AROUND THE GNAC

CWU: After a week off, Central Washington returns to the diamond this weekend for six games in four days. The Wildcats will take on the Academy of Art in a 4-game set running Friday through Sunday, and will make up a pair of games against San Francisco State on Monday that were rained out earlier in February.

MSUB: The Yellowjackets kick off their 2014 campaign in Lewiston, Idaho, against No. 2-ranked Lewis-Clark State of the NAIA. The teams are set for a 4-game series beginning Friday and wrapping up Sunday.

NNU: Northwest Nazarene kicked off its 2014 season in Hawaii last week, falling twice in extra innings and losing five games total on the road trip. Ryan Johnson was the Crusaders' top batter in the season-opening series, posting a line of 7-for-20 with two doubles, a triple and three RBI. Anthony Flatt came through with a pair of doubles and drove in four runs for the Crusaders, and Nick Morelli finished the weekend with a line of 6-for-13 with one double, one run scored and a pair of RBI.

On the mound, Andrew Groves logged four shutout innings of relief, while striking out four and allowing just two base hits. Groves earned Red Lion Pitcher of the Week honors for his effort. NNU ace Aaron Vaughn took the loss in his only start of the week, as he allowed seven hits and struck out six against just one walk in five innings. Vaughn allowed six runs in the Crusaders' 6-5 defeat, but only one was earned as NNU was hampered by three costly errors. Colben McGuire took the hill in NNU's season opener and struck out six over 5 1/3 while allowing four hits and three earned runs in the no-decision.

NNU remains on the road this week with a 4-game tilt against CSU Dominguez Hills beginning Thursday. The Crusaders will then make their home debut the following week with four games against Hawaii-Hilo running Feb. 24-25.

SMU: Foul skies sunk the Saints' hopes of opening their 2014 season last weekend, as SMU's 3-game set against Puget Sound was washed out. Saint Martin's is in California this week, challenging Cal Baptist in a game per day Wednesday through Saturday.

WOU: Western Oregon didn't fare much better than Saint Martin's in terms of weather last week, although the Wolves completed two of their scheduled five games against Sonoma State in Rohnert Park, Calif. WOU battled SSU in Game 1 on Wednesday, but gave up two runs in the fifth and four in the seventh in an eventual 7-1 loss. Game 2 was a different story however, as WOU got ahead 1-0 in the first inning and outpaced SSU over the 7-inning contest to earn the split with a 5-3 victory.

Reliever Kody Stone earned his third save of the season, and moved into sole possession of second place in the GNAC record books for career saves with 16.

The doubleheader scheduled between the teams on Thursday and the single game Friday were rained out. WOU challenges reigning NCAA Division III National Champion Linfield this weekend with a doubleheader in McMinnville, Ore., set for Sunday at noon. The first game was originally scheduled to be played on Saturday in Monmouth, but due to a poor weather forecast the teams will test their luck on Linfield's all-turf infield facility in hopes of completing the twin bill.
