**GNAC RED LION PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** David Downs, Seattle Pacific (G, 6-2, Jr., Kirkland, WA – Bellevue Christian) was named the Most Valuable Player leading the Falcons to the team title in Sodexo Tip Off Classic at Brougham Pavilion. Downs scored 31 points and also had a team-high nine assists as SPU debuted with 20- and 19-point victories. Downs made eight of 14 shots, including four of eight treys. He also led SPU with three steals and had just two turnovers. **Honorable Mention:** Mark McLaughlin, Central Washington; Teancum Stafford, Alaska Anchorage; Sam Johnson, MSU Billings; Anto Olah, Simon Fraser; Eric Taylor, Saint Martin's.

#### TEAM NOTES

**Alaska Anchorage:** Kyle Fossman scored 37 points and also had eight rebounds, four assists and four steals as the Seawolves opened their season with a pair of Division II victories in the UAA AT&T Jamboree. The Seawolves also got 33 points and 10 rebounds from tournament MVP Teancum Stafford and 15 rebounds from Liam Gibcus. Both Fossman and Gibcus joined Stafford on the all-tournament team. UAA's defense held its two opponents to a 34.8 shooting percentage.

**Alaska Fairbanks:** The Nanooks split two contests in the UAA A&T Jamboree, defeating Colorado State Pueblo 80-76 in overtime before losing to Colorado Christian 72-63. Stefan Tica had 23 points and eight rebounds to earn all-tournament honors. Dominique Brinson led the Nanooks with 27 points and Pat Voeut had 24 points. Zach Ngawaka had a team-high 22 rebounds.

**Central Washington:** Central Washington's Mark McLaughlin scored 58 points as the Wildcats split two games at the Sodexo. McLaughlin, who earned all-tournament honors, scored 31 in a 102-99 overtime loss to Azusa Pacific, including 18 in the first half when the Wildcats built a 54-40 lead. McLaughlin made 21 of 39 shots and also had 16 rebounds and four steals. Dom Williams, one of six former Tacoma CC players on the CWU roster, had 26 points, six assists and a team-high six steals.

**Montana State Billings:** Sam Johnson came off the bench to score 19 points and also grabbed a game-high 11 rebounds and Omar McDade had 16 as the Yellowjackets, the defending GNAC champions, cruised to a 39-point home victory over Black Hills State, making 12 of 28 three-pointers. Robby Trabing made five of six shots and also had seven rebounds, five assists and four steals. The latter two were team highs.

**Northwest Nazarene:** UCLA transfer Kenny Jones led the Crusaders with 17 points and four assists in a 15-point win over Portland Bible. The Crusaders also got 14 points each from Keith Moilanen and Jordan Nicholes. Jones also scored 17 points as NNU also beat College of Idaho 63-50 in an exhibition game

**Saint Martin's:** Eric Taylor made 2/3 of his shots (14 of 21) as the Saints opened their season splitting two games with PacWest schools. Taylor, coming off the bench in both games, finished the tournament at Western Oregon with 39 points and four steals. Evan Coulter had 25 points and Roger O'Neill and Rei Jensen, who had 20 rebounds, scored 23 points each.

**Seattle Pacific:** SPU's Jobi Wall joined Downs and McLaughlin on the all-tournament team at SPU scoring 25 points and hauling in nine rebounds. SPU outshot its two opponents by a .472 to .416 margin and outscored them at the foul line 40-13. The Falcons also shot 39.5 percent from the three-point arc and had 18 more rebounds (77-59) and eight fewer turnovers (23-31).

**Simon Fraser:** Australian Anto Olah had 41 points and 31 rebounds including a 23-point, 20 rebound performance Friday as the Clan beat Northwest Indian College twice by scores of 104-52 and 112-78. Olah made 17 of 30 shots. SFU was also led in the two victories by Elijah Matthews with 38 points on near-perfect shooting (15 of 17) and Taylor Dunn with 33. Matthews made eight of nine three-pointers.

**Western Oregon:** Redshirt freshman Andy Avgi scored 31 points and also had 13 rebounds to lead the Wolves in both categories in single-digit home losses to Hawaii Hilo and Chaminade. The 6-4 forward from Woodburn made 17 of 24 shots and had seven offensive rebounds.

**Western Washington:** The defending national champions breezed to a 56-point win over Multnomah Bible in their season debut. Paul Jones led the Vikings to the 100-44 win scoring 18 points on eight of 12 shooting. John Allen scored 17 and Rico Wilkins had 14 points.

**GNAC DRAWS A BLANK AGAINST D-1:** GNAC teams were winless in nine exhibition games with Division I schools. Only two of the games were decided by single digits – Alaska Anchorage's four-point loss to Troy and Seattle Pacific's six-point loss at Idaho. Western Washington lost by just 10 at UW.
