## SUMMARY

Alaska Anchorage is the No. 1 seed.

Seattle Pacific is the No. 2 seed with a win Saturday or a Western Washington loss.

Western Washington is the No. 3 unless it wins and Seattle Pacific loses.

Simon Fraser is the No. 4 seed.
If MSUB beats Alaska Anchorage, the CWU-SMU winner is the No. 5 seed and MSUB is the No. 6 seed.
If UAA beats MSUB, the CWU-SMU winner is the No. 5 seed and Saint Martin's is guaranteed either the $5^{\text {th }}$ or $6^{\text {th }}$ seed, win or lose.

If UAA beats MSUB and SMU beats CWU, UAF can secure the No. 6 seed with a win against Seattle Pacific. That would eliminate Central Washington.
