RED LION PLAYER-OF-THE-WEEK: GNAC Player - Fernando Robles, Northwest Nazarene (2B, 6-1, 180, Sr., Caldwell, ID) had eight hits in 16 at bats, including a double and a grand slam home run, as the Crusaders won three of four games with Holy Names. His slam came during a six-run fifth in Saturday's 9-5 win as NNU overcame a 1-0 deficit. He also picked up a win on the mound allowing just two hits and one earned run in 4 2/3 innings in Saturday's 6-4 victory. **Pitcher** – Spenser Watkins, Western Oregon (P, 6-1, Jr., Scottsdale, AZ -Horizon), a transfer from Glendale Community College in Arizona, pitched seven scoreless innings allowing six hits in his GNAC debut. Watkins walked two and struck out five in combining with Spencer Trautman for a 4-0 shutout of Cal State Stanislaus Saturday.

HONORABLE MENTION: Chris Bradshaw, Western Oregon; Travis Shaw, Saint Martin; Brendan Jeffers, Saint Martin's ... Bradshaw had four hits in 12 at bats as the Wolves won two of three games at Turlock, Calif. ... Shaw had six hits in 13 at bats, including three doubles, against Cal Poly Pomona. Jeffers allowed just two runs in six innings in a 4-0 loss.

AROUND THE GNAC: Western Oregon hit just .229 in its three-game series with Cal State Stanislaus, but got solid pitching, allowing just 10 runs in winning two of three games. Catcher David Scott led the offense with five hits ... Central Washington led 4-2 in its 5-4 loss to Cal State East Bay before the Pioneers scored a run in the eighth and two in the ninth to ruin the Wildcats' season debut Sunday ... Outfielder Logan Parker had eight hits in 17 at bats, including three doubles leading NNU to a 3-1 series win ... Travis Shaw led Saint Martin's with six hits, including three doubles in its four-game series at Cal Poly Pomona.
