on Sunday.

- Sophomore **Ben Leid** led the Central Washington offense for the week, finishing with a .333 batting average. Leid went 6 for 18 with four RBIs and two runs scored, including a home run and a double. He put together one of his best performances of the week in Tuesday's win, going 1 for 4 with a three-run homer in the first inning.
- Seven Central Washington pitchers toed the rubber for the Wildcats on Tuesday, with sophomore **Zach Connors** earning the win after throwing three innings as the starter. Connors allowed just one hit while striking out four batters in 42 pitches for his first win of the season.
