Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will embark upon Arch Madness, the State Farm Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, on Thursday afternoon in St. Louis. The 12th-seeded Beacons will play fifth-seeded Belmont in the first round with the winner of Thursday's game advancing to play fourth-seeded UNI on Friday at 2:30 p.m.

Last Time Out: Valpo ended the regular season on a high note, capturing a 75-72 win over Illinois State as part of Sunday's Senior Day festivities at the Athletics-Recreation Center. Cooper Schwieger went off for a career-high 28 points to lead all scorers, while Isaiah Stafford chipped in 20 and paced the team with eight rebounds. The Beacons led 44-31 at halftime and survived a late push by the Redbirds to secure the season sweep of the team from Bloomington-Normal and snap an 11-game skid.

Head Coach Roger Powell Jr.: Roger Powell Jr. (7-23) is in his first season as the head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program. After helping guide Gonzaga to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. He was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen in each of his final

three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. During his stint as an assistant at Valpo, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell capped a prolific collegiate playing career at Illinois with a national title game appearance in 2005 before going on to a successful professional playing career.

Arch Madness History

- In 2020, Valpo became the first team in the history of Arch Madness to win three games in three days to reach the MVC title game. As a No. 7 seed, Valpo became the lowest seed to ever play in the title game. The Beacons led Bradley 38-36 at halftime of the title game and were 20 minutes from clinching an NCAA Tournament berth, but the Braves eventually prevailed 80-66.
- Valpo entered Arch Madness as the No. 10 seed in 2017-18, No. 9 seed in 2018-19, No. 7 in 2019-20, No. 6 in 2020-21, No. 7 in 2021-2022 and the No. 10 in the league's first year with 12 teams in 2022-23.
- Valpo is 5-6 all-time in 10 Arch Madness games. Three of the five victories came during the 2019-20 run to the title game, which featured wins over Evansville, Loyola and Missouri State.

Valpo in St. Louis

- The program's history in the building now known as the Enterprise Center goes beyond the team's MVC Tournament appearances.
- Valpo's Sweet Sixteen game against Rhode Island in 1998 was played in the building, which was then known as the Kiel Center.
- Valpo also appeared in the 2002 NCAA Tournament in St. Louis, but the first-round date with Kentucky was played at the Edward Jones Dome.
- Head coach Roger Powell Jr. played in the Final Four in St. Louis in 2005, when he led Illinois to a 72-57 win over Louisville in the national semifinal before a 75-70 setback to North Carolina in the national title game. The event was held at the Edward Jones Dome.

Dec. 2 – Belmont 77, Valpo 68 (Nashville, Tenn.): Valpo faced a quick 9-0 deficit 90 seconds into the game as Belmont came out of the gate knocking down three 3s. The two teams played even for the final 38:30, but the early 3-point barrage stood as the difference as the Bruins prevailed 77-68. Isaiah Stafford led all scorers with 21 points, while Cooper Schwieger established a new personal best with 18. Valpo used a 10-0 run in the first half to trim a 12-point deficit to two, but the Bruins rattled off nine straight of their own

to boost the gap back to 11.

Feb. 10 – Belmont 96, Valpo 78: Belmont was red hot out of the gate, blitzing out to a 20-2 advantage by the time the game was six minutes old in the regular-season matchup at the Athletics-Recreation Center. The two teams played even at 76 all for the remaining 34 minutes, but the fast start for the guests was too much for Valpo to overcome. The Beacons trailed 54-27 at halftime and were down by as many as 30, but eventually cut the gap to as few as 12 in the second half. Four Valpo starters tallied double figures – Cooper Schweiger (16), Darius DeAveiro (14), Jaxon Edwards (13) and Isaiah Stafford (12).

Series Notes: Valpo leads 9-6 in an all-time series that began in 1997-98, a season that concluded with a Sweet Sixteen appearance for the Brown & Gold. Belmont won both matchups in its first season in the Missouri Valley Conference last year, besting the Beacons 76-64 on Dec. 1 in Nashville and 74-59 on Jan. 10 in Northwest Indiana. The Bruins are now 4-0 in MVC matchups between these two teams. Valpo has dropped five straight meetings dating back to Dec. 3, 2015.

Scouting the Bruins

- Finished the regular season on a three-game winning streak, beating Missouri State (93-78), Murray State (83-61) and Evansville (83-66).
- Went 7-1 over the last eight games of the regular season with the lone loss in that stretch coming to Drake.
- Players averaging in double figures for the season include Ja'Kobi Gillespie (17.5 ppg), Malik Dia (16.9 ppg) and Cade Tyson (16.7 ppg).

She Said Yes!

- Prior to the March 3 regular-season finale at the Athletics-Recreation Center, seniors Anthony Sciarroni, Connor Barrett and Jerome Palm were recognized along with student manager Nate Maxwell and cheer/dance seniors. The senior trio also addressed the crowd along with head coach Roger Powell Jr. following the contest.
- The highlight of the Senior Day festivities came courtesy of Palm, who proposed to his girlfriend Chloe Crichton on the court during the pregame ceremony.
- Jerome and Chloe met in Daytona Beach, Fla., where he spent his first year of junior college playing for Daytona Beach State in 2021. The relationship began when she initiated contact through Instagram. She was born and raised in England not far from Palm's native Amsterdam and moved to the United States in 2017.
- This was not the first marriage proposal to unfold during a Valpo basketball Senior Day. In 2015, Vashil Fernandez proposed to his wife Bridget. Fernandez ended up being granted an additional

season of eligibility, and had another big surprise during his second Senior Day in 2016, when he and Bridget announced that they were expecting.

The Dot Farewell Tour Reaches Its Final Stop

- Longtime Valpo men's basketball official scorekeeper Dot Nuechterlein will retire from her duties at the scorer's table following the 2023-24 season.
- Nuechterlein, age 86, began as the official scorer at Valpo in 1984. Her four-decade long tenure as the holder of an official scorebook featured two seasons doing so at Columbia while she lived in New York City during a brief hiatus from Valpo.
- According to Nuechterlein, she was the first female to serve as full-time official scorer for a Division-I men's college basketball team when she took over the post at Valpo in 1984.
- Nuechterlein was recognized during a pregame ceremony prior to the Feb. 21 game vs. Indiana State and worked her final home game at the ARC on March 3 vs. Illinois State. She is attending Arch Madness and will keep the book for Valpo's games, her final assignment as Valpo official scorer.
- Nuechterlein is part of a veteran Valpo scorer's table crew as Dave DeBoer and Dave Hollenbeck have served as shot clock, game clock and scoreboard operators since 1986 and John Bowker has served as public address announcer since 1987.

An ARC Encore

- Valpo freshman Cooper Schwieger put together quite the encore for his final performance at the ARC this season. He established a career high for the second consecutive game that he played, posting 28 points on March 3 vs. Illinois State.
- This outdid his previous personal best of 26, which occurred on Feb. 24 at Murray State. Schwieger missed the Feb. 27 game at UNI due to illness.
- Schwieger's 28 points marked the most by a Valpo freshman since Alec Peters put up 29 on March 4, 2014 vs. UIC a performance that was one day shy of exactly 10 years old when Schwieger enjoyed his big day against the Redbirds.
- Schwieger's 28 points came on 12-of-17 shooting and he also collected five rebounds.

Stafford Going Strong

- Isaiah Stafford scored 20 points or more in three of his final five games of the regular season.
- Stafford has 11 games this season with 20 points or more. He is one of five players in the MVC with 11 or more 20-point games, joining Drake's Tucker DeVries, Southern Illinois' Xavier Johnson, Indiana State's Robbie Avila and Belmont's Malik Dia.
- Stafford ranks seventh in the MVC in scoring at 16.8 points per game, and finished fourth in the MVC in league-only scoring average at 17.6.
- Although points scored at the junior college level are not officially recognized, Stafford surpassed 1,000 points as a college basketball player on Feb. 14 vs. UNI if those scored last season at John A. Logan College are considered.
- He scored 436 points for the Vols to go along with 203 as a freshman at Southern Indiana and 469 this year with the Beacons. All told, he has scored 1,108 points as a college basketball player entering Arch Madness.

Other Individual Trends & Tidbits

- Jerome Palm started the final five games of the regular season after coming off the bench in the previous 10. He is averaging 10.0 points per game over his last four contests after entering that stretch at 3.4 points per game for the season.
- Connor Barrett closed the regular season with a season-high nine points by draining three 3s on March 3 vs. Illinois State during his Senior Day game. He was 3-for-25 this season before going 3-for-6 against the Redbirds. Barrett started the year 1-for-15 from 3-point territory but is 6-for-16 over his last five games.
- Sherman Weatherspoon IV's last 16 shots have all come from 3-point range. He last attempted a 2-pointer with 6:11 to go in the first half on Feb. 21 vs. Indiana State.
- Cooper Schwieger has scored 20 points or more in three of his last four games.
- Isaiah Stafford has scored 20 points or more in four of his last six. Stafford has not attempted a free throw in his last three games.

Team Trends & Tidbits

- Valpo outrebounded Illinois State 31-26 in the March 3 regular-season finale, snapping a streak of 11 straight games being outrebounded. Not-so-coincidentally, Valpo also snapped an 11-game losing streak by beating the Redbirds.
- Valpo improved to 5-2 this season when outrebounding the opponent, but the Beacons are just 3-21 when being outrebounded or tied on the glass. Valpo is giving up a height disadvantage in most matchups as the Beacons are the second shortest team in the MVC, per KenPom, and rank 322nd nationally in height.
- Valpo had won the turnover battle in nine straight games prior to Feb. 27 at UNI. The Beacons lost the turnover battle in each of the final two regular-season games.
- Valpo has committed 12 turnovers or fewer in 12 of the team's last 13 games.
- Valpo had permitted 80 points or more in six straight and eight out of nine prior to holding the opponent under 80 in each of the final two regular-season games (68 at UNI, 72 vs. Illinois State).
- Valpo had a higher 3-point percentage than its opponent in each of the final three regular-season games.
- Valpo shot single-digit free throws in five of its final nine regular-season games. The Beacons shot more than 13 free throws just once in that stretch.
- Valpo had more 3-point attempts than its opponent in eight of the final nine games of the regular-season. The Beacons shot at least 24 3-pointers in seven of their last eight games.

Beating the Birds

- Valpo yet again defeated Illinois State on March 3 at the ARC, securing a season sweep of the Redbirds with a 75-72 victory.
- Valpo improved to 11-1 in the last dozen meetings with Illinois State and 11-2 in the 13 matchups that have occurred since Valpo joined The Valley.
- In the last dozen faceoffs, Valpo's only setback came in overtime.
- Five of the last seven games between the two teams have been decided by five points or fewer.
- Valpo has won the last six matchups that have occurred at the ARC.

Notes Wrapping Up March 3: Valpo 75, ILS 72

- Cooper Schwieger scored a career-high for his second straight game, pouring in 28 points.
- Schwieger and Connor Barrett returned to action after missing the Feb. 27 game at UNI due to illness.
- Barrett drained three 3s in a game for the first time since Dec. 18, 2022 at Elon and scored a season-high nine points on Senior Day.
- Jerome Palm posted eight points on 4-of-7 shooting, his third time in the last four games with eight points or more.
- Isaiah Stafford squeezed a team-high eight rebounds to go along with his 20 points. That marked his highest rebounding effort in conference play and his most in any game since Nov. 25 vs. Southern.
- Valpo brought an 11-game skid to a halt.
- Valpo snapped a skid of 11 straight losses in games decided by four points or fewer. This marked the team's first win in a game decided by four points or fewer since Nov. 27, 2022 vs. James Madison.
- Jaxon Edwards did not play as he was suspended by head coach Roger Powell Jr. for a violation of team rules.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Feb. 27: UNI 68, Valpo 54

- Cooper Schwieger and Connor Barrett did not make the trip to Cedar Falls due to illness. Schwieger had started each of the first 29 games of his freshman season prior to this absence.
- Isaiah Stafford grabbed seven rebounds, his highest total in his last 20 games.
- Darius DeAveiro tied a career high with four steals.
- Jerome Palm tied a career high with 14 points and was joined in double figures by Jahari Williamson, who put together his best showing of the last four games with 13 points.
- Kaspar Sepp had nine points and 11 rebounds. He played over 39 minutes and went 4-of-5 from 2-point territory.
- Valpo was just 1-of-11 from 3 in the first half but knocked down 6-of-13 from behind the arc over the final 20 minutes.
- UNI outscored Valpo 42-16 in the paint and 23-5 on the fastbreak. The Beacons made an uncharacteristic 18 turnovers, the team's highest total since Jan. 3 and second highest of the season.

The Baby Beacs

- You've likely heard of the 2004-05 "Baby Bulls," but it's time to officially dub the 2023-24 Valpo basketball team the "Baby Beacs." Like the 2004-05 Chicago Bulls featuring rookies Ben Gordon, Luol Deng, Chris Duhon and Andres Nocioni, this year's version of the Beacons is filled with promising young players.
- On Jan. 27 vs. Missouri State, four true freshmen were part of the Valpo starting lineup Sherman Weatherspoon IV, Kaspar Sepp, Cooper Schwieger and Jahari Williamson. This marked the first time in 40 years that Valpo had started four freshmen.
- Valpo's 2023-24 roster is a new-look group that is among the nation's most inexperienced teams. The Beacons rank 356 of 362 in the KenPom "experience factor" at 0.54. The experience factor is calculated using eligibility class weighted by minutes played.
- This marks Valpo's least experienced group since the farthest back KenPom data in 2006-07. Valpo's two most experienced teams in that time period were the 2012-13 team, which ranked 15th nationally at 2.30 in experience and went to the NCAA Tournament, and the 2015-16 group, which ranked 48th nationally at 2.01 and went to the NIT title game.
- The season most similar to this one in terms of KenPom experience factor was the 2013-14 campaign, when Valpo ranked 338th nationally at 0.66 during Alec Peters' freshman year.
- The only more inexperienced teams nationally, per KenPom, are Notre Dame, Boston, Saint Francis, Siena, Northwestern State and Idaho.
- Valpo has four freshmen with multiple double-figure scoring outputs this season Jahari Williamson, Kaspar Sepp, Cooper Schwieger and Sherman Weatherspoon IV. The last time that occurred was 2013-14 Alec Peters, Clay Yeo, Lexus Williams and Jubril Adekoya.

Sciarroni on Scholarship

- Head coach Roger Powell Jr. presented former walk-on Anthony Sciarroni with scholarship papers on Jan. 16 as part of "Team Time." He has earned an athletic scholarship for the Spring 2024 semester.
- Sciarroni spent three seasons on the Valpo football team, a member of the Division-I, nonscholarship Pioneer Football League, before joining the basketball program first as a manager, then as a walk-on and now as a scholarship player.
- -At St. Francis de Sales High School, Sciarroni was a four-year letter winner in basketball and was a team captain each of his final two seasons.

Who's Next?

- Justus McNair signed his National Letter of Intent to continue his basketball career at Valpo during the November signing period.
- The Joliet West senior and Joliet, Ill. native has a deep connection to head coach Roger Powell Jr. His parents grew up with Powell in Joliet.
- McNair, a 6-foot-3 guard, lists going to state in eighth grade as a favorite basketball memory. He also highlighted last season's Joliet West sectional championship appearance, fueled by a late-season, 14-game winning streak and a 29-6 record.

- Powell on McNair: "I'm extremely excited about this young man from Joliet, Ill., my hometown. He's a tough, physical and athletic guard who will add even more athleticism and ability to shoot the ball to our team next year. I'm fired up and can't wait to get him here and help us continue to build a winning tradition."

"The Rev" in the Community

- Since head coach Roger Powell Jr. was hired to lead Valpo's program, he has made numerous community engagement appearances including IBCA State Wide Clinic, Popcorn Fest, Valpo Kiwanis, Boys & Girls Clubs of Northwest Indiana, Big Shoulders NWI, the Valpo Athletics Coaches Tour and many more.
- An engaging speaker with an active social media presence, Powell has launched a video series featuring local restaurants called "Powell Party of Six," showcasing the Powell family meals in the community. Several editions have been released.
- Nicknamed "The Rev" because of his strong faith and calling as a preacher, Powell's hire as Valpo head coach made an immediate media splash. The news was featured prominently in the Chicago Sun-Times, on CBS 2 Chicago's 4 p.m. news and WGN-TV's GN Sports. He appeared on the Mully & Haugh morning show on 670 The Score in Chicago and Indiana Sports Talk with Bob Lovell out of Indianapolis.

Inside the Assistants

- Valpo's staff features two coaches who have played in the national title game - Powell and A.J. Moye. Powell has also coached in the national title game.
- Powell, Moye and Matt Gordon have all either coached or played in the Final Four.

- Assistant coach Pat Baldwin brings head coaching Milwaukee before serving as an assistant coach under Patrick Ewing at Georgetown during the 2022-23 season. He also worked under Chris Collins as an assistant during a successful run at Northwestern, so he has recent stops in the Big Ten and Big East to go along with head coaching experience. Pat's son Patrick plays in the NBA for the Washington Wizards.
- Assistant coach Matt Gordon spent the last two years in and Special Assistant to head coach Porter Moser. He joined Moser in Norman, Okla. after they previously worked together for a decade at Loyola. Gordon knows what it takes to win in the Missouri Valley Conference as he played a key role in a turnaround that saw the Ramblers post a 156-80 (.661) record during his seven seasons as an assistant coach. He helped the team to two Sweet Sixteen appearances in a four-year period including a historic run to the Final Four.
- Assistant coach A.J. Moye was a standout during his playing days at Indiana, where he took the Hoosiers to the 2002 national title game before beginning a professional playing career. He trained professional and collegiate players from 2011-2023 as part of Rising Talent Development (Mamba Sports Academy), serving as the Master Basketball Trainer for Kobe Bryant's academy. Moye played against Powell in the Big Ten and they later finished out their playing careers as teammates with Skyliners Frankfurt in Germany in 2010-11.
- Director of Recruiting & Player Development Lubos Barton returns to Valpo over two decades after wrapping up his storied career donning the brown and gold. After retiring from his professional playing career, Barton stayed in the game of basketball by beginning his coaching career overseas in 2016. A member of the Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2017, Barton was a standout on the court from 1998-2002, leading the team to three Mid-Continent Conference regularseason titles, three conference tournament championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.
- Special Assistant to the Head Coach Quintin Garrison served as the associate head coach at Trinity International University from 2018-2023.
- Video coordinator / Director of Basketball Operations Sean Taylor served as SIUE's graduate assistant/video coordinator from August 2021 to May 2023.
- Associate Director of Sports Performance Vijay Blackmon is in his second season as the strength & conditioning coach for Valpo men's basketball. He previously worked with strength & conditioning as part of Bryce Drew's Grand

Inside the Roster

- The 2023-24 roster features four returning letterwinners and 11 newcomers. The team lost 11 letterwinners from last season including all five starters.
- This marks the first time since the 2013-14 season that Valpo has no starters returning from the previous season. The 2012-13 NCAA Tournament team started all seniors Ryan Broekhoff, Kevin Van Wijk, Erik Buggs, Will Bogan and Ben Boggs. The 2013-14 season featured a five-member freshmen class led by Alec Peters.
- Prior to this season, Valpo had at least two returning starters in nine consecutive years.
- The 12 scholarship players on the roster include three returners, five true freshmen and four transfers. Valpo also has three walk-ons one returner, one former Valpo football player and one transfer.
- The 12 scholarship players are comprised of two seniors, two juniors, two sophomores and six freshmen (five true; one redshirt).
- The half dozen freshmen represent the team's most since 2008-09, when the team also had six on the roster De'Andre Haskins, Cameron Witt, Nick Shelton, Andrew Ferry, Erik Buggs and Logan Jones.
- This year's roster features players from five different countries The Netherlands, Canada, Estonia, South Sudan and the Unites States. In addition, six states are represented Indiana, Illinois, Ohio, Maryland, Virginia and Kansas.

Returnee Rundown

- Junior guard **Darius DeAveiro** ranked 14th in the Missouri Valley Conference in assists per game last season. He ranked fifth in the league in assist to turnover ratio at 1.89. During his rookie year in 2021-22, he finished the season as one of two freshmen nationally with 50 or more assists and fewer than 25 turnovers. He was named a captain by head coach Roger Powell Jr. prior to the season.
- Senior guard/forward **Connor Barrett** is the team's leading returning scorer and the longest-tenured member of the program. Roger Powell Jr.

Head Coach 1st Season * Illinois, 2005 7-24 Overall and at Valpo

Roger Powell Jr. was named the 23rd head coach of the Valparaiso University men's basketball program on April 7, 2023.

After helping guide Gonzaga University to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. Powell becomes the first Black head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program.

Powell was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. The 2020-21 team spent the entire season ranked No. 1 in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 overall seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2021 and 2022.

Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. In his first season in Nashville, he helped lead the Commodores to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Vanderbilt notched five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins while playing the toughest strength of schedule nationally.

During Powell's first stint on the Valpo bench, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. Valpo reached postseason tournaments in each of his five seasons on staff, including the memorable run to the NIT title game in 2016 which featured wins over Florida State, Saint Mary's and BYU.

A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell was a three-year starter for the University of Illinois during his playing days, earning Honorable Mention All-Big Ten recognition in each of his final two seasons after being named to the Big Ten All-Tournament Team as a sophomore. His winning track record dates as far back as his days playing for the Illini, when he helped the team to three Big Ten regular-season titles, two Big Ten Tournament crowns and three Sweet Sixteen berths. During his senior year in 2004-05, Powell was part of an Illini team that finished 37-2, won 29 straight to open the season and reached the national title game.

Powell accumulated 1,178 points and 531 rebounds during his four-year career at Illinois. He finished his career ranked among the top 30 scorers in program history. Following his collegiate tenure, Powell began a professional career that included a stint in the NBA with the Utah Jazz during the 2006-2007 season. He also played for the Rockford Lightning (CBA, 2005-06), Arkansas Rimrockers (2006-07, D-League), Siviglia Wear Teramo (Italy, 2007-08), Murcia (Spain, 2009-10), JDA Dijon (France, 2010) and Skyliners Frankfurt (Germany, 2010-11).

Off the court, Powell founded RPJ Ministries Organization, which mentors and trains young leaders to be Godly examples on their sports team and school campuses. He also founded Integrity Sports Corporation, a company focused on building basketball skills and integrity of high school and junior high athletes. Powell is a 2005 graduate of the University of Illinois with a degree in speech communications and received his master's degree in Sports Administration from Valpo in 2016.

Powell and his wife, Tara, have four children – Bria, Liam, Gabriel and Faith.
