#HowSweepItIs Western Washington swept this week's Player of the Week honors as forward **Dayana Diaz** and goalkeeper **Natalie Dierickx** received the weekly award. The sweep was the team's first since a pair of Vikings were named as Players of the Week to open the 2017 season.

#SecondSeason Conference play provided a fresh start for all nine teams, but two of them (Concordia and Seattle Pacific) still have perfect records intact through two weeks of GNAC action.

#AlexTheGreat Western Oregon keeper **Alex Qualls** has made an impressive 31 saves through eight matches this season. That number has the junior ranked first in saves throughout the GNAC.

The freshman scored both game-winners for the Vikings last week as Western Washington improved to 6-2-0 overall. Diaz netted what became the game-winner in the 75th minute on a penalty kick as the Vikings beat No. 7 Colorado Mines, 2-1, on Wednesday. Diaz then tallied the match's only goal unassisted in the 82nd minute in a 1-0 win over Simon Fraser on Saturday.

DEFENSE

Natalie Dierickx, Western Washington

Dierickx made nine saves as Western Washington scored two victories. Dierickx made six saves and did not allow a goal until the 83rd minute in the Vikings 2-1 victory over No. 7 Colorado Mines. She then posted her second shut-out of the season in Saturday's 1-0 win over Simon Fraser, making three saves.

Around The GNAC

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- Northwest Nazarene finished the fourth week of competition with a pair of losses, the team's only defeats to date.
- After seeing their best start in school history through six matches, the Nighthawks found themselves on the wrong end of a pair of 1-0 scorelines.
- In the most anticipated match of the week, No. 10 Concordia came into Nampa and topped NNU with a 26th minute goal. The home team received a few good looks at evening the match late but was unable to find the back of the net.
- Midfielder **Madi Taylor** leads Northwest Nazarene with 11 points in eight matches. The senior has tallied a team-high five goals.
- The club closes out the month of September this week with a pair of road tests. First up is a trip to Montana State Billings on Thursday afternoon, followed by a date with Seattle Pacific on Saturday.

SAINT MARTIN'S



- Saint Martin's fell in its lone match of the week, a 4-0 decision against Seattle Pacific.
- The Saints now sit at 4-3-0 overall. Their non-conference record of 4-1-0 was a program best for a mark heading into conference play.
- Midfielder **Kiersten Madsen** leads SMU through seven matches. The sophomore has tallied 12 points with five goals thus far.
- Saint Martin's 4.43 saves per match leads the GNAC in that category. Goalkeepers **Ali Koehler** and **Sara Christensen** have combined to make 31 saves this year.
- The Saints will stay home for two matches this week, starting Thursday against No. 17 Western Washington at 3:30 p.m.

SEATTLE PACIFIC



- Seattle Pacific finished its first week of conference action with a perfect 2-0 record on the road against GNAC opponents.
- Both victories were shutouts, with the highlight coming in a 4-0 win in Lacey against Saint Martin's. Forward **Sophia Chilczuk** recorded the match's first two goals for the Falcons.
- In the latest edition of the United Soccer Coaches Division II Coaches West Region Poll, SPU comes in ranked No. 6.
- Chilczuk leads the team in goals (6) while sophomore **Megan Moore** has paced the club in assists (5). Those two lead the Falcons in points, with senior **Kasey Reeve** following closely behind at five.
- Seattle Pacific returns home now, hosting Simon Fraser and Northwest Nazarene to end the month of September.

SIMON FRASER



- Simon Fraser went 0-1 last week, dropping a tight 1-0 decision on the road against a top-20 Western Washington club.
- Goalkeeper **Nicole Anderson** and a strong Clan defense kept a potent Vikings attack at bay for most of the match, but WWU eventually broke through for the game-winning goal in the match's 82nd minute.
- Senior **Jenna-lee Baxter** leads the team with 12 points after six matches, while forward **Emma Pringle** tops the club in goals (5).
- The Clan return to the pitch for a pair of matches this week, starting on Thursday at Seattle Pacific before hosting Central Washington on Saturday.

WESTERN OREGON



- Western Oregon posted a 2-0 mark in its fourth week of action. The Wolves worked a pair of 1-0 victories, first against Montana State Billings and then on the road against Northwest Nazarene.
- The biggest win came against the Nighthawks, who entered the week undefeated. A second minute goal from sophomore **Alexie Morris** would ultimately hold up in the 1-0 win.
- Morris' six points is tied for first on the club with forward **Alyssa Tomasini**.
- A pair of matches are on tap for Western Oregon this week, starting in Ellensburg against Central Washington on Thursday. The club will then return home for a showdown with No. 17 Western Washington Saturday morning.

WESTERN WASHINGTON



- Western Washington finished the fourth week of play with a 2-0 record.
- The highlight came in the team's non-conference finale, as the Vikings welcomed No. 7 Colorado Mines to Bellingham and sent the Orediggers packing with a 2-1 defeat. Forwards **Gabriella Pelogi** and **Dayana Diaz** tallied the team's pair of goals.
- Diaz received GNAC Offensive Player of the Week honors, while WWU goalkeeper **Natalie Dierickx** was the conference's Defensive Player of the Week. Dierickx is second in the conference with saves (30) and is just one behind the league leader (Alex Qualls, Western Oregon).
- In the latest edition of the United Soccer Coaches Division II Coaches Poll, Western Washington comes in ranked at No. 17 (and No. 3 in the West Region).
- The Vikings will hit the road this week, facing Saint Martin's in Lacey on Thursday afternoon and Western Oregon in Monmouth on Saturday.

Around The GNAC

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



- Central Washington lost its only match last week, dropping its home GNAC opener to Seattle Pacific.
- The Wildcats remained level with the Falcons for 17 minutes before the visitors from Seattle ultimately broke through. Seattle Pacific ultimately prevailed for a 2-0 victory.
- The team currently ranks third in the GNAC in saves per match at 4.14, just a few points behind first-place Saint Martin's (4.43). Goalkeepers **Emily Thomson** and **Kelsey Bechtholdt** have combined to make 28 saves this season.
- The Wildcats will face both Western Oregon and Simon Fraser this week.



CONCORDIA

- Concordia finished its second week of conference with another impressive showing, going 2-0 in a pair of matches to remain unbeaten on the season.
- The highlight was a 1-0 road victory against a previously-undefeated Northwest Nazarene team on Thursday afternoon. It was forward **Alaina Edgerly** who netted the winning-goal, taking advantage of a scramble in the box before catching the keeper out of position in the match's 26th minute.
- In the latest edition of the United Soccer Coaches Division II Coaches Poll, Concordia comes in ranked at No. 10. The Cavaliers are slotted second in the West Region Poll.
- The Cavaliers will return to the pitch for a single match this week, traveling to Lacey on Saturday to face Saint Martin's. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. in that one.

MONTANA STATE BILLINGS



- Montana State Billings went 0-2 last week, suffering a pair of road defeats against Western Oregon and Concordia on its Oregon swing.
- The Yellowjackets best shot at a win came against the Wolves, where they were level for 89 minutes before a 90th minute goal did the team in. The team was unable to find an equalizer in the final seconds, allowing Western Oregon to escape with the 1-0 victory.
- Montana State Billings recorded positive results in four of its first five matches before its recent slide. Its last win came on Sept. 11, rallying from a three-goal deficit to top Providence (Mont.) on the road in a 4-3 decision.
- The Yellowjackets return to the field on Thursday afternoon in Billings. They will take on Northwest Nazarene in a 1 p.m. kickoff.
