Next Up in Valpo Softball: The Valparaiso University softball team opens up the 2019 campaign this weekend with a strong test, heading to Starkville, Miss. for the Bulldog Kickoff Classic. Valpo will face Stephen F. Austin and Middle Tennessee State once apiece in addition to host Mississippi State - all postseason teams a year ago - before closing the tournament with a pair of games in bracket play.

Looking Ahead: Valpo takes a weekend off from competition before heading to Lynchburg, Va. for the Liberty Challenge Feb. 22-24.

Following Valpo Softball: All five games from this weekend's tournament will have live stats available via ValpoAthletics.com. The Feb. 9 game against Mississippi State, as well as any potential bracket play game against the Bulldogs, will be broadcast live on SEC Network+.

Head Coach Kate Stake: Kate Stake was hired as head coach of the Valparaiso softball program on July 23, 2014 and enters her fifth season as head coach in 2019. Stake, who is 89-116 at Valpo, led the Crusaders to the 2016 Horizon League Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament - the third in program history. Stake arrived at Valpo with eight seasons of assistant coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently serving as an assistant at mid-major power Hofstra. She played her collegiate softball at fellow MVC member Illinois State and is a 2005 graduate of ISU.

Series Notes: The games this weekend will be the first meetings all-time between Valpo and both Stephen F. Austin and Mississippi State. The only previous meeting with Middle Tennessee State came before anybody on this year's team was even born - the Blue Raiders earned an 8-4 win in Orlando, Fla. in March of 1996.

Scouting the Opposition: All three opponents this weekend advanced to the postseason a year ago. Stephen F. Austin posted a 31-24 overall record and an 18-9 mark in Southland Conference play, earning a bid to the 2018 NISC. MTSU went 39-22 overall and won five consecutive games to claim the Conference USA Tournament title, advancing to the NCAA Tournament. Mississippi State went 38-23 overall and earned an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament out of the SEC, falling in the regional final to Arizona.

Valpo Picked Sixth in Preseason Poll: Valpo was tabbed to finish in sixth position in the MVC preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches. Valpo tallied 53 points in the polling to finish in sixth position, just five points behind Illinois State for fifth place. Drake topped the poll with 99 points, including nine first-place votes.

Looking Back at 2018: Valpo made an immediate impact in its transition to the Missouri Valley Conference in 2018. Despite the move to the MVC, which concluded the 2018 season 12th in the nation in conference RPI - a 16-spot jump from the Horizon League the previous year - the Crusaders posted a 27-24 record and improved on their team RPI by 67 spots from the previous season. After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, Valpo earned a fourth-place regular season finish and advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals. Valpo boasted the MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-Conference honoree in Kelsie Packard.

What's Back, and What's New: Valpo lost seven position players and two pitchers from last year's squad, but among the team's 11 returnees are four of last season's top five hitters and two of the Crusaders' top three pitchers. Valpo welcomes six freshmen and a pair of junior college transfers to the mix this season.

Finally Outdoors: After a winter spent mostly in the cages and indoors, Valpo finally gets to spend an entire weekend outside - a luxury more often enjoyed by its early-season opponents during the winter months. Valpo faces teams from Texas, Tennessee and Mississippi this weekend - the last time Valpo took on a team located further north in the opening weekend of the season came in 2014, when it faced UMass Lowell.

Leader of the Pack: Junior pitcher Kelsie Packard will look to lead the way in the circle this year after closing strong last season. The 2018 MVC Newcomer of the Year, Packard made 23 appearances in the circle in her first year at Valpo, going 8-5 with a 2.68 ERA in 102 innings of work and striking out 111 batters. She stood out in MVC play, going 6-3 with a 1.78 ERA and striking out 78 batters over 67 innings in conference action. Packard finished the season ranked third in the MVC in conference-only play in opponents' batting average (.216), fourth in ERA and fourth in strikeouts.

Experience Up the Middle: While this year's Valpo team features just two seniors, the duo has the middle of the diamond on lockdown. Second baseman Carly Trepanier and shortstop Jaymee Lawton have been stalwarts in the starting lineup - Trepanier for each of her first three seasons, and Lawton the last two years after transferring to Valpo. Last season, Trepanier was an MVC All-Defensive Team selection and hit .291 (48-for-165) with 23 runs scored and 17 RBIs. She led the Brown and Gold in batting average, on-base percentage, doubles, triples, hits and walks. Meanwhile, Lawton hit .261 (35-for-134) with 25 runs scored and 30 RBIs in 2018 and tallied 11 home runs, tied for fourth in a single season in program history. Lawton enters her senior year with 16 career home runs, already ranking among the program's career top-10 chart.
