Wayne State University senior Shareta Brown has been named the 2015 *Women's Division II Bulletin* Player of the Year

Brown, the GLIAC Player of the Year, was an eight-time GLIAC South Division Player of the Week selection as well as a two-time USBWA National Player of the Week honoree. She led Division II in rebounding (14.7 rpg), field goal percentage (64.9), and offensive rebounds per game (6.0 rpg), was tied-for-first in double-doubles (25), and ranked second in triple-doubles (1), fourth in scoring average (22.0 ppg), and ninth in defensive rebounds per game (9.0 rpg). Brown set WSU single-season records for points (639), free throws made (177) and rebounds (427) for the second straight year. She broke the school records for single-season scoring average, field goal percentage and rebounding average.

Brown headlines the *WDIIB* All-American team, where she was joined on the first team by Shaunteva Ashley from Augustana, Jada Blackwell of Cal Poly Pomona, Kate Lehman from Fort Hays State, and West Texas A&M senior Chontiquah White.

Women's Division II Bulletin has named a Player of the Year every year since the 1993-94 season.
