CU returns home to face Life

Cumberland plays its first home game since December 15 with Thursday's contest against Life University at the Dallas Floyd Recreation Center. CU lost 4-of-6 on the road swing, including two defeats by eight points or less. The Phoenix are just 4-3 at home this season with losses to No. 11 Martin Methodist, No. 9 Freed-Hardeman and St. Catharine College as well as a victory over No. 18 Campbellsville University. Life won both meetings with CU last season, the Running Eagles' first year in the Mid-South Conference.

Thompson inches closer to 300

Cumberland's Lonnie Thompson entered the 2015-16 season with an overall coaching record of 289-230 in 18 seasons as a head coach. The Phoenix stand 9-11 so far in 2015-16 after last Saturday's double-overtime victory at Shawnee State, putting the Woodbury, Ga., native just two wins from the 300 plateau. Thompson spent four years as head coach at Motlow State Community College in Tullahoma, Tenn., com-

... piling a 74-43 record with back-to-back TJCAA Eastern Division championships. He is currently in his 14th season at Cumberland, entering this year with a 213-187 mark that includes three national tournament appearances and one TranSouth Conference regular season title. He posted his 100th career win on January 15, 2004, and his 200th career victory on February 19, 2009.

Injuries sidelining key players

Cumberland has already lost two players to season-ending injuries as well as 20 other missed contests by three players due to ailments. Senior Telvin Wilkerson (knee) and junior Uros Benacek (back) have been lost for the season. Junior Jamonte Graham strained a hamstring during the November 4 matchup with Oakwood University and played just one min-

ute at Columbia College [MO]. He missed all but two minutes in the next 10 games, a major blow to the club's depth at point guard. Graham reinjured the hamstring at the University of the Cumberland on January 7 and has missed the last three games. Freshman Will Shelton missed four games from Nov. 14-24 with a concussion, while junior DeQuan Bond battled a quad injury from the first week of the season until December, missing four total contests and playing limited minutes in two others.

Cumberland Five

- ◆ Junior Marquel Hickerson has posted double figures in 10 of the last 16 outings, including 21 points at Lindsey Wilson, 24 versus St. Catharine College and 18 against Campbellsville University before Christmas. His four games in the New Year have been about as up-and-down as one player can be, with one point at the University of the Cumberland but 27 two days later at the University of Pikeville. Last week he scored just three points at Georgetown College but netted 26 at Shawnee State with a 3-pointer to force double overtime and a banked-in 10-footer at the buzzer for the win. The Tullahoma, Tenn., native made 10-of-19 shots overall with four 3-pointers at Pikeville and hit 11-of-25 with four more triples at Shawnee State. He is posting 12.3 points per game and ranks third in the Mid-South Conference with 4.20 assists per game, with six in both meetings with Martin Methodist and seven at Lindsey Wilson. Hickerson is also averaging a career-best 5.5 rebounds per game, all while playing 34.5 minutes per outing.
- ◆ Senior guard Mark Brown is the club's leading scorer at 12.6 points per game, netting double figures in six of the last eight contests overall. The Nashville, Tenn., native has scored in double figures 13 times this season while shooting 38 percent from 3-point range. He netted 18 points in the first meeting with Martin Methodist, posted 16 and 14 points in the two

outings versus Freed-Hardeman and collected 15 points against both Bethel University and Dalton State College. Brown made just 3-of-17 attempts from 3-point range in contests versus Wilberforce University and the University of the Cumberland before hitting four trifectas in the first half at the University of Pikeville and three in his 18-point effort at Georgetown College. He posted a season-high 20 points at Shawnee State with five 3-pointers. Brown has made at least three 3-pointers in 12-of-20 contests this season and has seven games with at least four triples. Brown ranks second among the remaining players in rebounds with 5.4 per outing, including a season-best 10 at Freed-Hardeman on November 17.

- ◆ Junior Ronell Abaekobe has started 13 of the last 14 contests, averaging 11.4 points while shooting 50 percent (17-for-34) from 3-point range during that stretch. The Los Angeles, Calif., native posted 20 points and 12 rebounds at Freed-Hardeman and netted 20 points versus Fisk University. He added 17 points against Bethel University and 14 versus Wilberforce University. The 6-foot-7 guard/forward registered 12 points in 21 minutes at the University of the Cumberland and collected his second double-double of the year with 13 points and 11 boards at the University of Pikeville. Abaekobe posted 11 points and seven rebounds at Georgetown College and is averaging 9.7 points per game, tied for third on the club, along with 5.1 rebounds per game.
- ◆ Freshman Will Shelton entered the season as a player to watch and has delivered on that promise when healthy. The Savannah, Tenn., native has netted double-digits seven times this year, including 22 points versus William Woods, 15 points against Campbellsville University and 19 points versus Bethel University. He added 20 points at Georgetown College, taking a season-high 22 shots, and registered 13 points and nine rebounds in 48 minutes last Saturday at Shawnee State. Shelton missed four outings in the middle of November with a concussion but averaged 12.3 points and 5.8 boards after his return in four games from December 11-19. He is posting 9.4 points and 4.9 rebounds per game for the season.
- ◆ Junior DeQuan Bond averages 5.5 points and 3.8 rebounds despite playing on the interior against much taller (and in many cases) more

physically imposing players. Bond can step outside to shoot the three (39 percent this season) and has started 12 of 16 games in 2015-16 and 34 times in his Cumberland career. He posted one of the best games of his career at Georgetown College, netting 14 points with a career-high nine rebounds, hitting 5-of-11 shots and 3-for-4 at the foul line.

Johnson finding a rhythm

Junior Cameron Johnson spent the last two seasons as part of the program at Tennessee State University but sat out his first semester at Cumberland. The Chicago, Ill., native hit a pair of 3-pointers and scored 12 points in 26 minutes in his first action of the year in an 89-80 victory over Bethel University on December 15. He made 6-of-13 shots with one 3-pointer and one free throw for a team-leading 14 points at the University of the Cumberlands and netted 11 of his 13 points in the second half at the University of Pikeville, helping Cumberland nearly upset the Bears. Johnson was a major factor in CU's double-overtime win at Shawnee State, posting 20 points on 6-of-7 shooting overall and connecting on 8-of-10 at the foul line. He is posting 9.7 points and 4.1 rebounds in 24.4 minutes over seven games this season.

Tidbits

Cumberland has averaged 14.8 turnovers per game while forcing just 10.6, ranking last in the Mid-South Conference in turnover margin. CU

has posted 18 or more miscues in a game seven times this season but just twice in the last 12 outings ... The Phoenix rank next-to-last in the league in scoring margin, registering 70.9 points per outing compared to 77.1 for opponents ... Cumberland's nine wins this season have all come by single digits (2, 4, 9, 7, 6, 2, 9, 7, 1 points), with CU outscoring its opponents by just 46 total points in the nine victories. On the other end of the spectrum, the club's 11 losses have come by a combined 171 points, with six of those by single digits (8, 9, 4, 6, 4, 8 points). That makes the Phoenix 9-6 in games decided by 10 points or less in 2015-16.

Roster gutted at semester break

Cumberland began the 2015-16 campaign with eight newcomers, including junior college players Devarus Craig (Odessa JC) and Delaryn Dodd (Jackson State CC) and Williams Baptist transfer Cedric Nash, but all three forwards were deemed academically ineligible at the semester break. Craig was the team's leading scorer (12.3) and rebounder (6.8) while Dodd and Nash combined for 13.4 points and 8.9 boards per outing. With season-ending injuries to Telvin Wilkerson (knee) and Uros Benacek (back), Cumberland heads into the meat of its schedule short-handed to say the least.

Graham's health makes big difference

Junior Jamonte Graham made an immediate impact for Cumberland in the season-opener at

11th-ranked Martin Methodist, posting 13 of his 16 points in the second half in a 68-66 victory. The Nashville, Tenn., native added 12 points against Oakwood University two nights later but also injured his hamstring during the contest. He started at Columbia College [MO] but lasted just one minute, re-injuring the hamstring. Graham missed nine of the next 10 games, playing just two minutes at Freed-Hardeman. He played in the last three contests before Christmas, posting 16 points versus Wilberforce University in the final outing before the break but re-injured the hamstring at the University of the Cumberlands. In his absence, Cumberland is just 5-10 and junior Marquel Hickerson averages 35.9 minutes per game with no other primary ball-handler available.

Brown named Mid-South Player of the Week

Mark Brown earned Mid-South Conference Player of the Week honors on November 9 for his performances during the season's opening week. Brown led CU in victories over 11th-ranked Martin Methodist, William Woods and Oakwood University. CU's lone loss came at the hands of 16th-ranked Columbia College [MO].

The Nashville, Tenn., native posted 18 points in the season-opener at Martin Methodist and hit five 3-pointers while netting 19 points against Oakwood. He finished the week with 17 points versus William Woods. The senior averaged 14.8 and 6.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40 percent (12-for-30) from beyond the arc.

Nash garners All-Tournament accolades

Cedric Nash earned All-Tournament honors for his performance in two outings at the Columbia Classic in the season's first weekend. The junior registered 14 points and five rebounds against host Columbia College [MO] and netted 12 points with five boards versus William Woods. He made 9-of-23 shots from the field and 8-of-9 at the foul line in the two contests.

Daunting schedule hinders squad

Despite just two returning starters and eight newcomers, head coach Lonnie Thompson put together a tough schedule in the first two months of the 2015-16 campaign. Cumberland has played seven ranked teams in 16 outings this season, posting a 2-5 record. CU knocked off No. 11 Martin Methodist, 68-66, to open the year and defeated 18th-ranked Campbellsville University, 75-73, on December 5. MMC defeated CU the following week in Lebanon, 81-73, and the Phoenix dropped a 78-54 decision to 16th-ranked Columbia College [MO] on the road. Cumberland lost twice to ninth-ranked Freed-Hardeman in a span of seven days – 81-59 in Henderson and 77-61 in Lebanon – and dropped a 78-74 decision at No. 9 Dalton State College just before Christmas.

Phoenix picked seventh in Mid-South Preseason Coaches' Poll

Cumberland men's basketball was picked seventh in the 2015-16 Mid-South Conference Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced by conference officials in October. CU returns two starters and five letterwinners from last season's club that finished 9-21 overall. Fourteenth-year head coach Lonnie Thompson also welcomes eight newcomers in 2015-16. Senior Telvin Wilkerson is the team's leading returning scorer with 7.9 points per game, while junior Marquel Hickerson averaged 7.3 points and junior Uros Benacek shot 48 percent from 3-point range. Newcomers Ronell Abaekobe, Mark Brown, Delaryn Dodd, Cedric Nash and Devarus Craig will add depth to the squad as well. Head Coach Lonnie Thompson



Cumberland's Lonnie Thompson begins his 14th season at Cumberland and his 18th year as a head coach.

Thompson's program has enjoyed unprecedented success, with three national tournament appearances – the only appearances in school history as a four-year program. Cumberland made back-to-back appearances in the NAIA National Championships in 2008 and 2009, the only teams in program

annals to make consecutive trips to the national tournament.

The Woodbury, Ga., native has posted a 213-187 mark at Cumberland with one TranSouth Conference regular season championship and is 289-230 overall as a head coach. Thompson posted his 200th career head coaching victory on February 19, 2009, against Lambuth University in just his 11th year as a head coach.

Thompson came to CU from Motlow State Community College in Tullahoma, Tenn., where he led the Bucks to back-to-back TJC-CAA Eastern Division Championships. He was named TJCCAA Eastern Division Coach of the Year three times at Motlow State.

In his second season as head coach at Cumberland, Thompson led the Phoenix to the most wins in school history with a 28-6 record. CU won its only TranSouth Conference regular season championship and Thompson was a unanimous selection as Coach of the Year. He also captured his 100th career victory as a head coach during that campaign, which included the school's first-ever appearance at the NAIA National Tournament in Kansas City, Mo., where they were defeated in the Round of 16.

Cumberland posted a 21-12 overall mark in 2007-08 and made its second appearance in the NAIA National Tournament, falling to Oklahoma City in the first round. The 2008-09 squad finished 25-6 overall, reaching the national tournament for the second consecutive season. His 2011-12 team posted a 22-9 mark, just missing out on the national tourney again.

Thompson has a depth of coaching experience at all levels of college basketball, serving as an assistant coach at South Alabama, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee State, Creighton and Odessa Junior College, where he coached former NBA All-Star Larry Johnson.

Thompson and his wife, Felicia, have two sons, Destin and Darius, and one daughter, Devin, and the family resides in Murfreesboro, Tenn. Thompson re-



ceived his bachelor's from Middle Tennessee in 1986 and returned to his alma mater as an assistant coach under David Farrar in the mid-90's.
