



## 2017 D2CCA Softball All-West Region Teams

**RIVERSIDE, Calif.** — Chico State's **Haley Gilham** and Central Washington's **Kailyn Campbell** highlighted the 2017 Division II Conference Commissioners Association All-West Region Teams. Voting was conducted by the NCAA Division II Sports Information Directors from institutions and conference offices.

Gilham was named the West Region Pitcher of the Year after leading the Wildcats to the West Regional II finale – Chico State's third-straight NCAA Division II tournament appearance – and finishing the year with a 23-8 record. She finished the year with a 1.31 ERA with 26 complete games and 10 shutouts over 213.1 innings pitched.

Campbell earned herself the West Region Player of the Year honor after leading CWU to its second-straight Great Northwest Athletic Conference regular season championship. The senior finished the season with a .497 batting average, which ranks fourth in the division. Campbell also ranks second nationally in doubles and doubles per game, third in total bases, sixth in hits and her .873 slugging percentage was sixth-best.

**Kristin Worley** joined her teammate Gilham on the first team, while California Baptist was the only other team to have multiple players on the first team. Two freshmen Lancers made their debut on the first team in outfielder **Caitlyn Lloyd** and pitcher **Ciara Lloyd**.

Second baseman **Nicki Sprague** (Azusa Pacific) and outfielder **Janessa Bassett** (Dixie State) also represented the PacWest on the first team.

Four other players joined Campbell in representing the GNAC in pitcher **Anna Kasner** from Western Washington, shortstop **Kelsie Gardner** from Western Oregon, outfielder **Meghan Luebbert** from Concordia University of Portland and **Megan Dettling**, Montana State-Billings' designated player.

Rounding out the 14 first team members were three California Collegiate Athletic Association members: Cal State San Bernardino's catcher **Jessica Brown**, Cal State Monterey Bay's third baseman **Julia Garcia** and Humboldt State's utility-pitcher **Kalyn Paque**.

All of the 14 first teamers will now be placed on the national ballot for All-American recognition to be announced later this month.

The Division II Conference Commissioners Association encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of higher education. The CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact Division II intercollegiate athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.
