**GNAC RED LION PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Player** – Alexie Levin, Western Washington (1B, 5-7, So., Everett, WA - Everett) had seven hits in 13 at bats, scored four runs and drove in four as the Vikings won three of four games in Hawaii. Among her seven hits was a pair of doubles. **Pitcher** - Jenna DeRosier, Western Washington (P, 5-7, Sr., Kelso, WA) tossed complete-game wins over BYU-Hawaii (5-1) and Hawaii Hilo (6-2) allowing just 10 hits in 14 innings. She walked four and struck out five. **HONORABLE MENTION:** Megan Miller, Saint Martin's (3B, 5-3, So., Everett, WA - Cascade) had eight hits in 15 at bats, including a pair of doubles as the Saints opened their schedule with four games in California.

**AROUND THE GNAC:** Western Washington freshman Aspen Ison made her collegiate debut last Saturday tossing a one-hitter and blanking BYU-Hawaii 6-0. Ison, from Gig Harbor, walked two and fanned four in the contest ... The Vikings outhit their opponents .341 to .212 in their four games. WWU outfielder Autumn Isaacson stole six bases in six attempts ... Melanie Pfeiffer led Western Oregon with five hits in 14 at bats in a four-game series with nationally 21<sup>st</sup> ranked UC San Diego ... Taviah Jenkins had five of Saint Martin's 12 RBI in doubleheaders with Cal Baptist and Cal State San Bernardino.

**STREAK ENDS AT 27 GAMES:** Saint Martin's Sam Munger, who finished the 2013 season with a 26-game hitting streak, extended her streak to 27 games Saturday by going two-for-three in the Saints' season opener. That matched the 14<sup>th</sup> longest streak in NCAA Division II history. Munger, however, then went 0-for-4 in the second game. Her streak is the second longest in GNAC history. Danielle Monson of Central Washington hit in 40 consecutive games in 2010 to set a NCAA record, which since has been broken and now ranks second on the NCAA streak list.

WHAT HAPPENS IN VEGAS: Thirty-two Division II schools including six of the GNAC's seven teams will be in Las Vegas this weekend for the fifth annual Montana State Billings Stinger Invitational ... Four of the teams – No. 4 Humboldt State, No. 8 West Texas A&M, No. 14 Texas Woman's and No. 23 Dixie State – were nationally ranked in the NFCA pre-season poll ... Representing the GNAC will be Central Washington, Northwest Nazarene, Simon Fraser, Western Oregon, Western Washington and host Montana State Billings ... Saint Martin's, meanwhile returns to California for the second week in a row to take on Sonoma State and the Academy of the Art Saturday and Sunday.
