Next Up in Valpo Baseball: The Valparaiso University baseball program has put itself in a good position to make the upcoming Missouri Valley Conference Tournament in Terre Haute, but there is still work to be done this weekend at Emory G. Bauer Field. Valpo enters the three-game series against Illinois State needing one victory to lock up a conference-tournament berth. Valpo, Illinois State, Belmont and Bradley are all battling for the final two spots in the league tournament entering this weekend. In addition to important games, there will be a lot going on at Emory G. Bauer Field this weekend as Saturday will be a Valpo Alumni event with former members of the baseball program returning to town as well as senior day with three seniors being recognized as part of a pregame ceremony that will begin at 12:40 p.m.

Last Time Out: Valpo blitzed Belmont 12-3 in the series opener on Friday afternoon in Nashville as Griffin McCluskey delivered a strong pitching performance and Kyle Schmack and Jake Skrine both belted home runs. The Bruins did rally to win the remaining games in the weekend series, invoking the 10-run rule in a 13-3 win on Saturday before capturing a 5-1 triumph in the Sunday finale.

Following the Beacons: The Thursday and Friday games will air on ESPN+, while the Saturday contest will be carried on ESPN3. Todd Ickow will describe the scene with his play-by-play for all three games, while he'll be joined by a star-studded cast of color analysts featuring Leo Staudacher (Thursday), Brian Jennings (Friday) and Aaron Leavitt (Saturday). Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (187-290) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he entered 2023 having skipped 435 Valpo games. He entered the season with 168 victories, one of four coaches in program history with over 150. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Valpo holds a 15-25-1 all-time record in a series that dates back to 1969. The Brown & Gold went on the road and took two of three from the Redbirds last season in Normal after bouncing Illinois State from the MVC Tournament with a 6-5 win in Carbondale the year prior. Valpo also won three of four in the 2021 regular-season series at Emory G. Bauer Field. The Beacons are 8-6 against Illinois State since joining the Missouri Valley Conference including a 7-2 record in the last nine matchups.

McCluskey vs. Hometown Team: Griffin McCluskey will try to pitch Valpo into the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament on Thursday, and he will do so against his hometown team. The Normal, Ill. native will look to once again rise to the occasion against the Redbirds. Last season, he earned his first collegiate victory on April 17 in his hometown by limiting Illinois State to one run on four hits while walking one and striking out five over six quality innings, helping Valpo win the rubber match of the road series.

Senior Salute: Valpo will recognize three seniors as part of a pregame ceremony that is slated to begin at 12:40 p.m. on Saturday. The Beacons will recognize the trio of seniors who are completing their eligibility this year – pitcher Bobby Nowak, pitcher Nathan Chasey and catcher Jake Skrine.

In the Other Dugout – Illinois State

- Picked to finish seventh in the MVC preseason poll.
- Were swept in a key series with UIC at home last weekend, losing the first two games 10-0 and 11-2 before falling 3-2 in the finale.
- Have dropped six of their last seven but prior to that, picked up a road series win over Southern Illinois.
- Both teams are under the direction of ex-big leaguers as Illinois State head coach Steve Holm played for the San Francisco Giants (2008, 2009) and Minnesota Twins (2011), while of course Valpo's Brian Schmack pitched for the Detroit Tigers in 2003.

MVC Tournament Scenarios

- If Valpo gets swept by Illinois State this weekend, the team's only path to making the conference tournament field would be Bradley sweeping Belmont.
- If Valpo wins one game this weekend, the Beacons will clinch a spot in the MVC Tournament. One win over the Redbirds would assure that Valpo would finish ahead of both Bradley and Illinois State regardless of other outcomes this weekend. If Valpo wins exactly one game this weekend, the Beacons would be the No. 7 seed if Bradley wins the Belmont/Bradley series or the No. 8 seed if Belmont wins the Belmont/Bradley series.
- If Valpo wins two of three this weekend, the Beacons would finish as the No. 7 seed as long as Bradley wins at least one game against Belmont. If Valpo wins two of three but Belmont sweeps Bradley, then Valpo would be the No. 8 seed.
- If Valpo sweeps the weekend series from Illinois State, the Beacons would guarantee themselves at least the No. 7 seed. If Valpo sweeps Illinois State, UIC gets swept by Evansville and Murray State wins at least one game against Southern Illinois, Valpo would move up to the No. 6 seed. If Valpo sweeps Illinois State, UIC gets swept by Evansville and Murray State gets swept by Southern Illinois, there would be a three-way tie for fifth between Valpo, UIC and Murray State. All three teams would own a 3-3 record in games against the other two teams, so a "top down" tiebreaker would be used. Valpo would most likely end up as the No. 7 seed in this scenario since Murray State and UIC both have wins over first-place Indiana State.
- The double-elimination MVC Tournament will begin on Tuesday, May 23 in Terre Haute. The No. 6 seed will play the No. 7 seed at 2:30 p.m. and the No. 5 seed will play the No. 8 seed at 6 p.m. on the tournament's first day.

Program Progress

- Valpo currently has 19 wins, recently surpassing the team's win total of 16 that was reached each of the last two seasons.
- Valpo has secured its highest overall win total since the 2018 campaign.
- The team's highest overall win total comes despite the fact that six games have been called off due to poor weather.
- One more win would give the Beacons their first 20-win season since joining the Missouri Valley Conference prior to the 2018 campaign. Their last 20-win season came in 2017, when they won 24 contests.
- If the season ended now, Valpo's current overall winning percentage would mark the program's best since 2017.
- With nine conference victories, Valpo has tied its highest MVC win total since joining the conference. One more would give the program its outright league-only high.
- Valpo has already clinched its best conference winning percentage since joining the league. The Beacons will finish with no worse than a .333 league-only winning percentage. Prior to this season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.

- If Valpo qualifies for the MVC Tournament, that would also represent the first time the program has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Talkin' Schmack

- With Valpo's victory over Belmont on May 12, head coach Brian Schmack tied his predecessor Tracy Woodson for third on Valpo's all-time wins list.
- Schmack needs one more win to move into sole possession of third on the program's all-time wins list.
- Entering the Illinois State series, Schmack owns 187 career wins.
- With one more victory, Schmack would sit behind only Paul Twenge (1986-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359) on Valpo's all-time wins list.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo has launched 43 home runs this season, recently surpassing the 2018 campaign for fifth on the program's single-season home run list.
- This year's team owns the program's highest single-season home run total since 2002, when the team ripped 49 dingers, a total that ranks fourth in the program record book.
- Valpo holds its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.

Other Record Book Watches

- The Beacons are also reaching base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage is positioned to be its highest in over 20 years. If the season ended today, that mark would rank tied for fifth in the program's single-season record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This would be the first time since 2001 that Valpo would own an OBP of .386 or better, and if the Beacons move that up another percentage point, it would be the squad's best team OBP since 1999.
- Valpo owns a .976 fielding percentage for the season, in line to shatter the program record of .973 set in 2018.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka recently saw his 13-game hitting streak come to an end, but he still enters this weekend's series with Illinois State owning a 23-game on-base streak.
- Entering the second game of the doubleheader on April 15 at Bradley, Maka was hitting .268 for the season. Since then, he is hitting .566 to go along with a .522 OBP and .776 slugging percentage, leading the team in all three slash-line categories in that stretch.
- Of his 27 hits during those 15 games, 10 have gone for extra bases, including four home runs. He has totaled 45 bases and driven in 23 runs while scoring 15.
- Maka has made his way onto the league-leaders page in batting average, as his team-best average of .342 ranks third in The Valley.

Notes Wrapping Up Belmont (May 12-14)

- Griffin McCluskey started the series with an 11- strikeout, no-walk performance over eight strong innings to pitch Valpo to a 12-3 victory on Friday. He achieved the highest single-game strikeout total by a Valpo

pitcher since Jake Miller fanned 11 on April 3, 2022 at UIC.

- The 12 runs in the series opener tied Valpo's season high, reached on two prior occasions.
- Bobby Nowak did not allow a hit in his 5 1/3 innings in Sunday's series finale, but did walk six. He left the game with Valpo clinging to a 1-0 lead but was responsible for two runners on base, and eventually took a tough-luck loss in Valpo's 5-1 setback.
- Valpo owned a 7-3 edge in the hit column in the series finale, but Belmont held the upper hand in the column that counts.
- The Game 1 win helped Valpo improve to 11-0 when scoring nine runs or more this season.

Olive Branches

- After starting the season with a .217 average over the first eight games he played, Matt Olive has hit .360 over his last 15 games.
- Six of his 18 hits during that stretch have gone for extra bases including three home runs.
- Olive owns 15 RBIs and 30 total bases during those games, and he's slugging .600 to go along with a .507 on-base percentage.

Banged Up Beacons

- Valpo played without four starting position players for an extended period of time as third baseman Kaleb Hannahs, catcher Kade Reinertson, outfielder Spencer Warfield and first baseman Brady Renfro have all been sidelined.
- Furthermore, Valpo has been without two potential weekend starting pitchers as Connor Lockwood went down with a season-ending injury and Trent Turzenski has logged just one inning this season.
- OF/1B Kyle Schmack, DH/OF Matt Olive and DH/C Jake Skrine have all either missed games or left a game early during this recent injury-riddled stretch.

Notes Wrapping Up May 9: Valpo 9, Western Michigan 6

- Kyle Schmack had a three-hit game, his second of the season, matching his season high in the hit column that was set on April 8 at Evansville.
- Schmack's three RBIs marked his highest single-game total since four on Feb. 26 at UT Martin. He had a walk and two runs scored to go along with his big day that featured a pair of doubles.
- Jake Skrine had a triple, his first in a Valpo uniform.
- Valpo extended its head-to-head winning streak against Western Michigan to five.

Grand Salami Time

- Valpo has three grand slams this season, with Ryan Maka owning two of them.
- Maka's first slam came on April 2 vs. Murray State and his second was May 5 vs. Southern Illinois. Brady Renfro also has a grand slam, which occurred on March 10 at No. 22 Southern Miss.
- Prior to Renfro's bases-loaded big fly, no Valpo player had turned the trick since 2019 (Sam Shaikin).
- There have been 11 grand slams since Brian Schmack took over as Valpo head coach in 2014, and Maka is the first player with two in that time.
- Maka is the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- This marks the first time since at least 2006 that Valpo has slugged three

Back on the Bump

- In the top of the ninth of the May 7 game vs. Southern Illinois, Trent Turzenski logged his first inning of the season.
- The right-hander saw his first action since April 1, 2022 at UIC, when he went down with an elbow injury. He went over 13 months in between game action after undergoing Tommy John UCL reconstruction surgery.
- Turzenski, who was the Friday starting pitcher last season at the time of his injury, faced the minimum with help from a double play and worked a scoreless frame in his return to the bump against SIU.

Notes Wrapping Up Southern Illinois (May 5-7)

- Valpo's 9-8 win over the Salukis on May 5 helped the team improve to 9-0 when scoring nine runs or more this season.
- Valpo played its ninth one-run game of the season and improved to 6-3 in such contests.
- The win in the series opener helped Valpo improve to 7-1 all-time against SIU at Emory G. Bauer Field, but the Salukis rallied to win each of the next two games.
- The win in the series opener was Valpo's first against the MVC preseason favorite since 2018. Valpo had dropped 13 straight against teams picked to win the league since beating DBU during the 2018 campaign.
- Alex Thurston and Alex Ryan both had a season-high four hits in Sunday's series finale. For Ryan, the four hits represented a career high.

Storybook Moment (Minus the Fairytale Ending)

- The series opener at Missouri State on Friday, April 28 was all but over with two outs and nobody on base in the ninth inning and the lower third of the Valpo batting order due up with the Beacons trailing 3-0.
- Back-to-back walks to the No. 7 and No. 8 hitters set the stage for redshirt freshman Patrick Ilitch, who was inserted into the starting lineup less than an hour before game time due to an injury-related scratch and had just two career at-bats prior to the game.
- Ilitch – whose family owns Little Caesars Pizza, the Detroit Tigers and the Detroit Red Wings – delivered by smacking his first career home run to left, leveling the score at three.
- Missouri State eventually won on a walk-off home run in the 10th.

Renfro's Impressive Streak Snapped

- Brady Renfro reached base in the first 30 games of the 2023 season before his streak was snapped on April 22 vs. UIC.
- He became the first Valpo player to reach in 20 straight since Kaleb Hannahs did so in the final 20 games of the 2021 season.
- On April 9 at Evansville, Renfro surpassed Sam Shaikin's 23 gamer from 2017.
- Renfro owned Valpo's longest on-base streak since Nolan Lodden reached safely in 34 straight in 2016.

Weekly Awards Sweep

- Valpo earned its first sweep of the Missouri Valley Conference weekly awards since joining the league when Jake Skrine was named MVC Player of the Week and Bobby Nowak was tabbed MVC Pitcher of the Week on Monday, April 17.
- The last time Valpo swept the weekly awards in any conference was May 16, 2016, when Jake Hanson was named Horizon League Batter of the Week and Ellis Foreman achieved Horizon League Pitcher of the Week status.
- Skrine became the fourth member of the program to win MVC Player of the Week honors since joining the league and the first this season. He joined Sam Shaikin, Kaleb Hannahs and Nolan Tucker.
- Nowak became the third Beacon to earn MVC Pitcher of the Week this season, joining Jacob Rosenkranz and Connor Lockwood. Prior to this year, Valpo had won MVC Pitcher of the Week accolades on four occasions since joining the league – Jake Miller, Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse.

Beacon Brooms + Blanking the Braves

- The three-game road sweep at Bradley April 14-15 marked the program's first road sweep of a league series since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. Valpo's last sweep of a road conference series of three games or more was March 18-20, 2016 at Northern Kentucky.
- It was the first time Valpo swept a conference series in any location since taking all three from Southern Illinois on May 10-12, 2019 at Emory G. Bauer Field.
- The exclamation mark on the series was a 10-0 win in the finale, Valpo's first shutout of the season and first since March 25, 2022 vs. St. Bonaventure, a game decided by the identical score of 10-0.
- The 10-0 triumph marked Valpo's most lopsided league victory since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. The seven-inning win marked the first time Valpo implemented the 10-run rule since joining the league prior to the 2018 season.
- That was also Valpo's first shutout in a league game since joining The Valley. The team's last shutout win in conference play was April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State.

Strong Start

- Valpo stood at 7-6 through 13 games. That marked the program's best record at this juncture of the season since Paul Twenge's group won eight of its first 13 in 1997.
- Through nine games, the Valpo baseball program was off to its best start since Bruce Springsteen, Madonna and way before

Nirvana as the team's 6-3 record was its best at this point in the season since 1985. Head coach Rick Ferchen's team began 1985 with a 7-2 mark through nine games.

- The highlight of the sizzling start was a five-game winning streak that was snapped in Sunday's series finale at Little Rock. That marked the team's longest winning streak since recording six straight from May 15-25, 2016. That stretch featured wins over Oakland, Youngstown State and Northern Kentucky.

Top-25 Triumph

- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener.

- The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.

- At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.

- Southern Miss entered the game ranked No. 22 by Baseball America, the NCBWA and D1Baseball, while ranking No. 24 in the coaches' poll and No. 30 according to Collegiate Baseball.

- The Golden Eagles were the preseason favorites to win the Sun Belt Conference and won an NCAA Regional last season before falling to Ole Miss in the Super Regional. They own a streak of six straight 40-win seasons, the longest such streak in Division-I Baseball.

- Southern Miss swept former Missouri Valley Conference member (and powerhouse) Dallas Baptist the weekend prior to dropping the game to the Beacons.

Outdueling An All-American

- In the 6-1 victory at No. 22 Southern Miss on March 10, Valpo handed 2022 consensus All-American starting pitcher Tanner Hall the loss. He went six innings and allowed two runs on six hits while walking two and striking out five.

- Hall was outdueling by Valpo starting pitcher Jacob Rosenkranz, who yielded one run on just two hits in six innings to pick up the win. He walked only one and notched three strikeouts, needing only 60 pitches to get through six frames.

- The win marked the second of Rosenkranz's career, with both coming this season. His prior victory occurred on Feb. 26 at UT Martin.

- Rosenkranz was making the second start of his collegiate career and his first of the season. This one had a far different result than his first collegiate start, which came way back on March 14, 2021 at Middle Tennessee. In that outing, he did not record an out and was charged with three runs on one hit while walking two.

- After Rosenkranz was lifted, Ryan Mintz did the rest, working in and out of trouble over three scoreless innings to nail down his first career save.

- Thanks to his standout showing on the mound in the win over the Eagles, Rosenkranz was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on March 13. He became the second Valpo pitcher to earn an MVC weekly award this season, joining Connor Lockwood. They join Jake Miller, Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse as the only Valpo hurlers to achieve MVC Pitcher of the Week status since the program joined the league.

valPROS

- Valpo's program produced a pair of pitchers who went on to continue their careers in professional organizations following the 2022 spring.

- Left-hander Jake Miller was selected with the 237th overall pick in the eighth round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Detroit Tigers. He became Valpo's first draft choice since Scott Kapers was selected

in the 17th round of the 2018 draft by the Texas Rangers.

- Miller was Valpo's highest draft choice since 2010, when Kyle Gaedele went to the San Diego Padres in the sixth round. The New York native was the highest Missouri Valley Conference pitcher taken in the 2022 draft.

- Miller made his professional debut by pitching in five games in 2022 for the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Class-A Florida State League.

- Right-hander Colin Fields was signed by the Tigers as an undrafted free agent following the 2022 draft.

- Miller and Fields are part of a long list of Tiger ties within Valpo's program. Valpo legend Lloyd McClendon was on the Tigers big league coaching staff from 2006-2013 and 2017-2020 including a stint as interim manager, former Valpo players Bo McClendon and Dalton Lundeen were also drafted by the Tigers, Valpo head coach Brian Schmack played in the big leagues with the Tigers in 2003 and current Valpo player Patrick Ilitch is the grandson of longtime Tigers owner Michael Ilitch (1992-2017) and the nephew of current owner Christopher Ilitch (2017-present).

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- The Valpo offense is loaded with returning talent in 2023 as 82.7 percent of the team's hits from last season came from players who are back for the 2023 campaign. The top six Beacons in terms of batting average return and 11 of the 15 position players who saw action a year ago are back with the program.

- Relievers Nathan Chasey and Bobby Nowak are back after posting the club's top two ERAs a year ago, but the top two arms in the weekend rotation – Jake Miller and Colin Fields – were snatched up by the Detroit Tigers.

- Valpo's newcomers include five freshmen (Kyle Tyler, Will Radich, Adam Guazzo, Cole Syversen and Thomas Cooper), two junior college transfers (Josh Spencer and Kaleb Krier) and one four-year transfer (Jake Skrine, Indiana).

- Thoughts from Head Coach Brian Schmack on the Incoming Class: "The goal going into recruiting for the 2023 class was identifying strike throwers who can fit into our pitching philosophy. We think we found four guys who will be able to come

in and compete in the zone immediately. We also look at each of the guys and think there is some runway for them physically to be able to gain strength and velocity as they mature and get into our lifting program."

Inside the Assistants: Top assistant Kory Winter returns to head coach Brian Schmack's staff this season, while assistant coaches Jeff Mayes and Trey Matthews have joined the fold.

• After spending three seasons as a volunteer assistant, **Kory Winter** was hired as Schmack's top assistant and hitting coach beginning with the 2019 campaign. Winter played collegiately at Wittenberg and has completed coaching stints at Muskingum University and Shippensburg University. He is also Valpo's outfield instructor.

• **Jeff Mayes** is in his first season on the Valpo coaching staff, serving as the team's infield coach.
