



Alaska Anchorage, Northwest Nazarene Risk Win Streaks Thursday at Nampa

PORTLAND, Ore. – The two remaining unbeaten teams in the GNAC – Alaska Anchorage and Northwest Nazarene - will face off Thursday night in Nampa.

Northwest Nazarene is ranked for the first time in its NCAA school history; Alaska Anchorage will be looking to extend its school-record streak of consecutive wins on its opponent home court.

Both teams have already earned *GNAC Red Lion Team of the Week* honors this fall.

Alaska Anchorage (10-2 overall), last week's Red Lion award winner, brings a 4-0 conference record and a 12-match road win streak, into the contest.

Northwest Nazarene, which won the *Red Lion* award two weeks ago, brings a nine-match win streak into the contest and has won 15 of its last 16 matches dating back to last fall. Its last five wins have all been in straight sets (3-0).

That has earned NNU, which has wins over two ranked teams this fall (No. 17 Wayne State and No. 13 Central Washington), a No. 23 ranking in this week's American Volleyball Coaches Association.

The Crusaders lead the GNAC in kills (13.43 per set) and blocks (2.62), assists (12.43) and digs (20.50). UAA is the conference leader in opponent hitting percentage (.148).

Individually, the Seawolves are led by Katelynn Zanders, who ranks sixth in the GNAC in kills (3.27 per set) and second in aces (0.42), and Caitlin McInerney, who ranks second in blocks (1.12).

No NNU player is ranked in the Top 10 in the GNAC in kills, but Michelle Terpstra is the conference leader in assists (10.90) and Andrea Terpstra is the GNAC leader in blocks (1.26).

Seven different players – led by Andrea (114) – have 40 or more kills.

Elsewhere Thursday, 11th ranked Western Washington visits Seattle Pacific, Alaska plays at No. 13 Central Washington and Simon Fraser visits MSU Billings.

Saint Martin's and Western Oregon are idle until playing Saturday at Monmouth.

That will be one of five contests on Saturday as Alaska Anchorage will play at Central Washington, Alaska visits Northwest Nazarene, Western Washington plays at MSU Billings and Simon Fraser is at Seattle Pacific.

THIS WEEK'S HONOREES: Offense - Madi Cavell, Seattle Pacific (OH, 6-0, Sr., Keizer, OR - McNary) had 54 kills and hit for a .324 percentage at the Falcons opened their conference season with three wins, including a come-from-behind 3-2 win over Western Oregon. In that match she had 29 kills – the third highest single-match total in SPU history – and a career-high tying 19 digs. In the final two sets, she hit for a .619 percentage (14-1-21). On the week, she also had 38 digs, 10 assists and a team-high seven service aces. **Defense** – Samantha Hutchinson, Western Washington (L, 5-7, Sr., University Place, WA - Curtis) averaged eight digs per set (88 in 11 sets) in raising her national-leading average to 7.11 and increasing her career total to 2,005. She had 42 digs in a 3-2 loss to Alaska Anchorage, the most by a GNAC player since she had 45 against Seattle Pacific in 2011. In three matches, she helped hold WWU's opponents to a .115 hitting percentage. She is just the fourth player in GNAC history to record 2,000 or more digs.

Hutchinson Holds On To National Dig Lead

Samantha Hutchinson of Western Washington and Taylor Roberts of Northwest Nazarene rank first (7.11) and fourth (6.30) in this week's NCAA Division II national statistic report.

Madi Cavell of Seattle Pacific is the only other GNAC player ranked in the Top 20 in any category. She is 15th in points (4.74) and 17th in kills (4.15).

Cavell and Hutchinson were this week's *GNAC Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week* recipients this past week.

In team categories, Northwest Nazarene ranks fifth in digs (20.62) and sixth in blocks (2.59). Western Washington ranks seventh in digs (19.45) and Alaska Anchorage is 18th in blocks (2.40).

Team Notes

Alaska: The Nanooks were led by Brooke Mattice and Sam Harthun with 37 and 34 kills, respectively, in losses to Simon Fraser, Western Washington, Seattle Pacific and MSU Billings. UAF was out-hit .351 to .110 in the contest and outblocked 26-9.

Alaska Anchorage: In UAA's four conference matches, Erin Braun has a team-high 11 blocks and is hitting for a .458 percentage. Katelynn Zanders is the team-leader in kills (3.60) and service aces (7) and ranks second in blocks (10). Julia Mackey has 50 kills, 46 digs, six aces and eight blocks ... The Seawolves have won a school-record 12 consecutive matches on its opponents' home courts including a 3-2 win last week at Western Washington. That doesn't include a 3-0 loss to BYU-Hawaii in a neutral site West Regional playoff match last December.

Central Washington: Kiah Jones had 46 kills (4.18) to lead the Wildcats in their first three conference contests. Catie Fry was credited with 128 assists (11.64 per set) as she became the 26th player in GNAC history to record 2,000 career assists. She currently has 2,084. Defensively, Kaely Kight led the Wildcats with 54 digs and Kaitlin Quirk had 10 blocks

Montana State Billings: Monica Grimsrud had 48 kills and Chelsey Walter had 45 as the Yellowjackets won three of their first four conference matches. Walter and Ashlynn Ward each had 16 blocks as MSUB out-hit its opponents .238 to .185 ... With an 8-4 record, the Yellowjackets have already surpassed last year's win total when they finished with a 7-20 record.

Northwest Nazarene: The Crusaders, who haven't lost a set in three conference matches, earned their first-ever NCAA Division II Top 25 national ranking this week coming in at No. 23. They're off to a 10-1 start and have two wins over Top 25 teams – 17th ranked Wayne State and 13th ranked Central Washington. Going back to the end of last season, they've won 15 of their last 16 matches. In its first three league contests, Elayna Rice has led NNU with 31 kills and Andrea Terpstra has a team-best 12 blocks.

Saint Martin's: Kristyn Ross has 51 kills in four conference matches increasing her career total to 1,018. She is the 33rd player in GNAC history to record 1,000 or more. Her 28 kills last Thursday against MSUB is the second most this season in a GNAC match. Kyra Davidson led the Saints with 13 blocks in its first four league contests. The Saints were out-hit .247 to .114 in the four matches.

Seattle Pacific: Madi Cavell averaged 4.50 kills per set in the Falcons' first four conference contests, hitting for a .301 percentage. Twenty-nine of her kills – a GNAC season-high - came in a 3-2 win over Western Oregon. Cavell also had seven aces, matching Sara Biondi for the most of the team.

Simon Fraser: Kelsey Robinson had 32 kills as the Clan won one of three conference contests. Amanda Renkema was credited with 15 blocks, contributing to all but six of SFU's rejections.

Western Oregon: The Wolves forced both Seattle Pacific and Central Washington to five sets before losing matches last Thursday and Monday. Hannah Deede led WOU with 47 kills and also had 16 blocks in its four league contests. Maddi Ober led the team with 18 blocks.

Western Washington: Kayla Erickson led the Vikings with 42 kills as the Vikings won two of three contests. Erickson was charged with just 10 errors and hit for a .352 percentage in the contests. GNAC Defensive Player of the Week Samantha Hutchinson had 88 digs, including 42 in a five-set contest against Alaska Anchorage. That is the most by a GNAC player since Hutchinson had 45 against Seattle Pacific in 2011.

GNAC 48-35 In Non-Conference

GNAC teams posted a 48-35 record in non-conference matches – its best record in conference history.

Three non-conference matches remain to be played as MSU Billings host Rocky Mountain Oct. 28 and Saint Martin's has a home-and-home series with Evergreen State this Wednesday (at Lacey) and Oct. 22 (at Olympia).

Conference teams were 10-8 against CCAA opponents and 22-13 against PacWest foes. A year ago, GNAC teams were 9-19 against the PacWest.
