**Sonoma State's Lexi Zanonella-Arasa Named 2022 D2CCA
All-West Region Women's Soccer Player of the Year**

Western Washington leads region with five all-region selections

SAN FRANCISCO – Sonoma State sophomore midfielder Lexi Zanonella-Arasa has been named the 2022 Division 2 Conference Commissioners Association Women's Soccer West Region Player of the Year.

There were ten repeat honorees in 2022 and a total of twelve institutions had at least one student-athlete named to the 13-member first or second team. WWU led all programs with five selections. Hawai'i Hilo followed with four. Cal State LA and Sonoma State all earned three selections. Northwest Nazarene, Point Loma, and Stanislaus State each claimed a pair. Azusa Pacific, Cal State Monterey Bay, Concordia, Fresno Pacific, and Western Oregon each saw one student-athlete named to the team.

The D2 CCA Player of the Year award and all-region teams are nominated and selected by members of the region's athletics communications staffs.

The D2 CCA encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of high education. The D2 CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact NCAA Division II athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.

The 13 members of the All-West Region first team will now be placed on the national ballot for All-America consideration. The All-America teams will be released Wednesday, November 30. The complete All-West region teams follow.
