SEASIDE, Calif. -- Chico State's Casey Costello and Azusa Pacific's Pablo O'Connor took the Division II Conference Commissioners Association Baseball All-West Region top honors as Pitcher and Player of the year, respectively. Voting was conducted by the NCAA Division II Sports Information Directors from institutions and conference offices.

Costello was named the West Region Pitcher of the Year after a spotless 12-0 season. The La Quinta native allowed just 22 earned runs on 78 hits in 83.1 innings pitched while posting an impressive 2.38 ERA. The junior led Chico State to the best record in CCAA history of 34-4, a CCAA Baseball Tournament Championship and an NCAA West Regional appearance and no. 1 seed.

O'Connor was named the West Region Player of the Year after an impressive showing at the dish all season. The junior outfielder posted a .397 batting average and a .772 slugging percentage. Of his 75 hits, 34 of them were for extra bases in 18 home runs, 15 doubles and a triple.

Costello also received First Team honors in addition to three other CCAA representatives. Relief pitcher and the national leader in saves with 15, Nick Voumard, also earned D2CCA First Team honors. Catcher Cody Martin (Cal Poly Pomona) and Shortstop Tyler Place (Cal State San Marcos) round out the CCAA contingent on the first team. The CCAA dominated the second team with 13 selections giving it 17 total, the most of any conference.

It was crowded at the top as O'Connor led a group of 11 first team selections from the Pac West Conference including three players from Dixie State (2B Tyler Mildenberg, OF Trey Kamachi, Utility-Non Pitcher Drew McLaughlin). Pitcher Michael Fairchild and third baseman Adrian Tovalin joined O'Connor as first team representatives for APU as well. All totaled, the PacWest had 13 all-region selections.

Northwest Nazarene outfielder Billy King represented the GNAC earning first team honors as the senior led the Crusaders in hits (58), home runs (15), and RBI (44).

All of the 14 first teamers will now be placed on the national ballot for All-American recognition to be announced later this month.

The Division II Conference Commissioners Association encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of higher education. The CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact Division II intercollegiate athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.
