EIGHT ALL-AMERICANS AMONG CONTINGENT AT NATIONAL MEET: Eight past All-Americans are among 38 GNAC athletes who will compete in the NCAA Division II National Track and Field meet beginning Thursday at Allendale, Mich. ... Past All-Americans include men's javelin thrower Fritz Burghagen of Alaska Anchorage, who finished third last year with a mark of 230-4. Burghagen comes in as the No. 2 seed with a season-best of 229-3 ... On the women's side are five athletes who earned All-American honors in 2013 with Top 8 finishes and two who were All-American in previous seasons UAA's Karolin Anders placed fifth a year ago in the heptathlon with a score of 5,000, while Simon Fraser's Sarah Sawatzky placed sixth in the 800 (2:10.87). Three-fourths of Seattle Pacific's 4x400 All-American team – Kishia Mitchell, McKayla Fricker and Jasmine Johnson – return to try to duplicate or improve on last year's seventh-place place (3:43.40). They'll be joined this year by Tasia Baldwin in the relay race ... Katie Reichert of Western Washington placed seventh in the javelin (152-5) and UAA's Ivy O'Guinn finished seventh in the 1500 (4:41.98) in the 2012 national meet.

35 ALL-AMERICANS AND COUNTING: GNAC athletes have won 35 All-American awards in the javelin over the past 13 seasons, including 29 in the women's division. Burghagen, Reichert and Division II women's

national leader Bethany Drake are among nine GNAC javelin throwers in this year's field ... Drake set a GNAC all-time record of 169-6 early this season. That mark ranks fourth in NCAA Division II history and is 14th this season among all NCAA divisions. She'll be attempting to join Monika Gruszecki of Western Washington (2007, 11) and Brittany Aanstad of Seattle Pacific (2012) as GNAC national champions in the event. Five GNAC athletes are among the Top 8 seeds this year including Drake (1st), Reichert (3rd) and Western Oregon's Seabre Church (8th) in the women's event and Burghagen (2nd) and Slater Hirst of Western Washington (6th) in the men's field.

TOP SEEDS: In addition to Drake, Burghagen and Reichert, two other GNAC athletes are ranked in the Top 3 in their events coming into the national meet. McKayla Fricker of Seattle Pacific is the No. 3 seed in the 800 meters with a best of 2:06.85 and Ivy O'Guinn of Alaska Anchorage is the No. 3 seed in the 1500 meters with a season-best of 4:25.39.

A LOOK BACK AT THE CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS:

Western Washington won its third straight men's team title and its fifth overall in the GNAC Championships May 9-10 at Monmouth. The Vikings outpointed Alaska Anchorage 186-158 ... WWU previously won team titles in 2005 and 2010 before starting its current string of three in a row in 2012. WWU's five titles match Western Oregon's five wins in 2002, 2003, 2004, 2008 and 2011. UAA's Cody Thomas, who won the decathlon and scored a meet-high 21 individual meets, was selected the Outstanding Male Performer ... Alaska Anchorage (137 points) edged Northwest Nazarene and Western Washington by four points each to win its second straight women's team title. UAA's margin of victory was the second fewest in GNAC history and its winning point total was the fewest ever in meet history. Katelyn Steen, who tied Tayler Fettig of Central Washington and Karolin Anders of Alaska Anchorage for most individual points with 28, was selected the Outstanding Female Performer.

MOST VICTORIES: Steen was one of four women to win two individual events in the meet. She finished first in the steeplechase (10:34.40) and 5,000 (17:03.91) in addition to finishing second in the 1500 (4:30.98) to earn her 28 points ... Jamie Ashcroft of Alaska Anchorage swept the women's 100 (11.99) and 200 (24.62). SPU's McKayla Fricker won both the 800 (2:09.15) and 1500 (4:28.19) ... Tanya Bjornsson of Western Washington won both the 100 hurdles (14.21) and long jump (18-11 $\frac{3}{4}$) ... Fettig and Anders netted their 28 points with just one win each, each scoring in four events. Fettig won the high jump (5-8 $\frac{1}{2}$), finished second in the long jump (18-10) and heptathlon (4604) and fourth in the triple jump (36-8 $\frac{1}{4}$). Anders won the heptathlon (4,997), tied for second in the high jump (5-3 $\frac{3}{4}$), placed third in the long jump (18-9 $\frac{3}{4}$) and fourth in the triple jump (36-8 $\frac{3}{4}$) There were no two-event winners in the men's division. Thomas' 21 points came on his decathlon win and on fifth-place finishes in the long jump (20-10 $\frac{1}{4}$) and high jump (6-2 $\frac{1}{4}$) and a sixth in the 100 (11.00).

THREE-PEATS: Fricker was one of four GNAC athletes to win their third individual title in the same event at the GNAC conference meet. She won the 800 for the third year in a row in a time of 2:09.15 ... Western Washington's Lindsay Wells won the women's hammer (173-7) for the third year in a row and Rimar Christie of Northwest Nazarene complete a three-peat in the men's 100, winning it in the exact same time as he posted in 2013 (10.64) ... Ethan Hewitt of Alaska Anchorage also completed a three-peat in the 400 finishing first in a time of 47.94. His three-peat was rather unique, accomplished all in even number years (2010, 2012 and 2014).

50-POINT SCORERS: SPU's Kishia Mitchell was one of six athletes to join the 50-Point Career Club in the conference meet. She won the 400 and finished third in the 200 to earn 16 points and increase her career individual event total to 52, one fewer than she scored in her indoor career. Madison McClung of Western Oregon also scored 16 points to increase her career total to 59 points. Karolin Anders of Alaska Anchorage and WWU's Katelyn Steen led the meet with 28 points each to increase their career totals to 56 and 51 points, respectively. On the men's side, two athletes – Matson Hardie of Western Oregon and Brandon Roddewig of Central Washington – joined the 50-Point Club. Hardie scored six points to increase his career total to 52. Roddewig netted 13 points to increase his career total to 50.

WITH A LITTLE HELP FROM HER FRIENDS:

Seattle Pacific's Tasia Mitchell set a GNAC record earning her fifth conference meet victory in a relay event. She led the Falcons to a win in the 4x400 relay in a time of 3:50.05. She also was on SPU's winning 4x400 relay team last year and on its first-place 4x100 team in 2011, 2012 and 2013. It took a record-effort by Alaska Anchorage (46.68) to deny second-place SPU (47.31) and Mitchell their fourth consecutive win in the 4x100.

MEET RECORDS: Five meet records were set in the conference meet as Frank Catelli set a new meet and GNAC standard in winning the men's shot put (59-7). Tyrell Williams of Western Oregon tied the meet record in winning the 200 (21.32) and UAA's Cody Thomas set a record in the decathlon with a winning score of 6,617 ... Alaska Anchorage set two women's records as Joyce Kipchumba won the 10,000 in a meet-record time of 35:43.38. The foursome of Mackenzie Harsch, Rosie Smith, Sasha Halfyard and Jamie Ashcroft set a record in winning the 4x100 relay in a time of 35:43.88.

GNAC OUTDOOR ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

Men

Week of Feb. 24-March 2: Field – Slater Hirst, Western Washington (Jr., Shoreline, WA – King's) and Shane Brooks, Western Oregon (So., Pleasant Hill, OR) both had provisional national qualifying throws of 194-7 in the javelin at the Puget Sound Quadrangular and the Willamette Opener, respectively, as the outdoor season got underway. Both athletes finished first.

Week of March 3-9: Track – Bobo Camara, Alaska Anchorage (So., Cologne, Germany) won the 400 hurdles in a provisional national qualifying time of 53.14 at the UNLV Track Classic. His time ranks eighth in GNAC

history. He also won the 110 hurdles in a GNAC automatic qualifying time of 15.07. **Field** – Franz Burghagen, Alaska Anchorage (Jr., Berlin, Germany) automatically qualified for the NCAA national meet in the javelin, finishing first at Las Vegas with a throw of 216-10.

Week of March 10-16: Track - Elliott Bauer, Alaska Anchorage (Jr., Anchorage, AK – South Anchorage) posted a provisional national qualifying time in the 400 hurdles at the Ben Brown Invitational at Fullerton, Calif. Bauer was clocked in a time of 53.61. He also ran the lead leg as the Seawolves won the 4x400 relay at the Occidental Distance Relays in a GNAC record-time of 3:13.70. **Field** – Troy Martin, Central Washington (Fr., Port Angeles, WA) finished second in the shot put (50-2 ½) and third in the discus (159-5) posting GNAC season-best marks in both events at the Dusty Lane Open in Spokane. Both marks automatically qualify Martin for the GNAC meet in May.

Week of March 17-23: Track – Brady Beagley, Western Oregon (Sr., Grants Pass, OR – North Valley) finished ninth in the 1500 meters at the Oregon Preview in a provisional national qualifying time of 3:50.72. That time ranks fourth in WOU history and is the second best so far this spring in the GNAC and in NCAA Division II. **Field** – Frank Catelli, Western Washington (So., Sequim, WA) had a pair of provisional national qualifying and GNAC All-Time Top 10 performances at Eugene. He won the shot with a put of 57-2 ¼ and finished fourth in the discus with a throw of 165-4. His shot mark ranks second in GNAC history and his discus throw ranks eighth. His shot put mark leads Division II and is discus ranks second nationally.

Week of March 24-30: Track – Brady Beagley, Western Oregon (Sr., Grants Pass, OR – North Valley) placed fifth in the 5,000 meters at the Willamette Invitational in a provisional national qualifying time of 14:35.37. That time currently ranks eighth in Division II. It also is the third best in WOU school history. He also currently ranks fourth nationally in the 1,500 meter. **Field** – Anthony Montanez, MSU Billings (So., Lovell, WY) had a throw of 160-11 in the hammer, breaking the Yellowjacket school record by 23 feet. His mark was the longest by a non-Division I athlete in the University of Montana Al Manuel Invitational.

Week of March 31-April 6: Track – Micah Chelimo, Alaska Anchorage (Sr., Kapkoi, Kenya - Tambach) broke the GNAC record in the 10,000 meters by 31 ½ seconds running a Division II season-best and NCAA automatic qualifying time of 28:37.75 at the Stanford Invitational. He is the first athlete in GNAC history to run in the 28s. He finished third, just one second in back of the winner from Brigham Young. **Field** – Kevin Rima, Northwest Nazarene (Sr., Fairbanks, AK - Hutchinson) finished third at Stanford Friday in the discus with a school-record toss of 165-7. He then reset the record Saturday at San Francisco State winning the event with a provisional national qualifying throw of 168-3. That is the sixth best mark in GNAC history and ranks fifth this spring in Division II.

Week of April 7-13: Track – Bernari Sternen, Central Washington (Jr., Lynnwood, WA – Kamiak) ran a pair of provisional national qualifying and GNAC all-time Top 10 times in the Spokane CC WAR VII track-and-field meet. Sternen set a GNAC record in the 110 high hurdles, clocking a time of 14.47 and breaking the record of 14.54 set by Damien Davis of Western Oregon in 2003. In the 400 hurdles, Sternen ran the ninth fastest time in GNAC history (53.36). He finished second in both events. **Field** – Cody Thomas, Alaska Anchorage (Jr., Blenheim, New Zealand) scored 6,940 points to finish second in the decathlon at the Sac State Mondo Multi-Events. His score is the second highest in GNAC history and currently ranks sixth nationally in Division II. Among his marks was a long jump of 22-11 ¼, which ranks second this spring in the GNAC.

Week of April 14-20: Track – Micah Chelimo, Alaska Anchorage (Sr., Kapkoi, Kenya - Tambach) set a GNAC record and posted a NCAA Division II automatic qualifying mark in the 5,000 meters at the Mt. Sac Relays. He covered the 5K in a time of 13:41.99. He also posted a PNQ in the steeplechase (3:49.74). Chelimo is the current national leader in both the 5k and 10k. **Field** - Frank Catelli, Western Washington (So., Sequim, WA - Sequim) set a GNAC record in the shot with a provisional national qualifying put of 58-7 ½ in the Azusa Pacific Bryan Clay Invitational.

Week of April 21-27: Track – Rimar Christie, Northwest Nazarene (Jr., St. Michael, Barbados) and Tyrell Williams, Western Oregon (Jr., Salem, OR) ... Christie won three events at the WSU Cougar Invitational, finishing first in the 100 (10.87) and 200 (21.50) and also leading NNU to a win in the 4x100 relay (42.15). His 200 time is the second fastest in the GNAC this season. Williams won his heat of the 100 meters and placed fourth overall in the UC San Diego Triton Invitational in a time of 10.78. On the season, Williams is the GNAC leader in the 200 (21.48) and has the third best time in the 100. **Field** - John Haskin, Western Washington (So., Bainbridge Island, WA) posted a provisional national qualifying mark in the javelin with a throw of 193-11 at the WWU Vernacchia Invitational.

Week of Apr. 28-May 5: Track – Josh Hanna, Western Oregon (So., Quincy, CA) finished sixth in the 800 meters at the Oregon State High Performance Invitational at Corvallis in a provisional national qualifying time of 1:50.45. His time missed the auto standard by less than a second and was the second fastest in GNAC history. **Field** - Greyson Kilgore, Northwest Nazarene (Sr., Kuna, ID), pole-vaulted a GNAC season-best 14-7 ½ in the Idaho-Utah Border Clash after earlier in the week scoring 6,506 points to place second in the GNAC Multis at Ellensburg.

Women

Week of Feb. 24-March 2: Field – Bethany Drake, Western Washington (So., Sandy, OR) had an outdoor automatic qualifying throw of 156-11 in the javelin at UPS. Drake has a career-best of 157-4, which ranks sixth in

GNAC history. She won the event at UPS by almost 40 feet.

Week of March 3-9: Track – Jamie Ashcroft, Alaska Anchorage (Fr., Shawnigan Lake, BC) had two of the fastest sprint times in GNAC history at the UNLV Track Classic. She won the 100 meters in a GNAC-record time of 11.84, then finished sixth in the 200 in a time of 24.27. The latter time was the third quickest in GNAC history. Both marks provisionally qualified her for the NCAA national meet in May. **Field** – Seabre Church, Western Oregon (Sr., Florence, OR - Siuslaw) won the javelin at the Oregon State Invitational with an automatic national qualifying mark of 155-9. That toss ranks second in WOU school history and is seventh on the GNAC All-Time Top 10 list. She joins Bethany Drake of Western Washington (156-11) as automatic qualifiers for the NCAA national meet.

Week of March 10-16: Track – Rosie Smith, Alaska Anchorage (So., Anchorage, AK - Bartlett) finished second in the 100 hurdles at the Occidental Distance Carnival Friday in a time of 14.52, then posted a provisional national qualifying time of 14.40 in finishing fifth in the same event at the Fullerton State Ben Brown Invitational Saturday. Her 100 hurdles time ranks eighth in GNAC history. She also was a member of UAA's 4x100 relay team at Occidental than finished first in the third fastest time in GNAC history (47.11). **Field** – Becki Duhamel, Central Washington (Sr., Wenatchee, WA) posted GNAC automatic qualifying marks in both the discus (131-3) and shot put (41-5 ¼) at the Dusty Lane Open. She finished fourth in both events. Her marks rank first and second, respectively, so far this spring in the GNAC.

Week of March 17-23: Track – McKayla Fricker, Seattle Pacific (Sr., Canby, OR) finished second in the 800 and led the Falcons to a win in the 4x400 relay in a time of 3:54.16 at the Oregon Preview. Her 800 time of 2:08.00 which ranks No. 1 in NCAA Division II so far this spring automatically qualifies her for the NCAA national meet in May. It is also the sixth quickest in GNAC history. She was the first collegiate finisher, beating among others, four University of Oregon runners who wound up third through sixth. In the relay she came from behind in the final 200 meters as the Falcons edged Oregon by .47 seconds. **Field** – Katie Reichert, Western Washington (So., Longview, WA - Kelso) automatically qualified for the NCAA meet in the javelin winning the event at Eugene with the third best throw in GNAC history (162-1). Reichert's throw currently leads Division II.

Week of March 24-30: Track – Katelyn Steen, Western Washington (Jr., Sammamish, WA - Eastlake) won the 3000 meter steeplechase at the Club Northwest Spring Break Open in a provisional national qualifying time of 10:54.78. Her time is nearly half a minute quicker than anyone else in the conference this spring. **Field** - Lindsay Wells, Western Washington (Sr., Seattle, WA – Nathan Hale) finished first in the Spring Break Open in

the hammer in a PNQ of 171-1. That's 13 feet farther than anyone else has thrown the implement this spring.

Week of March 31-April 6: Track – Joyce Kipchumba, Alaska Anchorage (Jr., Kapsowar, Kenya – American International) ran the sixth fastest time in GNAC history in the 5,000 meters at the San Francisco State Distance Carnival. Her time of 16:44.97 bettered the national provisional standard by nearly 35 seconds. It currently ranks second nationally in Division II. **Field** – Bethany Drake, Western Washington (So., Sandy, OR) set a GNAC record in winning the javelin at the UPS Shotwell Invitational with a national-leading automatic national qualifying throw of 169-6. That mark earned Drake USTFCCCA National Athlete of the Week honors. It also ranks fourth all-time in NCAA Division II history and is the 10th longest throw this spring in all divisions.

Week of April 7-13: Track – Irene Moore, Saint Martin's (Jr., Bremerton, WA – Cross Point Academy) won the 400 hurdles at the Spokane CC WAR VII in a provisional national qualifying time of 1:02.54. That time ranks seventh in GNAC history. She also finished fifth in the 100 hurdles (15.12) and sixth in the long jump (16-8). Both of her hurdle times were school records. **Field** – Karolin Anders, Alaska Anchorage (So., Berlin, Germany) scored 5,048 points to win the heptathlon at the Sac State Mondo Multi-Events. She is the seventh athlete to score 5,000 or more points in Division II this spring. Her score also ranks fifth in GNAC history. Among her marks was a GNAC season-best and a NCAA national qualifying long jump of 18-10 ½. That is the 10th longest long jump in GNAC history.

Week of April 14-20: Track – McKayla Fricker, Seattle Pacific (Sr., Canby, OR - Canby), posted a NCAA automatic qualifying time in the 800 meters (2:06.85) finishing third overall at the Mt. Sac Relays. Her time is the fifth fastest in GNAC history and is the third fastest this spring in Division II. Wells added more than eight feet to her school record and national qualifying mark in the hammer with a throw of 179-5 at the Cal State L.A. Invitational. Walker finished sixth in the javelin in the Beach Invitational adding 15 feet to her provisional national qualifying mark with a throw of 150-5. Her mark eclipsed the school record by 10 feet.

Week of April 21-27: Track – Marie Smith, Northwest Nazarene (Sr., Boise, ID - Capital) won the 100 hurdles at the Washington State Cougar Invitational in a time of 14.38, breaking the Crusader school record for the third time this spring.
