff members are permitted to be employed at a noninstitutional camp or clinic during the quiet period from June 1-30.**

The Administrative Committee will meet again on June 10 and a membership update will be provided following the meeting.

Staff will also recap the Administrative Committee's actions since April 22 and provide an update on a review of the 2020-21 Division II playing and practice seasons and fall championships.
