CENTRAL WASHINGTON

- Central Washington had the week off from conference competition last week. The Wildcats hosted the final nonconference game of their regular season on Wednesday, taking a 7-5 win over Lewis-Clark State.
- Sophomore **Ben Leid** led the way for the offense in the win, going 3 for 5 with a pair of RBIs. Leid was one of five CWU players to hit for extra bases in the game with an RBI double in the fourth inning.
- Sophomore **Gabe Bustamante** picked up the win on the mound for Central Washington, throwing two innings and allowing two runs, one earned, on five hits. Fellow sophomore **Aaron Robertson** earned the save, throwing two innings and giving up just two hits.
