

2016 D2CCA Women's Soccer All-West Region Teams Announced

UCSD's O'Laughlin named West Region Player of the Year

SAN RAFAEL, Calif. — Thirteen different institutions were represented on the 2016 Division 2 Conference Commissioners Association Women's Soccer All-West Region Teams, led by seven selections for No. 9 nationally-ranked UC San Diego, including junior forward Katie O'Laughlin, named West Region Player of the Year.

O'Laughlin was the CCAA Offensive Player of the Year and All-CCAA First Team. She is the CCAA and West Region scoring champion with 16 goals and 41 points. The junior forward is 14th in points per game (1.95), 17th in goals per game (.76), and seventh in game-winners (6).

O'Laughlin, Meghan Berry, and Mary Reilly — all Second Team selections in 2015 — were named to the First Team in 2016. They were joined by Kiera Bocchino, Makenzie Brito, Itzel Gonzalez and repeat First Team selection Jordyn McNutt.

No. 1 nationally-ranked Western Washington had five selections, including first teamers Caitlyn Jobanek, Sierra Shugarts, and Emily Webster. Forward Gabriela Pelogi and goalkeeper Ashley Homer were named to the Second Team.

WWU (20-0-1) and UCSD (19-2-) will face off in the NCAA Division II women's soccer quarterfinal match on Nov. 20.

Central Washington had three selection to the team while Azusa Pacific and Notre Dame de Namur both had two selections. BYU-Hawaii, California Baptist, Dixie State, Dominican, Point Loma, Seattle Pacific, Simon Fraser, and Sonoma State all had one student-athlete honored.

The 13 first team members now advance to the national ballot, which will be announced Wednesday, Nov. 30.

The Division 2 Conference Commissioners Association encourages and promotes Division II athletics and high standards of sportsmanship as important elements of higher education. The CCA is a key communications link among the conferences as they discuss views, policies and regulations that impact Division II intercollegiate athletics and works closely with the NCAA as a communications channel to NCAA Division II member colleges and universities.
