Loomis threw the fifth no-hitter in NNU and GNAC history against Azusa Pacific. He was named the GNAC and NCBWA Pitcher of the Week.

#Slugfest In three games, Saint Martin's and Minot State combined for 86 runs. The Saints took two out of three games in the series, led by **Zach Raczok's** Player of the Week performance.

#OutComeTheBrooms Montana State Billings swept Metro State in a four-game series, outscoring their opponents 32-15. The Yellowjackets moved into first place with a 6-3 overall record.

#SeeYouInMarch Western Oregon and Montana State Billings played their final non-conference games before GNAC play begins in March. They are the only two teams ranked or receiving votes in the NCBWA West Region Poll.



Raczok went 7 for 13 with three runs, 10 RBI and two home runs as the Saints split their games against Minot State and Dixie State. He went 3 for 4 with two RBI in Friday's 14-9 win over Minot State and went 3 for 5 with six RBI, a double and a grand slam in a 17-12 Saturday win over Minot State.

Loomis threw the fifth no-hitter in GNAC history and the fifth in Northwest Nazarene history (the first in 13 years), beating Azusa Pacific on Friday night 4-0. In seven innings, Loomis allowed four walks and struck out seven and faced five batters above the minimum.

Around The GNAC

NO-NO NO.5: Northwest Nazarene starting pitcher **Colton Loomis**



threw the fifth no hitter in GNAC history on Friday, shutting down Azusa Pacific 4-0. The performance was also the fifth no-hitter in Crusader history as the senior earned his second GNAC Pitcher of the Week honors of the season. He was also selected as the

National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week thanks to the no-no. In the game, Loomis shut down the Cougars for seven innings, striking out seven batters with four walks. He advanced his overall record to 2-1 on the season.

The Crusaders finished the series with a split at Azusa Pacific, earning two wins on Friday while falling once each on Thursday and Saturday. They fell in game one of the series 3-2 in 10 innings. **Ross Clevenger** threw 6 2/3 innings, allowing just two runs on six hits with five strikeouts and three walks. Second baseman **Tyler Davis** hit his first home run of the season in the loss. In game two, the Crusaders bounced back with a 7-6 win. Davis smacked two more home runs, scoring three runs with two runs batted in. Outfielder **Ryan Johnson** hit a two run home run to put the Crusaders on the board first in the second inning. Northwest Nazarene then fell in the final game of the series 6-2.

YELLOWJACKETS BRING OUT FIRST BROOMS: Montana State



Billings traveled to Denver, Colo. to face Metro State, for a four-game series, and returned home with four more wins. The Yellowjackets outscored Metro State 32-15 in the four games as the hitters and pitchers came together for a dominant road series. Pitcher **Tanner Johnson** earned his second win of the season in the opening game,

striking out a career high 11 batters in the 5-2 win. In game two, the Yellowjackets were paced by outfielder **Luke Reinschmidt's** 4 for 4 performance which included two home runs and six RBI.

Montana State Billings was pushed in game three, needing extra innings to come away with the 6-5 victory. Outfielder **Casey Merritt** came through in the top of the eighth inning with an RBI double to score the eventual winning run. The Yellowjackets now own the top overall record in the GNAC at 6-3.

SAINTS SLUG WAY TO TWO WINS VS MINOT STATE: Saint



Martin's took part in a two-way slugfest against Minot State, where the two teams combined for 86 runs in just three games. Despite giving up 47 runs, the Saints

came away with two victories.

In game one, **Brandon Witherspoon** and **Shayne Kurihara** each hit home runs to lead the Saints to a 14-9 victory. Kurihara led the team with five RBI while catcher **Zach Raczk** was 3 for 4 with two RBI and a run scored. The Saints lone loss came in a tough game in which they could not shut the floodgates, falling 26-8. The Saint

Martin's defense made six errors while the team allowed 13 runs in the fourth inning. The pitching and defense had another tough outing in game three, but the offense lifted them up to a 17-12 victory. Third baseman **Adam Eskil** went 3 for 4 with three runs scored and four RBI while Raczk finished 3 for 5 with six RBI and a home run. The overall week's performance for Raczk earned him the GNAC's Player of the Week award.

WOLVES REMAIN OFF UNTIL CONFERENCE PLAY: Western



Oregon began its non-conference slate of games early this year and will be the first to end after wrapping up a four-game series against Cal State East Bay. The Wolves do not play again until the beginning of conference

play, a four-game series at Concordia on Sat., Mar. 5.

Western Oregon leaned heavily on its pitching in the series split against CSUEB, allowing a combined six runs in the first three games before giving up seven in the series finale. Starting pitchers **Garrett Alvarez** and **Darrien Moran** earned the wins for the Wolves, while fellow starting pitcher **Brady Miller** threw six innings with just two runs allowed in a no-decision.

The Wolves remain the lone GNAC team ranked in the NCBWA West Region Poll, dropping down to 10th after the week off. Montana State Billings is among those receiving votes with two.

TOP PERFORMERS: Saint Martin's pitcher **Aaron Shoup** was one of the lone Saints to not get hit hard on the mound. The freshman pitched five innings of relief in the team's 17-12 victory over Minot State, allowing just one run with seven strike outs. He earned his first career win in the outing... Northwest Nazarene second baseman **Tyler Davis** finished 5 for 16 at the plate with three home runs and four RBI in the team's four game series split at Azusa Pacific. He now leads the GNAC with three home runs on the season... Montana State Billings pitcher **Lee Busto** came out of the bullpen in all four games last week, not allowing a single run. He struck out two batters and allowed just one hit. The Yellowjackets' **Luke Reinschmidt** just missed another Player of the Week award, finishing last week 8 for 13 at the dish with eight RBI, six runs scored and two home runs... Concordia shortstop **Adam Taylor** finished 4 for 11 at the plate in the team's series split against Sonoma State, belting the Cavaliers first home run of the season.

FINAL WEEKEND OF NON-CONFERENCE: Western Oregon remains off this week along with Montana State Billings while the remainder of the GNAC continues non-conference play. Saint Martin's opens up a four-game series at Cal Baptist on Thursday to open the week, Concordia plays three games at Point Loma and Central Washington plays three at Academy of Art. GNAC play opens up the following week with Northwest Nazarene at Saint Martin's, Montana State Billings at Central Washington and Western Oregon at Concordia.
