GNAC Women's Basketball Championships Preview

LACEY, Wash. – Following an 11th-hour scramble for qualification into the 2016-17 GNAC Women's Basketball Championships, the conference's top six teams travel to Lacey to battle for the conference championship, starting on Thursday, March 2 in the Marcus Pavilion on the campus of Saint Martin's University.

Alaska Anchorage, Western Washington and Simon Fraser have been the top three teams in the conference standings all season, while Northwest Nazarene, Seattle Pacific and Central Washington booked their tickets to the tournament on the final day of the regular season. Alaska Anchorage will be looking to win an unprecedented third consecutive GNAC Championship.

Alaska Anchorage, the No. 2 ranked team in both national polls, earned the top seed after beating two nationally-ranked opponents on the final weekend of the regular season. The Seawolves, 27-1 overall, completed the first 20-0 conference season and were the fifth team in GNAC women's basketball history to finish undefeated. In fact, the Seawolves are undefeated against all NCAA Division II competition, thanks in large part to senior transfer **Autummn Williams**, who is 23 field goals away from the GNAC single-season record. Williams enters the tournament tied for second in the GNAC and is among the top-10 in Division II in scoring, averaging 21.1 points per game.

Senior **Kiki Robertson** was the GNAC Championships Most Valuable Player in each of the last two seasons. The guard has played an enhanced role this season, starting all 28 games and averaging 8.7 points per game. She ranks among the league leaders in assists at 5.5 per game. The Seawolves are well-rounded, leading the GNAC in both scoring offense (82.8 points per game) and scoring defense (52.8 points allowed per game).

Western Washington is the tournament's No. 2 seed after finishing with an 18-2 GNAC record, 24-4 overall. The Vikings had a 17-game winning streak that spanned nearly three months in the middle of the season. That included an 84-72 win against Simon Fraser in which Division II's leading scorer, **Taylor Peacocke**, tallied 41 points. The streak ended last weekend in a double overtime loss to Alaska Anchorage, which was the only GNAC team to defeat the Vikings all year. Peacocke is averaging 23.1 points per game and, at 1.841 points, is 105 points away from the GNAC career scoring record.

Seniors **Tia Briggs** and **Kiana Gandy** give Western Washington three double-digit scorers, averaging 12.9 points and 12.5 points per game respectively. Briggs is the Vikings' leading rebounder at 6.5 boards per game. Western Washington is the conference's most accurate shooting team, leading in field-goal percentage (.457), 3-point percentage (.370) and free-throw percentage (.808).

Simon Fraser locked up the No. 3 seed with nearly two weeks left in the season. In the first round, the Clan will face Central Washington, which is the only lower-seeded team to have beaten SFU in the regular season. At 24-6 overall and 15-5 in conference play, the Clan is one win away from equaling its program record of 26 wins in a season since joining the NCAA.



The Clan is led by a pair of dynamic scorers in seniors **Ellen Kett** and **Meg Wilson**. Kett, who averages 12.1 points per game, has already smashed the GNAC's single-season assists record with 234 and set a conference single-game record with 20 assists against Montana State Billings on Feb. 18. Wilson has been one of the primary beneficiaries with 14.7 points per game this year.

The No. 4 and No. 5 seeds, Northwest Nazarene and Seattle Pacific, split their games during the regular season and finished with identical 10-10 conference records. The two teams will meet again in the championships quarterfinals. The Falcons, 18-10 overall, started the year on an 11-game winning streak with impressive wins against last year's West Region runner-up UC San Diego, West Region No. 1 seed Azusa Pacific and South

Region semifinalist Nova Southeastern. The Crusaders, however, put an end to that winning streak on New Year's Eve with a 73-66 victory.

It was the first time all year that any team had reached 70 points in a game against Seattle Pacific, and that productive offense characterized Northwest Nazarene all season, averaging 77.9 points per game. The Crusaders, 12-14 overall, spread the wealth offensively evenly all season. There were only six games in which a single player reached the 20-point mark and no single player ever scored more than 25. **Kaitlyn Merritt** selflessly facilitates that offense with a team-best 83 assists and just 2.2 points per game in a team-high 26.2 minutes per game. Northwest Nazarene leads the GNAC with 38.2 rebounds per game, led by 5.2 rebounds per game from junior **Lexi Tubbs**.

The Seattle Pacific defense made the necessary adjustments in the second meeting, holding NNU to a season low 63 points for a 68-63 victory. The Falcons were ranked No. 9 in the NCAA Regional Rankings going into the final week of the regular season and will be looking to add to their resume for a chance to be one of the eight teams to compete in the NCAA West Region tournament. The Falcons are among the top defensive teams in the league, limiting opponents to 59.4 points per game while ranking third in the GNAC in both field goal defense (.389) and three-point defense (.301).

Junior **Courtney Hollander** is the Falcons leading scorer and rebounder with 12.2 points and 7.1 rebounds per game, but has battled through injuries through the second half of the season. Junior **Jordan McPhee** is averaging 11 points per game.

Central Washington, the No. 6 seed in the championships, put together an incredible run to get into the tournament on a tiebreaker. The run started when, at 3-10 in conference play, the Wildcats upset Simon Fraser with a 73-66 overtime victory in Burnaby, B.C. The Wildcats went on to win six of their last seven games, including another overtime win against Northwest Nazarene, to erase a four-game deficit to Alaska and clinch a berth into the tournament for a third consecutive season.

The Wildcats boast the GNAC's leading rebounder in junior Taylor Baird, who averages 8.6 rebounds per game while also leading the team in scoring at 13.1 points per game. Senior Jasmin Edwards is averaging 10.6 points per game while also distributing 141 assists.

GNAC Women's Basketball Player of the Week

Hanson closed out her collegiate career with 53 points and 14 rebounds in the Yellowjackets' final two games, shooting 61.3 percent from the floor and 17 of 18 from the free throw line. She finished with a double-double of 28 points and 11 rebounds in Thursday's contest with Central Washington, going 12 of 20 from the field. Hanson finished the

season with 25 points against Northwest Nazarene, which included a 14 of 15 performance from the free throw line. Hanson finished with a .867 career free throw percentage, a MSUB record and No. 4 in GNAC history.

Around The GNAC

ALASKA ANCHORAGE



- The Seawolves wrapped up the regular season with an undefeated record against NCAA Division II opponents, including the first 20-0 season in GNAC-play in conference history.
- Alaska Anchorage defeated No. 16 Western Washington in double overtime, 75-72, to clinch the GNAC regular season

title. The Seawolves then completed the perfect regular season with a 77-72 win against No. 21 Simon Fraser on Saturday.

- It is the fifth perfect season in GNAC women's basketball history and the first since switching to the 20-game format when Concordia joined the conference in 2015.
- Alaska Anchorage is ranked No. 2 in both the WBCA Coaches Poll and the D2SIDA Media Poll. In the second NCAA Regional Rankings, the Seawolves remained the No. 1 team in the West Region. The No. 1 team at the end of the season will host the regional tournament.
- The Seawolves will play the winner of Seattle Pacific and Northwest Nazarene in the semifinals on the GNAC Championships on Friday at 2:15 p.m. in Lacey, Wash.
- Alaska Anchorage leads NCAA Division II in steals per game with 16.1 and ranks third in scoring defense with 52.8 points allowed per game.
- Autummn Williams is averaging 21.1 points per game, which ranks sixth Division II and second in the GNAC. She also ranks second in the GNAC in steals with 2.6 and second in field-goal percentage at 51.1 percent.
- Kiki Robertson averages 3.4 steals per game, which ranks sixth in Division II. She also ranks 21st in assists this season with 5.5 per game.
- Alaska Anchorage is the only team to have beaten both Western Washington and Simon Fraser this season and the Seawolves did so twice. Central Washington is the only other GNAC team to have recorded a single win against either team.
- The Seawolves are riding a program-record 23-game winning streak into the GNAC Championships where they are looking for a third consecutive conference tournament championship.

CENTRAL WASHINGTON



- Central Washington wrapped up the regular season winning six of its last seven games to erase a four-game deficit in the standings with Alaska and secure a berth into the GNAC Championships for a third consecutive year.
- The Wildcats had to win all six games to force a tie with Alaska and they won the tiebreaker thanks to the overtime

win against Simon Fraser that started the run of six wins in seven games.

- In the first round, Central Washington will play none other than Simon Fraser.
 That game will tip off at noon on Thursday.
- Central Washington also needed overtime to defeat Northwest Nazarene on Tuesday to stay alive in the playoff hunt. **Kortney Grattic** hit a 3-pointer with six seconds left in regulation to send the game into overtime, where the Wildcats outscored the Crusaders 16-8 to secure the must-win game.
- **Taylor Baird** recorded her second consecutive double-double in the win against NNU with 26 points and 12 rebounds. She now averages a team-best 13.1 points and a GNAC-best 8.6 rebounds per game.
- Jasmin Edwards also had a double-double with 19 points and 10 assists. She now has 415 career assists, which ranks eighth in GNAC history. She will finish her career with 287 assists in GNAC games, which ranks fifth in GNAC history.
- On Thursday, Kaelie Flores scored a team-high 15 points off the bench to lead the Wildcats to a defensive 59-48 win against Montana State Billings. The Wildcats held all players not named Tiana Hanson to a combined 20 points all game.
- The Wildcats didn't play on Saturday and only could wait and find out if they were going to the GNAC Championships. After Seattle Pacific beat Western Oregon and Alaska lost to Western Washington, Central Washington clinched the No. 6 seed.
- Central Washington and Simon Fraser split results during the regular season with both teams winning on the road. The Wildcats won the more recent encounter, beating Simon Fraser in overtime. The Clan enters the tournament having won four of its last seven games, compared to six of the last seven for the Wildcats.

Around The GNAC

NORTHWEST NAZARENE



- The Crusaders defeated Montana State Billings on the final day of the regular season to secure the No. 4 seed at the GNAC Championships.
- The Crusaders will play Seattle Pacific in the first round. The game will tip off at 2:15 p.m. on Thursday afternoon in Lacey, Wash.
- The Falcons and Crusaders split their regular season meetings with both teams winning on the road. The Crusaders won the first meeting, ending Seattle Pacific's undefeated run to start the season.
- Northwest Nazarene was held to a season-low 63 points in the regular-season finale, but also held Montana State Billings to just 53 points, which was a season-best defensive effort for NNU. It was the first time NNU had held any team under 60 points.
- The Crusaders rank second in the conference in scoring with 77.9 points per game, but also rank in last place in scoring defense.
- Ellie Logan was the team's regular season leading scorer with 12.5 points per game. Lexi Tubbs added 10.5 points per game and a team-high 5.2 rebounds.
- Despite having one of the conference's most productive offenses, no individual has scored more than 25 points in any single game and the team has only six 20-point individual performances a sign of even distribution offensively.
- Kaitlyn Merritt has been the primary distributer offensively with a team-best 83 assists and just 31 turnovers.

SIMON FRASER



- With the No. 3 seed already set in stone, Simon Fraser earned a split on the final week of the regular season, beating Alaska before falling to Alaska Anchorage in the regular season finale.
- Simon Fraser is ranked No. 22 in the D2SIDA Media Poll and is receiving votes in the WBCA Coaches Poll. In the

NCAA Regional Rankings, Simon Fraser was No. 4 in the West Region on Wednesday.

- The Clan will play against Central Washington in the first round in a game scheduled to tip off at noon on Thursday at Saint Martin's University. The winner will face Western Washington in the semifinals.
- Central Washington and Simon Fraser split their regular-season meetings with each team winning on the road. The Clan won the first meeting, 77-60.
- Ellen Kett broke the GNAC's single season records for assists, assists in conference games, assists per conference game and is on pace to break the record for single season assists per game, a category in which she leads Division II.
- Meg Wilson has a team-best 441 points, 161 rebounds, and 70 steals. She has led the team in scoring in five of the last seven games.
- The Clan ranks second in the GNAC in assists per game (17.4), assist-turnover ratio (1.12) and turnover margin (3.9).

SEATTLE PACIFIC



- Seattle Pacific snapped its losing streak just in time in the regular season finale to defeat Western Oregon and clinch the No. 5 seed in the GNAC Championships.
- Seattle Pacific was ranked No. 9 in the first NCAA Regional Rankings prior to splitting the games last week against Concordia and Western Oregon. The top eight teams in the West Region advance to the postseason.
- Seattle Pacific will play against Northwest Nazarene on Thursday at 2:15 p.m. in Lacey, Wash. The two teams split the season series with each team winning on the road.
- The Falcons have played six games against nationally-ranked teams this season as well as UC San Diego, which is receiving votes.
- Seattle Pacific was without leading rebounder and scorer **Courtney Hollander** during the final two weeks of the regular season. Hollander averages 12.2 points and 7.1 rebounds per game this year.
- Carly Rataushk scored 12 points off the bench, pacing the Falcons to a 70-60 win over Western Oregon. She also had a team-best 15 points in the previous game against Concordia. Those 27 points in the last two games accounted for more than a quarter of her points all year. She has not missed from beyond the arc all year, going 4 for 4.
- Seattle Pacific ranks second in the conference in scoring defense with just 59.4 points allowed per game. The Falcons are 18-1 when holding opponents to to 68 points or less this season. The only loss came at Alaska, where the Falcons lost on the final possession 63-61.
- Jordan McPhee leads the team defensively with 10 blocks and 48 steals. She also has 85 defensive rebounds, which ranks second on the team.

WESTERN WASHINGTON



- Western Washington had its winning streak snapped in a nail-biting double-overtime loss to No. 2 Alaska Anchorage on Thursday. The Vikings quickly rebounded to defeat Alaska two days later.
- The Vikings are ranked No. 17 in the WBCA Coaches Poll and No. 13 in the D2SIDA Media Poll. They are also ranked No. 3 in the NCAA Regional Rankings, which help determine which eight teams advance to the regional tournament.
- Western Washington is the No. 2 seed at the GNAC Championships and will play the winner between Simon Fraser and Central Washington. The Vikings swept both Simon Fraser and Central Washington during the regular season.
- The Vikings won 18 of their last 19 games with the only loss being the doubleovertime defeat to undefeated Alaska Anchorage.
- Tia Briggs leads the team in rebounding with 6.5 per game. She has been
 the team-leader in rebounds in 11 games this season, topping out at 13 against
 Angelo State. She also had 18 points in that game against the No. 20-ranked
 Rams.
- Taylor Peacocke remained Division II's leading scorer with 23.1 points per game. She broke the GNAC record for points in a single season in conference games with 468. She needs just 46 points to become the GNAC's single-season record holder for points in all games.
- Peacocke can also break the GNAC's all-time career scoring record. She is just 105 points away from the record of 1946 career points set by Erin Chambers from Simon Fraser in 2015.
- The Vikings fell at the semifinals of last year's GNAC Championships, losing to Montana State Billings.
