**Next Up in Valpo Softball:** Valpo hits the road for its lone road weekend in a four-week-end stretch, making the trek to Cedar Falls, Iowa for a three-game series against UNI. This series represents the halfway mark in the Missouri Valley Conference slate.

**Previously:** Valpo dropped a three-game series at home to Drake last weekend, including a hard-fought 1-0 setback in the middle game of the series. The Brown and Gold then traveled to Loyola for a midweek doubleheader, falling 4-2 and 9-1 to the Ramblers.

**Looking Ahead:** Valpo will step out of conference play midweek next week for a single game at home against Western Michigan on Wednesday before turning around to host a three-game series against Indiana State on Friday and Saturday.

**Following Valpo Softball:** All three games this weekend will be broadcast live on ESPN+. Live stats for all three games will also be available via ValpoAthletics.com.

**Head Coach Kate Stake:** Kate Stake was hired as head coach of the Valparaiso softball program on July 23, 2014 and is in her fifth season as head coach in 2019. Stake, who is 101-135 at Valpo, led the Crusaders to the 2016 Horizon League Championship and a berth in the NCAA Tournament - the third in program history. Stake arrived at Valpo with eight seasons of assistant coaching experience at the Division I level, most recently serving as an assistant at mid-major power Hofstra. She played her collegiate softball at fellow MVC member Illinois State and is a 2005 graduate of ISU.

**Series Notes:** Valpo owns a 1-8 record all-time against UNI, but picked up that victory last season in the programs' first meeting as conference foes. Valpo claimed the opener, 2-0, before the Panthers came back with 5-0 and 7-3 victories to take the series. Valpo last played the Panthers in Cedar Falls in 2010, in the Crusaders' season opener at the UNI-Dome Invitational. Valpo played in the UNI-Dome just last year, as a doubleheader with Drake got moved to Cedar Falls, but has never played the Panthers outdoors in Cedar Falls.

**Scouting the Opposition:** The Panthers enter this weekend at 17-16 overall and 8-5 in Missouri Valley Conference play, but are on a three-game losing streak, most recently dropping a doubleheader to Drake by scores of 3-1 and 11-3. Junior Sammey Bunch is among the MVC's best hitters, entering the weekend hitting .433 with 13 home runs, 39 runs scored and 37 RBIs. In the circle, five pitchers have split time over the 33 games, with senior Brooke Craig pitching a team-high 60.1 innings, going 4-2 with a 3.25 ERA.

**Valpo Picked Sixth in Preseason Poll:** Valpo was tabbed to finish in sixth position in the MVC preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches. Valpo tallied 53 points in the polling to finish in sixth position, just five points behind Illinois State for fifth place. Drake topped the poll with 99 points, including nine first-place votes.

**Looking Back at 2018:** Valpo made an immediate impact in its transition to the Missouri Valley Conference in 2018. Despite the move to the MVC, which concluded the 2018 season 12th in the nation in conference RPI - a 16-spot jump from the Horizon League the previous year - the Crusaders posted a 27-24 record and improved on their team RPI by 67 spots from the previous season. After being picked ninth in the preseason poll, Valpo earned a fourth-place regular season finish and advanced to the MVC Tournament semifinals. Valpo boasted the MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-Conference honoree in Kelsie Packard.

**Look at the Ratings:** Valpo's front end of the MVC slate was loaded, as the four MVC teams which currently reside in the top-100 in the RPI accounted for the Crusaders' first four Valley weekend series. In Monday's NCAA RPI release, Valpo came in at 159, while as a conference, the MVC boasted four top-100 teams and ranked 11th - one spot higher than its 12th-place finish a year ago. For comparison, the Horizon League was 28th in 2017 in Valpo's final season as a league member. In fact, after playing three games against Drake last weekend, Valpo has already played 16 games this year against top-100 RPI teams - compared to 13 such games in its final two years in the Horizon League combined, none of which were league games.

**Dybalski Goes Deep:** Junior Hannah Dybalski went through the first 71 games of her career without a home run. But twice last week, Dybalski touched them all as she connected on a pair of homers. She led off the second inning in Valpo's midweek win at UIC April 3 with a round-tripper, and then last Sunday in the series finale against Drake, connected on a three-run homer.

**Big Innings, Few Hits:** In its last two wins, Valpo has put some crooked numbers on the scoreboard with a minimal number of hits. In the April 1 victory over Missouri State, the Crusaders used one error, three walks and one hit (a grand slam) to post five runs in the third inning, which eventually accounted for all of Valpo's runs in the victory. Then, April 3 at UIC, Valpo scored seven times in the first inning on just one hit (an RBI single) thanks to six walks and two hit batters. Incredibly, prior to Monday, Valpo had scored five or more runs on just one hit in an inning just twice in the previous 20 years.

**Trepanier Moves Up the Charts:** Senior Carly Trepanier will have her name plastered all over Valpo's career record book when her time as a Crusader comes to a close. Trepanier currently ranks fourth in program history in triples (10), seventh in on-base percentage (.393), tied for seventh in hits (181), eighth in total bases (253), ninth in batting average (.319), and 10th in stolen bases (28). She is just one hit shy of moving into sixth position, and one base away from seventh in total bases. Meanwhile, Trepanier is also just one walk and four runs away from those top-10 charts as well.

**No At-Bat Necessary:** Twice over the past week, Valpo has had a starter not record an official at-bat. Sunday in the series finale against Drake, Brittany Anderson went 0-for-0 with a run scored, drawing walks in all three of her plate appearances. Then, in the opener Tuesday at Loyola, Carly Trepanier finished 0-for-0 with a run scored and an RBI, walking in her first two plate appearances before delivering a sacrifice fly in her third.

**It Takes Three (or Fewer):** It seems overly simplistic, but limiting opponents' run production has been the key to Valpo's wins this season. Valpo is 11-1 this season when its opponent has scored three runs or fewer, including five shutouts. Meanwhile, the Crusaders are 1-18 when their opponent scores four or more runs. The only anomalies have come over the last week and a half - a 9-6 win at UIC April 3, and a 1-0 loss in the nightcap of the Drake twinbill last Saturday.

## Crusader Tidbits

### #1 Addi Burke (So., IF)

- Has made 17 starts at third base and three at designated player this season
- Had pair of multi-hit games in MVC-opening series at Bradley, going 4-for-9 over the three games
- Made highlight-reel play as defensive replacement in March 5 win at NC State, snagging a line drive at third base and doubling up the runner at third for a game-ending double play; play was @NCAASoftball #4 Play of the Week

### #2 Jenna Edwards (R-Jr., P)

- Tossed a gem in nightcap against Drake April 6, taking a tough-luck 1-0 loss in a three-hitter, striking out seven
- Threw a complete-game five-hitter with a season-best 10 K's in the nightcap win April 1 vs. Missouri State, and followed with five innings of three-hit ball, giving up just one run, to earn the win at UIC April 3
- Earned first career save in March 27 appearance versus IUPUI, throwing two shutout innings
- Had her longest scoreless performance in a Valpo uniform March 10 against Buffalo, throwing 5.2 innings of shutout relief with six strikeouts
- Pitched last season at Chattanooga State C.C., where she was an All-Conference honoree, recording 17 wins and tallied 154 strikeouts in 148 innings of work

### #4 Morgan Matalin (Jr., OF)

- Has started all 31 games in the outfield this year - 23 in left field and eight in center field
- Connected on three-run homer in middle game of SIU series; picked up game-winning RBI with tie-breaking RBI single in fifth inning against IUPUI
- Went 2-for-3 with two doubles and two RBIs in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- Led Valpo in batting average (.322) and slugging percentage (.508) with in MVC play last season

### #5 Ashley Barker (So., IF)

- Has made four starts at third base and three at designated player this year
- Drew a walk and scored a run in series finale with Drake April 7
- Drew a walk to lead off eventual five-run inning in nightcap win over Missouri State April 1
- Connected on a double and scored a run in a pinch-hitting appearance on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

### #8 Taylor Knight (Fr., P)

- Has made three starts and eight relief appearances in the circle this year
- Threw 1.2 shutout innings in opener April 1 against Missouri State
- Tossed two shutout innings in March 2 win over College of Charleston
- A two-time First Team All-State honoree for Elkhorn South [Neb.] H.S., helped team to four state championship game appearances and was the winning pitcher in the 2016 state title game

### #9 Addie Pixley (Jr., OF)

- Has started three games in right field and two at DP this year
- Came off the bench with an RBI double and scored a run on March 3 in the March 1 suspended game against Wagner

### #10 Jaina Westphal (Fr., OF)

- Has hit three home runs this year, most recently connecting on a two-run shot against IUPUI March 27
- Went 3-for-11 with two doubles in MVC-opening series at Bradley
- Owns a team-best 11 stolen bases on the year; has already stolen multiple bases three times this season
- Has started all 31 games this season in one of the corner outfield spots (20 in right field; 11 in left field)
- First Team All-State honoree as a senior at Burlington [Wis.] H.S., helping team to berth in state title game

### #11 Carly Trepanier (Jr., IF)

- Has drawn eight walks over Valpo's last nine games
- Ranks fourth in program history in triples (10), ninth in program history in career batting average (.319), seventh in on-base percentage (.393), tied for seventh in hits (181), eighth in total bases (253) and 10th in stolen bases (28)
- Has started 175 consecutive games for the Crusaders
- Leads Valpo with six multi-hit games on the year and also had a team-best 13-game on-base streak (snapped March 16 G2 at Bradley)
- An MVC All-Defensive Team selection a season ago
- NFCA Third Team All-Midwest Region as a sophomore in 2017

### #13 Brittany Anderson (So., UT)

- Has started all 31 games this season - 22 games at first base, six games at third base and three games in right field
- Connected on third home run of the year last time out in nightcap at Loyola
- Set a career high and matched a Valpo season high with three walks in the series finale against Drake, going 0-for-0 and scoring a run
- Scored at least one run in seven consecutive games Feb. 22-March 2, including three two-run games
- Has not committed an error in 235 career chances in the field
- Two-sport star at Valpo; an MVC First Team All-Conference honoree on the Crusaders' volleyball team in the fall of 2018, helping to lead team to postseason appearance in the NIVC

### #16 Hannah Dybalski (Jr., C)

- Has started eight games at catcher and five games at DP this year
- Delivered 3-run homer in series finale against Drake April 7
- Connected on first career home run in April 3 win at UIC as part of 1-of-2, 2-run, 2-RBI, 1-walk performance
- Drew pair of walks off the bench in nightcap March 16 at Bradley; started next day at DP and produced run-scoring single
- Went 2-for-2 with a double, an RBI and two runs scored in March 1 suspended game victory over Wagner

### #20 Jaymee Lawton (Sr., IF)

- Made first two starts of her career at shortstop last time out at Loyola
- Connected on decisive grand slam in nightcap win over Missouri State April 1, her second career grand slam

## Crusader Tidbits

- Had an 11-game on-base streak snapped in the series finale at Bradley
- Hit 11 home runs last season, tied for second in the MVC and tied for fourth in a single season in Valpo history

### #23 Peyton Moeder (Fr., OF)

- Missed opening weekend due to injury; has started each of the last 25 games (23 in center field, 2 in right field)
- Led way for Valpo offensively in March 17 win at Bradley, going 2-for-3 with a run scored and three RBIs
- Stole a base in all three games of the series against the Braves after swiping just one in her first 11 appearances
- Drew three walks and scored a pair of runs Feb. 24 in win over Princeton
- Two-time First Team All-State honoree at Mill Valley [Kan.] H.S.; helped team win regional titles and finish fourth in state each of her final two seasons

### #28 Kelsie Packard (R-Jr., P)

- Suffered injury while warming up for fifth inning April 1 against Missouri State and has been sidelined since
- Earned mid-week win over IUPUI with five innings of two-hit work
- Named MVC Pitcher of the Week March 11 after posting a 0.47 ERA in 15 innings of work over two wins, striking out 15 and allowing opponents to hit just .137 against her
- Threw five shutout innings of relief in March 5 win over NC State, just the third win over an ACC team in program history
- Threw 11th no-hitter in program history March 1 against Wagner - game was suspended after three innings and resumed March 3, when she threw the final two innings
- MVC Newcomer of the Year and a Second Team All-MVC selection in 2018 in her first season as a Crusader
- Went 6-3 with a 1.78 ERA and struck out 78 batters over 67 innings in conference action last season

### #32 Maddie Henry (Fr., C/UT)

- Has made four pinch-hit appearances this year
- Knocked a single back up the middle last time out at UIC
- Connected on her first collegiate hit in resumption of suspended game against Wagner March 3, an RBI double
- Played travel ball for Team Glory Fastpitch, where she was coached by former Crusader Maggie Seidel

### #33 Taylor Herschbach (Fr., IF)

- Has appeared in 30 of 31 games in her rookie season, including 29 starts
- 13 at designated player, 6 at 1st base, 8 at shortstop and 2 at 3rd base
- Reached base in 4 of 5 plate appearances in April 3 win at UIC, going 2-for-3 with two walks, two runs scored and two RBIs
- Led Valpo at the plate in the series at Southern Illinois, going 5-for-10 with two doubles and a triple
- Owns Valpo's longest hitting streak of the year, hitting in seven straight games March 1-10
- Scored at least one run in five straight games Feb. 24-March 3
- Second Team All-State honoree as a senior at Lockport Township [Ill.] H.S.

### #45 Emily Richardson (Jr., P)

- Has pitched in 13 games this season, making five starts and eight relief appearances
- Threw two shutout innings in March 5 win at NC State, striking out four
- Has reached in three of the first four plate appearances of her career this season, drawing a bases-loaded walk for an RBI in her first PA at Mississippi State Feb. 9 and connecting on a single in the resumption of the Wagner suspended game March 3
- Threw no-hitter last season against North Carolina Central, striking out a career-high 11 batters; was Valpo's first seven-inning no-no since 2002
- Went 4-2 with a 2.71 ERA and four saves in 72.1 innings of work last year, striking out 67 batters while surrendering just 51 hits
