



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR



#22 Michael Hill RB, 5-11, 205, Sr., St. Joseph, Mo. Central HS Missouri Western State

Hill earned MIAA Offensive Player of the Year and First Team All-MIAA after he rushed for a single season record 1,809 yards averaging 7.4 yards per carry which is also the best rushing average in a season. He found the endzone 14 times on the ground this season and has also added 14 receptions with three touchdowns. Hill is the MWSU all-time leader in rushing yards in a career with 4,610 yards on an MWSU record 862 carries. His 164.5 yards per game is the best by a Griffon in a single season and he has tied the record for most 100-yards rushing games in a career with 18. He has rushed for over 100 yards 10 times this season. His best game of 2012 occurred against Washburn on Nov. 3, 2012, when the senior had 259 yards on 26 carries and three touchdowns and sat out for most of the fourth quarter. Hill led the MIAA in rushing, scoring, touchdowns scored and is second in all-purpose yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

#66 Brandon Williams DL, 6-3, 325, Sr., Kirkwood, Mo. Rockwood Summitt HS Missouri Southern

Williams was an unanimous First Team All-MIAA selection and the MIAA Defensive Player of the Year in 2012. He became the all-time sacks leader for the school

became the all-time sacks leader for the school as he finished with 27. He had at least a 1/2 sack in all but 3 games this year and had a TFL in all but 1 game this year. He finished the season second on the team with 68 tackles, 31 solo, including 16.5 for a loss of 58 yards. He had 8.5 sacks for a loss of 39 yards, two pass break ups, eight quarterback hurries, five forced fumbles and one safety on the season. He finished third in the MIAA in sacks and tackles for a loss, while ranking second in forced fumbles.

Burnsville, Minn. - Missouri Western's Michael Hill was named the NCAA Super Region #3 Offensive Player of the Year while Missouri Southern State's Brandon Williams was selected as the Defensive Player of the Year.

First team all-region honorees are now eligible for Daktronics, Inc. Division II Football All-American selection. The announcement of those All-American teams is expected on December 11th, preceding the NCAA Division II Football Championship, which takes place Dec. 15 in Florence, Ala.

The team is sponsored by Daktronics, Inc., an acknowledged world leader in scoring, timing and programmable display systems for virtually every sport at every level of competition. The team is voted on by the members of the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) from Super Region #3, made up of football playing institutions in the Great American Conference (GAC), the Great Northwest Athletic Conference (GNAC), the Mid-American Intercollegiate Athletics Association (MIAA) and the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC).
