#TheHitsKeepComing Central Washington outfielder and GNAC Player of the Week **Zach Berryman** hit .632 (12 for 19) in four games against MSUB, including a 6-for-6 game on Saturday. Berryman won the GNAC regular-season batting title with a .379 average.

#MicDropMoment Montana State Billings clinched the No. 3 seed at the GNAC Championships in perhaps the most exciting way possible – a walk-off home run. **AJ Wagenmann** went deep to give MSUB a 12-11 victory over CWU and eliminate Saint Martin's.

#TourneyTime Northwest Nazarene, Western Oregon and Montana State Billings will compete at the GNAC Championships on Thursday and Friday from the WOU campus in Monmouth, Ore.

Berryman finished the 2022 season in style, batting .632 with a .682 on-base percentage and a .684 slugging percentage as the Wildcats' leadoff hitter. He went 12 for 19 with six runs scored, one double and an RBI. Berryman went 2 for 3 in Thursday's opener and then went 1 for 6 with a run scored in the nightcap. Berryman opened Friday by going 6 for 6 with four runs scored and an RBI single in the

opener and then went 3 for 4 with a double and a run scored in the nightcap.

GNAC Championships Preview

After tangling in the NCAA West Regional finals a year ago, Northwest Nazarene and Western Oregon are poised for another clash at the GNAC Championships on Thursday and Friday from the WOU campus in Monmouth, Oregon.

There was little to separate both schools during the regular season. The two clubs finished the year tied at 21-11 in GNAC play and were declared conference co-champions. The Nighthawks and Wolves also split their eight regular-season meetings. Only because Northwest Nazarene had a slightly better record (6-2) than Western Oregon (5-3) over No. 3 seed Montana State Billings were the Nighthawks awarded the No. 1 seed for the conference tournament.

Northwest Nazarene enters hitting .274 as a team with a 4.26 ERA. The Nighthawks' offense possesses a unique blend of contact and power, hitting tied for the most home runs in the conference (44) while striking out the fewest times (304, 40 less than the next-lowest team). Shortstop **Parker Price** sits atop the Nighthawks lineup and has been productive, hitting .320 with 14 doubles, seven home runs and 41 RBI. Price has walked as many times as he has struck out (20) and boasts a .407 on-base percentage and .538 slugging percentage, making him one of five GNAC players with a .300/.400/.500 slash line.

Third baseman **Duke Pahukoa**, a UNLV transfer, is hitting .306 with eight home runs as a middle of the order threat. Pahukoa ranks third in the GNAC with a .556 slugging percentage. **Grant Kerry** is tied for second in the GNAC with nine home runs while playing first base. Kerry and Price are the only two GNAC position players to win multiple Player of the Week awards this season.

Senior **Haden Keller** has been a unique two-way talent for the Nighthawks. As an outfielder and designated hitter, Keller is hitting .311 (ninth in the conference) with five home runs and 22 RBI, but he has been even more impressive on the mound. Through 12 starts, Keller ranks second in the conference among qualifying pitchers with a 3.40 ERA and is holding opposing hitters to a league-low .210 batting average. Keller's 63 strikeouts in 55.2 innings pitched rank fourth in the GNAC. On March 9, Keller threw the sixth no-hitter in GNAC history and first since 2019 against Central Washington.

Behind Keller, the Nighthawks pitching staff leads the conference in strikeouts (431) and fewest walks allowed (140). **Brock Moffitt** is a good candidate to start a game for NNU, pitching to a 3.78 ERA with 59 strikeouts in 47.2 innings. The Nighthawks have a pair of relief aces in left-handed setup man **Blake McFadden**, who has a 2.09 ERA and five wins in 38.2 innings pitched, and closer **Max Holtzclaw**. Holtzclaw ranks tied for second in Division II with 11 saves and has a 2.05 ERA in a GNAC-high 21 relief appearances. Holtzclaw has struck out 53 batters against just eight walks.

Western Oregon will be out for redemption after health and safety protocols forced them to withdraw from the 2021 GNAC Championships. The Wolves have a conference-leading 3.99 ERA, and their .976 team fielding percentage ranks fifth in all of Division II. Offensively, the Wolves use speed and contact to manufacture runs, with a league-high 61 stolen bases and 31 sacrifice hits.

Center fielder **Jacob Maiben** leads WOU offensively. Maiben has the fourth-highest batting average (.344) and has drawn the third-most walks (26), culminating in a GNAC-leading .460 on-base percentage. He is always a threat to run, with his 19 stolen bases edging out twin brother **Derek Maiben's** 18 for the conference lead. Derek Maiben is batting .296 with 33 RBI while playing shortstop for the Wolves.

First baseman **John Stark** is tied for second in the GNAC with nine home runs. Four of those bombs came in an April series against Central Washington in which Stark scooped GNAC Player of the Week honors. **Jackson Holstad** is batting .274 with 10 doubles while **Justyn Herzog** ranks second in the GNAC with four triples.

The key to any baseball postseason tournament is pitching depth, and Western Oregon may have more of it than anyone. The Wolves have two legit aces at the top of their rotation. **Arturo Alvarez** has a 2.83 ERA, lowest among GNAC starting pitchers, and has a perfect 7-0 record. Alvarez has only given up two

home runs in 60.2 innings pitched. **Mike Peterson**, the 2021 GNAC Pitcher of the Year, has a 3.68 ERA and 48 strikeouts against 12 walks in 52 innings pitched. No. 3 starter **Parker Johnson** is tied for the league lead with seven wins. All three starters rank in the conference top four for fewest hits, runs, walks and home runs allowed this season.

The Wolves have a stable full of bullpen arms, including **Sebastien Boivin** (2.21 ERA in 21 appearances), **Chris Hardin** (3.68 ERA in 20 appearances) and **Bryce Bond** (3.18 ERA, three saves). **Seth Kuykendall** has made five starts and 13 relief appearances and threw 6.2 shutout innings against Northwest Nazarene on April 22. **Matthew Dunaway** began the season as a starter, but moved to the bullpen and has racked up three saves and 47 strikeouts in 28.2 innings.

Montana State Billings locked down the No. 3 seed after going 16-16 in conference play. It is a return to the Championships for MSUB, which made the tournament every year and won four regular-season titles from 2015-2019 but missed last year's Championships. The Yellowjackets can rake, as they have the highest batting average (.279), on-base percentage (.388) and slugging percentage (.447) of teams to qualify for the Championships. They lead the GNAC in walks (229), runs (345), triples (18) and are tied for the lead with 44 home runs.

Shortstop **Cooper Dulich** has burst on the scene as a freshman, ranking third in the GNAC in batting average (.346) and on-base percentage (.459) while driving in 35 runs. Center fielder **Carson Green** is another member of the .300/.400/.500 club, hitting .319, ranking sixth in the GNAC with a .429 on-base percentage and slugging .530. **Hayden Foltz** is hitting .307 and ranks third in the GNAC with 43 RBI.

The Yellowjackets feature the only two GNAC position players to win NCBWA West Regional Player of the Week honors this season. **Tyler Godfrey** won the award for the week of April 4-10 after tallying walk-off hits in back-to-back games against Western Oregon. Godfrey is batting .285 this season. First baseman **Mitch Winter** earned the award for the week of April 18-24 after batting .667 and slugging 1.556 with four home runs during a four-game series against Saint Martin's. Winter is batting .270 and leads the GNAC with 10 home runs.

The Yellowjackets' pitching may be the most vulnerable in the tournament with a 7.42 team ERA. The team has relied heavily on two starting pitchers as **Dylan Barkley** leads the conference in innings pitched (72.1) and **Matthew Houlihan** ranks fifth at 61.1, while both players' 13 starts are the most in the conference. Barkley started the year on fire, throwing 12 scoreless innings to open the season and winning three of the conference's first four Pitcher of the Week awards. He currently has a 5.35 ERA.

Houlihan has a 5.72 ERA but has shown flashes of brilliance, such as a February 18 complete-game win over national top-10 ranked Colorado Mesa and a one-hit shutout over Saint Martin's on April 21. The most likely bullpen arms for MSUB are **Tyler Elliott** (15 appearances, 5.45 ERA, 48 strikeouts in 33 innings) and **Blake Rainey** (13 appearances).

The GNAC Championships will begin Thursday with three games: Western Oregon vs. MSUB at 10 a.m., Northwest Nazarene vs. MSUB at 1 p.m., and Northwest Nazarene vs. Western Oregon at 4 p.m. After day one, if teams are 2-0, 1-1 and 0-2, the 0-2 team is eliminated and the remaining teams will play on Friday. If there is a 1-1 tie after day one, the No. 1 team will automatically advance to the championship game. The No. 2 and 3 seeds will play a loser out game on Friday at noon.

Advance daily session tickets are available for purchase at GNACTickets.com and are priced at \$10 for adults and \$5 for seniors, students and children ages 6-14. Daily session tickets at the gate are priced at \$12 for adults and \$7 for seniors, students and children ages 6-14. Children 5 and under are free. Daily session tickets include admission to all games each day.

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS

• Montana State Billings closed the regular season by taking three out of four from Central Washington. The Yellowjackets won 7-4 and 12-11 in eight innings on Thursday, suffered a 17-12 loss in the opening game Friday and won the season finale on Friday, 9-8.

- **Cooper Dulich** closed a phenomenal freshman campaign by hitting .538 (7 for 13) against the Wildcats. Dulich reached base at a .667 clip and had a .768 slugging percentage while driving in eight runs and not striking out in 18 plate appearances. Dulich finishes the regular season ranked third in the GNAC in batting average (.364) and on-base percentage (.459) while being tied for fifth in RBI (35).
- **AJ Wagenmann** provided a storybook moment during Friday's wild second game. With one out in the eighth inning, Wagenmann sent a deep drive to left-center field for a walk-off solo blast and his fourth home run of the season. The win clinched MSUB's spot in the GNAC Championships.
- **Connor Redmond** had a strong start, allowing one earned run on seven hits in six innings while striking out six. After allowing three runs, one earned, in the sixth, Redmond handed things over to the bullpen with a 9-3 lead and MSUB hung on for a 9-8 victory. Redmond is 4-6 with a 6.75 ERA this season.
- The Yellowjackets' 18 triples rank 23rd in Division II. They will end the regular season with the conference leaders in home runs (**Mitch Winter**, 10), walks (**James Anderson**, 38), hit by pitches (Dulich, 13) and innings pitched (**Dylan Barkley**, 77.1).
- The Yellowjackets are receiving votes in the most recent NCBWA West Region Poll, but did not appear in the NCAA's regional rankings. They have received votes in nine of the past 10 NCBWA polls.

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



• Northwest Nazarene was idle last week. They completed their regular season with a clutch four-game sweep of Montana State Billings, winning twice on April 29 9-4, then on April 30 by 4-3 and 5-2 scores. After results the following week, the Nighthawks finished as GNAC co-champions with a 21-11 record and earned the No. 1 seed at the GNAC

Championships via tiebreaker.

- **Parker Price** earned GNAC Player of the Week honors for Apr. 25-May 1 after batting .500 (7 for 14) with five RBI, four runs scored and three home runs. All three dingers came Friday. Price homered in the first and sixth innings in the opener and again in the first inning in the nightcap. His second-game homer was the start of a 4 for 4 day in which Price later added an RBI single and a double. Price ranks seventh in the GNAC with a .320 average and fourth with 14 doubles and 41 RBI.
- **Alex Salsman** also hit .500 for the week, with six RBI that nearly always came in extremely clutch spots. Salsman hit an RBI double as part of a four-run first in the series opener before adding a two-run homer in the nightcap. On Saturday, Salsman's go-ahead home run in the eighth provided the winning 4-3 margin in the opener before his two-run single provided key insurance in a 5-2 finale win.
- **Blake McFadden** threw 5.2 scoreless innings over two relief appearances, including a four-inning save during the series opener. McFadden sports a 2.09 ERA and leads all conference relievers with 38.2 innings pitched.
- Northwest Nazarene ranks 23rd in Division II with a 4.09 ERA, 17th with a 1.34 WHIP and 10th with a 3.08 strikeout to walk ratio.
- The Nighthawks are fifth in the NCAA's latest regional rankings and seventh in the most recent NCBWA West Region Poll. The MSUB sweep was significant in the eyes of the NCAA committee, as the Nighthawks jumped up from eighth in the previous rankings.

WESTERN OREGON



• Western Oregon closed the regular season by winning three of four against Saint Martin's, working around heavy rain. On Wednesday, the Wolves won 4-0 and 2-1 in eight innings. On Saturday, WOU dropped the first game 6-4, but won the finale 6-4 in nine innings. Western Oregon finished as GNAC co-champions with a 21-11 record and will be the

No. 2 seed at the GNAC Championships, which they will host.

- **Jacob Maiben** had a strong final series, hitting .357 with two doubles and two RBI. He also reached on three walks and two hit by pitches and used his on-base opportunities to steal three bases, taking his league-leading total to 19. Maiben's most clutch moment was a bases-clearing two-run double in the top of the ninth inning of the season finale. A third run scored on an error on the play to give WOU a 6-3 lead in what was a must-win game that allowed the Wolves to claim a share of the regular-season GNAC title.
- **Arturo Alvarez** earned his second GNAC Pitcher of the Week nod of the season after throwing seven one-run innings in Friday's second game, striking out eight while allowing just four hits and a walk. Alvarez finishes the regular season with a 7-0 record and a league-low 2.83 ERA. The combination of **Mike Peterson** (six innings), **Sebasten Boivin** (one) and **Matthew Dunaway** (two) shut out SMU with five hits and nine strikeouts in the series-opening win.
- The Wolves rank fifth in Division II with a .975 fielding percentage and 18th with a 3.97 ERA. They lead the GNAC with four shutouts. **Derek Maiben** ranks 11th in Division II with seven sacrifice flies.
- Western Oregon ranks sixth in the latest NCBWA West Region poll, dropping one spot, and seventh in the NCAA's regional rankings, standing pat from last week.
