CENTRAL WASHINGTON

- Central Washington earned the first series sweep for a GNAC team this season by going 4-0 against Montana State Billings at home. The Wildcats won Friday's games 9-7 and 4-3 before completing the sweep with 9-8 and 9-4 victories on Saturday.
- Junior **Austin Ohland** was named both the GNAC and NCBWA Division II West Region Player of the Week after leading Central Washington's offense. Ohland finished the week with multi-hit efforts in every game and a .471 batting average. He went 8 for 17 with seven RBIs and six runs scored with a home run and three doubles. He put together one of his best performances of the series in the Friday's 9-7 win where he went 2 for 5 with four RBIs on a single and a three-run homer in the sixth inning.
- Sophomore Jonathan Garza II earned his first win on the mound of the season in Saturday's 9-8 victory. Garza threw five innings in relief for the Wildcats and allowed just one run on three hits against the top offense in the GNAC while striking out six batters.
