Next Up in Valpo Basketball: The Valparaiso University men's basketball team will open up Missouri Valley Conference play on Wednesday night as the Beacons host Drake in head coach Roger Powell Jr.'s first-ever league game at the helm of a program. Valpo will continue a home-heavy stretch by playing its sixth home game in the season's first seven contests and its third straight at the Athletics-Recreation Center as the defending MVC champions come to town. Valpo is seeking a third straight victory, its fourth win in five games and its fifth victory in the season's first seven contests.

Last Time Out: Valpo led wire-to-wire in Saturday's 71-59 triumph over Southern at the ARC, surviving several pushes where the Jaguars whittled what had been a 15-point gap all the way down to one. Each time, the Beacons had the answer to stay ahead, and the hosts hit their free throws over the final minute to pull away in the last nonconference game before league action tips off. Cooper Schwieger and Isaiah Stafford shared game-high honors with 17 points apiece, while Stafford finished one rebound shy of a double-double.

Head Coach Roger Powell Jr.: Roger Powell Jr. (4-2) is in his first season as the head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program. After helping guide Gonzaga to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. He was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen in each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. During his stint as an assistant at Valpo, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell capped a prolific collegiate playing career at Illinois with a national title game appearance in 2005 before going on to a successful professional playing career.

Series Notes: Drake holds a slight 10-8 lead in an all-time series that began in 1944-45. The Bulldogs have won four straight head-to-head matchups and six of the last seven. Drake has won eight of the 12 collisions that have occurred since Valpo joined The Valley. Valpo lost 85-82 in double overtime in the most recent showdown on Feb. 4 of last season.

Valpo in Valley Openers

- This marks the second time in three years that these two teams have lifted the lid on conference play by locking horns as Valpo visited Drake to start the 2021-2022 MVC slate.
- This marks the first time Valpo has played a conference game in the month of November since joining Division-I in 1978-79.
- Valpo is 1-5 in league openers since joining The Valley. The Beacons have dropped the last four MVC openers after a half-court buzzer-beater by Markus Golder helped Valpo start the 2018-19 conference campaign with a 58-56 home win over Illinois State.

Valpo vs. Valley Favorites

- Valpo will attempt to snap a five-game losing streak against teams picked to win the Missouri Valley Conference on Wednesday.
- The Beacons are 2-10 against the MVC preseason favorite in regular-season matchups since joining the league.
- The most recent win over a league favorite occurred on Feb. 13, 2021 at UNI.

Starting Strong

- At 4-2, Valpo owns its best record through the first six games of the season since also starting 4-2 in 2019-20, a year where the team went on to play in the MVC title game.
- With a win on Wednesday over Drake, Valpo would own five victories in the first seven games of the season for the first time since starting 8-0 in 2017-18.
- With a win on Wednesday, Valpo would own a three-game winning streak, which would tie for the program's longest since the start of the 2019-20 season.

Home-Heavy Start

- Valpo will close out a stretch of three straight home games and six of its first seven at the ARC on Wednesday.
- After this game, the Beacons will hit the road for three straight.
- Valpo started the season with three straight home games, the first time it has done so since 2016-17.
- This marks the most home games (six) that Valpo has had in the first seven games of a season since the 1969-70 season, when the Beacons traveled to Air Force and had home games against Saint Procopius, No. 10 Notre Dame, Whittier, Pacific Lutheran, Gustavus Adolphus and South Alabama over the first seven contests.
- Valpo has owned a record of .500 or better at home in 31 straight seasons.

Team Trends

- Valpo has held its opponents to 33 percent or lower from 3-point range in all six games this season.
- The Beacons have had 15 or more free-throw attempts in each of their six games.
- Valpo has won the turnover battle in five of the team's six games this season including four straight and each of the team's four victories.
- Valpo ranks second in the conference and 42nd nationally in turnover margin per game at +4.2.
- The Beacons rank second in the league and 27th nationally in blocks per game at 5.5.
- In each of Valpo's six games this season, the team that has shot 3s at a higher percentage has won the game.

Positive Strides

- Jerome Palm has scored 42 points in the first six games this season. He is one basket away from tying or surpassing his 23-game point total from last season of 44.
- Jaxon Edwards has scored 52 points in six games for Valpo this season. Last season, he totaled six points in 11 games while playing at Murray State.
- Sherman Weatherspoon IV had season highs in points (eight) and rebounds (six) on Nov. 25 vs. Southern. He had three total rebounds

for the season in his first five games and none over his previous three before tallying six against the Jaguars. He entered the game 2-for-14 from 3-point range but went 2-for-4 against Southern.

- Darius DeAveiro has 19 points over his last two games after he totaled seven over the first four games of the season including two points over his previous three games before this two-game stretch. He's had five assists or more in four of his six games.

- Cooper Schwieger has scored a dozen points or more in three straight including a season-high 17 points on 6-of-9 shooting in the Nov. 25 win over Southern. He has seven or more rebounds in four games this season and is 4-of-6 from 3 over the last two games after going 2-of-9 from long range in the first four contests.

- Isaiah Stafford is averaging 17.5 points per game this season after averaging 8.8 in 2021-22 at Southern Indiana before playing JUCO ball last year.

Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 25: Valpo 71, Southern 59

- Isaiah Stafford and Cooper Schwieger had 17 points apiece to share game-high honors while also serving as the team's top two rebounders.

- Stafford squeezed nine caroms to pace the team in that area followed by Schwieger with seven and Weatherspoon with six.

- Schwieger's 17 points outdid his previous season best of 13, which came last time out on Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois. The freshman has tallied 12 points or more in three straight and has scored at least eight points in each of his six contests.

- Stafford tied a season-high with seven made free throws and got to the stripe regularly with a season-high 11 attempts.

- With 17 points, nine rebounds and four assists, Stafford joined the short list of Valpo players who have achieved that combination in a game in the last decade – Ben Krikke, Javon Freeman-Liberty (x3), Tevonn Walker, Alec Peters (5x), Shane Hammink and Ryan Broekhoff (6x in his career).

- Darius DeAveiro tallied eight points and handed out a team-high five assists.

- This marked Valpo's most lopsided victory against a Division-I opponent since Jan. 28, 2023, an 81-69 win over Evansville.

- Valpo tied a season high with 18 made free throws, the third time this year that the team has converted exactly 18 freebies. The team shot 70 percent or better at the charity stripe in each of the last five contests.

- Valpo did a good job on the defensive glass, allowing just seven Southern offensive rebounds, the first time this season a Beacon opponent had fewer than 10.

Scouting the Bulldogs

- Preseason favorite to win the Missouri Valley Conference, collecting 24 first-place votes and 558 points to outdo UNI (19 first-place votes / 524 points) for the top spot.

- Led by MVC Preseason Player of the Year Tucker DeVries, the son of head coach Darian DeVries.

- Coming off a 77-71 win over Texas Southern on Saturday night.

- Lone loss came to Stephen F. Austin 92-68.

- Will be playing their first true road game of the season on Wednesday.

- Lost to Miami 63-56 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament last season after blitzing Bradley 77-51 in the MVC title game to take the conference tournament crown.

Region Rats No More

- This year's Drake team does not feature any players who attended high school in Northwest Indiana. This is a far cry from the recent past, including last year where D.J. Wilkins (Merrillville) and Roman Penn (Bishop Noll) both had homecomings when they played at the ARC.

- In 2021-22, Wilkins, Penn, Trumell Murphy (Griffith), ShanQuan Hemphill (Michigan City) and Jonah Jackson (Merrillville) made it five Drake players from Valpo's neck of the woods.

- This is the first year since 2017-18 that Drake does not have a Northwest Indiana native on the roster.

Bench Boost

- In the Nov. 21 win over Western Illinois, Valpo held the upper hand in bench points, 41-8. Three players – all underclassmen – combined for the 41 bench points as Ola Ajiboye (21), Jahari Williamson (13) and Sherman Weatherspoon IV (seven) all made key contributions.

- Ajiboye's career-high 21 points came on 8-of-10 shooting to go along with eight rebounds, two blocks, one steal and one assist.

- Ajiboye over doubled his previous career high of 10 points, which came on Nov. 6 of this season vs. Trinity Christian.

- He became the first Valpo player to shoot 80 percent or better at the ARC (with a minimum of 10 attempts) in a game against a Division-I opponent since Alec Peters on March 4, 2014 vs. UIC. He became just the 10th Valpo player in the last decade to shoot at an 80 percent clip or better with at least 10 shots.

- Ajiboye became the first Valpo player to come off the bench and score 20 points or more against a Division-I opponent since Sheldon Edwards on Feb. 16, 2022 vs. Loyola.

- This marked quite the turnaround for Ajiboye as he played but did not score in the previous game on Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois.

- Ajiboye became just the fourth Valpo player in the last decade to come off the bench and score 20+ points while pulling down 8+

rebounds. He joined Sheldon Edwards (Dec. 9, 2020 vs. SIUE), Darien Walker (Nov. 14, 2014 vs. East Tennessee State) and Bobby Capobianco (Nov. 29, 2013 vs. Mercer).

- Williamson hit three 3s en route to his 13 points while also swiping three steals. He became the first Valpo freshman to achieve that combo since Connor Barrett on Jan. 9, 2021 vs. Missouri State.

Scoring Surge

- Junior Darius DeAveiro tallied a career-high 11 points in Valpo's victory over Western Illinois on Nov. 21. His previous personal best in the scoring department was eight, achieved twice – Jan. 15, 2022 vs. Missouri State and Nov. 13, 2022 vs. Western Michigan.

- DeAveiro busted out of a shooting slump as he entered the game against the Leathernecks having gone 0-for-10 from the field over his previous three games and 2-for-17 shooting for the season. He altered that narrative by drilling four of his five shots including a three-point make.

- Valpo's starting point guard also thrived in the assist department in the win over Western Illinois, handing out a season-high seven helpers.

- DeAveiro became just the third Valpo player in the last decade to shoot 80 percent or better from the field (minimum five attempts) while handing out at least seven assists. He was the first to do it since Max Joseph on Jan. 10, 2018 vs. Drake. Before that, the most recent was Erik Buggs on March 2, 2013 against Green Bay.

Other Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 21: Valpo 73, Western Illinois 66

- The Leathernecks were limited to 26.3 percent from 3-point territory, missing 14 of their 19 attempts.
- Valpo prevailed despite being outrebounded by 13 (40-27) as Western Illinois owned a 14-6 advantage on the offensive glass. This was Valpo's first win when being outrebounded by such a wide clip since Jan. 2, 2022 vs. Illinois State.
- Valpo improved to 15-1 in its last 16 matchups with Western Illinois and extended its home head-to-head winning streak to eight.

"I" Stands for Isaiah

- As Paul Oren of "The Victory Bell" put it, the "I" on the center of the court in Champaign stood for Isaiah – as in Valpo's Isaiah Stafford – rather than Illinois on Nov. 17 as the Beacons clashed with the No. 23 Fighting Illini.
- Stafford scored 30 points on 11-of-23 shooting, 3-of-8 from 3 and 5-of-7 at the free-throw line. He finished one point shy of a career high that was set on Feb. 26, 2022 while playing for Southern Indiana vs. Lindenwood.
- This was the most points scored by a Beacon since Ben Krikke tallied 34 at UIC on Feb. 19 of last season.
- Stafford joined Krikke (3x), Javon Freeman-Liberty (twice), Bakari Evelyn, Alec Peters (10x) and Lavone Dority (twice) as the only Valpo players in the last decade with a 30-point performance.
- Stafford had the most points scored by a non-power conference opponent against Illinois since Ohio's Jason Preston in 2020.
- The bulk of Stafford's damage came before the break as he had 23 first-half points. This marked the highest scoring half by a Beacon since Javon Freeman-Liberty had 23 on March 7, 2020 vs. Missouri State in the MVC semifinals. However, that included points scored in overtime so Freeman-Liberty's total came in 25 minutes rather than 20.
- The last time a Valpo player scored more than 23 in a half was Alec Peters on Dec. 22, 2016, but that included double overtime.
- Stafford had Valpo's biggest first half and biggest half that did not include OT by a Valpo player since Peters scored 23 in the opening half on Dec. 17, 2016 vs. Indiana State.

Hats Off for Half 1

- Valpo led for the entirety of a brilliant first half and held a 45-38 advantage at No. 23 Illinois at the break after owning a cushion as big as 10.
- The program was hoping to record its fifth all-time victory against a nationally-ranked opponent and its first true road win against an AP Top-25 foe. The Brown & Gold fell to 0-44 all-time on the road against nationally-ranked opponents, with three of the program's four ranked wins coming at home and one on a neutral floor.
- Each of the last two road games against Top-25 teams and three of the last six have seen Valpo own the halftime lead. In addition

to the Nov. 17 game at No. 23 Illinois, Valpo led No. 22 Loyola 29-26 at the break on Feb. 17, 2021 and held a 35-33 edge at No. 25 Oregon midway through the Nov. 22, 2015 matchup.

- Valpo was also seeking its first power-conference win since 2016 vs. Alabama and was hoping to snap a 15-game skid against Big Ten Conference competition that dates back to Dec. 28, 2004 vs. Penn State.

Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 17: No. 23 Illinois 87, Valpo 64

- Jaxon Edwards pulled down 15 rebounds, the most by a Valpo player since Ben Krikke on Jan. 24, 2021 at Illinois State. Edwards tied with Krikke and Javon Freeman-Liberty for the most rebounds by a Valpo player since Alec Peters had 16 on Jan. 16, 2017.
- Jerome Palm posted a double-double of 12 points and 10 rebounds, establishing a new personal best in the scoring column. His previous career high was 11 set last season at Belmont and matched this year vs. Trinity Christian. This was Valpo's first double-double since Krikke at UIC on Feb. 19 of last season.
- Valpo shot a respectable 42.9 percent including 5-of-11 (45.5 percent) from 3 in the first half, but cooled off to 20 percent (9-of-45) and 0-of-8 from 3 after halftime.
- Valpo had 80 field-goal attempts in the game, becoming just the fifth Division-I team with 80 or more shots in a game against a Division-I opponent this season. The 80 field goal attempts were the most in a single game by Valpo since at least 2010 and the most against Illinois since Rutgers had 85 on Feb. 3, 2016, a game that went to triple overtime. It was the most shot attempts against the Illini since at least 2010.

"The Rev" in the Community

- Since head coach Roger Powell Jr. was hired to lead Valpo's program, he has made numerous community engagement appearances including IBCA State Wide Clinic, Popcorn Fest, Valpo Kiwanis, Boys & Girls Clubs of Northwest Indiana, Big Shoulders NWI, the Valpo Athletics Coaches Tour and many more.
- An engaging speaker with an active social media presence, Powell has launched a video series featuring local restaurants called "Powell Party of Six," showcasing the Powell family meals in the community. Episode 1 featuring Burgerhaus was released prior to the season with more editions to come.
- Nicknamed "The Rev" because of his strong faith and calling as a preacher, Powell's hire as Valpo head coach made an immediate media splash. The news was featured prominently in the Chicago Sun-Times, on CBS 2 Chicago's 4 p.m. news and WGN-TV's GN Sports. He appeared on the Mully & Haugh morning show on 670 The Score in Chicago and Indiana Sports Talk with Bob Lovell out of Indianapolis.

He also worked under Chris Collins as an assistant during a successful run at Northwestern, so he has recent stops in the Big Ten and Big East to go along with head coaching experience.

collegiate players from 2011-2023 as part of Rising Talent Development (Mamba Sports Academy), serving as the Master Basketball Trainer for Kobe Bryant's academy. Moye played against Powell in the Big Ten and they later finished out their playing careers as teammates with Skyliners Frankfurt in Germany in 2010-11.

- Director of Recruiting & Player Development **Lubos Barton** returns to Valpo over two decades after wrapping up his storied career donning the brown and gold. After retiring from his professional playing career, Barton stayed in the game of basketball by beginning his coaching career overseas in 2016. A member of the Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2017, Barton was a standout on the court from 1998-2002, leading the team to three Mid-Continent Conference regular-season titles, three conference tournament championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.

- Special Assistant to the Head Coach **Quintin Garrison** served as the associate head coach at Trinity International University from 2018-2023.

- Video coordinator / Director of Basketball Operations **Sean Taylor** served as SIUE's graduate assistant/video coordinator from August 2021 to May 2023.

- Associate Director of Sports Performance **Vijay Blackmon** is in his second season as the strength & conditioning coach for Valpo men's basketball. He previously worked with strength & conditioning as part of Bryce Drew's Grand Canyon program.

Inside the Roster

- The 2023-24 roster features four returning letterwinners and 11 newcomers. The team lost 11 letterwinners from last season including all five starters.

- This marks the first time since the 2013-14 season that Valpo has no starters returning from the previous season. The 2012-13 NCAA Tournament team started all seniors – Ryan Broekhoff, Kevin Van Wijk, Erik Buggs, Will Bogan and Ben Boggs. The 2013-14 season featured a five-member freshmen class led by Alec Peters.

- Prior to this season, Valpo had at least two returning starters in nine consecutive years.

- The 12 scholarship players on the roster include three returners, five true freshmen and four transfers. Valpo also has three walk-ons – one returner, one former Valpo football player and one transfer.

- The 12 scholarship players are comprised of two seniors, two juniors, two sophomores and six freshmen (five true; one redshirt).

- The half dozen freshmen represent the team's most since 2008-09, when the team also had six on the roster – De'Andre Haskins, Cameron Witt, Nick Shelton, Andrew Ferry, Erik Buggs and Logan Jones.

- This year's roster features players from five different countries – The Netherlands, Canada, Estonia, South Sudan and the United States. In addition, six states are represented – Indiana, Illinois, Ohio, Maryland, Virginia and Kansas.

Returnee Rundown

- Junior guard **Darius DeAveiro** ranked 14th in the Missouri Valley

Conference in assists per game last season. He ranked fifth in the league in assist to turnover ratio at 1.89. During his rookie year in 2021-22, he finished the season as one of two freshmen nationally with 50 or more assists and fewer than 25 turnovers. He was named a captain by head coach Roger Powell Jr. prior to the season.

- Senior guard/forward **Connor Barrett** is the team's leading returning scorer and the longest-tenured member of the program. Now in his fourth season at Valpo, Barrett saw action in 31 of the team's 32 games a year ago and scored a season-high 13 points including three made 3s on Dec. 18 vs. Elon.

- Senior forward **Jerome Palm** was named a captain by head coach Roger Powell Jr. prior to the season. He joined Valpo last year after a pair of junior college seasons. He had a season-high 11 points to go along with nine rebounds on Dec. 1 at Belmont.

Newcomer Notes

- Sophomore guard **Jaxon Edwards** has experience in the Missouri Valley Conference after playing in 11 games during the 2022-23 season as a freshman at Murray State. He led Cathedral to the 2021-22 Indiana 4A state championship in high school.

- Freshman guard **Sherman Weatherspoon IV** played at Golden State Prep in Napa Valley, Calif. in 2022-23, averaging 25 points, eight rebounds and four assists.

- Sophomore forward **Ola Ajiobye** played in 30 of 31 games with 14 starts at Central Michigan as a true freshman in 2022-23.

- Freshman guard **Jahari Williamson** played for Canada's U19 World Cup Team in Summer 2023 after participating in the U18 2022 Canada Games for Team Ontario.

- Freshman forward **Lucas Scroggins** spent the 2022-23 season at Bosco Institute in Crown Point.

- Freshman forward **Cooper Schwieger** averaged 11.2 points, 7.4 rebounds and 3.3 assists at Link Year Prep in Branson, Mo. last season.

- Junior guard **Isaiah Stafford** averaged 12.5 points per game to help John A. Logan to the junior college national title and a 33-2 mark in 2022-23 after spending his freshman season at Southern Indiana in 2021-22.

- Freshman forward **Kaspar Sepp** played for the Estonian national team during the 2023 summer after helping Estonia beat Finland to earn a promotion to the "A" division during the 2022 summer.

- Redshirt freshman **Lual Manyang** received a medical redshirt in 2022-23 due to a preseason injury at Hofstra.

Ryan Broekhoff (class of 2013) signed a contract with the Dallas Mavericks in the summer of 2018 after spending five seasons playing internationally in Russia and Turkey. Alec Peters (class of 2017) was the 54th pick in the 2017 NBA Draft by the Phoenix Suns. Peters appeared in 20 games for the Suns in 2017-18, highlighted by a 36-point performance in the season finale against Dallas – a new single-game high by a Valpo alum in the NBA. He has gone on to a successful career overseas with CSKA Moscow (2018-2019), Anadolu Efes (2019-2020) and Kirolbet Baskonia (2020-2022) and Olympiacos (2022-present).
- Valpo has produced over 50 professional players in the last three decades.

Head Coach

1st Season * Illinois, 2005

4-2 Overall and at Valpo

Roger Powell Jr. was named the 23rd head coach of the Valparaiso University men's basketball program on April 7, 2023.

After helping guide Gonzaga University to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. Powell becomes the first Black head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program.

Powell was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. The 2020-21 team spent the entire season ranked No. 1 in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 overall seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2021 and 2022.

Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. In his first season in Nashville, he helped lead the Commodores to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Vanderbilt notched five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins while playing the toughest strength of schedule nationally.

During Powell's first stint on the Valpo bench, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. Valpo reached postseason tournaments in each of his five seasons on staff, including the memorable run to the NIT title game in 2016 which featured wins over Florida State, Saint Mary's and BYU.

A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell was a three-year starter for the University of Illinois during his playing days, earning Honorable Mention All-Big Ten recognition in each of his final two seasons after being named to the Big Ten All-Tournament Team as a sophomore. His winning track record dates as far back as his days playing for the Illini, when he helped the team to three Big Ten regular-season titles, two Big Ten Tournament crowns and three Sweet Sixteen berths. During his senior year in 2004-05, Powell was part of an Illini team that finished 37-2, won 29 straight to open the season and reached the national title game.

Powell accumulated 1,178 points and 531 rebounds during his four-year career at Illinois. He finished his career ranked among the top 30 scorers in program history. Following his collegiate tenure, Powell began a professional career that included a stint in the NBA with the Utah Jazz during the 2006-2007 season. He also played for the Rockford Lightning (CBA, 2005-06), Arkansas Rimrockers (2006-07, D-League), Saviglia Wear Teramo (Italy, 2007-08), Murcia (Spain, 2009-10), JDA Dijon (France, 2010) and Skyliners Frankfurt (Germany, 2010-11).

Off the court, Powell founded RPJ Ministries Organization, which mentors and trains young leaders to be Godly examples on their sports team and school campuses. He also founded Integrity Sports Corporation, a company focused on building basketball skills and integrity of high school and junior high athletes. Powell is a 2005 graduate of the University of Illinois with a degree in speech communications and received his master's degree in Sports Administration from Valpo in 2016.

Powell and his wife, Tara, have four children – Bria, Liam, Gabriel and Faith.

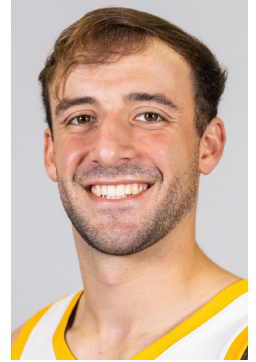
