Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will look to make it three wins in four games and back-to-back victories on Wednesday evening as the Beacons make their way to Carbondale, Ill. to close out the regular-season series with Southern Illinois. This will mark the first time the Beacons have visited the Salukis since Jan. 30, 2022 as Valpo did not make the trip to Carbondale last season. According to KenPom, this is a matchup of the Missouri Valley Conference's most-experienced team (Southern Illinois, 67th nationally) and least-experienced team (Valpo, 356/362 nationally).

Last Time Out: UIC led for 36 minutes, 5 seconds, but Valpo led when it counted in an 84-77 victory on Saturday afternoon at the Athletics-Recreation Center that came despite the hosts leading for less than two minutes. Valpo rallied from 12 down thanks in part to a 19-point, nine-rebound performance from Cooper Schwieger. Ola Ajiboye poured in 16 points and seven rebounds, while Isaiah Stafford and Darius DeAveiro had 10 points apiece. Valpo outscored UIC 50-38 after halftime including a 9-0 run in crunch time that flipped the game's outcome.

Head Coach Roger Powell Jr.: Roger Powell Jr. (6-13) is in his first season as the head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program. After helping guide Gonzaga to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. He was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen in each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the

aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. During his stint as an assistant at Valpo, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell capped a prolific collegiate playing career at Illinois with a national title game appearance in 2005 before going on to a successful professional playing career.

Jan. 10 – Southern Illinois 77, Valpo 68: Isaiah Stafford (19) and Darius DeAveiro (18) led Valpo in scoring as the Beacons outscored Southern Illinois 44-33 after halftime, but the Salukis prevailed 77-68 thanks to a 20-point halftime lead at the Athletics-Recreation Center. Valpo shot a robust 63 percent after the break on a night where the nation's second leading scorer – SIU's Xavier Johnson – had 22 points and seven assists.

Series Notes: Southern Illinois owns a 16-14 lead in an all-time series that dates back to 1928. The Salukis also have a 7-5 edge in the 12 games that have occurred since Valpo joined The Valley. SIU has won five straight head-to-head meetings in a series that has seen four of the last six decided by four points or fewer. This is the second time these two teams face off in a five-game span.

Scouting the Salukis

- Have dropped all three games they've played since the last Valpo/SIU matchup, falling vs. Drake (76-58), vs. Bradley (70-69) and most recently at UNI (61-57) on Saturday.
- Had won six straight before the current three-game skid.
- Larry Bird MVC Player of the Year candidate Xavier Johnson is the league's leading scorer at 23.2 points per game (third nationally) and leads the league at 6.1 assists per game (17th nationally).
- Picked ninth of 12 in the MVC preseason poll despite going 23-10 and 14-6 in MVC play a year ago.

Cardiac Kids

- Valpo trailed by as many as 12 including an 11-point deficit with 7:47 remaining and still a four-point gap with 2:30 to go, but the Beacons rallied past UIC 84-77 on Jan. 20.
- This marked the team's first double-figure comeback this season and the program's biggest rally since overcoming a 12-point deficit on Nov. 20, 2021 vs. Tulane in the Bahamas.
- After UIC led 70-59 with 7:47 on the clock, the Beacons outscored the Flames 25-7 for the remainder of the game.
- Valpo had just a 5.4 percent win probability midway through the second half, according to KenPom.

A Charitable Effort

- Valpo went 22-of-24 (91.7 percent) at the free-throw line in the Jan. 20 win over UIC, the team's best day at the stripe this season in terms of both made free throws and free-throw percentage.
- This was Valpo's highest made free-throw total since last season's home game against UIC (23, Jan. 17, 2023). This was the team's best percentage at the stripe (minimum seven attempts) since Feb. 12, 2022 at Missouri State (92.6 percent).
- Cooper Schwieger (9-for-9) and Ola Ajiboye (6-for-6) were both perfect at the free-throw line. Schwieger became the first Valpo player to go perfect at the foul line with nine or more attempts since Tevonn Walker went 10-for-10 back on Jan. 3, 2018 at Bradley.
- Since 2010, Schwieger was just the fourth different Valpo player to go perfect at the line with nine or more attempts, joining Walker (twice), Shane Hammink, Alec Peters (twice) and Ryan Broekhoff.
- Valpo went 19-of-21 (90.5 percent) at the free-throw line in the second half after having just three attempts in the first stanza. It was Valpo's highest made free-throw total in a single half since the second half of a Feb. 7, 2021 win over Drake.

Freshman on Fire

- Cooper Schwieger nearly picked up his third straight double-double when he had 19 points and nine rebounds on Jan. 20 vs. UIC. This marked his highest scoring output in league play, his third straight double-figure performance and his second-highest point total of the season behind 21 on Dec. 29 at Elon.
- Schwieger recorded eight or more rebounds for the fifth straight game.
- Schwieger has made 15 straight free throws since Jan. 10 vs. SIU, going 6-of-6 at Illinois State and 9-of-9 vs. UIC (no attempts at Evansville).
- He enjoyed his first collegiate double-double with a 16-point, 13-rebound effort on Jan. 14 at Illinois State before following with another double-double on Jan. 17 at Evansville, turning in 12 points and 10 boards.
- He became the third Valpo player with a double-double this season, joining Jaxon Edwards (Jan. 6 at UIC) and Jerome Palm (Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois). He became the first Beacon with multiple double-doubles this year.
- His 13 boards at Illinois State outdid his previous personal best of eight that was reached on Nov. 6 vs. Trinity Christian and Jan. 6 at UIC.
- In the game at Illinois State, Schwieger notched the first double-double by a Valpo freshman since Javon Freeman-Liberty on Jan. 29, 2019 vs. Missouri State. He collected the most rebounds by a Valpo player in an MVC game since Donovan Clay had 14 on Feb. 7, 2021 vs. Drake.
- Schwieger became the first Valpo player with back-to-back double-doubles since Sheldon Edwards on Feb. 19, 2022 at Evansville and

Rookie Report

- Cooper Schwieger is averaging 11.2 points per game and 5.7 rebounds per game this season.
- The Overland Park, Kan. native ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring average among freshmen. He is behind only Drake's Kevin Overton (12.5 ppg).
- Schwieger leads the league in rebounds per game among freshmen, well ahead of Evansville Joshua Hughes, who ranks second at 4.6.
- He also ranks second among MVC freshmen with 0.9 blocks per game.
- Schwieger is one of 10 freshmen nationally averaging at least 11.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game.
- Schwieger ranks sixth in the MVC in conference-only rebounding average at 7.1 and is the only freshman in the top 30.
- Schwieger's rebounding average of 5.7 per game currently ranks second among Valpo freshmen in the last 30 years behind only Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2024 member Ratis Grafs (5.8, 1999-00).

Ajiboye's Big Day

- Ola Ajiboye scored 16 points and pulled down seven rebounds in the Jan. 20 win over UIC. He went 5-of-7 from the floor and 6-of-6 from the free-throw line.
- He played 29 minutes, his second-highest total of the season and highest since Nov. 21.
- Ajiboye enjoyed his third double-figure scoring effort of the season and first since Nov. 21, when he scored 21 vs. Western Illinois.
- Ajiboye collected seven rebounds, tied with the previous game against UIC for his highest total in league play. This marked his fifth time with seven or more rebounds this season.
- Ajiboye's 16 points were more than he had scored in the previous five games combined (15).
- Ajiboye received the "Grit Chain" from the Valpo coaching staff, which is handed out to the game's grittiest player, for the win over the Flames.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Jan. 20: Valpo 84, UIC 77

- Valpo's 84 points marked the team's highest scoring output in a regulation MVC game since Feb. 25, 2020 vs. Missouri State (89).

- Valpo picked up its first win of the season when allowing 70+points. The Beacons were previously 0-10 in such games.
- Cooper Schwieger (19) and Ola Ajiboye (16) were joined in double figures by Darius DeAveiro (10) and Isaiah Stafford (10).
- The Beacons owned a 42-26 rebounding advantage and held an 11-5 edge on the offensive glass. This marked just the fifth time this season and fourth against a Division-I opponent that Valpo owned the edge on the glass, including both matchups with UIC.
- By going +16 in the rebounding department, Valpo owned its biggest edge on the boards this season. That was the team's top rebounding margin since Feb. 21, 2022, +16 vs. Evansville.
- Valpo turned it over just eight times, while UIC gave it away on only five occasions. This was the Valpo's third time this season with single-digit turnovers and first since Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois. The five turnovers for UIC marked a season low for the Flames and their lowest total in a true road game in 15 years.
- Valpo pulled out the win despite leading for just 1 minute, 59 seconds, while the Flames held the upper hand for 36:05.
- Valpo picked up its second win of the season when trailing at halftime (previously 1-11) and first since Nov. 14 vs. Green Bay.

Stafford Going Strong

- Since returning to the floor on Jan. 6 at UIC after missing the previous two games with an injury, Isaiah Stafford has scored in double figures in five straight games including three contests with 19 points or more.
- The junior college transfer has led the team in scoring (outright or tied) in 11 of his 17 games this season.
- Stafford, who ranks seventh in the MVC in scoring at 16.7 points per game, has scored 17 points or more in 10 of his 17 contests.
- Stafford is averaging 18.7 points per game in MVC play, which would be Valpo's third-highest league-only scoring average in the last 30 years behind Ben Krikke's 2022-23 (21.0 ppg) and Alec Peters' 2016-17 (20.9). Stafford ranks fourth in the MVC in league-only scoring average this year.
- In the Dec. 9 game at Virginia Tech, Stafford became the first Valpo player with 14+ points, four or more steals and multiple blocks in a game since Ryan Broekhoff on Feb. 10, 2011 vs. Detroit Mercy.

Darius Delivering

- Darius DeAveiro has already passed 100 assists for the season, as he has handed out 102 in 19 games. He's up to 220 career assists, reaching the 200 milestone on Jan. 10 vs. Southern Illinois.
- DeAveiro ranks 27th nationally and second in the MVC with 102 total assists and ranks 32nd in the country and second in the league at 5.4 assists per game.
- DeAveiro has scored nine points or more in seven straight games and is averaging 11.9 points per game in MVC play. This comes

after he averaged 1.4 points per game in conference action last season.

- Overall, the Valpo point guard is averaging 8.2 points per game this season after averaging 1.8 ppg a year ago.
- DeAveiro is hoping to become just the third Valpo player in the last 30 years to average at least 5.5 assists per game. The last to do so was Ali Berdeil in 2003-04 (6.0) and before that it was Bryce Drew in 1994-95 (6.0).
- His 10 assists in this season's game vs. Samford tied a career high set on Nov. 13, 2022 vs. Western Michigan.
- DeAveiro scored in double figures in four straight games from Dec. 29 to Jan. 10 after entering that stretch with two double-figure scoring outputs in his first 66 collegiate contests. He scored 18 or more in two of those contests.

We Are Young

- Valpo's 2023-24 roster is a new-look group that is among the nation's most inexperienced teams.
- The Beacons rank 356 of 362 in the KenPom "experience factor" at 0.54. The experience factor is calculated using eligibility class weighted by minutes played.
- The only more inexperienced teams nationally, per KenPom, are Notre Dame, Boston, Saint Francis, Siena, Northwestern State and Idaho.
- Valpo has four freshmen with multiple double-figure scoring outputs this season - Jahari Williamson, Kaspar Sepp, Cooper Schwieger and Sherman Weatherspoon IV. The last time that occurred was 2013-14 – Alec Peters, Clay Yeo, Lexus Williams and Jubril Adekoya.

Sciarroni on Scholarship

- Head coach Roger Powell Jr. presented former walk-on Anthony Sciarroni with scholarship papers on Jan. 16 as part of "Team Time." He has earned an athletic scholarship for the Spring 2024 semester.
- Sciarroni spent three seasons on the Valpo football team, a member of the Division-I, nonscholarship Pioneer Football League, before joining the basketball program first as a manager, then as a walk-on and now as a scholarship player.
- -At St. Francis de Sales High School, Sciarroni was a four-year letter winner in basketball and was a team captain each of his final two seasons.

Weekly Awards Pile Up

- Cooper Schwieger was named the MVC Freshman of the Week for the second time this season on Jan. 15. This came after he averaged a double-double of 12.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in games against Illinois State and Southern Illinois.
- This was the fourth time a Beacon had captured an MVC weekly honor this season. Schwieger was previously named MVC Freshman of the Week on Nov. 27, while Jahari Williamson earned that award on Jan. 2. Isaiah Stafford was tabbed MVC Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 20.
- This season has already tied for the program's most MVC weekly awards since joining the conference.

Close Calls

- Seven of Valpo's 13 losses have been decided by single figures including each of the team's last three setbacks.
- The team's 78-75 loss at Evansville on Jan. 17 marked the fourth time this season that the Beacons have dropped a game decided by four points or fewer.
- Dating back to last season, the Beacons have dropped nine straight games decided by four points or fewer with their most recent win by four points or fewer coming on Nov. 27, 2022 vs. James Madison.
- The Jan. 17 game at Evansville was the team's second game decided by three points or fewer this season (Dec. 16 vs. Chicago State) and first in league play since Feb. 26, 2023 at Murray State (L 77-76 in OT).

River City Return

- Isaiah Stafford made his return to the city of Evansville a memorable one on Jan. 17 by tying a career high and establishing a season best with a 31-point effort against the Purple Aces.
- Stafford outdid his previous Beacon best of 30 points, which came on Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois. He matched his overall NCAA career high of 31 that was established while playing for Southern Indiana which is also located in Evansville back on Feb. 26, 2022 in a game against Lindenwood.
- Stafford's showing included 10 made field goals, five made 3s and six made free throws. The five made triples tied his season high

that was established in the Nov. 6 opener vs. Trinity Christian. He also pulled down five rebounds and had two steals against the Purple Aces.

- Stafford had the highest scoring output by a Valpo player since Ben Krikke's 34 on Feb. 19 of last season at UIC. He became just the fourth different Valpo player in the last decade to score more than 30 points in a single game, joining program greats Ben Krikke (twice), Javon Freeman-Liberty and Alec Peters (6x).

Chasing 1,000 Across All Levels

- Although points scored at the junior college level are not officially recognized, Isaiah Stafford is closing in on 1,000 points as a college basketball player if those scored last season at John A. Logan College are considered.
- He scored 436 points for the Vols to go along with 203 as a freshman at Southern Indiana and 284 this year with the Beacons. All told, he has scored 923 points as a college basketball player, needing 77 to get to 1,000.

Hall Call

- Two former Valpo men's basketball standouts are part of the Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2024, which will be inducted as part of Valpo's All-Sports Reunion Weekend that is slated to take place on Feb. 9-10.
- 2003 graduate Raitis Grafs, a three-time all-conference performer, will be part of the four-member class. He currently ranks second in program history in blocked shots (228), fourth in rebounds (841) and sixth in points (1,621).
- The class will also feature 1964 alum Jon Robsch, who was a two-sport standout in baseball and basketball. He ranks fifth in program history in rebounds per game at 8.7 and his average of 10.3 rebounds per game as a senior still ranks eighth in program history.
- The class also features former softball standout Jordan Rutkowski '12 and former football star Ozzie Young '96. The Feb. 10 men's basketball game vs. Belmont will be part of the All-Sports Reunion festivities.

3-Point Sharpshooting

- Valpo's 11 made 3s marked the team's most since 14 in the season opener vs. Trinity Christian. That was the team's most made 3s against a Division-I opponent since Feb. 4, 2023, 12 in a double overtime game vs. Drake. This was Valpo's most made 3s in a regulation game vs. a Division-I opponent since Dec. 22, 2021 vs. William & Mary and most in a true road game since Feb. 13, 2021 at UNI.
- Evansville was hot from long range, hitting 3s at a 62.5 percent clip (10-of-16). Valpo went from its season best in terms of 3-point defense on Jan. 14 at Illinois State (5.6 percent) to the highest opposing 3-point percentage of the season on Jan. 17 at Evansville

(62.5 percent).

- The 62.5 percent showing by Evansville was the best 3-point percentage by a Valpo opponent since Chicago State on Nov. 16, 2022 (also 62.5 percent). It was the best in league play since Feb. 15, 2009 (UIC, 63.2 percent).
- Valpo simply faced a hot-shooting opponent as Evansville posted its best 3-point percentage in a single game since Dec. 5, 2017 at Bowling Green (80 percent).

Other Notes Wrapping Up Jan. 17: Evansville 78, Valpo 75

- Four Valpo players finished in double figures Isaiah Stafford (31), Cooper Schwieger (12), Darius DeAveiro (12) and Jahari Williamson (10).
- The game featured 12 ties and nine lead changes.
- Valpo was attempting to overcome a size disparity as Evansville leads the MVC in average height, ranking 48th nationally per KenPom, while Valpo ranks 11th in the MVC and 313th nationally in average height.
- Valpo pulled down 14 offensive rebounds, outscoring UE 20-8 on second-chance points.
- A five-game head-to-head winning streak against Evansville was snapped.
- Before this contest, Valpo was 9-1 in its last 10 games when making 10 or more 3-pointers and the lone loss was in overtime. The 11 Valpo triples came from three players Stafford (5), DeAveiro (3) and Williamson (3).

Defense Travels

- The 59-50 win at Illinois State on Jan. 14 marked the program's best statistical defensive performance in eight years based on points allowed, field goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage defense.
- The Beacons limited the Redbirds to 50 points, the lowest total by a Valpo opponent since an 85-45 win over Judson on Dec. 6, 2020 and the lowest by a Division-I opponent since a 55-38 win vs. Southern Illinois on Feb. 12, 2020.
- This was the fewest points permitted by Valpo in a true road game since Feb. 16, 2016, a 66-43 win at Cleveland State.
- Valpo held Illinois State to 5.6 percent from 3-point distance (1-of-18) and 32.2 percent from the field. That marked Valpo's best 3-point defense in a game since holding Cleveland State to 1-of-18 way back on Jan. 4, 2013. This was the first time Valpo limited an opponent to one made 3 or fewer in the opponent's home gym since Cleveland State on Feb. 19, 2012.
- This marked the first time Valpo held an opponent below 33 percent shooting since Feb. 27, 2021 vs. Indiana State. This was the team's best field goal percentage defense in a road game since a 66-43 win at Cleveland State on Feb. 16, 2016.
- The only thing colder than Illinois State's shooting was the sub-zero temperatures in the Bloomington-Normal area.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Jan. 13: Valpo 59, Illinois State 50

- Darius DeAveiro made his first three free throws to extend his streak of free-throw makes to 15 before finally misfiring at the stripe. Prior to the miss, DeAveiro was 22-of-23 from the foul line since Dec. 3.
- As a team, Valpo shot 84.6 percent (11-of-13) from the charity stripe against the Redbirds. That marked the team's top single-game free-throw percentage

this season. It was the team's top free-throw percentage since 90.9 on Feb. 4, 2023 vs. Drake.

- DeAveiro had eight assists to go along with nine points and four rebounds. Valpo was paced by Cooper Schwieger (16 points, 13 rebounds) and Isaiah Stafford (11 points).
- Sherman Weatherspoon IV made his first collegiate start. He became the fourth Valpo freshman to start a game this season. The starting five against the Redbirds featured three rookies.
- No Illinois State players scored in double figures.
- Valpo lost the turnover battle 11-7 but won the game, the team's first victory when committing more turnovers than the opposition this season (previously 0-5).
- Valpo continued its success in the all-time series with Illinois State, beating the Redbirds for the 10th time in the last 11 matchups.
- The nation's seventh most inexperienced team according to KenPom, Valpo knocked off a much more veteran Illinois State team that ranks 66th nationally and second in the MVC in experience, per KenPom.
- Valpo ended a 10-game losing streak with the team's first triumph since Nov. 25 vs. Southern and an 11-game road losing streak that dated back to Jan. 21, 2023 at Illinois State.
- Roger Powell Jr. earned his first road win as a head coach. It was fitting that the victory took place at Illinois State, where his father Roger Powell Sr. is a former men's basketball standout and a member of the Illinois State Athletics Hall of Fame.

Who's Next?

- Justus McNair signed his National Letter of Intent to continue his basketball career at Valpo during the November signing period.
- The Joliet West senior and Joliet, Ill. native has a deep connection to head coach Roger Powell Jr. His parents grew up with Powell in Joliet.
- McNair, a 6-foot-3 guard, lists going to state in eighth grade as a favorite basketball memory. He also highlighted last season's Joliet West sectional championship appearance, fueled by a late-season, 14-game winning streak and a 29-6 record.
- Powell on McNair: "I'm extremely excited about this young man from Joliet, Ill., my hometown. He's a tough, physical and athletic guard who will add even more athleticism and ability to shoot the ball to our team next year. I'm fired up and can't wait to get him here and help us continue to build a winning tradition."

Roger Powell Jr.

Head Coach 1st Season * Illinois, 2005 6-13 Overall and at Valpo

Roger Powell Jr. was named the 23rd head coach of the Valparaiso University men's basketball program on April 7, 2023.

After helping guide Gonzaga University to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. Powell becomes the first Black head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program.

Powell was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. The 2020-21 team spent the entire season ranked No. 1 in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 overall seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2021 and 2022.

Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. In his first season in Nashville, he helped lead the Commodores to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Vanderbilt notched five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins while playing the toughest strength of schedule nationally.

During Powell's first stint on the Valpo bench, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. Valpo reached postseason tournaments in each of his five seasons on staff, including the memorable run to the NIT title game in 2016 which featured wins over Florida State, Saint Mary's and BYU.

A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell was a three-year starter for the University of Illinois during his playing days, earning Honorable Mention All-Big Ten recognition in each of his final two seasons after being named to the Big Ten All-Tournament Team as a sophomore. His winning track record dates as far back as his days playing for the Illini, when he helped the team to three Big Ten regular-season titles, two Big Ten Tournament crowns and three Sweet Sixteen berths. During his senior year in 2004-05, Powell was part of an Illini team that finished 37-2, won 29 straight to open the season and reached the national title game.

Powell accumulated 1,178 points and 531 rebounds during his four-year career at Illinois. He finished his career ranked among the top 30 scorers in program history. Following his collegiate tenure, Powell began a professional career that included a stint in the NBA with the Utah Jazz during the 2006-2007 season. He also played for the Rockford Lightning (CBA, 2005-06), Arkansas Rimrockers (2006-07, D-League), Siviglia Wear Teramo (Italy, 2007-08), Murcia (Spain, 2009-10), JDA Dijon (France, 2010) and Skyliners Frankfurt (Germany, 2010-11).

Off the court, Powell founded RPJ Ministries Organization, which mentors and trains young leaders to be Godly examples on their sports team and school campuses. He also founded Integrity Sports Corporation, a company focused on building basketball skills and integrity of high school and junior high athletes. Powell is a 2005 graduate of the University of Illinois with a degree in speech communications and received his master's degree in Sports Administration from Valpo in 2016.

Powell and his wife, Tara, have four children – Bria, Liam, Gabriel and Faith.
