Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will continue a set of back-to-back Missouri Valley Conference road games on Wednesday as the Beacons voyage to Evansville, Ind. to square off with the Purple Aces. Valpo will look to make it consecutive wins after capturing a victory at Illinois State on Sunday.

Last Time Out: Cooper Schwieger had his first collegiate double-double with 16 points and a season-high 13 rebounds to help Valpo to a 59-50 victory on Sunday at Illinois State, snapping a 10-game skid with the young team's first road win and first Missouri Valley Conference triumph in 2023-24. It was Valpo's best statistical defensive performance in a road game in eight years, holding Illinois State to 32 percent shooting and 5.6 percent from 3-point range. Valpo has outscored the opponent in three straight halves – the second half vs. Southern Illinois and both halves at Illinois State.

Head Coach Roger Powell Jr.: Roger Powell Jr. (5-12) is in his first season as the head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program. After helping guide Gonzaga to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a programrecord 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. He was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen in each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. During his stint as an assistant at Valpo, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-

year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell capped a prolific collegiate playing career at Illinois with a national title game appearance in 2005 before going on to a successful professional playing career.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 25-72 all-time record as the two teams prepare for the 98th installment of this instate matchup. Valpo has won five straight meetings, sweeping Evansville last season 76-69 on Jan. 14 at the Ford Center and 81-69 on Jan. 28 at the ARC. Evansville is the second most common opponent in program history as Valpo has played only Butler (103) more frequently. Valpo is 8-2 in the last 10 showdowns including Arch Madness victories in 2020 and 2022.

Scouting the Purple Aces

- Under the direction of second-year head coach David Ragland, who spent two seasons on Valpo's staff as an assistant coach in 2016-17 and 2017-18.
- Two-time Valpo graduate Peter Funk is in his first year at Evansville as Assistant Coach/Chief of Staff after spending seven years at Valpo as a student manager, graduate assistant and most recently Director of Basketball Operations.
- Picked to finish 11th of 12 in the MVC preseason poll.
- Started the season 10-2 with the only losses coming to BYU and Missouri State. That stretch featured an early-season conference win vs. UNI, 91-89.
- Followed the 10-2 start with a current five-game slide, most recently falling 74-64 to Missouri State on Saturday. Other MVC losses during this skid have come to Indiana State (87-73), Murray State (81-59) and Bradley (86-50).
- Led in scoring by Ben Humrichous at 16.3 points per game.

Defense Travels

- The 59-50 win at Illinois State on Jan. 14 marked the program's best statistical defensive performance in eight years based on points allowed, field goal percentage defense and 3-point field goal percentage defense.
- The Beacons limited the Redbirds to 50 points, the lowest total by a Valpo opponent since an 85-45 win over Judson on Dec. 6, 2020 and the lowest by a Division-I opponent since a 55-38 win vs. Southern Illinois on Feb. 12, 2020.
- This was the fewest points permitted by Valpo in a true road game since Feb. 16, 2016, a 66-43 win at Cleveland State.
- Valpo held Illinois State to 5.6 percent from 3-point distance (1-of-18) and 32.2 percent from the field. That marked Valpo's best 3-point defense in a game since holding Cleveland State to 1-of-18 way back on Jan. 4, 2013. This was the first time Valpo limited an

opponent to one made 3 or fewer in the opponent's home gym since Cleveland State on Feb. 19, 2012.

- This marked the first time Valpo held an opponent below 33 percent shooting since Feb. 27, 2021 vs. Indiana State. This was the team's best field goal percentage defense in a road game since a 66-43 win at Cleveland State on Feb. 16, 2016.
- The only thing colder than Illinois State's shooting was the sub-zero temperatures in the Bloomington-Normal area.

First Collegiate Double-Double

- Cooper Schwieger enjoyed his first collegiate double-double with a 16-point, 13-rebound effort on Jan. 14 at Illinois State.
- He became the third Valpo player with a double-double this season, joining Jaxon Edwards (Jan. 6 at UIC) and Jerome Palm (Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois).
- Schwieger's 16 points marked his most in the last four games. He went 5-of-7 from the field and 6-of-6 at the free-throw line.
- His 13 boards outdid his previous personal best of eight that was reached on Nov. 6 vs. Trinity Christian and Jan. 6 at UIC.
- Schwieger notched the first double-double by a Valpo freshman since Javon Freeman-Liberty on Jan. 29, 2019 vs. Missouri State. He collected the most rebounds by a Valpo player in an MVC game since Donovan Clay had 14 on Feb. 7, 2021 vs. Drake.

With a Win on Wednesday, Valpo Would...

- Own back-to-back wins for the second time this season (Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois and Nov. 25 vs. Southern.)
- Extend the team's head-to-head winning streak against Evansville to six.
- Win consecutive road games for the first time since January of last season, also at Evansville (Jan. 14) and at Illinois State (Jan. 21).
- Win back-to-back games with both coming on the road for the first time since Jan. 23-24, 2021 at Illinois State, when two teams played each other back-to-back nights at the same location due to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Win consecutive games at two different road locations for the first time since 2016-17 (at Youngstown State, at Cleveland State).

Other Notes Wrapping Up Jan. 13: Valpo 59, Illinois State 50

- Darius DeAveiro made his first three free throws to extend his streak of free-throw makes to 15 before finally misfiring at the stripe. Prior to the miss, DeAveiro was 22-of-23 from the foul line since Dec. 3.
- As a team, Valpo shot 84.6 percent (11-of-13) from the charity stripe against the Redbirds. That marked the team's top single-game free-throw percentage this season. It was the team's top free-throw percentage since 90.9 on Feb. 4, 2023 vs. Drake.
- DeAveiro had eight assists to go along with nine points and four rebounds. Valpo was paced by Cooper Schwieger (16 points, 13

- Sherman Weatherspoon IV made his first collegiate start. He became the fourth Valpo freshman to start a game this season. The starting five against the Redbirds featured three rookies.
- No Illinois State players scored in double figures.
- Valpo lost the turnover battle 11-7 but won the game, the team's first victory when committing more turnovers than the opposition this season (previously 0-5).
- Valpo continued its success in the all-time series with Illinois State, beating the Redbirds for the 10th time in the last 11 matchups.
- The nation's seventh most inexperienced team according to KenPom, Valpo knocked off a much more veteran Illinois State team that ranks 66th nationally and second in the MVC in experience, per KenPom.
- Valpo ended a 10-game losing streak with the team's first triumph since Nov. 25 vs. Southern and an 11-game road losing streak that dated back to Jan. 21, 2023 at Illinois State.
- Roger Powell Jr. earned his first road win as a head coach. It was fitting that the victory took place at Illinois State, where his father Roger Powell Sr. is a former men's basketball standout and a member of the Illinois State Athletics Hall of Fame.

Stafford Going Strong

- Isaiah Stafford returned to the floor on Jan. 6 at UIC after missing the previous two games with an injury that occurred on Dec. 19 vs. Samford. In his return to action, Valpo's leading scorer turned in 19 points to pace the team, then he followed that up with another 19-point showing on Jan. 10 vs. Southern Illinois.
- Stafford made it three straight double-figure scoring outputs with 11 points on Jan. 14 at Illinois State. He also squeezed five rebounds in that one, tied for his most in the last eight games.
- The junior college transfer has led the team in scoring (outright or tied) in 10 of his 15 games this season.
- Stafford, who ranks eighth in the MVC in scoring at 16.2 points per game, has scored 17 points or more in nine of his 15 contests.
- In the Dec. 9 game at Virginia Tech, Stafford became the first Valpo player with 14+ points, four or more steals and multiple blocks in a game since Ryan Broekhoff on Feb. 10, 2011 vs. Detroit Mercy.

Handing Out Helpers

- Darius DeAveiro is already on the cusp of 100 assists for the season, as he has handed out 94 in just 17 games. He's up to 212 career assists, reaching the 200 milestone on Jan. 10 vs. Southern Illinois.
- DeAveiro ranks 30th nationally and second in the MVC with 94 total assists and ranks 33rd in the country and second in the league at 5.5 assists per game.
- By recording eight assists on Jan. 14 at Illinois State, DeAveiro made it 13 straight games with four or more helpers. That marked his second-highest assist total of the season behind only 10 on Dec. 19 vs. Samford.
- DeAveiro is on pace to become just the third Valpo player in the last 30 years to average at least 5.5 assists per game. The last to do so was Ali Berdeil in 2003-04 (6.0) and before that it was Bryce Drew in 1994-95 (6.0).
- His 10 assists in this season's game vs. Samford tied a career high set on Nov. 13, 2022 vs. Western Michigan.

Darius Delivering

- Darius DeAveiro has scored nine points or more in five straight games and is averaging 13.4 points per game during that stretch.
- DeAveiro scored in double figures in four straight games from Dec. 29 to Jan. 10 after entering that stretch with two double-figure scoring outputs in his first 66 collegiate contests. He scored 18 or more in two of those contests.
- DeAveiro is one of 10 players in the country averaging 7.5 points, 5.5 assists and shooting 80 percent or better at the free-throw line.
 - A breakout season for DeAveiro continued in a big way on Jan. 3 vs. Bradley, when he posted a career-high 19 points to go along with seven rebounds, four assists and one steal while committing just one turnover.
 - Since 2010, DeAveiro became just the seventh Valpo player with at least 19 points, seven rebounds and four assists in a game while committing one turnover or fewer. He joined a star-studded list of six Valpo greats who were all first-team all-conference performers
 - Brandon Wood, Ryan Broekhoff (twice), Alec Peters (3x), Tevonn Walker, Javon Freeman-Liberty (twice) and Ben Krikke. DeAveiro was the first to do it since Krikke on Jan. 25, 2023.
 - DeAveiro's career-high 19 points against the Braves easily outdid his previous career best of 11, which was reached twice this season (Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois, Nov. 29 vs. Drake). It also marked the first time in his collegiate career (68th game) that he led the team in scoring.
 - DeAveiro's seven rebounds vs. Bradley led the team, his second straight outing with seven boards after squeezing seven on Dec. 29 at Elon. Before the Elon game, DeAveiro's season high in the rebounding department was four and his career high was six, achieved back on Nov. 27, 2021 vs. Trinity Christian.

- Valpo's 2023-24 roster is a new-look group that is among the nation's most inexperienced teams.
- The Beacons rank 356 of 362 in the KenPom "experience factor" at 0.54. The experience factor is calculated using eligibility class weighted by minutes played.
- The only more inexperienced teams nationally, per KenPom, are Notre Dame, Boston, Saint Francis, Siena, Northwestern State and Idaho.
- Valpo has four freshmen with multiple double-figure scoring outputs this season Jahari Williamson, Kaspar Sepp, Cooper Schwieger and Sherman Weatherspoon IV. The last time that occurred was 2013-14 Alec Peters, Clay Yeo, Lexus Williams and Jubril Adekoya.

Rookie Report

- Cooper Schwieger is averaging 10.6 points per game and 5.2 rebounds per game this season.
- The Overland Park, Kan. native ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring average among freshmen at 10.3 points per game. He is behind only Drake's Kevin Overton (12.6 ppg).
- Schwieger ranks second among MVC freshmen with 0.9 blocks per game and leads the league in rebounds per game among freshmen at 5.2.
- Schwieger is one of 13 freshmen nationally averaging at least 10.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

Second-Half Sharpshooting

- Valpo finished with a season-best field-goal percentage of 51.0 on Jan. 10 vs. Southern Illinois.
- This marked the team's highest shooting clip since Feb. 11, 2023 vs. Illinois State (54.9 percent).
- In the game against the Salukis, Valpo went just 8-of-22 (36.4 percent) from the field before halftime before hitting at a 63 percent clip (17-of-27) after the break. The game completely flipped on both ends of the floor after the break as SIU shot 60.7 percent in the opening half but 39.1 percent after halftime.
- Both teams finished the game at exactly 51 percent shooting. This was just the third Valpo game since joining the Missouri Valley Conference where both teams shot over 50 percent, and both previous games were against Loyola Feb. 16, 2022 at the ARC and Feb. 9, 2020 in Chicago.
- This was the second time in the last four games that Valpo shot above 60 percent in the second half. The team hit at a 61.3 percent clip after halftime at Elon. The 63 percent against the Salukis was the team's best single-half shooting percentage since the first half of the 2022-23 season opener on Nov. 7, 2022 at Toledo when Valpo shot 65.5 percent.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Jan. 10: SIU 77, Valpo 68

- Valpo outscored SIU 44-33 in the second half, the first time the Beacons have held the upper hand in a half in a Missouri Valley Conference game this season. It marked the team's best half in any game since outscoring Central Michigan 45-34 after the break on Dec. 6.
- Isaiah Stafford (19) and Darius DeAveiro (18) were the team's top scorers, while Cooper Schwieger had a team-best seven rebounds to go along with his nine points and Sherman Weatherspoon IV played a season-high 25 minutes and tallied eight points.
- SIU's Xavier Johnson, the nation's second leading scorer, had 22 points including 10-of-10 at the free-throw line.
- Longtime Valpo fan and 1942 graduate Connie Bretscher celebrated her 103rd birthday by attending the game.

Williamson Captures MVC Honor

- Valpo's Jahari Williamson was named the Missouri Valley Conference Freshman of the Week on Jan. 2 following his careerhigh 24 points on Dec. 29 at Elon.
- Making his first collegiate start in the game against the Phoenix, Williamson knocked down five 3s and was a perfect 7-of-7 at the free-throw line. He also had five rebounds and two assists. The scoring output outdid his previous season best of 20 that came on Dec. 16 vs. Chicago State.
- Williamson's 24 points marked the most by a Valpo rookie since Javon Freeman-Liberty had 27 on Feb. 5, 2019 at Illinois State.
- Williamson became the third Beacon to achieve a Missouri Valley Conference weekly award this season, joining Isaiah Stafford

- (Nov. 20, Newcomer of the Week) and Cooper Schwieger (Nov. 27, Freshman of the Week). This year's team has already tied for Valpo's second most weekly awards in a single season since joining the MVC and needs just one more weekly honor to tie for the program's most since joining the conference.
- Valpo became the first Valley team this season to have two different players who have won the MVC Freshman of the Week Award (Williamson and Schwieger).
- Stafford's recognition came after he averaged 24.0 points per game against Green Bay and No. 23 Illinois including 30 against the Fighting Illini. Schwieger's came after a week where he averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in wins over Western Illinois and Southern.

20-Point Tandem

- On Dec. 29 vs. Elon, Cooper Schwieger and Jahari Williamson both eclipsed 20 points, marking the first time a Valpo tandem turned that trick since Ben Krikke and Kobe King did it on Feb. 14 of last season vs. Southern Illinois.
- This marked the first time in over 30 years that a pair of Valpo rookies each reached the 20-point threshold. No freshman tandem had achieved that feat since at least the start of the Homer Drew head coaching era in 1988-89.
- This marked the first time Valpo had a pair of 20-point scorers in a true road game since Dec. 18, 2019 at High Point (Javon Freeman-Liberty and Eron Gordon).

Underclassmen on Display

- A young and inexperienced team was even more young and inexperienced on Dec. 29 at Elon as junior Isaiah Stafford was sidelined with an injury.
- Three of the five starters in that game were freshmen and four were underclassmen, including rookie Jahari Williamson, who made his first collegiate start.
- Of the team's 78 points at Elon, 51 (65.3 percent) were scored by freshmen and 68 (87.2 percent) were scored by freshmen and sophomores.
- Williamson scored a career-high 24 points, knocked down five 3s and was a perfect 7-of-7 at the free-throw line. He also had five rebounds and two assists. He outdid his previous season best of 20 that came on Dec. 16 vs. Chicago State.
- Cooper Schwieger went 7-of-11 from the field for a season-high 21 points with the bulk of his damage coming after halftime. Over the final 20 minutes, he scored 15 points on 6-of-7 shooting. Schwieger outdid his previous personal best of 18 that occurred on Dec. 2 at Belmont.

Roger Powell Jr.

Head Coach 1st Season * Illinois, 2005 5-12 Overall and at Valpo

Roger Powell Jr. was named the 23rd head coach of the Valparaiso University men's basketball program on April 7, 2023.

After helping guide Gonzaga University to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. Powell becomes the first Black head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program.

Powell was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. The 2020-21 team spent the entire season ranked No. 1 in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 overall seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2021 and 2022.

Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. In his first season in Nashville, he helped lead the Commodores to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Vanderbilt notched five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins while playing the toughest strength of schedule nationally.

During Powell's first stint on the Valpo bench, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. Valpo reached postseason tournaments in each of his five seasons on staff, including the memorable run to the NIT title game in 2016 which featured wins over Florida State, Saint Mary's and BYU.

A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell was a three-year starter for the University of Illinois during his playing days, earning Honorable Mention All-Big Ten recognition in each of his final two seasons after being named to the Big Ten All-Tournament Team as a sophomore. His winning track record dates as far back as his days playing for the Illini, when he helped the team to three Big Ten regular-season titles, two Big Ten Tournament crowns and three Sweet Sixteen berths. During his senior year in 2004-05, Powell was part of an Illini team that finished 37-2, won 29 straight to open the season and reached the national title game.

Powell accumulated 1,178 points and 531 rebounds during his four-year career at Illinois. He finished his career ranked among the top 30 scorers in program history. Following his collegiate tenure, Powell began a professional career that included a stint in the NBA with the Utah Jazz during the 2006-2007 season. He also played for the Rockford Lightning (CBA, 2005-06), Arkansas Rimrockers (2006-07, D-League), Siviglia Wear Teramo (Italy, 2007-08), Murcia (Spain, 2009-10), JDA Dijon (France, 2010) and Skyliners Frankfurt (Germany, 2010-11).

Off the court, Powell founded RPJ Ministries Organization, which mentors and trains young leaders to be Godly examples on their sports team and school campuses. He also founded Integrity Sports Corporation, a company focused on building basketball skills and integrity of high school and junior high athletes. Powell is a 2005 graduate of the University of Illinois with a degree in speech communications and received his master's degree in Sports Administration from Valpo in 2016.

Powell and his wife, Tara, have four children – Bria, Liam, Gabriel and Faith.
