Next Up in Valpo Baseball: After being picked to finish 10th in the preseason poll, the Valparaiso University baseball team has exceeded expectations by earning a spot in the eight-team Missouri Valley Conference Tournament, which will begin on Tuesday as the eighth-seeded Beacons take on fifth-seeded Murray State in the opening round. If Valpo beats Murray State in the first round of the double-elimination tournament, the Beacons will play top-seeded Indiana State on Wednesday at 3 p.m. CT. If Valpo drops the opening game, the Brown & Gold will play an elimination game at 11:30 a.m. CT on Wednesday.

Last Time Out: Valpo took care of business over the final weekend of the regular season as the Beacons needed to win one game in the three-game set with Illinois State to clinch a Missouri Valley Conference Tournament berth, and did just that in Thursday's series opener. Valpo trailed 6-4 in the bottom of the eighth and rallied for three runs to grab a 7-6 lead. Head coach Brian Schmack turned to usual starter Bobby Nowak in the ninth and he nailed down the save to clinch the team's tournament berth. The final two games of the regular season had no implications on who made the tournament, and Valpo fell 20-10 in eight innings on Friday and 10-3 on Saturday.

Following the Beacons: Every game in the tournament will be broadcast on ESPN+. Scott Warmann (play-by-play) and Shane Dennis (analyst) will have the call of Tuesday's game against Murray State. Tom Ackerman (play-by-play) and Kirk Champion (analyst) comprise the other broadcast tandem that will call games this week. Links to live video and stats are available on ValpoAthletics.com. Head Coach Brian Schmack: Brian Schmack (188-292) is in his 10th season in charge of the program. He ranks third in program history in seasons coached and games coached as he entered 2023 having skipped 435 Valpo games. He entered the season with 168 victories, one of four coaches in program history with over 150. The former big-league pitcher led Valpo to 25 wins in his inaugural campaign in 2014, a school record for victories by a first-year skipper. Schmack, a member of the 2003 Detroit Tigers, served as pitching coach/associate head coach at Valpo for seven seasons prior to his promotion.

Series Notes: Murray State owns a slight 6-5 edge in the all-time series after the Racers came to Emory G. Bauer Field and took two of three on April 2-3 of this season. Valpo dropped both ends of a lopsided doubleheader on April 2, falling 14-3 and 14-5 before bouncing back to take the series finale 5-2 on May 3. Program Progress

- Valpo currently has 20 wins, the team's highest overall win total since the 2017 campaign (24).
- The team recently surpassed 2018 (19) for the team's highest overall win total since joining the Missouri Valley Conference.
- The team's highest overall win total in recent years comes despite the fact that six nonconference games were called off due to poor weather.
- Valpo will finish with no worse than a .426 winning percentage, so the Beacons have clinched the program's highest winning percentage since 2017.
- With 10 conference victories, Valpo has notched its highest MVC win total since joining the league. The team's previous Valley-only peak was nine in 2021.
- Valpo finished the season with a league-only winning percentage of .370. Prior to this season, the team's best MVC winning percentage was .321 in 2021.
- This also represents the first time that Valpo has finished ahead of more than one team in the conference standings since joining the league. The team finished seventh of eight in 2018 and 2019 and eighth of eight in 2021 and 2022. There was no MVC play in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Valpo in The Valley Tournament

- This will represent Valpo's fifth MVC Tournament appearance, and in two of the first four the Beacons have put together notable victories.
- In 2021, Valpo survived a pair of elimination games with wins over Missouri State and Illinois State to finish as one of the final four teams standing in the event, joining a pair of NCAA Regional qualifiers (Indiana State and DBU) and a 40-win team (Southern Illinois).
- Valpo made a strong entrance in its first MVC Tournament back in 2018, beating a DBU team that went on to earn an NCAA at-large berth by a score of 13-10 in the tournament opener before incurring tight setbacks to Bradley (11-9) and DBU (7-5).
- There have been two seasons where Valpo bowed out after the opening round – setbacks to Missouri State (2019) and Indiana State (2022).

Talkin' Schmack

- With Valpo's victory over Illinois State on May 18, head coach Brian Schmack surpassed his predecessor Tracy Woodson for third on Valpo's all-time wins list.
- Entering the MVC Tournament, Schmack owns 188 career wins.
- He sits behind only Paul Twenge (1986-2006, 378) and the legendary Emory G. Bauer (1954-1981, 359) on Valpo's all-time wins list.

Beacon Blasts

- Valpo has launched 47 home runs this season, recently surpassing the 2018 campaign (41) for fifth on the program's single-season home run list.
- This year's team owns the program's highest single-season home run total since 2002, when the team ripped 49 dingers, a total that ranks fourth in the program record book.
- Valpo holds its highest single-season home run total during the BBCOR bat era that began in 2011.

Other Record Book Watches

- The Beacons are also reaching base at a high clip, as the team's .386 on-base percentage is positioned to be its highest in over 20 years. If the season ended today, that mark would rank tied for fifth in the program's single-season record book, joining the 2001 and 1998 seasons. This would be the first time since 2001 that Valpo would own an OBP of .386 or better, and if the Beacons move that up another percentage point, it would be the squad's best team OBP since 1999.
- Valpo owns a .974 fielding percentage for the season, in line to outdo the program record of .973 set in 2018.

Skrine Shots

- Catcher Jake Skrine, who joined the program as a graduate transfer from Indiana prior to this season, has belted 11 home runs in his lone season with the Brown & Gold.
- This marks the highest single-season home run total by a Valpo player since Josh Wallace hit 11 in 2008.
- If Skrine hits one more, he will own Valpo's highest single-season home run total since 2002 (Dan Schrum, 13). If he hits two more, he will crack the program's single-season top five in home runs.
- Skrine hit two home runs over his first 21 games and has now hit nine over his last 20.
- He had a pair of three-homer series this season – at Bradley and vs. Illinois State including a two-homer game against the Redbirds.

Maka-ing Good Things Happen

- Ryan Maka ranks fourth in the Missouri Valley Conference with a .343 batting average. In MVC-only games, he finished the season second in the league in batting average at .382.
- In league-only play, Maka also ranked in the top 10 in The Valley in slugging percentage, on-base percentage, runs scored, hits, RBIs, total bases and walks.
- Entering the second game of the doubleheader on April 15 at Bradley, Maka was hitting .268 for the season. Since then, he is hitting .444 to go along with a .496 OBP and .694 slugging percentage, leading the team in all three slash-line categories in that stretch.
- Of his 32 hits during those 18 games, 10 have gone for extra bases, including four home runs. He has totaled 50 bases and driven in 25 runs while scoring 18 in those 18 contests.
- Maka's batting average from last season to this season jumped nearly 100 points as he hit .250 as a freshman a year ago.

Bobby on the Bump

- Valpo will start senior RHP Bobby Nowak for the conference tournament opener against Murray State.
- Nowak leads the Missouri Valley Conference in opposing batting average as opponents are hitting just .199 against him.
- He ranks sixth in the league in ERA at 3.59.
- Nowak's regular-season outing against Murray State was his first career start, when he went six innings and permitted two runs on just four hits and one walk while striking out nine to earn the victory.
- After coming out of the bullpen for the first 25 appearances of his Valpo career including serving as the team's primary closer last season, Nowak moved into the weekend rotation for the bulk of conference play and made seven starts.

- He temporarily returned to a relief role on May 18 vs. Illinois State, when he nailed down the save to clinch a spot in the MVC Tournament. That was his 10th career save, moving into a tie for sixth in program history in that category, joining Jon Tieman (2017-2021) and Dallas Cawiezell (2005-2007).

Winning the Close Ones

- With the 7-6 win in the May 18 game vs. Illinois State, Valpo improved to 7-3 this season in one-run games.
- This marks Valpo's best winning percentage in one-run games since at least 2005.
- Nine has been a key number for the Beacons this season as Valpo is 11-0 when scoring nine runs or more but just 9-23 when scoring fewer than nine runs.

Olive Branches

- After starting the season with a .217 average over the first eight games he played, Matt Olive has hit .377 over his last 18 games.
- He has also reached base at a .500 clip and slugged .574 during that stretch.

Banged Up Beacons

- Valpo played without four starting position players for an extended period of time as third baseman Kaleb Hannahs (hand), catcher Kade Reinertson (hand), outfielder Spencer Warfield (hand) and first baseman Brady Renfro (hip) have all been sidelined.
- Hannahs returned to the lineup for the Illinois State series on May 18, and during his first plate appearance since April 9 at Evansville, he launched a home run.
- Furthermore, Valpo has been without two potential weekend starting pitchers as Connor Lockwood (elbow) went down with a season-ending injury and Trent Turzenski has logged just one inning this season after an elbow injury last year.

Grand Salami Time

- Valpo has three grand slams this season, with Ryan Maka owning two of them.
- Maka's first slam came on April 2 vs. Murray State and his second was May 5 vs. Southern Illinois. Brady Renfro also has a grand slam, which occurred on March 10 at No. 22 Southern Miss.
- Prior to Renfro's bases-loaded big fly, no Valpo player had turned the trick since 2019 (Sam Shaikin).
- There have been 11 grand slams since Brian Schmack took over as Valpo head coach in 2014, and Maka is the first player with two in that time.
- Maka is the first Valpo player since at least 2006 with two career grand slams.
- This marks the first time since at least 2006 that Valpo has slugged three grand slams as a team in the same season.

Storybook Moment (Minus the Fairytale Ending)

- The series opener at Missouri State on Friday, April 28 was all but over with two outs and nobody on base in the ninth inning and the lower third of the Valpo batting order due up with the Beacons trailing 3-0.
- Back-to-back walks to the No. 7 and No. 8 hitters set the stage for redshirt freshman Patrick Ilitch, who was inserted into the starting lineup less than an hour before game time due to an injury-related scratch and had just two career at-bats prior to the game.
- Ilitch – whose family owns Little Caesars Pizza, the Detroit Tigers and the Detroit Red Wings – delivered by smacking his first career home run to left, leveling the score at three.
- Missouri State eventually won on a walk-off home run in the 10th.

Renfro's Impressive Streak Snapped

- Brady Renfro reached base in the first 30 games of the 2023 season before his streak was snapped on April 22 vs. UIC.
- He became the first Valpo player to reach in 20 straight since Kaleb Hannahs did so in the final 20 games of the 2021 season.
- On April 9 at Evansville, Renfro surpassed Sam Shaikin's 23 games from 2017.
- Renfro owned Valpo's longest on-base streak since Nolan Lodden reached safely in 34 straight in 2016.

Weekly Awards Sweep

- Valpo earned its first sweep of the Missouri Valley Conference weekly awards since joining the league when Jake Skrine was named MVC Player of the Week and Bobby Nowak was tabbed MVC Pitcher of the Week on Monday, April 17.
- The last time Valpo swept the weekly awards in any conference was May 16, 2016, when Jake Hanson was named Horizon League Batter of the Week and Ellis Foreman achieved Horizon League Pitcher of the Week status.
- Skrine became the fourth member of the program to win MVC Player of the Week honors since joining the league and the first this season. He joined Sam Shaikin, Kaleb Hannahs and Nolan Tucker.
- Nowak became the third Beacon to earn MVC Pitcher of the Week this season, joining Jacob Rosenkranz and Connor Lockwood. Prior to this year, Valpo had won MVC Pitcher of the Week accolades on four occasions since joining the league – Jake Miller, Colin Fields (twice) and Easton Rhodehouse.

Beacon Brooms + Blanking the Braves

- The three-game road sweep at Bradley April 14-15 marked the program's first road sweep of a league series since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. Valpo's last sweep of a road conference series of three games or more was March 18-20, 2016 at Northern Kentucky.
- It was the first time Valpo swept a conference series in any location since taking all three from Southern Illinois on May 10-12, 2019 at Emory G. Bauer Field.
- The exclamation mark on the series was a 10-0 win in the finale, Valpo's first shutout of the season and first since March 25, 2022 vs. St. Bonaventure, a game

decided by the identical score of 10-0.

- The 10-0 triumph marked Valpo's most lopsided league victory since joining the Missouri Valley Conference. The seven-inning win marked the first time Valpo implemented the 10-run rule since joining the league prior to the 2018 season.
- That was also Valpo's first shutout in a league game since joining The Valley. The team's last shutout win in conference play was April 23, 2017 vs. Wright State.

Strong Start

- Valpo stood at 7-6 through 13 games. That marked the program's best record at this juncture of the season since Paul Twenge's group won eight of its first 13 in 1997.
- Through nine games, the Valpo baseball program was off to its best start since Bruce Springsteen, Madonna and way before Nirvana as the team's 6-3 record was its best at this point in the season since 1985. Head coach Rick Ferchen's team began 1985 with a 7-2 mark through nine games.
- The highlight of the sizzling start was a five-game winning streak that was snapped in Sunday's series finale at Little Rock. That marked the team's longest winning streak since recording six straight from May 15-25, 2016. That stretch featured wins over Oakland, Youngstown State and Northern Kentucky.

Top-25 Triumph

- Valpo was recognized by D1Baseball as one of three "Upsets of the Night" on March 10 after beating No. 22 Southern Miss 6-1 in the series opener.
- The victory snapped the team's skid of 15 straight losses against nationally-ranked opponents and marked the team's first victory over a top-25 foe since beating No. 25 Illinois on April 17, 2018.
- At No. 22, Southern Miss was the highest ranked team that Valpo has defeated since a win over No. 9 Arizona State on April 21, 2013.
- Southern Miss entered the game ranked No. 22 by Baseball America, the NCBWA and D1Baseball, while ranking No. 24 in the coaches' poll and No. 30 according to Collegiate Baseball.
- The Golden Eagles were the preseason favorites to win the Sun Belt Conference and won an NCAA Regional last season before falling to Ole Miss in the Super Regional. They own a streak of six straight 40-win seasons, the longest such streak in Division-I Baseball.
- Southern Miss swept former Missouri Valley Conference member (and powerhouse) Dallas Baptist the weekend prior to dropping the game to the Beacons.

Outdueling An All-American

- In the 6-1 victory at No. 22 Southern Miss on March 10, Valpo handed 2022 consensus All-American starting pitcher Tanner Hall the loss. He went six innings and allowed two runs on six hits while walking two and striking out five.
- Hall was outdueling by Valpo starting pitcher Jacob Rosenkranz, who yielded one run on just two hits in six innings to pick up the win. He walked only one and notched three strikeouts, needing only 60 pitches to get through six frames.

- The win marked the second of Rosenkranz's career, with both coming this season. His prior victory occurred on Feb. 26 at UT Martin.
- Rosenkranz was making the second start of his collegiate career and his first of the season. This one had a far different result than his first collegiate start, which came way back on March 14, 2021 at Middle Tennessee. In that outing, he did not record an out and was charged with three runs on one hit while walking two.
- After Rosenkranz was lifted, Ryan Mintz did the rest, working in and out of trouble over three scoreless innings to nail down his first career save.
- Thanks to his standout showing on the mound in the win over the Eagles, Rosenkranz was named MVC Pitcher of the Week on March 13.

valPROS

- Valpo's program produced a pair of pitchers who went on to continue their careers in professional organizations following the 2022 spring.
- Left-hander Jake Miller was selected with the 237th overall pick in the eighth round of the Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Detroit Tigers. He became Valpo's first draft choice since Scott Kapers was selected in the 17th round of the 2018 draft by the Texas Rangers.
- Miller was Valpo's highest draft choice since 2010, when Kyle Gaedele went to the San Diego Padres in the sixth round. The New York native was the highest Missouri Valley Conference pitcher taken in the 2022 draft.
- Miller made his professional debut by pitching in five games in 2022 for the Lakeland Flying Tigers of the Class-A Florida State League.
- Right-hander Colin Fields was signed by the Tigers as an undrafted free agent following the 2022 draft.
- Miller and Fields are part of a long list of Tiger ties within Valpo's program. Valpo legend Lloyd McClendon was on the Tigers big league coaching staff from 2006-2013 and 2017-2020 including a stint as interim manager, former Valpo players Bo McClendon and Dalton Lundeen were also drafted by the Tigers, Valpo head coach Brian Schmack played in the big leagues with the Tigers in 2003 and current Valpo player Patrick Ilitch is the grandson of longtime Tigers owner Michael Ilitch (1992-2017) and the nephew of current owner Christopher Ilitch (2017-present).

Who's Back, Who's Gone, Who's New?

- The Valpo offense is loaded with returning talent in 2023 as 82.7 percent of the team's hits from last season came from players who are back for the 2023 campaign. The top six Beacons in terms of batting average return and 11 of the 15 position players who saw action a year ago are back with the program.
- Relievers Nathan Chasey and Bobby Nowak are back after posting the club's top two ERAs a year ago, but the top two arms in the weekend rotation – Jake Miller and Colin Fields – were snatched up by the Detroit Tigers.
- Valpo's newcomers include five freshmen (Kyle Tyler, Will Radich, Adam Guazzo, Cole Syversen and Thomas Cooper), two junior college transfers (Josh Spencer and Kaleb Krier) and one four-year transfer (Jake Skrine, Indiana).

Pitching Profiles
