Alyssa Benthagen, Central Washington C/IF • 5-6 • Senior • Spokane, Valley, Wash.

Playing eight games in the final week, Benthagen led the Wildcats with a .440 batting average, going 11 for 25 with seven runs, three home runs, seven walks and 10 RBIs. Benthagen went 3 for 5 in Monday's opener against Simon Fraser, hitting a three-run homer and an RBI single. She then went 2 for 3 in the nightcap with a pair of solo home runs. On Tuesday, Benthagen went 1 for 4 with an RBI single and went 2 for 2 in the nightcap with a pair of RBI singles. In the weekend series with Saint Martin's, Benthagen's best effort came in Saturday's second game where she went 2 for 4 with two more RBI singles.

Booth threw a pair of shutouts against Western Oregon to close the regular season and move into a tie for first in the GNAC with 16 wins on the season. In Friday's 10-0, five-inning win, Booth allowed just one hit and struck out nine. She faced just three batters over the minimum. In Saturday's 1-0 victory, Booth allowed four hits and struck out six. She threw 80 pitches in the game, 61 for strikes.

### **GNAC Championships Preview**

BURNABY, B.C. – Northwest Nazarene was almost impossible to beat in the conference regular season. Now the Nighthawks lead the field as the GNAC Softball Championships begin on Thursday at Beedie Field on the campus of Simon Fraser University.

The Nighthawks won their third consecutive regular-season title with an impressive 18-3 conference mark and enter the GNAC Championships with a 33-15 overall record. Northwest Nazarene is on a seven-game win streak and went 15-3 in the month of April.

While leading the GNAC with a 2.07 ERA and ranking fourth with a .273 batting average, NNU finished with a 1.60 ERA and a .309 batting average in conference play, leading the GNAC in both categories. The Nighthawks outscored GNAC teams 140-46 and limited opponents to a .227 batting average.

Senior **Tori Hensley** leads NNU both in the circle and at the plate. She ranks second in the GNAC with a 1.94 ERA, compiling a 14-5 record, and ranks third in the conference with a .373 batting average and is fourth with 57 hits. Junior **Sidney Booth** continues to be a two-way threat in 2023, ranking third in the conference with a 1.98 ERA and sharing the GNAC lead with 16 wins. At the plate, Booth is hitting .271 with 39 hits and 28 RBIs.

Senior Maia McNicoll enters the championships with a .299 batting average. She ranks second in the GNAC with 86 total bases, is fourth with a .585 slugging percentage and is tied for fourth with 12 doubles. Freshman Clarissa Moreno is batting .293 and is tied for fourth in the GNAC with 33 runs scored.

Thanks to inclement weather early in the season, Saint Martin's was forced to play one-third of its conference schedule over the final week of the regular season. The Saints met the challenge, going 6-2 over that stretch to clinch the No. 2 seed and its third straight GNAC Championships berth.

Finishing 15-9 in GNAC play and 28-16 overall, the Saints enter the tournament ranked second in the GNAC with a 3.13 ERA and third with a .282 batting average. The Saints' 24 home runs are second among the teams in the championships field.

Junior **Tia Ridings** leads the SMU pitching staff, ranking sixth in the GNAC with a 2.69 ERA. She has 15 wins and a .239 opponent batting average in 112 innings. Sophomore **Chloe Leverington** has a 2.81 ERA and her 12 saves rank in the top five in Division II.

Offensively, freshman **Haley Agena** leads the conference with a .493 batting average and a .493 on-base percentage. Junior **Britney Patrick** is batting .341 while freshman **Shelby Lawson** is batting .320.

Western Washington secured the No. 3 seed with a late season run, sweeping four games from Montana State Billings in a neutral-site series in Yakima



on Apr. 22 and 23 before splitting a rain make-up doubleheader with Saint Martin's on Apr. 26. The Vikings won six of their final seven games of the regular season.

The only GNAC team hitting above .300 this season, Western Washington leads the conference with a .301 batting average and is fourth with a 3.21 ERA. The team's .239 opponent batting average ranks second in the league.

Senior **Mareena Ramirez** has been a flamethrower for the Vikings in the circle, leading the conference with a 1.87 ERA. She is tied for first in the GNAC with 16 wins and is among the Division II leaders with 162 strikeouts. In 157.1 innings, Ramirez has allowed 56 runs and just 25 extra-base hits.

Freshman **Hailey Rath** has been the Vikings' top offensive threat, ranking sixth in the GNAC with a

.345 batting average and fifth with 51 hits. Senior **Kinzey Williams** is hitting .331 on the season and is sixth in the conference with 49 hits.

Despite losing its last seven games of the regular season, Western Oregon reached the GNAC Championships as the No. 4 seed. The Wolves howled over the first half of the conference season, going 9-3 in their first three series. They were stung late, dropping three of four games at Montana State Billings and all four games in the final weekend to Northwest Nazarene.

Western Oregon has excelled in the circle, ranking third in the GNAC with a 3.16 ERA. Senior **Maddie Mayer** ranks fourth in the conference with a 2.24 ERA while limiting opponents to a .229 batting average. Senior **Chelsea Smith** owns a 3.20 ERA and a .223 opponent batting average while striking out 148 in 122.2 innings.

The Wolves own a .237 team batting average with sophomore **Maddie Doig** ranking 10th individually with a .330 batting average. Senior **Natalie Willoughby** owns a .320 batting average.

The GNAC Softball Championships begin Thursday with No. 2 Saint Martin's facing No. 3 Western Washington at noon. No. 1 Northwest Nazarene will take on No. 4 Western Oregon at 2:30 p.m. The double-elimination tournament concludes with the championship game on Saturday at noon. The winner of the GNAC Championships receives the conference's automatic berth to the NCAA Division II Championships.

Tickets are available for advance purchase at GNACTickets.com. All games will be live-streamed on the conference's YouTube page, GNAC.tv.

The GNAC Softball Championships will mark just the third time that an NCAA conference tournament has been held outside the United States. Simon Fraser previously hosted the GNAC Women's Soccer Championships in 2015 and 2016.

## **GNAC Championships Participants**

### NORTHWEST NAZARENE



• Northwest Nazarene closed out the regular season with a sweep of Western Oregon in Monmouth. The Nighthawks won Friday's game 10-0 (five innings) and 5-1 and Saturday's games 1-0 and 3-1.

 Junior Sidney Booth was named the GNAC Softball Pitcher of the Week after she allowed just five hits and

struck out 15 in 12 innings of work. Booth allowed just one hit in Friday's opener, striking out nine in the five-inning win. She then threw a four-hit shutout on Saturday, striking out six to improve to 16-8 on the season. At the plate, Booth batted .417 with four runs and three RBIs, topped by a 2 for 3 effort in Friday's opener with a double, three RBIs and a run scored. Booth is third in the GNAC with a 1.98 ERA and enters the week with a .271 batting average.

• Senior **Tori Hensley** had the other two pitching wins for the Nighthawks. In Friday's second game, Hensley allowed one run on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts in the victory. She closed the regular season by allowing just four hits in four innings while taking a no-decision in Saturday's finale. At the plate, Hensley batted .364 with four hits and two runs scored. Hensley is second in the GNAC with a 1.94 ERA and third with a .373 batting average.

• Northwest Nazarene enters the GNAC Championships leading the conference and is 24th in Division II with a 2.07 ERA and ranks fourth with a .273 batting average. The Nighthawks are 14th in Division II with 176 walks and 23rd with a WHIP (walks plus hits per innings pitched) of 1.12.

• The only GNAC representative in the NCAA West Region Rankings, Northwest Nazarene was No. 6 sixth in the latest rankings released on Apr. 26.

• The 2023 GNAC regular season champions and the defending GNAC Championships winner, NNU is making its fifth straight tournament appearance. The Nighthawks are 10-5 all-time.

### SAINT MARTIN'S



• Saint Martin's went 6-2 in eight games last week to earn the No. 2 seed in the GNAC Championships. On Tuesday, the Saints swept a doubleheader from Western Oregon, 9-7 and 4-1, and split a Wednesday doubleheader with Western Washington, losing the opener 2-0 and winning the nightcap 5-2.

• The Saints closed the regular season by taking three of four games at Central Washington. After dropping Saturday's opener 7-6 in 12 innings, SMU won the nightcap 9-7 before sweeping Sunday's games, 6-1 and 9-1 in five innings.

• Junior **Britney Patrick** hit .400 in the eight games to lead Saint Martin's offensively, going 8 for 20 with a double, seven RBIs and eight runs scored. Patrick did her most damage in the CWU series. In Saturday's opener, she went 2 for 3 with an RBI double and a run scored. In Sunday's opener, Patrick went 3 for 4 with a pair of RBI singles and two runs scored. Patrick enters the GNAC Championships ranked seventh in the conference with a .341 average.

• Junior **Tia Ridings** went 3-1 in six appearances and five starts in the marathon week. In Tuesday's second game against WOU, Ridings allowed one run on five hits with two walks and six strikeouts in 5.1 innings for the victory. She earned the win in relief in Saturday's second game at CWU, allowing three runs, two earned, on six hits with a walk and four strikeouts in 3.2 innings. In Sunday's finale, Ridings allowed one run on three hits with seven strikeouts in four innings for the win. Ridings is sixth in the GNAC with a 2.69 ERA.

• Saint Martin's enters the GNAC Championships ranked second in the GNAC with a 3.13 ERA and third with a .282 batting average.

• The Saints are making their third consecutive GNAC Championships appearance and eighth overall. They went 2-2 last year, falling twice on Championship Saturday to Northwest Nazarene.

### WESTERN OREGON



• Western Oregon dropped all six of its contests last week. The Wolves lost both ends of Tuesday's doubleheader at Saint Martin's, 9-7 and 4-1. They then lost all four games at home to Northwest Nazarene, falling 10-0 (five innings) and 5-1 on Friday and 1-0 and 3-1 on Saturday.

Senior Kirah McGlothan led WOU offensively with a .364

batting average, going 4 for 11 with two runs scored and a home run. McGlothan had a hit in both games at Saint Martin's. She went 1 for 1 in Friday's second game against Northwest Nazarene and had a solo home run in Saturday's finale that accounted for the Wolves' lone run. McGlothan enters the GNAC Championships with a .250 batting average.

• Sophomore **Maddie Doig** batted .308 in the six games, going 4 for 13 with two doubles and three RBIs. All four hits came in the Saint Martin's doubleheader. In the opener, Doig went 2 for 4 with a pair of doubles, including a two-RBI double in the seventh inning. She then went 2 for 3 in the nightcap with an RBI single in the fourth. Doig enters the week with a .330 batting average.

• Senior Chelsea Smith amassed a 3.05 ERA in four appearances. Her best effort came in Saturday's opener, allowing one run on three hits with eight walks and four strikeouts in six innings of work. Smith enters the GNAC Championships ranked ninth in the GNAC with a 3.20 ERA. Senior Maddie Mayer is fourth with a 2.24 ERA.

• Western Oregon enters the tournament ranked third in the GNAC with a 3.16 ERA. The Wolves are batting .257 on the season.

• Western Oregon returns to the GNAC Championships for the first time since 2021. The Wolves are making their ninth tournament appearance, the most of any team.

### WESTERN WASHINGTON



• Western Washington wrapped up its regular season by splitting a rain make-up doubleheader at Saint Martin's on Wednesday. The Vikings won the opener, 2-0, before falling 5-2 in the nightcap.

• Senior **Mareena Ramirez** threw another gem to win the opener, allowing just three hits and walking one while striking out six to improve to 16-6 on the season. Ramirez enters

the GNAC Championships leading the conference with a 1.86 ERA and 162 strikeouts in 157.1 innings.

• Freshman **Hailey Rath** hit .286 in the two games and batted in two of the Vikings' four runs. Rath went 1 for 3 with a double in the opener and drew a bases-loaded walk to open scoring in the fifth inning. She then went 1 for 4 in the nightcap with an RBI single in the seventh. Rath is sixth in the GNAC with a .345 batting average.

• Junior **Emily Paulson** went 2 for 4 with a walk, a double, two runs scored and an RBI. Paulson went 1 for 3 in the opener with an RBI double in the sixth inning. She then went 1 for 1 with a walk in the nightcap and scored the opening run of the game in the second inning. Paulson enters the week with a .250 batting average.

• Western Washington enters the GNAC Championships leading the conference with a .301 batting average. The Vikings rank fourth with a 3.21 ERA.

• Western Washington is making its third straight GNAC Championships appearance and sixth all-time. The Vikings won the tournament in 2021 and went 0-2 in 2022.
