#### **ALASKA**

- Jordan Wilson scored 30 points in each game and at the Al Kaly Shrine Classic, made 23 of 34 field goals to earn GNAC Player of the Week.
- **Jaylee Mays** has come off the bench in each of the four games to score a total of 71 points, including 48 from beyond the arc, making 16 of 25 such shots.
- Kaillee Skjold is averaging a double-double with 56 points and 42 rebounds in four games.

#### **ALASKA ANCHORAGE**



- The Seawolves played Post twice in a row and won both games by large margins. Alaska Anchorage has won all of its games by an average of 39 points, which is the fourth highest in Division II.

- Seattle Pacific is outrebounding its opponents by 12.2 rebounds per game, which is the 22nd-best rebounding margin in Division II.
- Courtney Hollander leads the Falcons in points with 66. She also has a teambest 42 rebounds to go along with seven assists, five steals and two blocks.
- Brianne Lasconia is 9 for 22 from beyond the arc this season, coming off the bench in each game for SPU.
