PLAYERS OF THE WEEK: Offense – Andrea Terpstra, Northwest Nazarene (MB, 6-4, Jr., Ripon, CA) tallied 50 kills and 20 blocks as the Crusaders won three of four matches in the CSU East Bay/Notre Dame de Namur Route 92 Showdown. Terpstra, a transfer from San Diego State, hit for a .417 percentage (50-10-96). Defense – Samantha Hutchinson, Western Washington (L, 5-7, Jr., University Place, WA - Curtis) averaged 8.50 digs – two more than her season average of 6.50 - as the Vikings won three of four matches at the Sonoma State Seawolf Invitational. Hutchinson had a total of 102 digs in 12 sets. TEAM NOTES

Alaska Anchorage: Katelynn Zanders led the Seawolves with 60 kills, including 50 in the UC San Diego Invitational. The Seawolves also got 48 kills from Julia Mackey and 41 from Brooke Pottle.

Alaska Fairbanks: Sam Harthun had 61 kills, including 19 in a 3-0 win over Notre Dame de Namur, as the Nanooks earned their first win of the season. Harthun, who hit for a .242 percentage, also had 31 digs and a team-best six aces. Keri Knight, who had 31 kills, also had six aces.

Central Washington: Kaely Kight had 103 digs, averaging 6.44 per set as the Wildcats split four matches, including a 3-2 win over nationally second-ranked Washburn. Kight currently ranks second in the GNAC in digs, averaging 5.87 per set. Emmy Dolan led CWU with 43 kills and three players – including setter Catie Fry, Kaitlin Quirk and Erin Smith – each had 12 blocks.

MSU Billings: Monica Grimsrud led the Yellowjackets with 63 kills and a .306 percentage as MSUB won one of four matches. Grimsrud also had 31 digs and five blocks. The 'Jackets also got 32 kills from Chelsey Walter, 27 from Storm Siemion and 25 from Ashlynn Ward.

Northwest Nazarene: In addition to *GNAC Offensive Player of the Week* Andrea Terpstra, the Crusaders, who were selected the *GNAC Team of the Week*, were also led by Michelle Terpstra averaged 10.58 assists totaling 127 in 12 sets. She also had 40 digs, the second most on the

team, nine blocks and four aces. Libero Taylor Roberts had 57 digs.

Saint Martin's: Kristyn Ross had 57 kills and 52 digs in five matches, including 42 kills and 44 digs in the CSU East Bay/Notre Dame de Namur Route 92 Showdown. The Saints also got 45 kills from Carrie Starbuck and 41 from Kyra Davidson. Larissa Hamilton had a team-best 17 blocks.

Seattle Pacific: Nikki Lowell had 57 kills and a .258 hitting percentage as the Falcons split four matches. Lowell also led SPU with 19 blocks. Ellie Britt and Madi Cavell had 36 and 34 kills, respectively.

Simon Fraser: Amanda Renkema and Kelsey Robinson had 37 and 35 kills, respectively, as the Clan opened their season with two of three matches in the Hilton Metrotown BC Challenge.

Western Oregon: Christie Colasurdo and Cherene O'Hara led the Wolves with 47 and 46 kills in five matches, including a 3-1 win over Willamette. Each player had 37 kills in WOU's four matches at the Colorado Mines Oredigger Classic.

Western Washington: Kayla Erickson and Emily Boerger earned all tournament honors at Sonoma State. Erickson had 50 kills and hit for a .437 percentage, while Boerger had 44 kills and a team-high 13 blocks. She made only four errors in 90 swings, hitting a team-high .444.

PREVIOUS RED LION PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Week of Sept. 2-8: Offense – Marcy Hjellum, Central Washington (OH, 5-11, Sr., Kennewick, WA - Kamiakin) had 28 kills and 20 digs to earn *Red Lion Offensive Player of the Week* honors. She led the Wildcats to a sweep of Alaska Fairbanks and Alaska Anchorage as CWU nailed down a post-season playoff berth. **Defense** – Heather Allen, Northwest Nazarene (MB, 5-10, Sr., Boise, ID) had 16 blocks including 10 (the second highest single-match total this fall in the GNAC) in Saturday's 3-1 win against Alaska Fairbanks. Allen, the *Red Lion Defensive Player of the Week*, also had 13 kills and hit for a .333 percentage (13-2-33).
