**Seattle Pacific's Makena Rietz Named 2021 D2CCA All-West Region Women's Soccer Player of the Year**

*Hawaii Hilo, Point Loma, and Western Washington lead region with four all-region selections*

SAN FRANCISCO – Seattle Pacific senior midfielder Makena Rietz has been named the 2021 Division 2 Conference Commissioners Association Women's Soccer West Region Player of the Year.

A total of 11 institutions had at least one student-athlete named to the 13-member first team. Due to a tie in voting, five forwards were selected for the second team. Hawaii Hilo, Point Loma, and Western Washington all had four selections.

Chico State, Seattle Pacific, and Sonoma State all earned three selections. Azusa Pacific claimed two spots while Cal State LA, Northwest Nazarene, and Stanislaus State each saw one student-athlete named to the team.

The D2 CCA Player of the Year award and all-region teams are nominated and selected by the region's sports information directors.

The D2 CCA encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of high education. The D2 CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact NCAA Division II athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.

The 13 members of the All-West Region first team will now be placed on the national ballot for All-America consideration. The All-America teams will be released Wednesday, Dec. 7. The complete All-West region teams follow.
