Next Up in Valpo Basketball: After starting the season with six of its first seven games within the confines of the Athletics-Recreation Center, the Valparaiso University men's basketball team will keep the travel bags handy for an upcoming nine-day stretch that features three games away from home on three separate trips to three different states. The Beacons will start that stretch with their first road Missouri Valley Conference game of the season on Saturday at Belmont before stepping outside of league play for the final five nonconference games including two on the road next week.

Last Time Out: Valpo took the lead on MVC preseason favorite and defending conference champion Drake with 16:29 left in the first half and held that advantage all the way until the final 2:07 of the half with the cushion peaking at nine. The Beacons also led early in the second half before a 10-0 run by the Bulldogs served as a turning point in an 83-65 win for the guests in Wednesday's league lidlifter. The game was closer than the final score would indicate as Valpo led for 17:25 compared to 18:03 with Drake in front. Isaiah Stafford scored a team-high 20 points while Darius DeAveiro matched a personal best with 11 and Cooper Schwieger contributed 13.

Head Coach Roger Powell Jr.: Roger Powell Jr. (4-3) is in his first season as the head coach of the Valpo men's basketball program. After helping guide Gonzaga to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. He was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen in each of his final

three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. During his stint as an assistant at Valpo, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell capped a prolific collegiate playing career at Illinois with a national title game appearance in 2005 before going on to a successful professional playing career.

**Series Notes:** Valpo leads 9-4 in an all-time series that began in 1997-98, a season that concluded with a Sweet Sixteen appearance for the Brown & Gold. Belmont won both matchups in its first season in the Missouri Valley Conference last year, besting the Beacons 76-64 on Dec. 1 in Nashville and 74-59 on Jan. 10 in Northwest Indiana. Valpo has dropped three straight dating back to Dec. 3, 2015 and has lost three straight when visiting Belmont with the most recent head-to-head win in Nashville coming 86-60 on Feb. 7, 2000.

### **Opening League Action**

- Wednesday's game vs. Drake marked the first time Valpo has played a conference game in the month of November since joining Division-I in 1978-79.
- Valpo fell to 1-6 in league openers since joining The Valley. The Beacons have dropped the last five MVC openers after a half-court buzzer-beater by Markus Golder helped Valpo start the 2018-19 conference campaign with a 58-56 home win over Illinois State.
- This marks the second straight season that Valpo's first MVC road game has occurred at Belmont.
- Valpo is 3-3 in its first MVC road game of the season since joining the league.

### A Scoring Surge

- Entering the Nov. 21 game vs. Western Illinois, junior Darius DeAveiro had played 58 career games and owned a career high of eight points, achieved twice (Jan. 15, 2022 vs. Missouri State and Nov. 13, 2022 vs. Western Michigan). Since then, he has scored at least eight points in each of his last three games including a personal-best 11 on Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois and Nov. 29 vs. Drake.
- DeAveiro made three 3-poiners on Nov. 29 vs. Drake after having entered the game with no more than one 3-point make in any of his first 60 career games. For further comparison, he made three 3s all of last season in 25 games.
- Valpo's starting point guard entered this season with seven career made 3s over 54 games and has five 3s in the first seven contests this year.

- DeAveiro busted out of a shooting slump as he entered the Nov. 21 game against the Leathernecks having gone 0-for-10 from the field over his previous three games and 2-for-17 shooting for the season. He had scored seven total points over his first four games this season before scoring 30 points over his last three contests.
- Valpo's starting point guard has also thrived in the assist department during this recent surge, giving out five or more helpers in each of the last three games. He's tallied five or more assists on five occasions this season, including a season-best seven on Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois.
- DeAveiro became just the third Valpo player in the last decade to shoot 80 percent or better from the field (minimum five attempts) while handing out at least seven assists in the game against the Leathernecks. He was the first to do it since Max Joseph on Jan. 10, 2018 vs. Drake. Before that, the most recent was Erik Buggs on March 2, 2013 against Green Bay.

### Welcome to The Valley

- Valpo newcomers have achieved Missouri Valley Conference recognition in back-to-back weeks as Isaiah Stafford was tabbed MVC Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 20 before Cooper Schwieger earned MVC Freshman of the Week on Nov. 27.
- Valpo has already won two MVC weekly awards in the first three weeks this season, one away from the team's season total from last year and already only two away from the team's highest total number of weekly awards in a season since joining The Valley.
- Schwieger's honor came after he averaged 15.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game, going 4-of-6 from 3-point range in a pair of wins over Western Illinois and Southern.
- Stafford averaged 24.0 points per game during the week of his award, tallying 18 in a home win over Green Bay before exploding for 30 at No. 23 Illinois.

### Freshman on Fire

- Schwieger has scored 12 points or more in four consecutive games and in five of his seven games this season. He's tallied at least eight points in each of his first seven collegiate contests.
- Schwieger has shot at least 45 percent in each of his last four games, boasting five made field goals or more in each of those contests.
- The rookie has pulled down six or more rebounds in five of his first seven games.
- Schwieger has blocked at least one shot in six of his seven games.
- The Overland Park, Kan. native ranks second in the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring average among freshmen at 12.0 points per game. He is one of three rookies averaging double figures, joining Drake's Kevin Overton (14.0 ppg) and Evansville's Chuck Bailey III (11.0 ppg).
- Schwieger ranks second among MVC freshmen with 1.3 blocks per game and leads all MVC rookies with 5.6 rebounds per game.

### **Stafford's Steady Scoring**

- Isaiah Stafford has scored 17 points or more in five of his seven games this season, most recently turning in his third performance of 20+ points with 20 exactly on Nov. 29 vs. Drake.
- The junior college transfer has led the team in scoring (outright or tied) in five of the seven games this season.
- His rebounding has seen an uptick over the last three games as he has pulled down seven rebounds or more in three straight contests after a stretch of three straight games where he had three or fewer boards
- Stafford, who ranks sixth in the MVC in scoring at 17.9 points per game, made three 3s in the conference opener against the Bulldogs, his third game this season with at least a trio of triples. He also swiped three steals against Drake, his fourth multi-steal game.

### **Home-Heavy Start**

- Valpo closed out a stretch of three straight home games and six of its first seven at the ARC on Nov. 29 vs. Drake.
- Now, the Beacons will hit the road for three straight.
- Valpo started the season with three straight home games, the first time it has done so since 2016-17.
- This marked the most home games (six) that Valpo has had in the first seven games of a season since the 1969-70 season, when the Beacons traveled to Air Force and had home games against Saint Procopius, No. 10 Notre Dame, Whittier, Pacific Lutheran, Gustavus Adolphus and South Alabama over the first seven contests.
- Valpo has owned a record of .500 or better at home in 31 straight seasons.

### **Team Trends**

- Valpo has held its opponents to 33 percent or lower from 3-point range in all seven games this season. Overall, the Beacons are holding opponents to 26.5 percent from 3, ranking 22nd nationally in 3-point defense.
- The Beacons have had 15 or more free-throw attempts in each of their seven games.
- Valpo has won the turnover battle in five of the team's seven games this season including each of the team's four victories.
- Valpo ranks third in the conference in fewest turnovers committed per game at 10.6 and fourth in turnover margin at +3.0 per game.
- The Beacons rank second in the league and 47th nationally in

blocks per game at 5.0.

- Valpo has had the same starting lineup in all seven games this year – Jerome Palm, Cooper Schwieger, Jaxon Edwards, Darius DeAveiro and Isaiah Stafford.

### More Individual Beacon Bits

- Jerome Palm has scored 48 points in the first seven games this season. During the Nov. 29 game vs. Drake, he surpassed his 2022-23 season point total of 44.
- Jaxon Edwards has scored 60 points in seven games for Valpo this season. This is 10 times his scoring total of six points in 11 games while playing at Murray State a year ago.
- Ola Ajiboye has over doubled his scoring production from last season despite seeing fewer minutes. He is averaging 6.3 points per game in 18.2 minutes per game after tallying 3.0 points per game in 19.2 minutes per game last year at Central Michigan.
- Sherman Weatherspoon IV had season highs in points (eight) and rebounds (six) on Nov. 25 vs. Southern. He had three total rebounds for the season in his first five games and none over his previous three before tallying six against the Jaguars. He entered the game 2-for-14 from 3-point range but went 2-for-4 against Southern.

### Additional Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 29: Drake 83, Valpo 65

- Free-throw shooting played a big role as Valpo went just 8-of-17 (47.1 percent) and Drake was 19-of-26 (73.1 percent). Foul trouble plagued the Beacons as Jaxon Edwards, Cooper Schwieger and Ola Ajiboye were tagged with four fouls apiece.
- Drake was held to just 26.1 percent from 3-point territory, missing 17 of 23 attempts.
- Isaiah Stafford (20), Cooper Schwieger (13) and Darius DeAveiro (11) were three Beacons in double figures. Jaxon Edwards chipped in eight points to go along with seven rebounds, sharing the lead on the boards with Stafford, who also swiped three steals.

### **Scouting the Bruins**

- Picked to finish fifth in the Missouri Valley Conference preseason
- Went 21-11 overall and 14-6 in The Valley last season including an overall home mark of 12-2.
- Lost last season's star player Ben Sheppard, who was selected by the Indiana Pacers with the 26th overall pick in the 2023 NBA Draft.
- Put together a 90-70 blowout victory at UNI, the team picked second in the preseason poll, to open league play on Wednesday.
- Have won three straight games but do have losses to Furman, Arizona and Monmouth.

### Notes Wrapping Up Nov. 25: Valpo 71, Southern 59

- Isaiah Stafford and Cooper Schwieger had 17 points apiece to share gamehigh honors while also serving as the team's top two rebounders.
- Stafford squeezed nine caroms to pace the team in that area followed by Schwieger with seven and Weatherspoon with six.
- Schwieger's 17 points outdid his previous season best of 13, which came last time out on Nov. 21 vs. Western Illinois. The freshman has tallied 12 points or more in three straight and has scored at least eight points in each of his six contests.
- Stafford tied a season-high with seven made free throws and got to the stripe regularly with a season-high 11 attempts.
- With 17 points, nine rebounds and four assists, Stafford joined the short list of Valpo players who have achieved that combination in a game in the last decade Ben Krikke, Javon Freeman-Liberty (x3), Tevonn Walker, Alec Peters (5x), Shane Hammink and Ryan Broekhoff (6x in his career).
- Darius De Aveiro tallied eight points and handed out a team-high five assists.
- This marked Valpo's most lopsided victory against a Division-I opponent since Jan. 28, 2023, an 81-69 win over Evansville.
- Valpo tied a season high with 18 made free throws, the third time this year that the team has converted exactly 18 freebies. The team shot 70 percent or better at the charity stripe in each of the last five contests.
- Valpo did a good job on the defensive glass, allowing just seven Southern offensive rebounds, the first time this season a Beacon opponent had fewer than 10.

### **Bench Boost**

- In the Nov. 21 win over Western Illinois, Valpo held the upper hand in bench points, 41-8. Three players all underclassmen combined for the 41 bench points as Ola Ajiboye (21), Jahari Williamson (13) and Sherman Weatherspoon IV (seven) all made key contributions.
- Ajiboye's career-high 21 points came on 8-of-10 shooting to go along with eight rebounds, two blocks, one steal and one assist.
- Ajiboye over doubled his previous career high of 10 points, which came on Nov. 6 of this season vs. Trinity Christian.
- He became the first Valpo player to shoot 80 percent or better at the ARC (with a minimum of 10 attempts) in a game against a Division-I opponent since Alec Peters on March 4, 2014 vs. UIC. He became just the 10th Valpo player in the last decade to shoot at an 80 percent clip or better with at least 10 shots.
- Ajiboye became the first Valpo player to come off the bench and score 20 points or more against a Division-I opponent since Sheldon Edwards on Feb. 16, 2022 vs. Loyola.
- This marked quite the turnaround for Ajiboye as he played but did not score in the previous game on Nov. 17 at No. 23 Illinois.
- Ajiboye became just the fourth Valpo player in the last decade to come off the bench and score 20+ points while pulling down 8+ rebounds. He joined Sheldon Edwards (Dec. 9, 2020 vs. SIUE), Darien Walker (Nov. 14, 2014 vs. East Tennessee State) and Bobby Capobianco (Nov. 29, 2013 vs. Mercer).
- Williamson hit three 3s en route to his 13 points while also swiping three steals. He became the first Valpo freshman to achieve that combo since Connor Barrett on Jan. 9, 2021 vs. Missouri State.

### "I" Stands for Isaiah

- As Paul Oren of "The Victory Bell" put it, the "I" on the center of the court in Champaign stood for Isaiah as in Valpo's Isaiah Stafford rather than Illinois on Nov. 17 as the Beacons clashed with the No. 23 Fighting Illini.
- Stafford scored 30 points on 11-of-23 shooting, 3-of-8 from 3 and 5-of-7 at the free-throw line. He finished one point shy of a career high that was set on Feb. 26, 2022 while playing for Southern Indiana vs. Lindenwood.
- This was the most points scored by a Beacon since Ben Krikke tallied 34 at UIC on Feb. 19 of last season.
- Stafford joined Krikke (3x), Javon Freeman-Liberty (twice), Bakari Evelyn, Alec Peters (10x) and Lavone Dority (twice) as the only Valpo players in the last decade with a 30-point performance.
- Stafford had the most points scored by a non-power conference opponent against Illinois since Ohio's Jason Preston in 2020.
- The bulk of Stafford's damage came before the break as he had 23 first-half points. This marked the highest scoring half by a Beacon since Javon Freeman-Liberty had 23 on March 7, 2020 vs. Missouri State in the MVC semifinals. However, that included points scored in overtime so Freeman-Liberty's total came in 25 minutes rather

than 20.

- The last time a Valpo player scored more than 23 in a half was Alec Peters on Dec. 22, 2016, but that included double overtime.
- Stafford had Valpo's biggest first half and biggest half that did not include OT by a Valpo player since Peters scored 23 in the opening half on Dec. 17, 2016 vs. Indiana State.

### Hats Off for Half 1

- Valpo led for the entirety of a brilliant first half and held a 45-38 advantage at No. 23 Illinois at the break after owning a cushion as big as 10.
- The program was hoping to record its fifth all-time victory against a nationally-ranked opponent and its first true road win against an AP Top-25 foe. The Brown & Gold fell to 0-44 all-time on the road against nationally-ranked opponents, with three of the program's four ranked wins coming at home and one on a neutral floor.
- Each of the last two road games against Top-25 teams and three of the last six have seen Valpo own the halftime lead. In addition to the Nov. 17 game at No. 23 Illinois, Valpo led No. 22 Loyola 29-26 at the break on Feb. 17, 2021 and held a 35-33 edge at No. 25 Oregon midway through the Nov. 22, 2015 matchup.
- Valpo was also seeking its first power-conference win since 2016 vs. Alabama and was hoping to snap a 15-game skid against Big Ten Conference competition that dates back to Dec. 28, 2004 vs. Penn State.

## "The Rev" in the Community

- Since head coach Roger Powell Jr. was hired to lead Valpo's program, he has made numerous community engagement appearances including IBCA State Wide Clinic, Popcorn Fest, Valpo Kiwanis, Boys & Girls Clubs of Northwest Indiana, Big Shoulders NWI, the Valpo Athletics Coaches Tour and many more.

   An engaging speaker with an active social media presence, Powell has launched a video series featuring local restaurants called "Powell Party of Six," showcasing the Powell family meals in the community. Episode 1 featuring Burgerhaus was released prior to the season with more editions to come.
- Nicknamed "The Rev" because of his strong faith and calling as a preacher, Powell's hire as Valpo head coach made an immediate media splash. The news was featured prominently in the Chicago Sun-Times, on CBS 2 Chicago's 4 p.m. news and WGN-TV's GN Sports. He appeared on the Mully & Haugh morning show on 670 The Score in Chicago and Indiana Sports Talk with Bob Lovell out of Indianapolis.

Moye played against Powell in the Big Ten and they later finished out their playing careers as teammates with Skyliners Frankfurt in Germany in 2010-11.

- Director of Recruiting & Player Development **Lubos Barton** returns to Valpo over two decades after wrapping up his storied career donning the brown and gold. After retiring from his professional playing career, Barton stayed in the game of basketball by beginning his coaching career overseas in 2016. A member of the Valpo Athletics Hall of Fame Class of 2017, Barton was a standout on the court from 1998-2002, leading the team to three Mid-Continent Conference regular-season titles, three conference tournament championships and three NCAA Tournament appearances.
- Special Assistant to the Head Coach **Quintin Garrison** served as the associate head coach at Trinity International University from 2018-2023.
- Video coordinator / Director of Basketball Operations **Sean Taylor** served as SIUE's graduate assistant/video coordinator from August 2021 to May 2023.
- Associate Director of Sports Performance **Vijay Blackmon** is in his second season as the strength & conditioning coach for Valpo men's basketball. He previously worked with strength & conditioning as part of Bryce Drew's Grand Canyon program.

## **Inside the Roster**

- The 2023-24 roster features four returning letterwinners and 11 newcomers. The team lost 11 letterwinners from last season including all five starters
- This marks the first time since the 2013-14 season that Valpo has no starters returning from the previous season. The 2012-13 NCAA Tournament team started all seniors Ryan Broekhoff, Kevin Van Wijk, Erik Buggs, Will Bogan and Ben Boggs. The 2013-14 season featured a five-member freshmen class led by Alec Peters.
- Prior to this season, Valpo had at least two returning starters in nine consecutive years.
- The 12 scholarship players on the roster include three returners, five true freshmen and four transfers. Valpo also has three walk-ons one returner, one former Valpo football player and one transfer.
- The 12 scholarship players are comprised of two seniors, two juniors, two sophomores and six freshmen (five true; one redshirt).
- The half dozen freshmen represent the team's most since 2008-09, when the team also had six on the roster De'Andre Haskins, Cameron Witt, Nick Shelton, Andrew Ferry, Erik Buggs and Logan Jones.
- This year's roster features players from five different countries The Netherlands, Canada, Estonia, South Sudan and the Unites States. In addition, six states are represented Indiana, Illinois, Ohio, Maryland, Virginia and Kansas.

## Returnee Rundown

- Junior guard Darius DeAveiro ranked 14th in the Missouri Valley

Conference in assists per game last season. He ranked fifth in the league in assist to turnover ratio at 1.89. During his rookie year in 2021-22, he finished the season as one of two freshmen nationally with 50 or more assists and fewer than 25 turnovers. He was named a captain by head coach Roger Powell Jr. prior to the season.

- Senior guard/forward **Connor Barrett** is the team's leading returning scorer and the longest-tenured member of the program. Now in his fourth season at Valpo, Barrett saw action in 31 of the team's 32 games a year ago and scored a season-high 13 points including three made 3s on Dec. 18 vs. Elon.
- Senior forward **Jerome Palm** was named a captain by head coach Roger Powell Jr. prior to the season. He joined Valpo last year after a pair of junior college seasons. He had a season-high 11 points to go along with nine rebounds on Dec. 1 at Belmont.

- Sophomore guard **Jaxon Edwards** has experience in the Missouri Valley Conference after playing in 11 games during the 2022-23 season as a freshman at Murray State. He led Cathedral to the 2021-22 Indiana 4A state championship in high school.
- Freshman guard **Sherman Weatherspoon IV** played at Golden State Prep in Napa Valley, Calif. in 2022-23, averaging 25 points, eight rebounds and four assists.
- Sophomore forward **Ola Ajiobye** played in 30 of 31 games with 14 starts at Central Michigan as a true freshman in 2022-23.
- Freshman guard **Jahari Williamson** played for Canada's U19 World Cup Team in Summer 2023 after participating in the U18 2022 Canada Games for Team Ontario.
- Freshman forward **Lucas Scroggins** spent the 2022-23 season at Bosco Institute in Crown Point.
- Freshman forward **Cooper Schwieger** averaged 11.2 points, 7.4 rebounds and 3.3 assists at Link Year Prep in Branson, Mo. last season.

# Roger Powell Jr.

Head Coach 1st Season \* Illinois, 2005 4-3 Overall and at Valpo

**Roger Powell Jr.** was named the 23rd head coach of the Valparaiso University men's basketball program on April 7, 2023.

After helping guide Gonzaga University to a 121-13 record during his four seasons as an assistant coach, Powell returned to Valpo, where he was part of head coach Bryce Drew's staff from 2011-2016 and led the team to 124 wins in five seasons, including a program-record 30 victories and a National Invitation Tournament (NIT) title game appearance in 2015-16. Powell becomes the first Black head coach in the history of the Valpo men's basketball program.

Powell was part of head coach Mark Few's Gonzaga staff as the Bulldogs reached the 2021 national championship game after winning their first 31 games of the season. During Powell's first season on staff in 2019-20, Gonzaga was 31-2 at the time the NCAA college basketball season was halted due to COVID-19. The Bulldogs reached the Sweet Sixteen each of his final three seasons on staff, including two Elite Eight appearances and the aforementioned trip to the 2021 national title game. The 2020-21 team spent the entire season ranked No. 1 in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 overall seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in 2021 and 2022.

Prior to his arrival at Gonzaga, Powell served as the associate head coach at Vanderbilt University under Bryce Drew from 2016-2019. In his first season in Nashville, he helped lead the Commodores to an NCAA Tournament appearance. Vanderbilt notched five top-25 wins, six top-50 victories and 11 top-100 RPI wins while playing the toughest strength of schedule nationally.

During Powell's first stint on the Valpo bench, he was part of four Horizon League regular-season championships in a five-year period while also leading the 2012-13 and 2014-15 squads to Horizon League tournament titles and NCAA Tournament appearances. Valpo reached postseason tournaments in each of his five seasons on staff, including the memorable run to the NIT title game in 2016 which featured wins over Florida State, Saint Mary's and BYU.

A product of Joliet West High School and a native of Joliet, Ill., Powell was a three-year starter for the University of Illinois during his playing days, earning Honorable Mention All-Big Ten recognition in each of his final two seasons after being named to the Big Ten All-Tournament Team as a sophomore. His winning track record dates as far back as his days playing for the Illini, when he helped the team to three Big Ten regular-season titles, two Big Ten Tournament crowns and three Sweet Sixteen berths. During his senior year in 2004-05, Powell was part of an Illini team that finished 37-2, won 29 straight to open the season and reached the national title game.

Powell accumulated 1,178 points and 531 rebounds during his four-year career at Illinois. He finished his career ranked among the top 30 scorers in program history. Following his collegiate tenure, Powell began a professional career that included a stint in the NBA with the Utah Jazz during the 2006-2007 season. He also played for the Rockford Lightning (CBA, 2005-06), Arkansas Rimrockers (2006-07, D-League), Siviglia Wear Teramo (Italy, 2007-08), Murcia (Spain, 2009-10), JDA Dijon (France, 2010) and Skyliners Frankfurt (Germany, 2010-11).

Off the court, Powell founded RPJ Ministries Organization, which mentors and trains young leaders to be Godly examples on their sports team and school campuses. He also founded Integrity Sports Corporation, a company focused on building basketball skills and integrity of high school and junior high athletes. Powell is a 2005 graduate of the University of Illinois with a degree in speech communications and received his master's degree in Sports Administration from Valpo in 2016.

Powell and his wife, Tara, have four children – Bria, Liam, Gabriel and Faith.
