Next Up in Valpo Baseball: Three weekends remain of regular-season action, and the Valparaiso University baseball team will look to take another step toward locking up a Missouri Valley Conference Tournament berth as the Beacons welcome MVC preseason favorite Southern Illinois to Porter County for a three-game series that cranks up on Friday. Valpo enters the weekend in sixth place in a 10-team league in which the top eight teams reach the conference tournament, but three teams are tied for seventh and only one game behind the Beacons.

Last Time Out: Valpo's scheduled midweek game at Western Michigan was canceled due to horrific weather after the Beacons dropped three games at Missouri State last weekend in Springfield. The first game went extras thanks to a heroic game-tying three-run homer by Patrick Ilitch with two outs in the ninth inning, but the Bears walked off with a 4-3 win in 10. The hosts invoked the 10-run rule with a 12-2 win in Game 2 before fending off a late Valpo rally for a 9-6 triumph in the series finale.

Following the Beacons: The Friday and Sunday games this weekend will stream on ESPN+, while Saturday's contest will be streamed on ESPN3. Todd Ickow (Friday/Sunday play-by-play), Sam Michel (Friday/Sunday analyst, Saturday play-by-play) and Joshua Lipowski (Saturday analyst) will have the call this weekend. Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (184-286) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he entered 2023 having skippered 435 Valpo games. He entered the season with 168 victories, one of four coaches in program history with over 150. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 10-7 lead in an all-time series that dates back to 1966. Last season, Valpo dropped two of three in Carbondale but prevailed 11-10 in a high-scoring series finale after dropping the middle game in a similar slugfest, 15-12. SIU blanked the Beacons in the series opener, 4-0. Valpo has had good success at Emory G. Bauer Field against the Salukis, taking three of four in 2021 and sweeping a three-game series in 2019. Valpo is 6-1 all-time when hosting SIU.

In the Other Dugout – SIU

- Looking to rebound after losing two of three at home against Illinois State last weekend. After utilizing the 10-run rule in an 11-1 win in Game 1, the Salukis dropped a pair of thrillers, 5-4 and 10-7 in 12 innings.
- The Salukis were swept by nationally-ranked Indiana State the previous weekend, but own series wins over Evansville and Bradley and sweeps of UIC and Belmont.
- Preseason favorite to win the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Coming off a 44-16 season in 2022.

- Enter the weekend in third place in the 10-team league, looking up at only Indiana State and Missouri State.

Program Progress

- Valpo currently has 16 wins, which was the team's final win total each of the last two seasons. That comes despite the fact that six games have been canceled and not made up and 10 games still remain on the regular-season schedule.
- With the team's next victory, Valpo will secure its highest overall win total since the 2018 campaign.
- If the season ended now, Valpo's current overall winning percentage would mark the program's best since 2016.
- Valpo needs two more conference wins to match and three to surpass its highest conference win total since joining the league.
- Valpo is on pace to secure its highest conference-only winning percentage since joining the league.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka has hit safely in his last eight games, and has recorded multiple hits in six of those eight contests.
- Of the six multi-hit games during that stretch, three of them have been three-hit outputs.
- Entering the second game of the doubleheader on April 15 at Bradley, Maka was hitting .268 for the season. Since then, he is hitting .563 to go along with a .583 OBP and .969 slugging percentage, leading the team in all three slash-line categories in that stretch.
- Of his 18 hits during those eight games, seven have gone for extra bases, including three home runs. He has totaled 31 bases and driven in 12 runs while scoring 11.
- Maka has suddenly made his way onto the league-leaders page in batting average, as his team-best average of .341 ranks sixth in The Valley.

Olive Branches

- After starting the season with a .217 average over the first eight games he played, Matt Olive has hit .429 over his last eight games.
- Five of his 12 hits during that stretch have gone for extra bases including three home runs.
- Olive owns 11 RBIs and 23 total bases during those eight games, and he's slugging .821 to go along with a .528 on-base percentage.
- Olive has hit safely in all eight games during that stretch which was interrupted when he missed time due to a hamstring injury. He has multiple hits in four of his last seven.
- He has also notched multiple RBIs in four of his last eight.

Schmack Swiping Sacks

- Kyle Schmack has lifted his season stolen base total to 10, which ranks tied for eighth in the Missouri Valley Conference.
- Schmack becomes the first Valpo player to reach double figures in the stolen-base column since Chase Dawson back in 2018.
- With one more steal, Schmack would own Valpo's highest single-season stolen base total since 2017, when James Stea swiped 21 bags.

Banged Up Beacons

- Valpo played without four starting position players during its recent series at Missouri State as third baseman Kaleb Hannahs, catcher Kade Reinertson and outfielder Spencer Warfield are all currently on the shelf, while first baseman Brady Renfro also missed the series after he was a late scratch prior to Friday's series opener.
- Furthermore, Valpo has been without two potential weekend starting pitchers as Connor Lockwood went down with a season-ending injury and Trent Turzenski has yet to take the mound this season as he recovers from an injury.

 OF/1B Kyle Schmack, DH/OF Matt Olive and DH/C Jake Skrine have all either missed games or left a game early during this recent injury-riddled stretch.

Storybook Moment (Minus the Fairytale Ending)

- The series opener at Missouri State on Friday, April 28 was all but over with two outs and nobody on base in the ninth inning and the lower third of the Valpo batting order due up with the Beacons trailing 3-0.
- Back-to-back walks to the No. 7 and No. 8 hitters set the stage for redshirt freshman Patrick Ilitch, who was inserted into the starting lineup less than an hour before game time due to an injury-related scratch and had just two career at-bats prior to the game.
- Ilitch whose family owns Little Caesars Pizza, the Detroit Tigers and the Detroit Red Wings delivered by smacking his first career home run to left, leveling the score at three.
- Missouri State eventually won on a walk-off home run in the 10th.

Notes Wrapping Up Missouri State

- Valpo outhit Missouri State 8-7 in the series opener, but incurred the team's sixth loss of the season when outhitting the opponent. Seven of the eight hits were singles, with the lone exception the game-tying home run by Patrick Ilitch in the ninth inning.
- Valpo played its eighth one-run game of the year in the series opener, dropping to 5-3 in such contests.
- The series opener was the team's fourth extra-inning contest of the year and its first extra-inning defeat.
- Matt Olive hit his fifth home run of the season and the seventh of his career in the windy series finale.
- Kyle Schmack worked four walks in the series finale, becoming the first Valpo player to reach four times via the base on balls in the same game since Spencer Mahoney on April 2, 2014 vs. Northern Illinois.

Renfro's Impressive Streak Snapped

- Brady Renfro reached base in the first 30 games of the 2023 season before his streak was snapped on April 22 vs. UIC.
- He became the first Valpo player to reach in 20 straight since Kaleb Hannahs did so in the final 20 games of the 2021 season.
- On April 9 at Evansville, Renfro surpassed Sam Shaikin's 23 gamer from 2017.
- Renfro owned Valpo's longest on-base streak since Nolan Lodden reached safely in 34 straight in 2016.

Nowak's New Role

- After his first 25 outings with the Brown and Gold since joining the team prior to last season all came in relief, Bobby Nowak has started a game during each of the last six series.
- The transition to starter has been smooth as Nowak ranks among the league leaders in several categories.
- He has permitted just 7.00 hits per nine innings, a total that ranks second in the MVC.
- Nowak has fanned opponents at a high clip, notching 12.25 strikeouts per nine innings. That leads The Valley and ranks 34th nationally.
- Nowak's ERA of 3.50 is in the top 10 in the league (seventh), while his opponent batting average of .215 ranks fourth.
- The right-hander tossed a three-hit shutout in the second game of a

doubleheader on April 15 at Bradley. He walked three and struck out six in a game that Valpo won 10-0 in seven innings on 10-run rule.

- Nowak pitched Valpo's first shutout since March 12, 2021, a no-hitter by Colin Fields. He threw the team's first three-hitter since Dalton Lundeen on May 1, 2015 vs. Milwaukee. Since that time, Fields was the only Valpo pitcher to allow three hits or fewer while going the distance.
- Nowak's effort was Valpo's first complete game since Trent Turzenski on Feb. 25, 2022 at Alabama A&M.

Notes Wrapping Up UIC (April 21-23)

- Three different Beacons had multiple home runs in the three-game series as Valpo totaled seven long balls as a team.
- Ryan Maka, who hit .571 in four games during the week with four extra-base hits, eight RBIs and seven runs scored, had two big flies against the Flames. He lifted his season home run total to six and his career total to 11.
- Jake Skrine had a multi-homer series and has now gone yard in five of his last seven games. He has seven total home runs this year after joining Valpo as a graduate transfer from Indiana.
- After entering the weekend having missed the previous six games with a hamstring injury, Matt Olive homered in each of the first two games of the series. He now has four home runs this season and six in his career.
- In the series opener, Josh Cottrill earned the win in relief, the first decision of his collegiate career. He worked four innings of five-run, five-hit ball while walking four and striking out three.
- Valpo batters struck out just twice in the series opener, tying a season best set on March 5 at Little Rock. This was the fewest times Valpo batters had struck out in a league game since the team struck out just once on May 16, 2021 vs. Evansville.
- The team banged out 17 hits in the series-opening win, tying a season high set twice in late February during a series at UT Martin. That marked the team's highest hit total in Valley play since May 1, 2021 vs. Illinois State (18).
- The second game in the series a 5-4 win on Saturday saw Ryan Mintz earn his first win of the season and his second in a Valpo uniform after logging three scoreless innings of two-hit ball while issuing no walks.
- The Saturday game represented Valpo's seventh one-run game of the season with the Beacons upping their record to 5-2 in such contests.
- Redshirt freshman Patrick Ilitch had his first collegiate hit in Sunday's series finale.
- The 21 runs scored by UIC in the series finale were the most allowed by Valpo in a game since San Diego State scored 22 times on Feb. 14, 2015.

Weekly Awards Sweep

- Valpo earned its first sweep of the Missouri Valley Conference weekly awards since joining the league when Jake Skrine was named MVC Player of the Week and Bobby Nowak was tabbed MVC Pitcher of the Week on Monday, April 17.
- The last time Valpo swept the weekly awards in any conference was May 16, 2016, when Jake Hanson was named Horizon League Batter of the Week and Ellis Foreman achieved Horizon League Pitcher of the Week status.
- Skrine became the fourth member of the program to win MVC Player of the Week honors since joining the league and the first this season. He joined Sam Shaikin, Kaleb Hannahs and Nolan Tucker.
- Nowak became the third Beacon to earn MVC Pitcher of the Week this season, joining Jacob Rosenkranz and Connor Lockwood. Prior to this year,

Valpo had won MVC Pitcher of the Week accolades on four occasions since joining the league – Jake Miller, Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse.

Skrine Doing Fine

- Jake Skrine's MVC Player of the Week nod on April 17 came after he batted .636 (7-for-11) with five runs scored, three home runs and nine RBIs in a three-game road sweep of Bradley. He hit a long home run in each of the three games in the series on his way to racking up 16 total bases, slugging 1.455 and reaching base at a .643 clip.
- In the second game of the series, Skrine had the first five-RBI game by a Valpo player since Riley Dent batted in six on May 1, 2021 at Illinois State. He also went 4-for-4 in that game and scored a pair of runs. He drove in a run in each of his five plate appearances.
- In the Saturday doubleheader at Bradley, Skrine went 6-for-7 with two home runs, four runs scored and seven RBIs. He was named the National Player of the Day by D1Baseball.
- Skrine's huge weekend came in his return to the lineup after missing the previous two games due to an injury. With starting catcher Kade Reinertson sidelined, he got the nod behind the plate and had a strong defensive series as well, posting a perfect fielding percentage to go along with no passed balls while cutting down a pair of would-be base stealers.

Beacon Brooms + Blanking the Braves

- The three-game road sweep at Bradley April 14-15 marked the program's first road sweep of a league series since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. Valpo's last sweep of a road conference series of three games or more was March 18-20, 2016 at Northern Kentucky.
- It was the first time Valpo swept a conference series in any location since taking all three from Southern Illinois on May 10-12, 2019 at Emory G. Bauer Field.
- The exclamation mark on the series was a 10-0 win in the finale, Valpo's first shutout of the season and first since March 25, 2022 vs. St. Bonaventure, a game decided by the identical score of 10-0.
- The 10-0 triumph marked Valpo's most lopsided league victory since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. The seven-inning win marked the first time Valpo implemented the 10-run rule since joining the league prior to the 2018 season.
- That was also Valpo's first shutout in a league game since joining The Valley. The team's last shutout win in conference play was April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State.

Strong Start

- Valpo stood at 7-6 through 13 games. That marked the program's best record at this juncture of the season since Paul Twenge's group won eight of its first 13 in 1997.
- Through nine games, the Valpo baseball program was off to its best start since Bruce Springsteen, Madonna and way before Nirvana as the team's 6-3 record was its best at this point in the season since 1985. Head coach Rick Ferchen's team began 1985 with a 7-2 mark through nine games.
- The highlight of the sizzling start was a five-game winning streak that was snapped in Sunday's series finale at Little Rock. That marked the team's longest winning streak since recording six straight from May 15-25, 2016. That stretch featured wins over Oakland, Youngstown State and Northern Kentucky.

Top-25 Triumph

- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener.
- The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.

- At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.
- Southern Miss entered the game ranked No. 22 by Baseball America, the NCBWA and D1Baseball, while ranking No. 24 in the coaches' poll and No. 30 according to Collegiate Baseball.
- The Golden Eagles were the preseason favorites to win the Sun Belt Conference and won an NCAA Regional last season before falling to Ole Miss in the Super Regional. They own a streak of six straight 40-win seasons, the longest such streak in Division-I Baseball.
- Southern Miss swept former Missouri Valley Conference member (and powerhouse) Dallas Baptist the weekend prior to dropping the game to the Beacons.

Outdueling An All-American

- In the 6-1 victory at No. 22 Southern Miss on March 10, Valpo handed 2022 consensus All-American starting pitcher Tanner Hall the loss. He went six innings and allowed two runs on six hits while walking two and striking out five.
- Hall was outdueled by Valpo starting pitcher Jacob Rosenkranz, who yielded one run on just two hits in six innings to pick up the win. He walked only one and notched three strikeouts, needing only 60 pitches to get through six frames.
- The win marked the second of Rosenkranz's career, with both coming this season. His prior victory occurred on Feb. 26 at UT Martin.
- Rosenkranz was making the second start of his collegiate career and his first of the season. This one had a far different result than his first collegiate start, which came way back on March 14, 2021 at Middle Tennessee. In that outing, he did not record an out and was charged with three runs on one hit while walking two.
- After Rosenkranz was lifted, Ryan Mintz did the rest, working in and out of trouble over three scoreless innings to nail down his first career save.
- Thanks to his standout showing on the mound in the win over the Eagles, Rosenkranz was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on March 13. He became the second Valpo pitcher to earn an MVC weekly award this season, joining Connor Lockwood. They join Jake Miller, Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse as the only Valpo hurlers to achieve MVC Pitcher of the Week status since the program joined the league.

valPROS

- Valpo's program produced a pair of pitchers who went on to continue their careers in professional organizations following the 2022 spring.
- Left-hander Jake Miller was selected with the 237th overall pick in the eighth round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Detroit Tigers. He became Valpo's first draft choice since Scott Kapers was selected in the 17th round of the 2018 draft by the Texas Rangers.
- Miller was Valpo's highest draft choice since 2010, when Kyle Gaedele went to the San Diego Padres in the sixth round. The New York native was the highest Missouri Valley Conference

pitcher taken in the 2022 draft.

- Miller made his professional debut by pitching in five games in 2022 for the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Class-A Florida State League.
- Right-hander Colin Fields was signed by the Tigers as an undrafted free agent following the 2022 draft.
- Miller and Fields are part of a long list of Tiger ties within Valpo's program. Valpo legend Lloyd McClendon was on the Tigers big league coaching staff from 2006-2013 and 2017-2020 including a stint as interim manager, former Valpo players Bo McClendon and Dalton Lundeen were also drafted by the Tigers, Valpo head coach Brian Schmack played in the big leagues with the Tigers in 2003 and current Valpo player Patrick Ilitch is the grandson of longtime Tigers owner Michael Ilitch (1992-2017) and the nephew of current owner Christopher Ilitch (2017-present).

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- The Valpo offense is loaded with returning talent in 2023 as 82.7 percent of the team's hits from last season came from players who are back for the 2023 campaign. The top six Beacons in terms of batting average return and 11 of the 15 position players who saw action a year ago are back with the program. Relievers Nathan Chasey and Bobby Nowak are back after posting the club's top two ERAs a year ago, but the top two arms in the weekend rotation Jake Miller and Colin Fields were snatched up by the Detroit Tigers.
- Valpo's newcomers include five freshmen (Kyle Tyler, Will Radich, Adam Guazzo, Cole Syversen and Thomas Cooper), two junior college transfers (Josh Spencer and Kaleb Krier) and one four-year transfer (Jake Skrine, Indiana).

Pitching Profiles
