CU hosts Faulkner for Senior Day

Cumberland and Faulkner have played each of the last eight seasons, with CU winning three of the first four meetings. The Eagles have posted wins in three of the last four outings to knot the overall series at 4-4. Last season CU played perhaps its best first half of the season but lost both quarterbacks to injury and No. 7 Faulkner scored 27 straight points in the second half in a 34-16 victory. Anthony Woodard caught a pair of touchdown passes for the Bulldogs, who led 16-7 at the break and missed another touchdown late in the period that led to a safety. Reed Gurchiek and Broc Loveless were both injured late in the half. Cumberland managed just 29 yards of offense in the second half. Terrell Robinson's sweep around the right side for the Eagles went 40 yards for a score with 11:34 left in the third period and on the ensuing possession, Brandon Mallory fumbled, setting up Faulkner at the CU8. Robinson hit Keithon Redding for an eight-yard TD on the first play and Faulkner never looked back.

five total turnovers, but miscues over the last four contests have led directly to three straight defeats for the Bulldogs. CU posted one or no turnovers in four of the first five outings and had three in a loss at the University of the Cumberland. Over the last four games, though, Cumberland has committed 13 turnovers, including a then season-high four at Campbellsville University and five this past week versus Bethel University. Bulldog opponents have feasted on the offense's miscues this season, turning those into 87 points, including 24 by Campbellsville and 21 from Bethel.

collecting a career-best 14 tackles and his first sack of the season in last week's contest versus Bethel University. He registered seven solo stops in the contest for CU, which limited the Wildcats to just 326 yards of offense despite Bethel starting six drives on Cumberland's side of the field. It marked the second 14-tackle performance of the season for Carr, who also tallied 14 stops at Valdosta State. He ranks second on the club with 76 tackles along with four tackles for loss this season.

Chaplin carrying the lead for CU

Junior Austin Chaplin has taken over as the feature back for Cumberland, rushing 104 times for 555 yards and five touchdowns over the last five games. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native carried 22 times for 87 yards versus Reinhardt University. Chaplin posted a career-best outing against Kentucky Christian, rushing for 229 yards on 31 carries with three touchdowns, all career-highs, with TD runs of three, two and four yards. The previous week at the University of Pikeville, he carried 27 times for 156 yards and one touchdown, including 17 times for 124 yards and one TD in the second half. This is Chaplin's first season at running back after two years as a defensive back at CU. He leads the club with 683 rushing yards on 139 attempts with six touchdowns. He also has 16 receptions for 153 yards and one TD.

Green is big-play guy for CU

Redshirt junior Michael Green accounted for three touchdowns for the second time this season at the University of the Cumberlands on September 19, catching TD grabs of 64, 37 and 35 yards. He finished the contest with five receptions for 172 yards, both career-bests. He also found a groove on kickoff returns at UC, setting up the offense with short fields after 45, 37 and 23-yard returns. The Nashville, Tenn., native also accounted for three touchdowns in the season opener against Georgetown College, catching 31 and 34-yard TD passes and tossing a 58-yard scoring pass on a reverse. He was at it again at the University of Pikeville on October 3, collecting five receptions for 162 yards, including an 88-yard TD catch-and-run. Green caught four passes for 85 yards at Campbellsville University with a 43-yard touchdown grab and collected eight grabs for 123 yards with a 62-yard TD last week versus Bethel University, his third 100-yard receiving day of the season. He has 29 plays of 20-plus yards this season

with nine of 40-plus, which includes passes, receptions and kickoff returns. He is tied for second in the Mid-South Conference in receiving yards (882) and ranks third in receiving yards per game (98.0), sixth in receptions (40) and third in all-purpose yards (1473).

Snyder posts second straight bad outing

Redshirt junior Justin Snyder posted steady if not spectacular numbers through the first seven games this season for Cumberland, but the quarterback has registered his worst two outings of the season in the last two games. The Jonesborough, Tenn., native completed just 12-of-29 passes for 143 yards and one touchdown but also threw two interceptions two weeks ago at Campbellsville University. This past week against Bethel University, Snyder completed only 17-of-33 attempts for 198 yards and two touchdowns but also four interceptions, one of which was returned for a touchdown. Granted, two of last week's picks were deflected off CU receivers, just as six of his 10 interceptions this season have come off tipped balls by his own players. He has thrown for 1,741 yards and 17 touchdowns this season while completing 51 percent of his throws. Snyder completed 15-of-27 passes for five touchdowns at the University of the Cumberlands on September 19, including TD throws of 64, 37 and 35. It marked the most TD passes for a Cumberland QB since Brandon Janco tossed six against Campbellsville on Oc-

tober 22, 2005. Snyder finished 20-of-28 passing for 260 yards and three touchdowns in the season opener against Georgetown College, with five of those completions for 29 yards or more. He took over at QB for departed seniors Broc Loveless and Reed Gurchiek and played in a pair of games last season in relief, completing 6-of-13 passes for 58 yards and one interception. Snyder is learning his third offense since enrolling at CU in 2012, this one more of the Mike Leach Air Raid-variety under first-year offensive coordinator Klay Koester.

Stewart leads defensive backfield

Redshirt sophomore Tyler Stewart has posted 65 tackles, tied for third on the squad, with nine pass breakups (tied for the team lead) and one interception in nine games this season for the Bulldogs. The Baltimore, Md., native collected 11 tackles, including seven solo, in the season opener versus Georgetown College. He added six tackles and two pass breakups at West Alabama and recorded five stops with an interception at the University of the Cumberlands. The INT and 29-yard return set-up a touchdown that tied the game on the last play of the first half.

He registered eight tackles at Valdosta State and played perhaps his best all-around game of the season at the University of Pikeville, collecting a team-best 12 stops along with three pass breakups. Stewart took control of the defensive backfield with the absence of redshirt junior Tyler Burr, who missed the first four games this season with an ankle injury. Stewart transferred to Cumberland after spending the last two years at Carson-Newman, posting four tackles in five games last season for the Eagles. He attended Knox Karns High School in Knoxville, Tenn., earning First Team All-District honors as a junior and senior and Second Team Prep XTra accolades from the *Knoxville News-Sentinel* as a senior.

Jernigan leading CU in tackles again

Redshirt junior Nathan Jernigan leads the Bulldogs in tackles again this season, collecting 91 in nine outings in 2015, tied for second in the Mid-South Conference. The Eagleville, Tenn., native registered a game-high 15 tackles with 1.5 sacks in the season opener against Georgetown College. He also recorded 15 tackles in last year's season-opener against the University of the Cumberlands and netted a career-best 16 stops in last season's finale at Alderson Broaddus. Jernigan added 10 stops at West Alabama, had nine tackles at the University of the Cumberlands and versus Reinhardt University and finished with eight stops at Valdosta State. He earned his second Tennessee Sports Writers Association Player of the Week honor on October 6, posting 11 tackles with a forced fumble and one pass breakup at the University of Pikeville. Jernigan collected 12 stops at Campbellsville University and recorded 11 last week versus Bethel University. He has posted double-figure tackles 11 times in his career, with 10 of those outings over the last 20 contests.

Defensive scores are the norm for CU

Under head coach and defensive coordinator Donnie Suber, Cumberland has registered 28 defensive touchdowns in seven-plus seasons, which includes interceptions, fumble returns and blocked punts, as well as forcing five safeties. The Bulldogs have three defensive scores so far this season, with Nathan Anderson blocking a punt out of the end zone for a safety at West Alabama and Anthony Knight picking up a blocked extra point and returning it 85 yards for two points at Valdosta State. Two weeks ago at the University of Pikeville, Anderson blocked

his second punt of the season and this time scooped up the bouncing ball and returned it six yards for the TD. CU posted five touchdowns with a safety in 2014. Knight returned an interception 74 yards for a touchdown against the University of the Cumberlands and then had a 54-yard INT return for a score at Pikeville. Kendall Trice forced a fumble on a sack and Donovan Norfleet picked up the loose ball and raced 35 yards for the score at Union College. Norfleet also picked up a fumble and covered 61 yards for a TD versus Campbellsville University and Rickey Dowdy registered a 70-yard interception return for a score in the season finale against Alderson Broaddus. The chart to the left has a complete listing of all defensive scores under Suber.

Defensive depth chart has experience

While the offensive side of the ball has several new faces, especially at the skill positions, many of the Cumberland defensive starters and some backups have seen extensive action over the last two seasons. Redshirt seniors Cayman Russell and Anthony Knight, redshirt juniors Justus Dauscha, Tyler Burr, Andrew Leonard and Nathan Jernigan and junior Christopher Golden have all played in double-digit games in their Bulldog careers, combining for 122 starts and 190 games played. The chart above shows games played and starts for the offensive and defensive lines for CU heading into this season.

tackles with two sacks and two quarterback hurries in the season opener versus Georgetown College, picking up where he left off in 2014. Against the University of Pikeville he added five stops with 1.5 sacks and three quarterback hurries. It marked his fifth multi-sack outing over the last two years and he has 14.0 sacks in his last 20 games overall. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native posted three tackles with one pass breakup at West Alabama and added five stops with 0.5 sacks at the University of the Cumberlands. He ranks second on the squad this season with 4.5 sacks, which is tied for 10th in the Mid-South Conference. Last season Dauscha registered 69 tackles with 16 tackles for loss and 9.5 sacks last season, ranking eighth nationally in sacks and 19th in tackles for loss.

Russell always attacking

Despite playing with shoulder and ankle injuries this season, redshirt senior Cayman Russell continues to excel from his defensive line position. The Hendersonville, Tenn., native leads the Bulldogs with 8.5 tackles for loss, tied for 10th in the Mid-South Conference, and ranks third on the club with 3.5 sacks. He posted 1.5 sacks at the University of the Cumberlands and 1.0 in the season opener versus Georgetown College. Russell registered seven stops against Georgetown and the Cumberlands and collected six at the University of Pikeville. He added eight versus Reinhardt University and posted six at Campbellsville University.

Offensive line shuffles again

Cumberland's projected starting offensive line at the beginning of fall camp has been replaced by a makeshift unit because of injuries and illness (check starters on page 12 of these notes). Sophomore Nick Bodden was last season's starter at left tackle, but the Hoover, Ala., native missed all of fall camp with mono and has started the last five games at that spot. Sophomore Chandler Peoples started every game at center last season but missed most of the West Alabama contest because of injury was hurt again versus Kentucky Christian and his outlook for the rest of the season is bleak. Senior Will Boler moved from right to left tackle in Bodden's absence but returned to the right side at Pikeville, while redshirt freshman Jeff Benson started the first two games of the season, one at tackle and one at guard, but will not play again this season because of concussion symptoms. Benson started at guard due to an injury

to redshirt sophomore Zac Carter, who started the season opener versus Georgetown College but did not play for five weeks before returning against Reinhardt University. Redshirt junior Anthony Bartolomeo drew his first career start at West Alabama and played the whole game at guard at the University of the Cumberlands. Bartolomeo took Peoples' spot after he was injured versus Kentucky Christian and will likely start the rest of the year, though he has moved to right guard the last two games. The right side of the line has been more steady, with redshirt junior Chris Escamilla and redshirt sophomore Jason Smith starting all nine contests, though Smith moved to left guard at Pikeville in another shuffle of the line and Escamilla is now the center in Peoples' absence.

Burr picks up TSWA Defensive accolade

Cumberland safety Tyler Burr was named the Tennessee Sports Writers Association Defensive Player of the Week on October 13 after posting nine tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss, one pass breakup, one quarterback hurry and one interception in a 54-21 victory over Kentucky Christian. The Alexandria, Ala., native was the team's leading tackler in the contest, posting five solo stops, and broke up a pass in the end zone on a drive that ended with a missed field goal for the Knights. Playing in just his second game of the year, the redshirt junior also pressured KCU quarterback Graham Johnston into an incompleting and his diving interception near midfield in the second quarter was the fifth of his career. Burr has 26 tackles with 2.5 tackles for loss and one fumble recovery in five games after missing the first four contests of the season with an ankle injury.

EKU transfer Smith starts at tackle, guard

Redshirt sophomore Jason Smith has started all nine games this season for the Bulldogs, including the first four contests at right tackle then four games at left guard and this past week back at right tackle. The Paducah, Ky., native transferred from Eastern Kentucky University, appearing in one game last season for the Colonels, versus Morehead State, after redshirting in 2013. Smith was a two-time Honorable Mention All-State selection by the *Louisville Courier-Journal* at Lone Oak High School in Paducah, playing on the offensive and defensive lines for the Purple Flash.

Jernigan earns MSC, TSWA honors

Cumberland linebacker Nathan Jernigan was voted the Mid-South Conference as well as the Tennessee Sports Writers Association Defensive Player of the Week on September 7-8 after posting 15 tackles in CU's 33-26 victory over No. 11 Georgetown College. The Eagleville, Tenn., native collected 1.5 sacks against Georgetown, with one late in the first half and another with Justus Dauscha in the fourth quarter. The Bulldog defense held the Tigers to 1-of-9 on third down in the second half and 0-for-2 on fourth down in the fourth quarter.

Jernigan wins second TSWA honor

Redshirt junior linebacker was named the Tennessee Sports Writers Association Defensive Player of the Week for the second time this season on October 6 after collecting 11 tackles with a forced fumble and a pass breakup at the University of Pikeville. The Eagleville, Tenn., native also recovered an onside kick in the final minutes of the game and tackled Pikeville quarterback Hasani Warren on the final offensive play for the Bears as he scrambled for a first down. Jernigan forced a fumble on UPike's first series of the game that CU turned into a touchdown as well. He continues to lead the Bulldogs in tackles this season after ranking first on the club in tackles in each of the last two campaigns.

Dauscha, Jernigan, Russell named Preseason All-Americans

Cumberland's Justus Dauscha and Nathan Jernigan were both First Team honorees and Cayman Russell earned Second Team honors on the USA College Football NAIA Division Pre-Season All-American teams released in June. Dauscha registered 69 tackles with 16 tackles for loss and 9.5 sacks last season, ranking eighth nationally in sacks and 19th in tackles for loss. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native recorded three sacks versus the University of Pikeville and posted two sacks apiece against Belhaven University and Campbellsville University. Jernigan led the Bulldogs in tackles for the second straight year, finishing with 99 stops along with eight tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks. The Eagleville, Tenn., native also registered three pass breakups, three quarterback hurries, one forced fumble and one blocked punt. He tallied double-digit tackles in five contests, including 15 in the season opener against the University of the Cumberlands and 16 in the season finale versus Alderson Broaddus. Russell registered

76 tackles with 10.0 tackles for loss and 3.5 sacks, adding three blocked extra points, three quarterback hurries, two forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries. The Hendersonville, Tenn., native recorded 10 stops at Pikeville and blocked two extra points at Union College, helping the Bulldogs win in overtime. He also had eight tackles at Bethel University and 10 stops versus Alderson Broaddus.

Bulldogs look to continue winning ways

Cumberland has compiled a 36-18 mark over the previous five seasons, the best five-year run in program history. The Bulldogs posted 8-3 records in 2010 and 2012 and a 7-3 mark in 2011, playing for the division championship in all three campaigns. The squad was 7-4 overall in 2013, winning seven of its final nine outings, but struggled down the stretch last season, dropping its last three games en route to a 6-5 mark. CU ranks third in total victories among the 18 football-playing schools in the state of Tennessee since the start of the 2010 season. Carson-Newman (44-20) leads all schools during that stretch with Chattanooga (41-25) second and CU (39-24) in third heading into this week's games. UT Martin (37-29), Maryville College (36-23) and Tennessee State (35-31) are next in line in total wins over that span. The football-playing schools in the state include Austin Peay, Carson-Newman, Chattanooga, Cumberland, Lane College, Rhodes College, Maryville College, Memphis, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech, Tusculum College, University of the South, UT Martin and Vanderbilt. East Tennessee State is also restarting football this season after a 12-year absence.

Head Coach Donnie Suber



**Third Season as HC/
Eighth Season as
Defensive Coordinator/
Defensive Backs Coach**

Donnie Suber was named head coach at Cumberland University on January 28, 2013, the fifth head coach of the program since it was revived in 1990. He just finished his seventh season in his third stint at Cumberland, serving as the defensive coordinator and defensive backs coach. He has worked as an assistant coach at the collegiate level for the past 22 years, 11 of those at CU.

The Bulldogs continued their recent winning ways in Suber's first year at the helm of the program, posting four straight victories in the middle of the year and seven of the final nine outings to finish 7-4, the club's fourth consecutive winning season. Nathan Jernigan was voted Mid-South Conference West Division Freshman of the Year while four players earned First Team All-Mid-South West honors and five more garnered Second Team accolades.

Cumberland also led the Mid-South Conference with 28 Scholar-Athletes and ranked No. 1 in the nation for the second straight year with 16 Daktronics-NAIA Scholar-Athletes.

Last season the Bulldogs ended the year 6-5 overall, with five players garnering All-Mid-South Conference recognition, including defenders Grant Jones, Justus Dauscha and Nathan Jernigan.

Cumberland's defense has made significant improvements in Suber's six years at CU. The Bulldogs were ranked 47th or lower in every defensive statistical category in his first season as coordinator in 2008 but improved to 16th nationally in scoring defense along with eighth in pass defense, 21st in opponent first downs and 28th in total defense in 2009. Cumberland led the Mid-South Conference in almost every defensive category in 2010 and ranked in the Top 10 nationally in scoring defense, total defense, rush defense, pass defense, sacks, third down conversions and opponent first downs.



The unit forced 32 turnovers in 2009 and 2011 and 29 in 2010, a big jump over the 19 opponent miscues in his first year back at CU. The squad racked up 52 interceptions during that span, including 18 in 2009, 15 in 2010 and 19 in 2011. The defense played a major role in the team's offensive production in 2011 as well, with the Bulldogs scoring 120 points (17 touchdowns, 1 field goal) off opponent miscues. Cumberland scored off an opponent turnover in 16 straight games from October 23, 2010, at Bethel University until September 22, 2012, at UVA-Wise. From 2008-11, Cumberland posted 95 total sacks, including 32 in 2010 and 24 in 2009.

Cumberland has scored 16 defensive touchdowns, forced five safeties and blocked two punts recovered for touchdowns during Suber's tenure. Thirty-three Bulldogs have earned All-Mid-South Conference defensive honors during Suber's seven seasons as well, including two National Defensive Players of the Week in 2010 and one in 2014.

Suber earned his bachelor's in Recreation and Hotel Management from Georgia Southern in 1990 and played on NCAA Division I-AA national championship teams as a defensive back in 1986, 1989 and 1990.

His first coaching position was at Cumberland University as the defensive backs coach and strength coach as a graduate assistant. Suber earned his master's from Cumberland in Organizational Behavior in 1993.
