



2021 Division II CCA All-America Softball Team

Two players from the northeast corridor of the country have landed the top national honors on the Division II Collegiate Commissioners Association's All-America softball team for the 2021 season, as Saint Anselm pitcher Morgan Perry was selected as the Ron Lenz national Pitcher of the Year and Shippensburg first baseman Hannah Marsteller was chosen as the Ron Lenz national Player of the Year.

Perry, a senior, pitched for the Hawks when they reached the championship series of the NCAA Division II Tournament in 2018 and led the Hawks to their second regional championship with a season where she went 19-1 with a 0.63 earned run average and struck out 215 batters in 123 innings of work. Her average of 12.2 strikeouts per seven innings leads the nation and her earned run average is the third-lowest in NCAA Division II.

Marsteller, a sophomore, ranks among the top 10 nationally in several offensive categories, including the top slugging percentage mark of 1.103 as she finished the season with 18 home runs and had 32 of her 58 hits for extra bases. She was also one of the toughest hitters to strike out this season as she fanned only five times in 147 plate appearances, helping her land the Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference's East Division athlete of the year honor.

The Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference showed up prominently on the first team as five players from that conference landed on the top squad. Colorado Mesa had two of the five in Ellie Smith, the RMAC's player of the year, at the utility-pitcher position and outfielder Lauren Wedman. Smith had a national-high 80 runs batted in while also recording 13 wins in the circle, while Wedman batted .514 and drove in 67 runs, the second-most in the nation.

The other three RMAC selections were outfielder Shelby Robb from MSU Denver, designated player Piper Lujon from Colorado Christian and utility player Brianna Santos from UCCS. Robb had the nation's highest batting average for players who played at least 30 games this season with a .535 mark, while Lujon led her team with a .441 average and belted 15 home runs and Santos batted over .400 this season while hitting 14 home runs along the way.

Augustana, the top seed for the upcoming NCAA Division II Championships and its first round opponent, Valdosta State, each had a first-team selection. Kendall Cornick, the third outfielder named to the first team, is one of four Vikings on the overall squad and led the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a .459 average while also recording 17 doubles and 33 stolen bases.

Nicole Pennington, one of three Valdosta State players on the D2CCA team, is one of just four players in NCAA Division II with a slugging percentage of 1.000 or better (all four are on the D2CCA All-America team) as she has blasted a national-high 24 home runs from her shortstop position. The other players with a slugging percentage that high on the first team were Marsteller and Malone catcher Bailey Byers, who has a mark of 1.044 after leading her team with a .504 batting average.

The balance of the infield consisted of Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association player of the year Sydni Hawkins, a second baseman from Missouri Western who led the MIAA in hitting and third baseman Alyssa Herrera, a freshman from Georgian Court who recorded a league-high 55 hits and batted .444 in her first season for a Lion team that reached the championship round of the NCAA East Regional.

Besides Perry, the other two first-team pitchers also earned top honors within their respective conferences during the past spring. Minnesota State's Mackenzie Ward was named as the Northern Sun's top pitcher as she led the nation with 316 strikeouts and posted a 0.90 ERA; the 11.8 strikeouts per seven innings were second only to Perry's mark. Meanwhile, Indianapolis' Kenzee Smith was named as the Great Lakes Valley Conference's freshman of the year as she posted the lowest ERA in the league at 1.22 while winning a conference-high 23 games in the circle.

The 2021 D2CCA All-America team includes players from nine schools that had their first-ever selection to the squad.

This is the 14th season of the All-America program which is selected by CoSIDA members from schools playing in NCAA Division II and fifth in which the program was solely sponsored by the Division II Collegiate Commissioners Association.
