McClave was named the final GNAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week after averaging 26 points and 5.5 rebounds per game to close out the Wolves' season in a pair of wins. She led all scorers in Thursday's 77-63 win over Northwest Nazarene and followed that up with a 23-point performance in Saturday's win over Central Washington. For the week, McClave shot 42% from the field, 35% from

three-point range and went a perfect 12 for 12 from the free-throw line.

GNAC Women's Basketball Championships Preview

Bellingham, Wash. – The 2023 GNAC Women's Basketball Championships, presented by Under Armour, tips off Thursday in Western Washington University's Carver Gym with plenty of intrigue ranging from a back-to-back regular-season champion to the pursuit of a GNAC record.

Western Washington enters the tournament with a true home court advantage as the reigning GNAC regular-season champions and the No. 1 seed. The Vikings finished the conference slate with a 16-2 record (22-3 overall) to claim the regular season title for the second year in a row. The Vikings have performed particularly well at home where they compiled an 11-2 record during the regular season.

Western Washington is ranked No. 2 in the West Region coming into the tournament after compiling a 14-game win streak from Nov. 19 to Jan. 19. The Vikings lead the GNAC and rank second in Division II with a .386 three-point percentage, 19.6 assists and six blocks per game. They also lead the conference and rank third in Division II with a .488 field goal percentage and fourth with a +11.4 rebound margin. In terms of raw winning prowess, WWU leads the conference and ranks 14th in Division II having won 88% of its games.

The Vikings are led by junior forward **Brooke Walling**, who ranks ninth in the GNAC in scoring with 13.4 points per game. Walling has also been excellent on the boards, pulling down an average of 9.2 rebounds per game, and has recorded 10 double-doubles to rank second in the conference.

Montana State Billings secured the No. 2 seed in the tournament with a 14-4 GNAC record (23-6 overall). The Yellowjackets were the only team in the conference to hand WWU a loss in the regular season, sweeping the season series from the Vikings. The wins came in a stretch where MSUB won 11 games in a row from Jan. 5 to Feb. 16.

The Yellowjackets rank fifth in the GNAC in scoring with 68.4 points per game but have been elite defensively, leading the conference by holding opponents to an average of just 58.1 points per game. They also lead the GNAC with a 1.30 assist to turnover ratio that ranks No. 6 in Division II. Montana State Billings enter the GNAC Championships ranked No. 4 in the West Region.

Leading the way for MSUB is junior forward **Dyauni Boyce**, who averages 10.9 points per game while shooting 42.2% from the field. Boyce also leads the team in rebounds with an average of 5.6 per game. She is joined by senior forward **Taryn Shelley**, who has been potent off the bench with 11.1 points per game in an average of 17.9 minutes per contest.

Central Washington comes in as the No. 3 seed after compiling a 12-6 conference record (20-7 overall). The Wildcats come into Bellingham as the reigning GNAC champions. They lead the GNAC and Division II with 31.9 defensive rebounds per game. They also lead the conference with 9.7 three-pointers made per game, good for seventh in Division II, and 78.5 points per contest which ranks 10th in the division.

The Wildcats' offense features three of the conference's top-eight offensive threats in the conference in senior center **Samantha Bowman**, sophomore guard **Valerie "Sunshine" Huerta** and freshman guard **Asher Cai**. Bowman leads the trio, and the GNAC, with 21.6 points and 14.8 rebounds per game. A tour de force on the court, Bowman leads the conference and ranks second in



Division II with 22 double-doubles this season in her pursuit of the conference's all-time rebounding record. Entering the tournament, Bowman trails the record of 1,181 career rebounds set by UAA's Rebecca Kieplinski in 2009 by just eight.

Huerta has been the top CWU shooter from long range, leading the team with a .477 three-point percentage while knocking down 18.5 points per game to rank third in the GNAC. She also leads the team with a .877 free-throw percentage and an average of 32.4 minutes played per contest. Cai ranks eighth in the conference with 14.1 points per while shooting 38.9% from the field and 30.3% from long range.

Alaska Anchorage locked in the No. 4 seed with a 10-8 conference record (18-9 overall). The Seawolves were strongest at home where they owned a 10-3 record and will look to carry their form

from the final two weeks of the regular season, where they won four in a row, into the postseason. The Seawolves lead the GNAC and rank eighth in Division II with a +7.92 turnover margin.

Junior guard **Vishe' Rabb** has led the charge for UAA this season, scoring an average of 16.8 points per game to head up the Seawolves' offense and rank fifth in the GNAC. She holds the top free-throw percentage in the GNAC at 86.8%. Rabb has also been one of the best on the boards for UAA, pulling in an average of 6.3 rebounds per contest.

Seattle Pacific enters the GNAC Championships as the No. 5 seed after putting together a 9-9 conference season (14-12 overall). The Falcons average just 60.9 points per game but, like MSUB, they feature a strong defense that ranks third in the conference holding opponents to just 58.5 points on average. They also rank third in the GNAC with a .383 field goal percentage defense.

When it comes to offensive production, senior guard/forward **Ashley Alter** and senior forward **Natalie Hoff** have led the way for SPU. Alter ranks seventh in the GNAC with 15.2 points per game while Hoff averages 10.5 points.

Simon Fraser comes in as the No. 6 seed with an 8-10 conference record (10-12 overall). The Red Leafs have excelled at stopping opponents from long range and rank third in the GNAC in three-point percentage defense (.303). They have been one of the best blocking teams, averaging 4.8 blocks per game to rank second in the GNAC.

Junior guard/forward **Jessica Wistozki** led the GNAC in scoring for much of the season, finishing the regular season second in the conference and in the top 10 in Division II with 21.3 points per game. Sophomore forward **Gemma Cutler** and **Sophia Wisotzki** have been the other top-scoring threats for SFU as it heads to Bellingham looking to advance from the first round for the first time since 2017.

The GNAC Women's Basketball Championships begin with the quarterfinals on Thursday. No. 3 Central Washington and No. 6 Simon Fraser tip off at 5:15 p.m. while No. 4 Alaska Anchorage and No. 5 Seattle Pacific face each other at 7:30 p.m.

The winner of Central Washington/Simon Fraser will face No. 2 Montana State Billings in the semifinals on Friday at 5:15 p.m. The winner of Alaska Anchorage/Seattle Pacific will face No. 1 Western Washington at 7:30 p.m. The championship game will be on Saturday at 7:30 p.m.

ALASKA ANCHORAGE

• Alaska Anchorage enters the GNAC Championships with a 10-8 conference record after winning its final games of the regular season 64-54 at Seattle Pacific on Thursday and 65-58 over No. 22 Montana State Billings on Saturday.

• Junior guard **Vishe' Rabb** led the Seawolves to close the conference slate, averaging 21.5 points and eight rebounds per game in the wins. Rabb's highlight of the week came in Thursday's win where she led all scorers with 28 points on 7 of 14 from the field, 3 of 6 from three-point range and a perfect 11 of 11 from the free-throw line.

• Sophomore guard **Jazzpher Evans** also averaged double-digit scoring with 10 points per game. Evans finished with 14 points, two rebounds, an assist and a steal on Thursday. She followed that up with six points, two rebounds, two assists and a steal on Saturday.

• Alaska Anchorage will face Seattle Pacific for the second time in as many weeks for the quarterfinals of the GNAC Championships on Thursday. The winner of that game will face No. 1 seed Western Washington in the semifinals on Friday.



CENTRAL WASHINGTON

• Central Washington ended the regular season with a 12-6 GNAC record after splitting its final week on the road. The Wildcats opened the week with a 100-74 win over Saint Martin's on Thursday before falling 83-72 to Western Oregon on Saturday.

• Senior center **Samantha Bowman** led the way for CWU, averaging 25 points and 14.5 rebounds per game. Bowman captured her 22nd and 23rd double-doubles of the season in the games recording 21 points and 12 rebounds on Thursday and 29 points and 17 rebounds on Saturday. She leads the GNAC and ranks seventh in Division II in scoring with an average of 21.6 points per game.

• Bowman was joined by sophomore point guard **Valerie Huerta** and freshman guard **Asher Cai** in averaging double-digit scoring for the week. Huerta averaged 20 points and two rebounds per game while Cai averaged 10 points and eight boards per contest.

• Senior **Tori Maeda** has been one of the best playmakers in the GNAC and ranks second in the conference with 5.1 assists per game. Last week, Maeda averaged six points and seven assists per game. Her high point came in Thursday's win where she narrowly missed out on a double-double with nine point and 10 assists.

• Central Washington will face Simon Fraser in the quarterfinals on Thursday. The Wildcats split the regular season series with the Red Leafs with each team winning on the road.



MONTANA STATE BILLINGS

• Montana State Billings enters the GNAC championships as the No. 2 seed with a 14-4 conference record after splitting its final week of the regular season. The Yellowjackets took an 84-58 win over Alaska on Thursday before falling 65-58 to Alaska Anchorage on Saturday.

• Sophomore guard **Aspen Giese** led MSUB for the week averaging 16.5 points, six rebounds and three assists per game. Giese's high point of the week came in Thursday's win where she finished with 18 points to go with seven boards, four assists and a block.

• Senior guard **Shayla Montague** averaged 14.5 points per game, shooting 52% from the field and 56% from three-point range for the week. She knocked down 17 points to go with two boards, an assist and a steal on Thursday and followed that up with 12 points, five rebounds, three assists and two blocks on Saturday.

• Montana State Billings will face the winner of SFU vs. CWU on Friday in the semifinals of the GNAC Championships.



SEATTLE PACIFIC

• Seattle Pacific secured its place in the GNAC Championships by splitting its final week of the regular season to finish with a 9-9 conference record. The Falcons fell 64-54 to Alaska Anchorage on Thursday before bouncing back with a 69-47 win over Alaska on Saturday.

• Senior forward **Natalie Hoff** led the offense for the week, averaging 16 points and 5.5 rebounds per game while shooting 48% from the field and 60% from the free-throw line. Hoff opened the week with 16 points, seven rebounds and two assists on Thursday before finishing with 16 points, four rebounds and a block in Saturday's win.

• Senior guard/forward **Ashley Alter** nearly averaged a double-double per game with 13.5 points and 9.5 rebounds per contest. Her highlight of the week was an 18-point, 11-rebound double-double to lead the team to victory on Saturday.

• Seattle Pacific will look to get revenge immediately against Alaska Anchorage as the Falcons face the Seawolves in the quarterfinals of the GNAC Championships on Thursday.



SIMON FRASER

• Simon Fraser finished the regular season with an 8-10 GNAC record after dropping its final game of the conference slate with an 87-63 loss to Western Washington on Thursday.

• Junior guard/forward **Jessica Wisotzki** led the Red Leafs in their final game of the regular season with 17 points to go with three rebounds, four assists and a block. Wisotzki ranks second in the GNAC and ninth Division II with an average of 21.4 points per game. She also leads the conference with 2.55 three-pointers made per contest.

• Senior forward **Sophie Klassen** added 11 points, two steals and a rebound on Thursday on 4 of 7 from the field and 3 of 3 from the free-throw line while sophomore forward **Gemma Cutler** chipped in six points to go with nine rebounds and a block.

• Simon Fraser will face Central Washington in the quarterfinals on Thursday after splitting the regular-season series with the Wildcats. The Red Leafs narrowly dropped their most recent meeting with CWU 88-81 in Burnaby. The winner of Thursday's game will advance to face Montana State Billings on Friday.



WESTERN WASHINGTON

• Western Washington closed out the conference schedule with an 87-63 win over Simon Fraser on Thursday to secure its second regular-season title in as many years with a 16-2 GNAC record.

• Senior center **Carley Zaragoza** led the Vikings to victory with a 20-point performance while shooting 8 for 11 from the field and 4 for 7 from the free-throw line. Zaragoza also added seven rebounds, two steals and an assist in 18 minutes off the bench.

• Heading into the GNAC Championships, Western Washington leads the conference in scoring margin (+17.6), free throw percentage (.758), field goal percentage (.488), field goal percentage defense (.352), three-point field goal percentage (.386), rebounding defense (29.4), rebounding margin (+11.4), blocked shots per game (6.0), assists per game (19.6) and offensive rebound percentage (.358).

• Western Washington will host the GNAC Championships in Bellingham as the No. 1 seed and will face the winner of Seattle Pacific and Alaska Anchorage on Friday in the semifinals.
