PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-OFFENSE

Josh Johnson, San Diego **Sophomore** **Quarterback**
Oakland, Calif. (Oakland Tech)

San Diego's Josh Johnson threw a game-winning touchdown with 6:37 remaining in the fourth quarter, then tacked on a two-point conversion toss for insurance as USD recorded the PFL's first-ever victory against the Ivy League in a 17-14 victory against Yale. Johnson completed 22-of-34 passes for 198 yards.

Scott Phaydavong, Drake **Sophomore** **Half Back**
Des Moines, Iowa (Air Force Prep Academy)

Drake's Scott Phaydavong didn't record a touchdown, but his 28 carries for 234 yards set up four touchdowns as Drake picked up its first-ever victory against Wisconsin-Platteville, 37-14. The 234 yards rushing are the third-most by a I-AA back in a single game this season. His first-half totals of 17 carries and 176 yards were the 10th best performance in I-AA for a single-game.

DEFENSE

James Adams, Drake **Junior** **Linebacker**
Kansas City, Mo. (Park Hill HS)

The Pioneers must have thought that Drake's James Adams was everywhere as the linebacker recorded 13 tackles (6 solo), including a tackle for loss, forced a fumble, which he then recovered and ran back 28 yards and then tacked on a 35-yard interception return for touchdown in Drake's dominant victory against Wisconsin-Platteville.

Ryan Horvath, Drake **Senior** **Kicker**
Overland Park, Kans. (Blue Valley North HS)

Drake's Ryan Horvath put together the seventh-best punting performance in I-AA this season, booming four punts for a 50.8 yard-per-punt average (203 total yards). All four punts were over 50 yards and two were placed inside the 20-yard line. Horvath added a 20-yard field goal and was 4-4 on PATS, accounting for seven points in Drake's home-opening victory.

PFL TO RETURN TO SINGLE-DIVISION FORMAT IN 2006: The Pioneer Football League will return to a single-division, round-robin format in 2006, the conference office announced, Sept. 7. The league voted this summer on the move back to a single-division format, which the league used in its first eight seasons. The change resulted from the league's reduction to eight members for the 2006 campaign – Austin Peay leaves the conference at the conclusion of the 2005 season. The final round-robin schedule will provide seven league games annually for all teams with alternating seasons of four home/three road and three home/four road.

2005 PIONEER FOOTBALL LEAGUE WEEKLY NOTES

2005 PFL CHAMPIONSHIP: The 2005 PFL Championship will be hosted by the PFL North champion, Nov. 19. It is the 5th PFL Championship since the beginning of the divisional era in 2000. The PFL North is undefeated in the four previous championships.

PFL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME ENDS AFTER 2005: With the 2006 change in regular-season scheduling, the PFL Championship will be discontinued after this season's championship game hosted by the PFL North champion, Nov. 19.

FG TRIFECTA: Kickers are getting a toehold in the PFL this season, with 18-of-27 (.667) field goal attempts being made this season. In fact, three PFL kickers have recorded three field goals in a contest this season and one – San Diego's Hutch Parker – has hit three in a game twice this season. The list of three-goal kickers:

- Hutch Parker (USD) vs Azusa Pacific, Sept. 3
- Bradley Wilson (APSU) vs Cumberland, Sept. 10
- Brad Smith (DAV) vs Lenoir-Rhyne, Sept. 17
- Hutch Parker (USD) vs Yale, Sept. 17

DAYTON AND THE SPORTS NETWORK POLL: Dayton is ranked #1 this week in the Sports Network poll. The Flyers have been ranked first in the Sports Network poll at least once in every year since the poll began in 2001. The Flyers have been ranked either first or second in the Sports Network I-AA Mid-Major poll for 48 of a possible 57 weeks the Sports Network poll has been in existence.

SAN DIEGO VS. IVY LEAGUE: San Diego posted the PFL's first-ever victory against an Ivy League opponent, coming from behind to win 17-14 in front of 3,266 at Torrero Stadium. It was the only loss by an Ivy League school last week, the opening weekend of Ivy play. USD now travels cross country to face Princeton, which opens a three-game homestand. The Torreros take a eight-game win streak into Princeton.

CONSTRUCTION MADNESS: Two PFL members are playing away from their friendly confines due to renovations at their on-campus facilities and a third just completed renovations to its facility.

Butler opened its season at the University of Indianapolis' Key Stadium due to renovations at the Butler Bowl – the first time since 1928 that the Bulldogs have played a home-opener away from the Butler Bowl.

Drake will play its entire 2005 home schedule away from 79-year old Drake Stadium which is getting a complete facelift which should be completed in time for the school's internationally-known Drake Relays. Drake will host its four home games at high school campuses in the Des Moines area.

Davidson dedicated the newest additions to its football venue, Richardson Stadium, during a halftime ceremony, Sept. 10. Among the upgraded amenities are expanded stadium seating, and a new press box, weight room and visitors' locker room.

DAYTON EXTENDS STREAK: Dayton shutout Austin Peay, 46-0, Saturday, to extend its streak of games without being shutout to 323. The Flyers were last shut out on Oct. 16, 1976, a 9-0 loss to Marshall.

NFL CONNECTIONS: San Diego head coach **Jim Harbaugh** isn't the only person with an NFL connection in the PFL. Davidson sophomore **Beaux Jones** is the son of former NFL quarterback Bert Jones, who played for the Baltimore Colts from 1973-1981.

Also, former Dallas Cowboy's kicker **Billy Cundiff** is a Drake alumnus. He was cut prior to the start of the 2005 season, but has three years of experience. Cundiff is in the NFL record books, with seven field goals made in a Monday Night overtime victory at the New York Giants last season.

Dayton's contribution to the NFL resides in Tampa Bay where head coach **Jon Gruden**, a 1986 grauate, became the second Dayton alumnus to coach a Super Bowl winner (XXXVII). He joined 1953 UD graduate and 1993 Pro Football Hall of Fame inductee Chuck Noll who won four Super Bowls (IX, X, XII, & XIV) as coach of the Pittsburgh Steelers.

PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATION: the Pioneer Football League's coaches tabbed Drake and Morehead State to win their respective divisions in the PFL's preseason poll. Drake is picked first for the first time since divisional play began while it is the fourth time in five seasons Morehead State has been chosen as the PFL South winner.

PFL NORTH POLL RESULTS: Drake, the 2004 PFL Champion, received five of the nine possible first-place votes in the PFL North. Dayton and San Diego split the four remaining first-place votes and were picked second and third, respectively. Valparaiso and Butler round out the five-team PFL North, the two teams selected in a fourth-place tie.

PFL SOUTH POLL RESULTS: Morehead State, the three-time PFL North defending champion, received five first-place votes. Second-place Jacksonville picked up three first-place votes while Austin Peay, which was picked third, claimed one first-place vote. Davidson rounds out the four-team PFL South.
