CU drops MSC opener to Lindsey Wilson
Cumberland opened Mid-South Conference play on the road for the third time in the last four years. This year's outing against Lindsey Wilson went in favor of the Blue Raiders who held off a late comeback from CU to win 73-69. Marquel Hickerson led the way for Cumberland who had three players in double-figures, knocking down a game-best 21 points. He also collected a game-high seven assists. Mark Brown posted 14 points while Devarus Craig registered 18.

CU picked seventh in MSC

Cumberland was picked to finish seventh in the Mid-South conference. The poll was voted on by the conference's coaches. After finishing 9-21 overall and 4-12 in the MSC, CU collected 20 points and is slated just in front of Shawnee State (17) and St.

season, winning 78-67 on November 5, 2008, and 73-55 on January 5, 2009. In that season, Cumberland reached the NAIA Championships but fell 72-62 to 17th-ranked Auburn Montgomery. In last season's outing in Lebanon, Marquel Hickerson posted 22 points and Josh Wilkerson netted 15, as the tandem combined to make 17-of-20 from the charity stripe, as the Bulldogs started fast and held off a late comeback in the final minutes to win 76-68. Hickerson was at it again in the second meeting between Cumberland and St. Catharine, racking up his first career double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds. Telvin Wilkerson added 18 points in Cumberland's 77-70 over the Patriots.

Tip-off Central

Cumberland started red-hot during the season's first week, going 3-1, but have since struggled through the games that have followed. Five consecutive losses came after defeating Oakwood University, 80-63, in Huntsville, Ala. on November 10. Martin Methodist avenged its season-opening loss in Lebanon, pulling out a 81-73 victory. CU then lost a heartbreaker to Fisk University, falling 81-72 in double-overtime. Hickerson's last second floater dropped as time expired in regulation and Mark Brown's triple tied the game again, sending it to a second OT. Tough times continued for Cumberland, facing ninth-ranked Freed-Hardeman twice in a week, dropping both contests. Sandwiched between those losses to the Lions was a defeat to Mid-South foe, Lindsey Wilson. CU forged a late comeback but fell short, 73-69. In the rematch versus Fisk on Monday, Ronell Abaekobe lit a fire under Cumberland with monstrous slam dunk late in the first half. CU closed out the half on a 21-10 run and held on for its first victory in nearly three weeks, 76-70.

Injuries Hurting CU

Cumberland has been marred by injuries early in the 2015-16 campaign. Senior guard Telvin Wilkerson injured his knee in the preseason and will likely miss the entire year. CU's 6-foot-11 center, Uros Benacek has been plagued by a lower back injury and there is no timetable for his return. Jamonte Graham strained a hamstring during the Nov. 4 matchup with Oakwood and missed the following games against William Woods and Fisk. He reinjured the hamstring in his first two minutes at Freed-Hardeman. Freshman Will Shelton and junior DeQuan Bond both returned to action Monday night following their injuries. Shelton posted five points in 30 minutes of play while Bond put up two in 17 minutes off the bench.

Cumberland Five

◆ Senior guard Mark Brown has led CU in scoring in four of the team's 11 games this season. His 18 points led Cumberland past No. 20 Martin Methodist in the season opener and his season-best 19 came two days later against Oakwood University. The Nashville, Tenn., native has posted double-digit point efforts in seven of 11 contests this season, scoring at least 14 in each of those outings.

◆ Marquel Hickerson has produce last minute magic late in games this season. With just 15 seconds remaining in the season opener versus Martin Methodist College, Hickerson's one-hander off the glass clinched the victory. Hickerson's best game came in the conference opener against Lindsey Wilson, where he picked up a season-high 21 points. His seven assists against the Blue Raiders also led both teams. The Tullahoma, Tenn., native has led or tied for the most assists in all 11 contests this season.

◆ Although head coach Lonnie Thompson has used six different starting lineups this season, CU has been very productive off the bench. Devarus Craig has produced four double-digit efforts. His 15 points against Martin Methodist were a game-best. The Odesa College transfer has posted double-figure points seven different times and produced a career-best 23 en route to his first double-double of the season against Fisk University on Monday.

◆ CU has outscored opponents by 10 points in the first half compared to being outscored by 56 in the second period.

◆ Turnovers have hindered Cumberland throughout the season. CU has coughed up the ball 168 times while opponents have only turned the ball over 113. Cumberland averages 15.3 turnovers per game.

MSC Honors by Cumberland

Mark Brown was named Mid-South Conference Men's Basketball Player of the Week on November 9 for his performance during the season's opening week. Brown led Cumberland in victories over 11th-ranked Martin Methodist, William Woods University and Oakwood University. CU's lone loss came at the hands of 16th-ranked Columbia [MO] College. The senior averaged 14.8 and 6.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40 percent from beyond the arc. This was Brown's first player of the week honor and the first of his career at Cumberland.

Nash named to All-Tournament Team

Cedric Nash earned All-Tournament honors for his performance at the Columbia Classic in the season's first weekend. The redshirt sophomore averaged 13.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in Cumberland's two contests against host Columbia [MO] College and William Woods University. Nash started both games for CU during the tournament, going 9-for-23 from the field and 8-of-9 from the charity stripe.

Non-Conference Notes

Cumberland played four teams ranked in the NAIA Preseason Coaches' Poll to open the season. CU knocked off No. 11 Martin Methodist, 68-66, after Marquel Hickerson's leaper off the glass dropped with three seconds remaining. MMC defeated CU the following week at the Dallas Floyd Recreation Center, 81-73. Cumberland played 16th-ranked Columbia College [MO] on the road, falling 78-54. CU lost to ninth-ranked Freed-Hardeman twice within a weeks time, dropping the first contest, 81-59, in Henderson and then 77-61 in Lebanon.

Plenty of new faces for Cumberland

With the departure of eight letterwinners from a year ago, CU's roster looks much different than it has in previous years. Senior Mark Brown transferred from Shorter University after starting his collegiate career at Freed-Hardeman. Juniors Ronell Abaekobe and Cameron Johnson both came in from NCAA institutions; Abaekobe spent a year at Delta State University while Cameron Johnson came from Tennessee State University. Devarus Craig, Delaryn Dodd and Jamonte Graham all transferred from junior colleges-Craig from Odessa College, Dodd from Jackson State Community College and Graham from Columbia State Community College. Uros Benacek also transferred from Columbia State last season.

Transfers making an impact

With so many new faces on this year's team, head coach Lonnie Thompson has needed his transfers to make an immediate impact. Mark Brown has led the way for Cumberland, starting all 11 games and posting 12.9 points per game to lead the squad. The senior ranks second on the team in total assists with 19. Devarus Craig ranks second on the team in points per game with 11.9 and is picking up a team-best 6.6 rebounds per game.

Hickerson's minutes adding up

Marquel Hickerson, the only player on this year's team who saw significant playing time last season, is at it again in 2015-16. Hickerson is averaging 35.2 minutes per game which is just a minute less than Mark Brown's team-high 36.4 average. The junior guard has put up impressive numbers during the season's first 11 games. His nine triples are third best on the team while knocking 24-of-32 from the free throw line. He leads Cumberland in assists with 59 and is averaging 5.6 per game.

Abaekobe heating up

Ronell Abaekobe, the Los Angeles, Calif., native has put together back-to-back stellar performances for Cumberland. He reached the 20-point mark against Freed-Hardeman on Nov. 24, producing his first double-double of the year. In Monday's action against Fisk, Abaekobe fueled a late first half surge that gave Cumberland a lead that would not be relinquished, which led to CU's 76-70 victory.

Craig posting up down low

Devarus Craig has become a force to be reckoned with over the last two weeks. The junior forward now ranks second on the team, averaging 11.9 points per game, and continues to pick up the offensive boards. Craig's 25 offensive rebounds ranks second on the team. His strong post play has allowed Cumberland to remain close in games. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native produced his best game of the year against Fisk on Monday where racked up 23 points and 16 rebounds. The junior forward's 23 points is the most scored by any Cumberland players this season.

18th Season

14th at CU

Cumberland's Lonnie Thompson begins his 14th season with the Bulldogs and his 18th year as a head coach.

Thompson's program has enjoyed unprecedented success, with three national tournament appearances – the only appearances in school history as a four-year program. Cumberland made back-to-back appearances in the NAIA National Championships in 2008 and 2009, the only teams in program annals to make consecutive trips to the national tournament.

The Woodbury, Ga., native has posted a 213-187 mark at Cumberland with one TranSouth Conference regular season championship and is 289-230 overall as a head coach. Thompson posted his 200th career head coaching victory on February 19, 2009, against Lambuth University in just his 11th year as a head coach.

Thompson came to CU from Motlow State Community College in Tullahoma, Tenn., where he led the Bucks to back-to-back TJCCAA Eastern Division Championships. He was named TJCCAA Eastern Division Coach of the Year three times at Motlow State.

In his second season as head coach at Cumberland, Thompson led the Bulldogs to the most wins in school history with a 28-6 record. CU won its only TranSouth Conference regular season championship and Thompson was a unanimous selection as Coach of the Year. He also captured his 100th career victory as a head coach during that campaign, which included the school's first-ever appearance at the NAIA National Tournament in Kansas City, Mo., where they were defeated in the Round of 16.

Cumberland posted a 21-12 overall mark in 2007-08 and made its second appearance in the NAIA National Tournament,

falling to Oklahoma City in the first round. The 2008-09 squad finished 25-6 overall, reaching the national tournament for the second consecutive season. His 2011-12 team posted a 22-9 mark, just missing out on the national tourney again.

Thompson has a depth of coaching experience at all levels of college basketball, serving as an assistant coach at South Alabama, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee State, Creighton and Odessa Junior College, where he coached former NBA All-Star Larry Johnson.

Thompson and his wife, Felicia, have two sons, Destin and Darius, and one daughter, Devin, and the family resides in Murfreesboro, Tenn. Thompson received his bachelor's from Middle Tennessee in 1986 and returned to his alma mater as an assistant coach under David Farrar in the mid-90's.

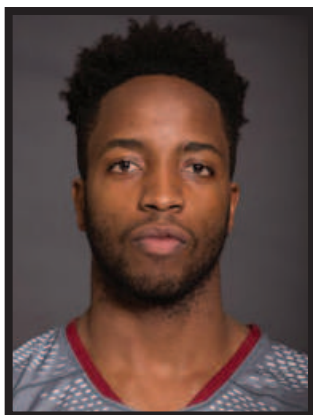

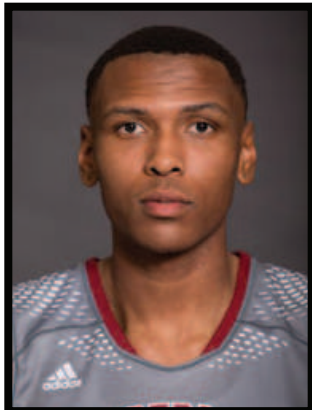

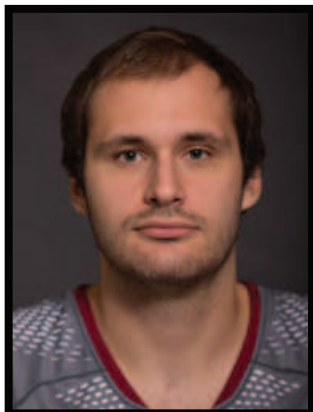
